THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Wes Cunningham, 1B • Sr., 6-1, 195 • Louisville, Ky. • Murray State

Cunningham hit a scorching .667 (14-for-21) in five games last week, scoring 13 runs, two doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI as Murray State compiled a perfect 5-0 record. The senior had at least two hits in all five games last week and has had eight-straight multi-hit games. He began the week by going 3-for-5 with a home run and four RBI as the Thoroughbreds won at No. 20 Kentucky. He followed that with a 3-for-5 performance and two RBI in a win over Southern Illinois. On Friday he hit three home runs and drove in six runs in a doubleheader sweep of Mid-Continent. In the finale game of that series, he was 4-for-5 and scored a career-high five runs. Cunningham's .471 batting average currently ranks second in the OVC.

Hunter Rivers, RHP • Fr., 6-1, 170 • Trinity, Ala. • Jacksonville State

Rivers allowed just two hits while striking out a career-best six in seven innings of work in a win over Miami (Ohio) on Saturday. The freshman faced just two batters above the minimum and the two hits he allowed were both singles. The righty tossed 81 pitchers and recorded seven groundball outs and eight fly outs to go along with his six strikeouts (against only one walk). The RedHawks hit just .087 against him as he lowered his season E.R.A. to 4.01.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (10-8, 0-0 OVC): After playing Evansville mid-week, the Austin Peay hosted the Governors Challenge this past weekend, its second home tournament of the season. The Govs lost to Georgia State in Saturday's opener and then topped Centenary 7-0 in Saturday's finale. Sunday's game with Centenary was cancelled due to rain. Senior catcher Trey Lucas hit .455 (5-for-11) with two doubles, two home runs and six RBI. He has had a hit in 16 of 17 games this season and in five straight entering this week. He hit a three-run homer in the win over Centenary. Junior hurler Ryne Harper allowed three hits and struck out nine in six innings of work, in the win over the Gents on Saturday night. It was his second win on the season as he shutdown a Centenary team that had combined for 26 runs in its previous two games. Austin Peay has 47 stolen bases this season (2.6/game), which is above the 26 stolen bases it had at the same point of the year last season. Those 47 swipes are most in the OVC. APSU will play at Indiana State and host Lipscomb this week before hosting Murray State in the OVC opener this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (3-14, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois is looking forward to a return home for its first home game of the season on Tuesday when Chicago State comes to Coaches Stadium. The Panthers have played its first 17 games of the season away from home, including seven in the state of Florida over the past week and a half. After a three-game series at South Florida (where EIU won two of three), the Panthers dropped neutral site contests with Army, Akron, Indiana and No. 27 Ohio State. Sophomore Ben Thoma homered twice and had a career-best five RBI in the team's loss to Army last week. The next game out Akron limited Eastern to a season-low three hits in a 6-1 loss. The team ended the week with a good showing with nationally-ranked Ohio State in a game that was a back-and-forth affair. The Buckeyes eventually scored the go-ahead run in the bottom of the eighth inning to win by a lone run. After hosting Chicago State, the Panthers will play a non-conference game at Southern Illinois and then head to Eastern Kentucky to open OVC play this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (7-10, 0-0 OVC): After playing its first 12 games of the season away from home, Eastern Kentucky played five home games last weekend. The Colonels split a two-game series with Purdue before being swept in a three-game series by Bowling Green. Junior outfielder Ryan Faidley hit .389 (7-for-18) with six runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. He was 2-for-4 with a two-run home run in Tuesday's 5-2 victory over the Boilermakers. In the series with BGSU, EKV lost close games, including a two-run affair and a one-run game. EKV continues the home stand on Tuesday when Miami (Ohio) comes to town. On Wednesday Eastern will return the game and play the RedHawks in Oxford. This weekend OVC play opens with Eastern Illinois coming to town to play the Colonels.

Jacksonville State (9-10, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State was 3-1 in its four contests a week ago and has now won seven of its last 10 contests overall. The week began with an 11-7 road win over rival Samford, before the Gamecocks won two of three from Miami (Ohio) in a weekend series. Sophomore Sam Eberle hit .438 (7-for-16) with six runs scored, a double, three home runs and 10 RBI during the week. He raised his batting average 34 points on the season and had a pair of three-run homers to help the team to the win over Samford. In the first game against Miami, Eberle was 3-for-4 with four RBI. Freshman Hunter Rivers had the best outing of his rookie season by allowing just two hits and striking out six in seven innings in the series opening win over Miami. He faced just two batters over the minimum and both hits allowed were singles. RedHawk batters hit just .087 against the righty. He earned OVC Pitcher of the Week honors for his performance. During the week senior second baseman Bert Smith became the program's all-time hits leader (263) by passing All-American and former OVC Player of the Year Clay Whittemore. He is just 25 hits away from becoming the OVC all-time leader (287 held by SEMO's Jeremy Johnson). Smith has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games dating back to last year. Junior Todd Cunningham has three triples this season bringing his season total to 15, just one short of the OVC record of 16 currently held by Bill Maclin (Tennessee Tech). This week the Gamecocks will host Troy and Samford in non-conference action before traveling to UT Martin to begin OVC play this weekend.

Morehead State (11-12, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State played five games last week, losing on the road at Tennessee and winning three of four games in a home series with IPFW. After losing 13-2 at Tennessee, the Eagles topped IPFW 21-6 and 15-6 before falling 9-8 in extra innings. MSU ended the weekend with a 13-12 win over the Mastodons. During the week senior shortstop Drew Lee became the school's all-time leader in total bases for a career (392). Entering this week Lee needs only two more runs scored to break the Eagle career record in that category too, and he is on pace to break school records for hits, RBI and at-bats as well. In four games last week Lee hit .500 (10-for-20) with eight runs scored, four doubles, a home run, eight RBI and five stolen bases (in five attempts). Lee was 4-for-4 in the series opening win over IPFW. Junior pitcher Jeff Arnold improved his record to 2-0 on the season by pitching seven strong innings in the team's Friday win over IPFW. He scattered six hits, three runs and struck out three. This week Morehead State will host Indiana in non-conference action before

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

hosting Southeast Missouri State in a three-game OVC opening series this weekend.

Murray State (11-8, 0-0 OVC): Murray State won all five of its games last week to run its winning streak to six games and seven of its last eight overall; that came on the heels of losing seven games in a row. The week began with a non-conference win over nationally-ranked Kentucky (No. 20) in Lexington. The team also beat Southern Illinois and then swept a three-game series with Mid-Continent at home. The Thoroughbreds offensive attack was led by senior Wes Cunningham who was named OVC Player of the Week. Cunningham hit .667 (14-for-21) with 13 runs scored, two doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI in five games. He was 3-for-5 with a home run and four RBI in the team's win over Kentucky and followed that with a 3-for-5 performance and two RBI in the SIU victory. In a doubleheader win over Mid-Continent on Friday, Cunningham blasted three home runs and drove in six. On the mound junior lefty Jake Donze pitched seven strong innings in picking up the win over the Salukis. This week Murray State will host No. 22 Western Kentucky before traveling to Austin Peay to begin OVC play over the weekend.

Southeast Missouri (11-8, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri State was a perfect 4-0 last week and won its fifth game in a row overall after home victories against Freed-Hardeman and a three-game sweep of Valparaiso at Capaha Field. Junior Casey Jones continued his hot hitting streak, hitting .471 (8-for-17) with three runs scored, three doubles and five RBI in the four games. Overall Jones has hit safely in 13-straight games, the second longest active streak in the OVC. His .482 batting average is the best in the OVC entering this week. Jones' two-out, two-RBI single in the seventh inning on Saturday helped the Redhawks to the one-run win over Valpo. Junior Nick Thomas picked up two wins on the mound last week. The righty started the midweek game with Freed-Hardeman and then was victorious in relief against the Crusaders. In the relief appearance he entered with the score tied, one out and a runner on first and got out of the inning unscathed allowing Southeast to score in the next inning to win the game. This week the Redhawks will host Saint Louis and Arkansas State in mid-week action before traveling to Morehead State to open OVC play this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (5-15): After playing its first 15 games of the season away from home, SIU Edwardsville finally played its first two home games of the season, topping North Dakota 11-0 and 6-1 in mid-week action. In the 11-0 win, Dustin Quattrocchi, Brian Lorenz and Josh Malin combined for the shutout while Brett Keeler led the offensive attack by going 5-for-5 with four RBI and two runs scored. The week ended by being swept in a three-game series at Evansville. The Cougars lost games by margins of 3-2 (10 innings), 9-2 and 9-3. SIUE returns to action this week when they travel to Cookeville, Tenn. to battle future OVC foe Tennessee Tech. It is the first of seven series against OVC teams this season (usually occurring when the OVC team has its weekend bye from league play).

Tennessee Tech (9-11, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech began last week with a home victory over East Tennessee State before traveling to Memphis where they dropped three games, including the finale that went into extra innings. Junior A.J. Kirby-Jones had another solid week hitting .529 (9-for-17) with five runs, five doubles, three home runs and 12 RBI. Including four walks Kirby-Jones had a .619 on-base percentage and 1.353 slugging percentage during the week. He was 2-for-3 with a double and home run in the team's one-run win over ETSU to begin the week. He leadoff double in the ninth inning of that game set the stage for a three-run rally as the Golden Eagles came from behind to win. He was 5-for-6 with six RBI in the opener at Memphis and in the finale was 2-for-4 including a three-run home run that sent the game into extra innings. AJKJ now has 11 home runs and 33 RBI in just 20 games this season, marks that should rank at the top of the national lists when the first NCAA statistics are released on Tuesday. Tech will play at Belmont this week before hosting future OVC opponent SIU Edwardsville for three games this weekend.

UT Martin (11-8, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin continued its early season success by winning three of five games last week including sweeping Cleveland State in a three-game series over the weekend (after losing two games at Arkansas-Little Rock to being the week). The hero of the week was junior first baseman Wes Patterson who hit .573 (8-for-15) with nine runs scored, four home runs and 13 RBI in five games. Most of that came against UALR, where he was 7-for-11 (.636) in the weekend series. That included a 7-for-8 outing with four home runs and 12 RBI in Saturday's doubleheader. In game two of that twin bill (a 20-11 UTM win), Cunningham drove in eight runs, which tied the Skyhawk all-time record for a single game. Also in that game Trey Karlen scored six runs which tied the UT Martin single game record held by two other players. For the week junior third baseman Cody Terry extended his hitting streak to 14 games, which is the longest active streak in the OVC this season (and one off the longest overall in 2010). Freshman hurler Dan Tobik made two appearances last week, pitching 8.2 innings, allowing five hits, two unearned runs, no walks and striking out six. He did not figure into a decision at UALR but made his first start of the season against Cleveland State, scattering three hits over six innings to pick up the win. He now has an OVC-low 1.14 ERA (2.24 lower than second place) in 23.2 innings of work this season. Overall the Skyhawks have won three of their five weekend series this year and the 11 games is tied for the most in the OVC entering the week. UTM won just 20 total games a season ago.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: After five weekends of non-conference play, Ohio Valley Conference squads will enter Conference play this weekend...The matchups include preseason favorite Eastern Illinois at Eastern Kentucky, Southeast Missouri and Morehead State, Murray State at Austin Peay and Jacksonville State at UT Martin...Tennessee Tech has a bye in Conference action this weekend, so instead the Golden Eagles will host future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville in Cookeville...Murray State leads a group of three teams with 11-8 records at this point of the season; the Thoroughbreds have won six straight games and are tied with Southeast Missouri (winners of five consecutive contests) and UT Martin atop the standings...Austin Peay is just one win behind that group of players (10-8) entering this week...The first set of official NCAA statistical leaders will be released on Tuesday and when they come out, there should be several OVC individuals at or near the top of several categories...That includes Tennessee Tech junior A.J. Kirby-Jones who has an amazing 11 home runs and 33 RBI in just 20 games this season...Southeast Missouri State's Casey Jones leads the lead with a .482 batting average while Murray State's Wes Cunningham (.471) also has a high average at this point of the year...On the pitching side of things, UT Martin's Dan Tobik has a 1.14 E.R.A. in 23.2 innings of work in 2010.

Kirby-Jones Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News: Tennessee Tech junior A.J. Kirby-Jones was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News on March 15. In six games during the week Kirby-Jones hit .526 (10-for-19) with eight runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. The junior had a .655 on-base percentage and a 1.421 slugging percentage for the week. In the first game of the Buffalo series, Kirby-Jones was 4-for-4 at the plate with three home runs and five RBI. He also drove in three runs in a road win over South Alabama on Wednesday and in game two of the series against Buffalo.

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40.

Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

baseball student-athletes are among the 30 baseball players named as a candidates for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The three players are Murray State first baseman **Wes Cunningham**, Southeast Missouri State catcher **Jim Klocke** and Morehead State shortstop **Drew Lee**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of classroom, character, community and competition.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
