THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Cameron Flynn, DH/OF • So., 6-0, 185 • Lexington, Ky. • Morehead State
Flynn hit .588 (10-for-17) with seven runs scored, two doubles, a triple, four home runs and 16 RBI in four games last week for Morehead State. The sophomore started the week by belting a home run and driving in a career-best six RBI in a non-conference victory over Indiana. In a doubleheader against Southeast Missouri on Saturday, Flynn went deep three times, including twice in a 12-11 victory in game two of the double-dip. In total he had nine RBI in that doubleheader, including five in the second game. For the week Flynn had a 1.529 slugging percentage.

PITCHER

Matt Harris, RHP • So., 6-0, 180 • Lexington, Ky. • Eastern Kentucky
Harris picked up two victories in relief last week, in helping Eastern Kentucky to a 4-1 mark on the week including a three-game Conference opening sweep of Eastern Illinois. The sophomore was nearly unhittable in 9.1 innings of work, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out eight batters in four total appearances. On Tuesday he pitched two innings of perfect relief in a home victory over Miami (Ohio). The next day in a game at Miami (Ohio), Harris added 1.2 innings of perfect relief. On Saturday he combined with Stephen Hefler to shutout EIU, pitching four scoreless innings of relief as he picked up the victory in EKU's 1-0, 12-inning victory. In that outing he struck out five while allowing just one hit. Harris closed the week by pitching up his second victory of the week, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings of relief without giving up a hit or a walk. For the week opponents hit just .036 against Harris.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (13-10, 2-1 OVC): Austin Peay played five games last week, splitting two non-conference games before winning two of three from Murray State in the OVC opening series for both teams. The Governors lost 6-5 at Indiana State on Tuesday before topping Lipscomb 4-3 on Wednesday. On Saturday APSU swept a doubleheader from Murray State, winning 11-8 and 14-8. It was the first set of consecutive wins the team had had since beating UT Martin last season; in fact that was the only consecutive OVC wins the team had all of last year on its way to a last place finish in the league. On Sunday the team dropped the finale to the Thoroughbreds 9-6. Austin Peay is now 12-4 at Raymond C. Hand Park this year but just 1-6 on the road (which is where its next two OVC series will take place). Senior catcher Trey Lucas had a five-RBI, his second of the season. In the second game on Saturday junior John Hogan was 4-for-4 with four RBI. Sophomore Jon Clinard had a team-best eight hits and four stolen bases last week. Junior Ryne Harper won his third consecutive start on Saturday. This week APSU will host Middle Tennessee before traveling to Eastern Illinois for a three-game set.

Eastern Illinois (4-18, 0-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois began the week with a non-conference win over Chicago State (4-1) in its home opener on Tuesday. Eastern improved to 15-1 in home openers under head coach Jim Schmitz. The following day the Panthers lost 9-8 at Southern Illinois. In that game Zach Borenstein hit a pair of three-run home runs (in consecutive innings). EIU led 8-6 entering the bottom of the eighth before SIU scored three times. Eastern has been outscored 35-13 in the eighth inning this season. The weekend was not much better for the Panthers, losing all three OVC games at Eastern Kentucky (the first sweep by an OVC opponent since Samford in 2008). That included a 1-0 loss in 12 innings, a 6-3 loss and a 7-6 defeat. Although only 1-9 in its last 10 games overall, Eastern Illinois has been in most every game, as its last five losses have come by a combined seven runs. EIU is just 1-9 this season in one-run games. Senior Mike Recchia pitched seven scoreless innings in the first game on Saturday, netting his best outing of the year in getting a no-decision. EIU will play at Saint Louis midweek before hosting Austin Peay in an OVC series this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (11-11, 3-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a home-and-home series with Miami (Ohio) to begin the week, winning 7-3 in Richmond before falling 11-3 in Oxford. The Colonels then hosted preseason favorite Eastern Illinois and ECU swept the Panthers, putting itself atop the OVC standings after one week of conference play. It was the first three-game sweep of an OVC opponent since March 2007 and helped even the team's overall record at 11-11 on the year. Game one featured a 12-inning, 1-0 game that saw Ryan Faidley drive in the winning run with two outs in the bottom of the 12th. Junior 3B Jayson Langfels hit .474 (9-for-19) with a triple, home run and three RBI. He was 2-for-2 and scored two runs in the win over Miami (Ohio). On Sunday he smashed his seventh home run of the season, and then delivered a two-run single in the bottom of the eighth inning to break a 4-4 tie and send ECU to the victory. Sophomore hurler Matt Harris made four appearances last week, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out eight and picking up two wins in 9.1 innings of work. Harris struck out three batters in two innings of perfect relief work against Miami on Tuesday and 1.2 innings of perfect relief the next day in Oxford. On Saturday he combined to help ECU shutout EIU, pitching four innings, allowing one hit and striking out five while picking up the win. He picked up his second win in as many days on Sunday, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings. For his efforts Harris was named OVC Pitcher of the Week. This week the Colonels will host Marshall and then travel to Southeast Missouri for an OVC series.

Jacksonville State (13-11, 2-1 OVC): Jacksonville State continued its winning ways (the team has won nine of its last 11) with non-conference home wins over in-state rivals Troy and Samford to begin the week before winning two of three games at UT Martin over the weekend to begin OVC play. Senior Andrew Edge extended his hitting streak to 12 games and leads the Gamecocks with 13 multiple-hit games. Junior All-American Todd Cunningham hit .478 (11-for-23) with eight runs scored, three doubles, a home run, three RBI and two stolen bases in five games last week. He also had a four-hit performance on Saturday against the Skyhawks. Senior Bert Smith continued his assault on the OVC record books, as he is just 17 hits, 24 games played and 19 at-bats from owning each of those Conference all-time marks. The Gamecocks continue to pile up home runs on the season, hitting two long balls in each of its last four games; the team has 31 on the season (tied for second in the OVC). Daniel Adamson has reached base safely in 26 of his last 27 games dating back to last season while Bert Smith has reached base in 28 of his last 29 games. This week Jax State will play at No. 25 Alabama before hosting Tennessee Tech in OVC action.

Morehead State (13-14, 1-2 OVC): Morehead State topped Indiana 20-15 in non-conference action during the week before hosting Southeast Missouri to open OVC play over the weekend. The Eagles won the middle game of the three game series in a slugfest weekend that saw the teams combine for 78 total runs in the three games. Sophomore Cameron Flynn was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .588 (10-for-17) with seven runs scored, two doubles, a triple, four home runs and 16 RBI in the four games. Flynn drove in a career-high six runs in the win over Indiana to begin the week. In

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

Saturday's doubleheader the outfielder connected for three round-trippers, as MSU lost game one 23-10 but rebounded for a 12-11 win in game two. Two of his three home runs came in the Eagle win. For the week Flynn slugged 1.529. Senior SS Drew Lee broke the school record for runs scored during the week and is closing in on the MSU career marks for hits, RBI and at-bats. Flynn, Lee and J.D. Ashbrook each enter this week on eight-game hitting streaks. Sophomore Josh Schneider picked up two wins on the mound this week, both coming out of the bullpen. Schneider now has six wins on the season, which is tied for the national lead entering the week. The righty pitched 2.2 innings against IU and finished off the week with 4.0 innings against Southeast Missouri. This week the Eagles will host Georgetown (Ky.) during the week before playing SIU Edwardsville at home over the weekend.

Murray State (12-11, 1-2 OVC): Murray State saw its six-game winning streak come to an end on Tuesday when the Thoroughbreds hosted and lost to nationally-ranked Western Kentucky. The team then traveled to Austin Peay to open up OVC play, dropping both games of a doubleheader on Saturday before salvaging Sunday with a 9-6 victory. In was junior lefty Jake Donze who helped the T'Breds on Sunday, as he struck out a career-high nine in eight innings of work. Donze allowed five runs on eight hits and came out of the game after facing two batters in the ninth inning. Offensively Elliot Frey led the team with a .500 (6-for-12) average last week; he scored three runs and drove in five RBI. Jonathan Craycraft added a .462 (6-for-13) batting average, a home run and two RBI. The team's leading hitter, Wes Cunningham, struggled by hitting just .231 (3-for-13), although those three hits were all home runs, as the senior drove in seven RBI. Murray State plays at Belmont on Tuesday (Belmont topped Murray State 8-6 in Murray on March 2 of this season) and then hosts UT Martin in OVC play this weekend.

Southeast Missouri (15-9, 2-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri continues to be the hottest team in the league having won nine of its last 10 games, including non-conference contests with Saint Louis and Arkansas State last week and taking two of three from Morehead State in the OVC opening series over the weekend. It is easy to see why the team has a league-best 15 overall wins at this point of the year, as Southeast leads the league in team batting (.351), team pitching (5.48 E.R.A.) and team fielding (.961). The Redhawks scored 49 runs in its three games at MSU series as the team won games by margins of 23-10 and 15-7 and lost the middle game of the series by a score of 12-11. Senior catcher Jim Klocke hit .478 (11-for-23) with eight runs, two doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI in five games. Klocke now has a team-high 30 RBI on the year. The senior hit two home runs in the series finale with MSU and currently has a 12-game hitting streak, tied for the second-longest active streak in the OVC. The Redhawks do not play a mid-week contest this week but will instead prepare to host Eastern Kentucky for a three-game set this weekend at Capaha Field. The series is the beginning of seven-straight home games for the Redhawks.

SIU Edwardsville (7-16): SIU Edwardsville played three games at future OVC foe Tennessee Tech over the weekend, losing the opener 5-0 before sweeping a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 11-8 (in 11 innings) and 12-4. In the doubleheader SIUE pounded out 31 hits to win its sixth and seventh games of the season. In the first game of the doubleheader, the Cougars trailed 8-3 after seven innings by rallied for five runs in the eighth to tie it and won in the 11th inning when Joel Greatting had a bases-loaded double that plated three runs. In game two SIUE had 18 total hits in winning by eight runs. Dustin Quattrocchi picked up saves in both games for the Cougars, including pitching 3.2 innings on relief in the finale. This weekend SIUE will play three games at another future OVC foe, Morehead State.

Tennessee Tech (11-13, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech was the only team not to host a Conference matchup this weekend, but instead played future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville in a three-game set. After a road win over Belmont to begin the week, the Golden Eagles started the weekend with a 5-0 shutout of SIUE. Senior Adam Liberatore had another good outing, allowing just two hits while striking out 10 batters in 7.2 innings of work. The outing earned Liberatore his third victory on the mound this season. On Saturday Tech lost an 11-8 extra inning affair to the Cougars and after rain forced Sunday's game to be played as the nightcap to Saturday's contest, the Golden Eagles also lost that game 12-4. Chad Oberacker hit .524 (11-for-21) during the week while adding five runs, two doubles and five RBI. Oberacker now has a seven-game hitting streak. A.J. Kirby-Jones continued his hot streak to start the season, connecting for three more home runs and seven RBI in four games last week. Kirby-Jones has 14 home runs and 40 RBI in 24 contests this year. Tennessee Tech will travel to Tennessee on Tuesday before playing three games at Jacksonville State this weekend.

UT Martin (12-11, 1-2 OVC): UT Martin opened the week with a 20-3 loss to Southern Illinois in non-conference action. The Skyhawks then hosted Jacksonville State, topping the Gamecocks 9-7 in the opener before dropping the final two games of the series. The win over Jax State on Saturday was the fourth-straight for UTM over the Gamecocks and first at Skyhawk Field over the JSU since May 2004. Sophomore Jordan Owen hit .611 (11-for-18) in four games last week; Owen scored five runs, had two doubles, two home runs and five RBI. Junior closer Wes Alsup notched his team and OVC-leading sixth save in the 9-7 win on Saturday. He faced four total batters, allowing a hit and striking out three. UTM also set a school record during that game, hitting four home runs in one inning. UT Martin will travel to Southern Illinois on Tuesday before playing an OVC series at Murray State this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Last weekend marked the first weekend of Conference play as eight of the nine OVC schools were in action...Eastern Kentucky was the lone team to come away with a sweep (of Eastern Illinois) and are now atop the league standings at 3-0...Austin Peay, Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri each won two of three games...Southeast Missouri has now won nine of its last 10 games overall and leads the OVC in team batting, team pitching and team fielding after 24 total games; the Redhawks 15 overall wins are also tops in the league...This weekend's matchups include Eastern Kentucky at Southeast Missouri, Tennessee Tech at Jacksonville State, Austin Peay at Eastern Illinois and UT Martin at Murray State...The first set of NCAA statistical leaders were released last Tuesday and among the notables were Tennessee Tech junior slugger A.J. Kirby-Jones who is second in home runs (0.55/game) and slugging (1.076); new NCAA leaders will be released tomorrow.

The OVC in the NCAA Statistical Leaders: In the first set of national statistical leaders released last Tuesday, the OVC had several teams and individuals among the leaders. As a team Austin Peay ranked 10th nationally in stolen bases (2.61/game) while Eastern Kentucky was 10th in double plays (1.29/game). Individually, Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** ranked second in home runs (0.55/game), second in slugging (1.076) and fourth in walks (1.30/game). Murray State senior **Wes Cunningham** is sixth in hits (40), ninth in home runs (0.47/game), ninth in slugging (.918) and third in total bases (78). Morehead State senior **Drew Lee** is eighth in hits (39) and fifth in total bases (72). Jacksonville State's **Andrew Edge** is eighth in RBI (1.76/game). The latest set of NCAA rankings will be released tomorrow (March 30).

JSU's Smith Closes in on OVC Hits, At-Bats and Games Played Records: Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** now has 270 career hits, which is just 17 away from tying the OVC all-time record for hits in a career. That mark (287) is currently held by Jeremy Johnson, who played at Southeast Missouri State from 1997-2000. Smith has now played in 200 career games, just 24 away from equaling the mark of 224 held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith is also just 19 at-bats behind Snellgrove's OVC record of 831.

Kirby-Jones Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News: Tennessee Tech junior A.J. Kirby-Jones was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News on March 15. In six games during the week Kirby-Jones hit .526 (10-for-19) with eight runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. The junior had a .655 on-base percentage and a 1.421 slugging percentage for the week. In the first game of the Buffalo series, Kirby-Jones was 4-for-4 at the plate with three home runs and five RBI. He also drove in three runs in a road win over South Alabama on Wednesday and in game two of the series against Buffalo.

College Baseball Foundation National All-Star Lineup: Each week the College Baseball Foundation and Diamond Sports releases a "National All-Star Lineup" which gives accolades to the past week's top performers around the country. The "National All-Star Lineup" is nominated by college coaches, staff, and baseball media contacts. Below are a list of OVC players who have been honored by the CBF this season.

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40.

Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national

committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

Three OVC Players Named Candidates for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Three OVC baseball student-athletes are among the 30 baseball players named as a candidates for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The three players are Murray State first baseman **Wes Cunningham**, Southeast Missouri State catcher **Jim Klocke** and Morehead State shortstop **Drew Lee**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of classroom, character, community and competition.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
