THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Wes Cunningham, 1B • Sr., 6-0, 195 • Louisville, Ky. • Murray State

Cunningham hit .417 (5-for-12) in three games during the week and smashed three home runs to establish a new Murray State single season home run record (17). The senior began the week with a grand slam at No. 14 Ole Miss as the Thoroughbreds erased a nine-run deficit to force extra innings with the nationally-ranked Rebels. In a doubleheader sweep of league-leading Southeast Missouri on Sunday, Cunningham hit a two-strike, two-out game-tying home run in the seventh inning to force extra innings in a game MSU won 5-3. In the second game of that double-dip, the first baseman was 3-for-4 with another home run and four RBI. Cunningham is currently on pace to set Murray State single-season records for hits, runs scored and RBI. It marks the second time this season the senior has been named OVC Player of the Week.

CO-PITCHER

Josh Mueller, RHP • Jr., 6-4, 215 • Columbia, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Mueller tossed seven innings of one-run ball in a 7-3 win over UT Martin in the series opener between the two teams. The junior allowed five hits (all singles) and one run, keeping the Skyhawks off the scoreboard until the sixth inning. Mueller struck out eight batters, including the first batter of the frame three different times. Mueller has now won his last two starts and struck out 26 total batters in his last three outings. Mueller is the third different Panther named OVC Pitcher of the Week this season.

CO-PITCHER

Coty Green, RHP • Sr., 6-2, 224 • Chattanooga, Tenn. • UT Martin

Green earned his OVC-leading eighth victory of the season, tossing a seven-inning complete game in a 2-1 win at Eastern Illinois. Green retired 17 of the first 19 batters he faced and carried a shutout into the final inning before allowing a run in that final frame. He finished the 92-pitch outing with no walks and six strikeouts (five looking), including the final out of the game with the potential tying run on second base. Green also pitched one inning of relief during the week against No. 14 Ole Miss. It marks the second time this season Green has been named OVC Pitcher of the Week.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (22-19, 4-8 OVC): Austin Peay was able to play two mid-week games before seeing its OVC weekend home series with Morehead State cancelled due to the heavy rains that battered the middle Tennessee region. The Govs opened the week with a 5-4 victory over No. 17 Vanderbilt at Raymond C. Hand Park in Clarksville. Senior Matt Kole kept his hot month going when he hit a game-tying grand slam in that game, after the Govs trailed 4-0 entering the sixth inning. Two innings later Adam Browett scored what was the game-winning run, walking, stealing second, advancing to third on a throwing error and then scoring on a wild pitch. APSU reliever David Vicini picked up the victory in relief while Zach Gerler picked up his OVC-leading ninth save of the season. A day later the Govs fell at Belmont 7-4 despite scoring three runs in the first inning. Kole finished the month of April with 29 RBI (he has 44 on the season). Austin Peay will return to action with three games at Tennessee Tech this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (13-29, 8-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois was able to avoid the weather problems that plagued the rest of the Conference, as they played all three OVC games at home with UT Martin this past weekend. The Panthers won two of those three contests to improve to 8-9 in OVC play which puts them in sixth place in the standings. EIU has won four of its last five OVC games overall. The week started with two non-conferences losses, a 10-2 defeat to Missouri at a neutral site in O'Fallon, Mo. and an 8-6 10-inning defeat at home to Southern Illinois. Junior pitcher Josh Mueller was named OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week after allowing just one run and striking out eight in seven innings of work against UTM on Saturday. He allowed just five hits (all singles) and kept the Skyhawks off the board until the sixth inning. During the week junior Cam Strang hit .350 (7-for-20) with three runs, two doubles and six RBI. The shortstop hit safely in all five games to increase his hitting streak to a career-best 15 games. Mike Recchia and Mike Hoekstra tossed complete games for the pitching staff which is starting to hit its stride on the season. Recchia struck out a season-high nine on Sunday, in registering his first career nine-inning shutout. Alex Gee was a perfect 5-for-5 in the team's loss to Southern Illinois; that was the first five-hit game by an Eastern Illinois player this season. Zach Borenstein saw his 29-game streak of reaching base end against Mizzou. The Panthers have finals this week and will play three games at Jacksonville State this coming weekend. The Panthers are now in a stretch where they play 10 of its final 15 regular season games at home.

Eastern Kentucky (21-19, 8-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky was unlucky last week, having all four of its scheduled games cancelled due to weather. The week was to begin with a game against nationally-ranked Western Kentucky but that game had to be cancelled due to scheduling conflicts. The Colonels were then supposed to host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series in Richmond over the weekend but Mother Nature forced the cancellation of each of those games. That will leave the Colonels without having played a game for a stretch of 10 days when they host Ohio University on Wednesday night. This weekend EKV will travel to Murray State for a key OVC showdown. Murray State is just half a game out of first place while Eastern Kentucky is 1.5 games behind first place Southeast Missouri.

Jacksonville State (21-19, 8-6 OVC): While other OVC teams had this past weekend cancelled due to heavy rains, Jacksonville State had the weekend off on its schedule, as the team had a bye from OVC competition. The Gamecocks did play two mid-week games, losing to UAB at home by a score of 7-5 and then a night later topped the same team by the identical 7-5 score. Sophomore Kyle Bluestein hit .500 (4-for-8) in those games, scoring three runs, netting two doubles, homering and driving in two runs. Senior Bert Smith is now just four hits away from the 300 career mark, which would make him the only active Division I player with that many hits. Smith is also closing in on the OVC career games played mark (8 away). Jax State is also the only Division I team currently with four active players with 200 or more hits (Smith, Daniel Adamson, Steven Leach and Todd Cunningham). JSU has now stolen a base in 17 of its last 18 games overall. Smith is 12-of-13 in stolen base attempts against OVC foes. The Gamecocks return to the field this week with a non-conference game at Troy and then will host Eastern Illinois in a three-game series.

Morehead State (23-19, 5-6 OVC): Due to rain Morehead State played just once last week, winning a mid-week non-conference game at Marshall. The Eagles weekend OVC series with Austin Peay was cancelled due to heavy rains. In the Marshall contest, freshman Cody Gibson pitched 4.2 innings of scoreless relief to lift the Eagles to the victory. Gibson allowed just two hits while striking out three. Offensively MSU took the lead in the seventh inning on back-to-back singles from Michael Bottoms and Andrew Deeds which set up an Eric Bainer bunt that the Thundering Herd misplayed leading to the Eagles third run. Deeds currently has a nine-game hitting streak for Morehead

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

State. The Eagles have this week off for finals, meaning the team will go 11 days between games due to this past weekend's cancellation. They return to the field this weekend when they host OVC foe UT Martin for a three-game series. Entering the week MSU finds itself in seventh place in the OVC standings.

Murray State (21-21, 8-5 OVC): Murray State had an exciting week, playing three total games, two of which went into extra innings, including sweeping two games from first place Southeast Missouri in Cape Girardeau. The week started with an 11-10, 10-inning loss at nationally-ranked Ole Miss. In that game the Thoroughbreds fell behind by nine runs by rallied to force extra innings before eventually losing by a lone run. Senior Wes Cunningham was named OVC Player of the Week for the second time this year after hitting .417 (5-for-12) with four runs, three home runs and nine RBI. The three home runs gave Cunningham 17 on the season, which set a new Murray State single-season record. Against Southeast Missouri, Cunningham hit a two-out game-tying home run that forced extra innings where MSU eventually won the game. In the final game of the Southeast series, Cunningham was 3-for-4 with four RBI. Senior lefty Matt McGaha pitched four innings of relief without allowing a hit to the league's top hitting team. In those four innings he allowed just one base runner and fanned three. Now just half a game out of first place, the Thoroughbreds will host Eastern Kentucky for three crucial OVC games this weekend.

Southeast Missouri (26-17, 10-6 OVC): Southeast Missouri State play four games last week, splitting a pair of road games at Central Arkansas before losing two OVC games to Murray State in a weekend series that was shortened by a game due to rain. The teams were unable to play on Saturday but did play a doubleheader on Sunday with Murray State winning 5-3 in extra innings and 13-9 in the nightcap. During the week senior Jim Klocke hit .533 (8-for-15) with five runs, two doubles, a home run and seven RBI. Klocke slugged .867 on the week and is now just four RBI away from claiming SEMO's all-time record. Klocke now has 181 RBI, just 27 shy of the OVC all-time record. Louie Haseltine had a 17-game hitting streak end last week but junior Casey Jones extended his hitting streak to 17 which is active entering this week. In Wednesday's win over UCA, head coach Mark Hogan registered his 850th career victory as a head coach. Hogan is now 850-647-3 in 28 years as a collegiate head coach. Despite the two losses to Murray State this weekend, Southeast Missouri finds itself still atop the OVC standings, a half a game ahead of Murray State. This week the Redhawks will host Mid-Continent and then due to an off-week in their OVC schedule of games, will play three games at Nebraska.

SIU Edwardsville (12-31): SIU Edwardsville had a busy week, playing five games, all of which were away from home. The Cougars lost 6-5 at Indiana State, 11-4 at Saint Louis University and then three over the weekend at rival Southern Illinois (7-3, 4-2, 8-5). SIUE has now lost nine games in a row overall and are 4-25 in true road games this season. Through 43 games Dustin Brooks is the team's leading hitter, batting .341 on the season. He has four home runs and 27 RBI. The Cougars will play just one series this coming week, playing three games at Bradley over the weekend.

Tennessee Tech (20-21, 6-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech played just once last week, playing in-state rival East Tennessee during the mid-week. The team saw a three-game OVC series at Eastern Kentucky washed away due to heavy rains. In the ETSU contest, the Golden Eagles fell to their rival Bucs by an 8-7 margin in a 13-inning marathon contest. Tech had 13 hits in the contest with Chad Hayes netting a team-high three knocks. Junior A.J. Kirby-Jones hit his 19th home run of the season in the seventh inning of the game that put Tennessee Tech on top 7-5 at the time. Overall the team used seven total pitchers over the 13 innings. The Golden Eagles will have the week off due to finals but return to the field this weekend when they host Austin Peay for a three-game series. Tech has won six-straight OVC games and is now in fourth place in the OVC standings, just 1.5 games out of first place.

UT Martin (20-23, 5-10 OVC): UT Martin was one of the few OVC teams who got in a full slate of games last week. The Skyhawks lost 15-6 at No. 14 Ole Miss and then were able to beat Mother Nature and play all three games at Eastern Illinois over the weekend. UTM lost game one 7-3, but took game two by a 2-1 margin before losing the third game 5-2. Senior Coty Green was named OVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season after shutting down EIU in the second game of the weekend. Green retired 17 of the first 19 batters he faced in tossing a seven-inning complete game. Green walked nobody and struck out six (five looking) as the Skyhawks won 2-1. Green now has an OVC-best eight wins on the year and 13 career wins in two seasons at UTM. That is the fifth-highest total in program history. Senior catcher Ty Nelson hit .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles and two RBI in his four games. Sophomore Jordan Owen blasted a home run in game two of the EIU series, giving him a team-high 13 on the season (all of which have come in the last 27 games of the season). Owen has hit six home runs in his last 11 games. This week the Skyhawks will play at Arkansas State and then head to Morehead State for a three-game series.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Mother Nature wrecked havoc on the OVC schedule of games for the second-straight weekend, including washing out two series completely and allowing only one series (of four total) to play the scheduled three games...A week ago all but one of Saturday's games were washed out, leaving three of the four series not to be played as scheduled...Despite losing two games to Murray State, Southeast Missouri State still sits on top of the league standings by half a game over Murray State...The league standings have tightened, as six games are now within just 2.5 games of the Redhawks and the last place team is only 4.5 out of first place...This weekend's games will feature Eastern Illinois at Jacksonville State, UT Martin at Morehead State, Eastern Kentucky at Murray State and Austin Peay at Tennessee Tech...In non-conference action Southeast Missouri plays at Nebraska while SIU Edwardsville is at Bradley.

JSU's Smith Sets OVC Record for Career Hits and At-Bats, Closes in on OVC Mark for Games Played: This season Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** has set OVC career marks for both hits and at-bats. On April 17 Smith set the record for hits, registering his 288th mark against Austin Peay and breaking the previous record of 287 held by Jeremy Johnson (Southeast Missouri, 1997-2000). Smith now has 296 career hits (and closing in on a NCAA milestone). On April 7 against No. 19 Alabama Smith became the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats, passing the mark of 831 career at-bats previously held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith now has 879 career at-bats. Smith has now played in 216 career games, just eight away from equaling the OVC career mark of 224 held by MTSU's Snellgrove (1994-97).

Smith Set to Become Only Active NCAA Player with 300 Career Hits: Not only is Jacksonville State's **Bert Smith** rank among all the career and active OVC leaders, but he is only four hits away from making a mark in the NCAA record book. With seven more hits Smith will become the only active Division I baseball player with 300 career hits. Preston Hale of North Florida is next with 262 career hits among active players.

EKU's Langfels Sets OVC Career Triples Mark: With a triple on March 24 against Miami (Ohio) Eastern Kentucky's **Jayson Langfels** netted his 17th career triple, which set the OVC career mark (previously 16 by Tennessee Tech's Bill Maclin from 1968-71). Langfels now has 18 career triples.

Morehead State's Lee, Southeast Missouri's Klocke Search for OVC Career RBI Record: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** is approaching the OVC career RBI mark. Entering the week Lee has 182 RBI (a MSU record) and is now just 26 away from the OVC mark of 208 held by Western Kentucky's Mike Williams (1978-81). Lee has some company in the chase now, as Southeast Missouri senior catcher **Jim Klocke** now has 181 career RBI, and Tennessee Tech junior utility man **A.J. Kirby-Jones** has 175.

Klocke One of 10 National Finalists for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Southeast Missouri State senior catcher **Jim Klocke** has been named one of 10 finalists for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Nationwide voting runs now through May 31 to determine the recipient of the award, which will be announced in June at the NCAA College World Series in Omaha, Neb. Fans can vote online for Klocke by going to <http://www.seniorclassaward.com> or by text messaging BASEBALL to 74567. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. Earlier in the year two additional OVC players - Murray State first baseman **Wes Cunningham** and Morehead State shortstop **Drew Lee** - were among the 30 candidates for the award but those two did not make the final cut to 10.

Hitting Streaks: Southeast Missouri State senior catcher **Jim Klocke** recently had a 25-game hitting streak come to an end. The streak was the longest in the OVC this season. The all-time OVC mark is 42 games by Austin Peay's Chuck Abbott, set in the 1996 season. Although a full list of all-time OVC hitting streaks are not available, below are a list of streaks of 25 or more games over the last eight years (2003-present).

Morehead State ranks second in home runs (2.15/game), eighth in scoring (9.5 runs/game), sixth in runs (389) and fourth in slugging (.588). Individually, Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** ranks second in home runs (0.45/game) and third in slugging (.854) and second in walks (1.18/game). Tennessee Tech's **Chad Oberacker** is third in hits (78). Morehead State's **J.D. Ashbrook** is first in runs (1.55/game), fourth in home runs (0.43/game), fifth in slugging (.834), eighth in total bases (131) and seventh in on-base percentage (.548). Murray State senior **Wes Cunningham** is eighth in slugging (.827), fifth in total bases (134) and third in runs (1.46/game). Southeast Missouri's **Casey Jones** is 10th in batting average (.449) and third in RBI (1.56/game). Morehead State's **Drew Lee** is sixth in RBI (1.51) and eighth in total bases (131). Eastern Illinois' Mike Hoekstra is eight in walks allowed per nine innings (1.05). The latest set of NCAA rankings will be released on Tuesday.

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. More information on the stadium and the Diamond Jaxx can be found at <http://www.diamondjaxx.com>. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Diamond Jaxx box office or by calling (731) 988-5299. A link to order tickets online will be available soon and posted at OVCsports.com.

EKU's Purcell Named to Mid-Season NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List: Eastern Kentucky junior closer **Ryne Purcell** is one of 45 players named to the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List. The award is given to the top relief pitcher in college baseball. Purcell has an OVC-best eight saves this season. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 2, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced on the opening day of the College World Series on June 19.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2010 season, there were three players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having two former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and relief pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is now the closer in Minnesota after being the setup man in Arizona last year. That number became four at the end of the first week of the regular season as another former OVC player - Austin Peay catcher **A.J. Ellis** - was called up from AAA by the L.A. Dodgers. One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox third base coach.

Lee Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and the NCBWA: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as well as by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on April 19/20 after an outstanding week. In four Morehead State victories Lee hit .550 (11-for-20) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, two stolen bases and a 1.450 slugging percentage. In a mid-week win over Marshall, the senior homered, drove in three runs and scored three times as the Eagles prevailed 15-6. Lee started a weekend sweep of OVC foe Eastern Kentucky by homering three times in game one of Saturday's doubleheader. He drove in two more runs in the second game of the twin bill, bringing Saturday's RBI total to six. Lee concluded the week by adding another home run and driving in five additional runs.

Flynn Named CollegeBaseballInsider.com National Player of the Week: Coming off a week where he doubled his season home run and RBIs total, Morehead State sophomore **Cameron Flynn** was named the National Player of the Week by CollegeBaseballInsider.com on March 31. In four games the previous week, Flynn batted .588 (10-for-17) with four home runs and 16 RBI. The Lexington native smacked two doubles and one triple, scored seven runs and slugged a remarkable 1.529. He knocked in a career-high six in a mid-week win over Indiana, before homering three times and tallying nine RBI in an OVC doubleheader against Southeast Missouri State on Saturday.

Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
