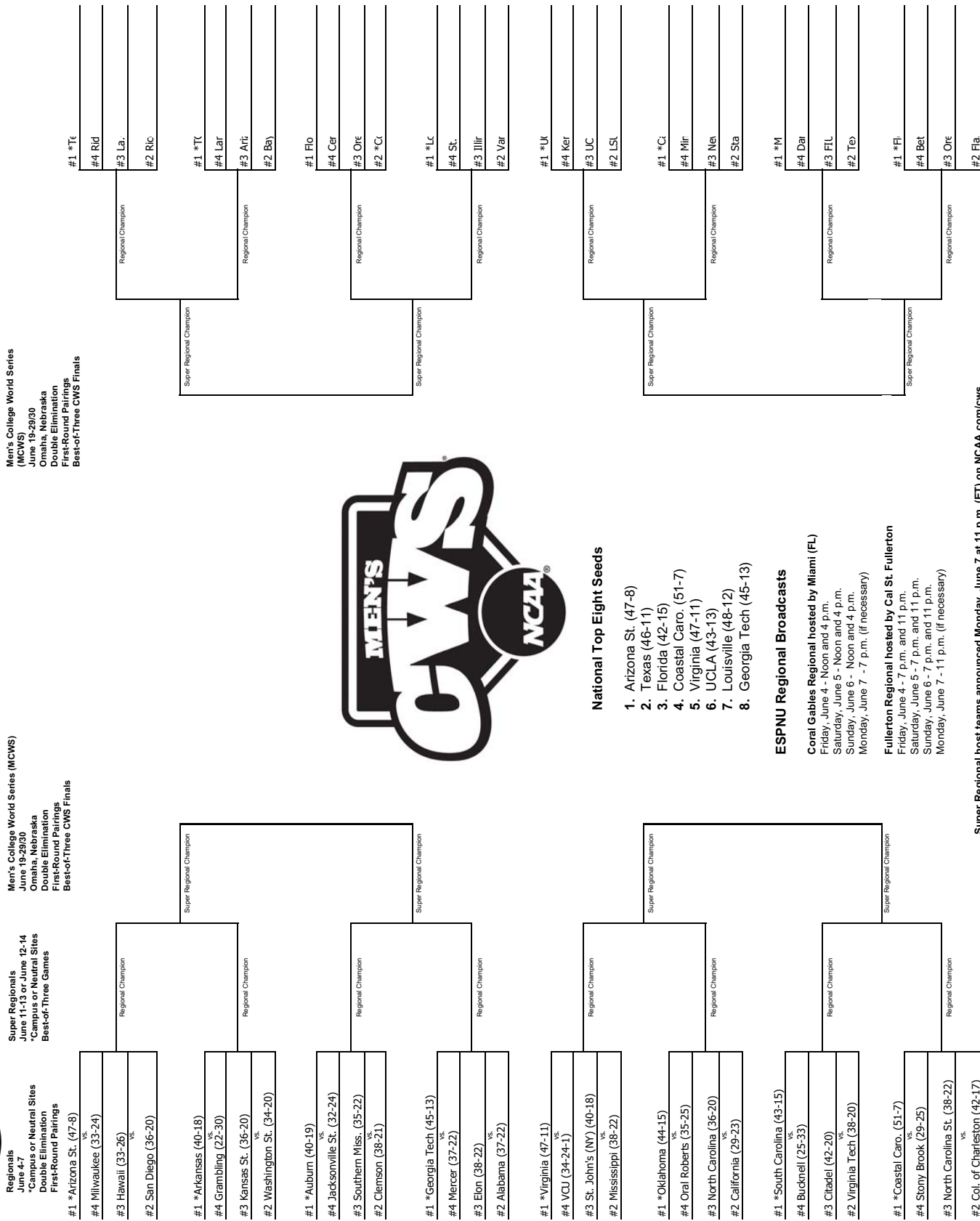

JACKSONVILLE STATE NOTES

Jacksonville State Back in the NCAA Tournament: Jacksonville State is back in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006. The No. 2 seed in last week's OVC Championship, the Gamecocks won three games to claim its third OVC Championship since joining the league. In its last two appearances in the NCAA Tournament, Jacksonville State lost two games in 2004 (at Georgia Tech) and two games in 2006 (at Alabama). Prior to joining the Division I ranks the Gamecocks appeared 13 Division II Regionals and seven Division II World Series. That includes winning it all in Division II in 1990 and 1991.

Gamecocks Claim Third OVC Tournament Crown: Entering the OVC Championship as the No. 2 seed (including winning five of its last six games), Jacksonville State went through the tournament undefeated, winning all three games to claim its third crown since joining the Conference in 2004. The Gamecocks were also OVC Tournament Champions in 2004 and 2006. Since the league moved to a neutral site format for its championship in 2001, Jacksonville State's three titles are the most for any OVC team. It also marked the third-straight season that the league's regular season champion did not win the league's tournament. In the seven years that JSU has been in the OVC, the team has played in the championship round of the event six times (2008 was the exception).

More on the OVC Championship: This season marked the 31st OVC Baseball Tournament, as the first event was held in 1980. Prior to the 1980 event, the winner of each division matched up in a three-game series to determine who the OVC champion was in that season. Since 2001 the tournament has been played at a neutral site (prior to that, the event was held at the No. 1 seed and regular season champion). From 2001-09 that neutral site was Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.; the 2010 event was the first at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. and the 10th time the event has been held at a neutral site.

Smith Named OVC Tournament MVP: Senior second baseman Bert Smith was named the MVP of the 2010 OVC Baseball Championship. Smith hit .500 (7-for-14) with three runs scored, two doubles, four RBI and two stolen bases. Smith also added a .643 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage in the three games. He was also perfect in the field, not committing an error in 18 chances, and netting seven putouts and 11 assists and helping turn three double plays. Smith had multiple hits in each game, including going 3-for-4 with three runs scored in the championship game victory over Tennessee Tech.

Smith All-Time OVC Leader for Games Played/Started, Hits and At-Bats: This season Jacksonville State senior second baseman Bert Smith has set OVC career marks for hits, at-bats and games played/started. On April 17 Smith set the record for hits, registering his 288th mark against Austin Peay and breaking the previous record of 287 held by Jeremy Johnson (Southeast Missouri, 1997-2000). Smith now has 320 career hits. On April 7 against No. 19 Alabama Smith became the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats, passing the mark of 831 career at-bats previously held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith now has 939 career at-bats. On May 16 Smith played in his 225th career game, setting a new OVC record in that category. That passed the previous record of 224 held by MTSU's Snellgrove (1994-97). He has now played in 232 games. Of those games, 231 have been starts, which is also the all-time OVC record.

Jax State Among National Leaders: Among the most recent set of NCAA statistical leaders released, Jax State's Bert Smith currently ranks 15th nationally in stolen bases (34) and 22nd nationally in stolen bases per game (0.61). As a team the Gamecocks ranks 24th nationally in triples (23).
