### PLAYER

**Trenton Moses, 3B/1B • R-Jr., 6-3, 228 • Advance, Mo. • Southeast Missouri**

In three games against North Dakota last week Moses hit .786 (11-for-14) with five runs scored, two doubles, a home run, five RBI and a stolen base. Moses was 3-for-4 with a RBI and stolen base in the series opener, an 8-6 UND victory. On Saturday he was 3-for-5 with two runs, a double and RBI as the Redhawks rebounded with a 13-6 victory. The redshirt junior closed the weekend by going 5-for-5 with three runs scored, a double, home run and three RBI as Southeast won 15-0. Overall Moses reached base safely in 12-of-15 total at-bats and had a 1.143 slugging percentage and .800 on-base percentage. After starting the season 0-for-13, Moses is 17-for-28 (.607) in his last seven games and leads the Redhawks in batting (.415). He also has a current six-game hitting streak.

### PITCHER

**Matthew Shepherd, RHP • Jr., 6-3, 185 • Bluff City, Tenn. • Tennessee Tech**

Shepherd allowed just one hit and no runs over seven innings as Tennessee Tech topped Youngstown State 13-7 in game two of Saturday's doubleheader. The junior struck out six and left the game after seven innings leading 12-0. YSU would only get one more hit off the TTU bullpen but did score seven runs in the eighth inning (thanks to seven walks) to narrow the final margin. After walking the leadoff batter of the game, Shepherd retired the next 10 batters before issuing a walk in the fourth inning. After allowing a leadoff single in the fifth, the junior retired nine of the final 11 batters he faced in picking up his first victory of the season. Shepherd currently has a 2.67 E.R.A. on the year and has struck out 28 batters in 27 innings of work.

## TEAM NOTES

**Austin Peay (8-6, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay won a pair of non-conference games last week, topping South Dakota State and Arkansas State...After topping South Dakota State 10-7 on Monday, the Governors lost the next day to the Jacks by a score of 8-2...Then after losing the first two games of the ASU series by margins of 11-2 and 6-1, APSU salvaged a win in the finale...The win on Sunday was the first on the season on the road for the Govs... Rolando Gautier currently has a 13-game hitting streak, which is the longest in the OVC this season; the freshman hit .368 (7-for-19) with three runs scored, a double, home run and five RBI last week...Gautier's two-run home run against SDSU was his first long-tripper of the year...Freshman 2B Jordan Hankins saw his 10-game hitting streak end last week but he has reached base safely in all 14 games this year...Junior lefty Jeremy Dobbs picked up both of Austin Peay's wins last week, pitching nine total innings and striking out 11 batters; he picked up the SDSU victory in relief and started Sunday's win at Arkansas State, allowing two runs over seven innings...On Saturday senior Jack Snodgrass was the hard-luck loser after pitching five innings of non-hit baseball before eventually allowing two runs on five hits over seven innings...This week Austin Peay will host Tennessee before playing a three-game series at Illinois State.

**Eastern Illinois (1-10, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois dropped a three-game weekend series at Alabama, falling to 1-10 on the season...EIU has played a tough schedule as its opponents have a combined 37-22 (.627) record this year...The Panthers have continued to struggled at the plate, hitting just .167 as a team last week...On the season EIU is hitting .208, which is the lowest team average in the OVC...OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year Mike Hoekstra pitched seven strong innings in Friday's 3-2 loss to the Crimson Tide; he struck out seven and did not walk a batter while scattering seven hits...Hoekstra left the game down a run and saw his team tie the game at 2-2 in the top of the ninth only to give up a run in the bottom of the inning...Hoekstra has 19 strikeouts on 20.2 innings of work this season...Reliever Brent McNeil has posted a team-best 2.08 E.R.A. in 13 innings this season...This week Eastern Illinois will play at Mississippi State on Tuesday and then play a three games series at Memphis over the weekend.

**Eastern Kentucky (6-8, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky began the week with a loss at Kentucky, its fourth in a row overall, but rebounded by sweeping UNC Asheville over the weekend to pull to 6-8 on the season...Junior Jacob Daniel hit .500 (9-for-18) with four runs scored, two doubles, a home run and six RBI in four games last week; he was 4-for-5 in game one of the UNCA series and 2-for-4 with three RBI in the second game...Daniel is currently hitting .347 on the season, second on the Colonels team...Senior pitcher Chris Hord earned the win on Saturday against UNCA, pitching the final 4.2 innings of the game and holding the Bulldogs scoreless while surrendering only two hits, walking none and striking out nine of the 16 batters he faced...In just 9.1 innings of work this season Hord has 17 strikeouts and just three walks...Eastern Kentucky will now begin a five-game road swing that will see them play a doubleheader at Western Virginia on Tuesday and three games at Indiana State this weekend.

**Jacksonville State (11-3, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State is the hottest team in the OVC, having won eight games in a row over the past two weeks...Overall the team has won 11 of its last 12 games, losing just a 6-1 decision at UAB on March 1...Last week the team topped in-state rival Samford 5-2 in a game shortened to five innings due to weather, and then swept Southern Illinois in a three-game set by scores of 3-1, 4-1 and 6-1...With the Gamecocks win on Sunday, head coach Jim Case won his 300th game as a collegiate head coach...This year's start is the best for JSU under Case and best for the program since 2000...The SIU series win was the fourth-straight three-game series sweep for the team dating back to last season and sixth-straight series win overall...Junior Sam Eberle hit .333 (5-for-15) with a home run and eight RBI last week; Eberle had multiple-RBI in three of the team's four games last week...On Saturday Eberle slugged a three-run home run with the game tied to push his team to a 4-1 victory...True freshman Coty Blanchard continues to lead the team with a .489 batting average; he has reached base in all 12 games in which he has played this season and leads JSU with eight multi-hit games (which ranks second in the OVC)...Senior hurler Jordan Beistline is 3-0 with a 0.00 E.R.A. in 16.1 innings of work this season...This week the Gamecocks will travel to Winter Haven, Fla. for five games, as the squad will battle Indiana, Navy, Bradley, Northwestern and Bucknell at the Russ Matt Central Florida Games.

**Morehead State (2-14, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State lost a mid-week game at Lipscomb to begin last week and then lost two of three games in a home series with LaSalle over the weekend...The Eagles beat LaSalle 6-4 on Friday before losing games by 13-9 and 9-6 margins to close the weekend series...Junior catcher Taylor Davis hit .636 (7-for-11) with three runs, a double, home run and four RBI...In Morehead State's win over LaSalle, the junior was 4-for-4; in the second game of that series he hit his third home run of the season... Junior Matthew Robertson made three appearances last week, pitching seven total innings and picking up his team's win over LaSalle on Friday; Robertson allowed three hits and no runs during his time on the mound while striking out three...This week the Eagles will host

## 2011 OVC TOURNAMENT

This year marks the second at Pringles Park for the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The tournament made its debut in Jackson, Tenn. in 2010 after nine years in Paducah, Ky. The 2011 OVC Baseball Championship will be held May 25-28 (29). Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn DiamondJaxx), the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement in 2009, guaranteeing tournaments through 2012 will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 11th year the tournament has been held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Jacksonville State was 3-0 in its way to its third OVC Tournament Championship and first since the 2006 season. The Gamecocks topped Eastern Illinois and then Tennessee Tech twice to win the title.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

**Murray State (8-7, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State finished its 11-game home stand with a four-game weekend series with IPFW, and the Thoroughbreds took three of four from the Mastodons, pushing its record back over .500 (8-7) on the season...The 'Breds finished the home stand 8-3 overall, winning six of its last seven games overall...After dropping the Friday opener 9-2, Murray State swept a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 5-3 and 9-0 and then won 4-1 on Sunday...Sophomore SS Brandon Elliott hit .750 (9-for-12) on the week, scoring eight runs, recording two doubles and stealing a base; Elliott had a .917 slugging percentage and a .800 on-base percentage on the week...Elliott was 3-for-3 with a double and two runs scored in the first game of the series and 3-for-4 with two runs scored in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader...Senior left-handed pitcher Jake Donze combined with Curran McNeeley and Tyler Saltsman for a seven-inning shutout of IPFW in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, a 9-0 Thoroughbreds victory...Donze allowed just one hit and struck out five without walking a batter in five innings of work...In four starts this season Donze is 2-0 with a 1.11 E.R.A. and he has 18 strikeouts against only eight walks...This week Murray State will play at Kentucky on Tuesday and then play three weekend games at Georgia State.

**Southeast Missouri (9-6, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri saw its mid-week games at Arkansas-Little Rock cancelled due to weather, so the team played just three weekend games at home against North Dakota...In that series the Redhawks dropped Friday's games 8-6 before winning on Saturday and Sunday by margins of 13-6 and 15-0...On Sunday Southeast pounded out 24 hits in the 15-0 victory over UND; four different Redhawks homered and Trenton Moses and Tim Rupp each went 5-for-5 in the game...The four home runs and 24 hits were both season-highs for Southeast who is leading the OVC in team batting average (.300)...For the week Moses hit .786 (11-for-14) with five runs scored, two doubles, a home run, five RBI and a stolen base; Moses reached base in 12 of 15 total at-bats during the week including his 5-for-5 game on Sunday...Moses currently leads Southeast with a .415 batting average...On the mound Brad LaBruyere picked up the win on Sunday tossing 6.1 innings of shutout baseball against North Dakota; on the season he is now 2-0 with a 3.50 E.R.A...This week the Redhawks will play two mid-week games at Missouri State before hosting Wright State for three games.

**SIU Edwardsville (4-11):** SIUE concluded its Florida trip on Tuesday with a 3-2 extra inning loss to Seton Hall before returning home to host Chicago State for three games...The Cougars won the first two games of the series played at GCS Ballpark in Sauget, Ill. by scores of 14-0 and 6-5...The series concluded with SIUE winning 7-3 on Sunday in a game played at Edwardsville High School...In the win on Friday, Spencer Patton struck out 12 Chicago State batters in seven innings of work; Patton allowed just two hits and walked only two in the contest...On the season Patton is 1-2 with a 1.66 E.R.A. in 21.1 innings of work; Patton has 27 strikeouts against only seven walks on the year...This week the Cougars will play at Illinois State on Wednesday before beginning a 13-game home stand...This weekend's games features contests with Valparaiso and Creighton.

**Tennessee Tech (7-9, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech opened the week with a 8-1 loss at Charlotte and saw the second game in that series rained out...The Golden Eagles then returned home and swept Youngstown State in a three-game series which included a doubleheader win on Saturday (by scores of 10-6 and 13-7) and a 5-4, 11-inning victory on Sunday...Matthew Shepherd allowed just one hit over seven innings in game two of Saturday's doubleheader, striking out six and leaving with a 12-0 lead...The Golden Eagles bullpen would then walk seven batters in the eighth inning and surrender seven runs to make the final margin 13-7...Shepherd leads the Golden Eagles with a 2.67 E.R.A. in five appearances (four starts) on the year...Senior Chad Oberacker hit .474 (9-for-19) in four games last week while driving in seven RBI and stealing two bases...On Sunday the All-American was also the starting pitcher and struck out 12 batters over eight innings in getting a no-decision...This week the Golden Eagles will play at East Tennessee State on Wednesday before hosting Purdue for a three-game weekend series.

**UT Martin (4-10, 0-0 OVC):** UT Martin opened the week by concluding its weather re-arranged series with defending Summit League Champion South Dakota State as the Skyhawks lost 10-3...UTM then hosted Purdue for a three-game series dropping the first two games before winning 10-9 on Sunday in walk-off fashion and ended Purdue's eight-game winning streak...In the win on Sunday Cody Terry hit the two-run homer which capped a five-run ninth inning comeback and marked the third-straight one-run game in the series with the Boilermakers...Freshman Phil Sorensen hit .438 (7-for-16) with a run scored, three double and four RBI in the four games last week; overall he has hit in eight-straight games...Sorensen had three hits and a RBI in the 10-9 win over Purdue on Sunday...Freshman Stu Jones earned his first collegiate victory on Sunday after pitching a scoreless ninth inning against the Boilermakers; Jones has a 1.80 E.R.A. in five appearances this season...After ending its 11-game home stand, the Skyhawks will now play 10-straight on the road...This week the team plays at Memphis and Arkansas State during the mid-week before traveling to UAB for a three-game weekend series.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

**Pringles Park to Host 2011 OVC Baseball Championship:** For the second year in a row Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. will host the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The Championship was held there for the first time last year as part of a three-year contract with the venue, which is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx), the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year the six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 25-29 and marks the 32nd OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (and was held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. for nine years). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Generals box office or by calling (731) 988-5299.

**2012 OVC Schedule to Switch to Friday-Saturday-Sunday Format:** In February 2011 the OVC announced a change in its Conference series format for the 2012 season. Currently the OVC plays a three-game series spread over two days, with the teams playing a doubleheader on Saturday (with one of those games being a 7-inning game, the other a 9-inning affair) and a single 9-inning game on Sunday. Starting in 2012 the series schedule will move to a three-game series over three days (Friday-Saturday-Sunday), with a single 9-inning game being played each day. Games on Friday will begin no earlier than 3 p.m. local time and no later than 6 p.m. local time. The item was unanimously approved by the OVC Board of Presidents at its meeting in early February. The OVC was previously one of just six Division I Conferences that consistently played a three-game series over just two days. One of the biggest advantages of the new schedule is the improvement of student-athlete welfare. The new format will lessen the burden of long Saturday doubleheaders (that in the past could last up to 9-10 hours) and help protect the teams from an increased risk of injury. It will also give OVC programs a competitive advantage as it will allow them to use their ace pitchers (who will normally pitch during the Friday contest) during important mid-week contests with the appropriate amount of rest, thus improving the league's performance in those key matchups. Another advantage is the flexibility in playing the three-game series when weather becomes an issue. Previously when the Saturday doubleheader was rained out, the teams played a doubleheader on Sunday if possible and missed at least an entire game in the series. Should weather be a factor with the new schedule, teams could play a doubleheader on either Saturday or Sunday and avoid missing as many key Conference games.

**NCAA Institutes Pace of Play Rules for 2011 Season:** Last July the NCAA Baseball Rules Committee voted to mandate the use of a timing device and implemented penalties for non-compliance this season (after the rules were used experimentally last season). The rule will require pitchers to start their delivery in no more than 20 seconds without runners on base. Pitchers who do not comply initially receive a warning with additional violations resulting in a ball being added to the count of the current batter. If the batter is at fault for the pitch not being thrown in 20 seconds, a warning will be given initially and additional violations will add a strike to the count. Additionally, in non-televised games, umpires will enforce a 90 second limit between innings. The new ruling allows conferences to choose to use a visible clock or assigned an umpire to administer the rules (in OVC games, the umpires will keep the clock).

**College Baseball Gets New Bats for 2012:** In NCAA baseball this season the Ball-Bat Coefficient of Restitution (BBCOR) standard has gone into effect (the standard was announced in Sept. 2008). The new BBCOR formula provides a better measure of the bat's performance and therefore allows the rules committee and bat testing laboratories to better predict field performance based on lab tests. The goal is that non-wood bats that meet this new standard will perform similarly to wood bats.

**TTU's Oberacker Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award:** Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** is one of 30 NCAA baseball student-athletes named as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. The list of candidates follows this release. Oberacker, the preseason OVC Player of the Year, is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School*®, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

**EKU's Purcell Named to NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List:** Eastern Kentucky University senior closer **Ryne Purcell** was one of 45 players named to the initial watch list for the seventh annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year

Award, given to the top relief pitcher in all of Division I baseball. Purcell, who arrived at EKU from Kaskaskia College before last season, led the OVC and was 12th in the country with 12 saves in 2010. The right-hander from Vincennes, Ind. appeared in 30 games, all in relief, with a 2-1 record and 34 strikeouts in only 31.1 innings of work. He sealed the Colonels' first postseason victory since 2007 when he saved a 4-3 win over Murray State in the OVC Tournament on May 26. Of the 45 pitchers on the list, Purcell is the lone representative from the OVC. The Big 12, SEC and Conference USA led the way with four players each on this year's watch list. The Big 10, Atlantic 10 and Atlantic Sun each have three pitchers on the list. Nominations for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award were made by baseball sports information/media relations contacts. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 18, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 1, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in Omaha on the opening day of the College World Series on June 18.

**Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater:** This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes third-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

**Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite:** Despite not having a preseason All-OVC selection, OVC head coaches still believed Jacksonville State was the top team in the league. After finishing 1.5 games out of first place in the regular season in 2010, JSU swept through the OVC Tournament, including besting regular season champion Tennessee Tech twice on its way to its third OVC Championship (2004, 2006, 2010) since joining the league in 2004. The Gamecocks did lose five positional starters from that team (three who were All-OVC selections). Jax State claimed four first-place votes and 59 total points to be picked as the favorites. Southeast Missouri finished next with three first-place votes and 55 points while Tennessee Tech, last year's regular season champions, were third with two first-place votes and 54 points. Eastern Illinois was picked fourth (36) and was followed by Eastern Kentucky (33), Murray State (28), Austin Peay (25), Morehead State (19) and UT Martin (10).

**TTU's Oberacker, EIU's Hoekstra Earn Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors:** Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** was named OVC Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Illinois junior hurler **Mike Hoekstra** was tabbed OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year in a vote of OVC head coach. Oberacker is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). Hoekstra started last season as EIU's No. 3 pitcher on paper and finished the season with a team-best 4.16 E.R.A. while winning four games in 11 starts. Hoekstra had a pair of complete games and a shutout on his resume during the season and walked only five batters in 67 innings of work (a mark that set a new OVC single-season record and ranked him first nationally in walks allowed per nine innings - 0.67).

**SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC:** On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC next season (2011-12) and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition this year; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
