Ben Waldrip, 1B • Jr., 6-6, 245 • Medford, Md. • Jacksonville State

Waldrip earned his second OVC Player of the Week honor of the season after hitting .471 (8-for-17) with four runs scored, a double, home run and four RBI in four games during Jacksonville State's trip to the RussMatt Central Florida Games in Winter Haven. The junior had three multi-hit games to raise his batting average 31 points to .397. Against Big Ten preseason favorite Indiana, he was 3-for-4 with a solo home run in the ninth inning that gave JSU its first lead of the day (the team would lose in extra innings). Against Northwestern Waldrip was 2-for-4 as the Gamecocks won 3-2. In the finale in Florida he drove in three runs in a victory over Bucknell. That included what proved to be the game-winning runs with a two-RBI double in the sixth inning. For the week Waldrip had a .706 slugging percentage and a .526 on-base percentage.

PITCHER

Mike Hoekstra, RHP • Jr., 6-3, 180 • Lansing, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Hoekstra did not walk a batter while tossing a complete game in Eastern Illinois' 3-1 victory over Memphis in the series opener on Friday night. The junior scattered seven hits and allowed only one earned run while striking out five in going the distance for the first time this season. In the process he picked up his second win of the year. Hoekstra held the Tigers to just a .100 average (1-for-10) with runners on base and retired 19 of the final 22 batters he faced.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (9-9, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay was 1-3 last week, losing a non-conference home game to SEC foe Tennessee to begin the week before losing two of three games in a series at Illinois State over the weekend...Junior lefty Jeremy Dobbs picked up the win on Saturday against the Redbirds, striking out a career-high 11 in just 6.2 innings of work...Dobbs allowed five hits and two run (one earned) in the victory; he is unbeaten on the season...The 11 strikeouts was the most by an Austin Peay pitcher since February 2010...Freshman outfielder Rolando Gautier extended his hitting streak to an OVC-best 17 games with a hit in each of the Govs four games last week...Freshman second baseman Jordan Hankins saw his streak of reaching base safely end at 17 games following Saturday's second game at Illinois State...Austin Peay's offense has struggled in its last eight games, hitting .213 and averaging 3.0 runs per game; the team is just 2-6 during that span...APSU will play at Western Kentucky on Tuesday (in a game originally slated to be played Wednesday but moved up a day) before beginning OVC play this weekend at Murray State.

Eastern Illinois (3-12, 0-0 OVC): After winning just one of its first 12 games of the season (including a loss at Mississippi State to begin last week), Eastern Illinois was 2-1 last weekend, taking two of three on the road at Memphis...The weekend started with a complete game pitching performance from junior Mike Hoekstra, who scattered seven hits and struck out five (while walking zero) in his nine innings of work as EIU won 3-1; he retired 19 of the final 22 batters he faced and held the Tigers to 1-for-10 with runners on base...Hoekstra now has two of the Panthers three wins this season and has 24 strikeouts against only seven walks and a 3.34 E.R.A. in 29.2 innings of work...Senior Shawn Ferguson batted .545 (6-for-11) with a run scored and RBI in the Memphis series; Ferguson is batting .368 with runners on base this season and leads the team with a .378 average overall this year...Ben Thoma hit .385 (5-for-13) against the Tigers and added three runs, two home runs and three RBI...After not recording a home run in its first 12 games of the season, EIU had three this past weekend in Memphis...Eastern Illinois has posted 10 or more hits in three of its last four games overall...After playing its first 15 games of the season away from home, EIU will finally get to play home games this week starting with Chicago State on Tuesday and continuing with Southern Illinois on Wednesday...his weekend the team will host Eastern Kentucky to begin OVC play.

Eastern Kentucky (6-13, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky had a rough week, going 0-5 in five road games...The Colonels lost a doubleheader at West Virginia and then was swept in a weekend series at Indiana State, which included a hard-luck 1-0 loss in 15 innings on Saturday to the Sycamores...EKU has been a team of streaks this year, opening the year on a four-game skid before winning three in a row, losing four in a row, winning three in a row and now losing five-straight...Junior SS Richie Rodriguez hit .435 (10-for-23) last week and added three runs a RBI and two stolen bases; in the last two games of the ISU series, Rodriguez was 7-for-10 with two stolen bases...Rodriguez ranks third in the OVC with 10 multi-hit games this season...Senior hurler Chris Hord struck out eight in two appearances last week, allowing no earned runs in six innings of work...After five-straight on the road EKU will play at home on Tuesday, hosting Miami University (Ohio); a day later the team will repay the favor, playing a road game at MU...The week concludes with a three-game OVC series at Eastern Illinois.

Jacksonville State (14-5, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State traveled to Winter Haven, Fla. to compete in the RussMatt Central Florida Games...The Gamecocks started the trip with a 3-2, extra-inning loss to Big Ten preseason favorite Indiana and an 8-5 loss to Navy but rebounded with victories over Bradley (5-2), Northwestern (3-2) and Bucknell (9-1) to improve to 14-5 on the season...JSU has now won 11 of its last 13 games overall...The 14-5 start is the best under current head coach Jim Case...Junior 1B Ben Waldrip was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .471 (8-for-17) with four runs scored, a double, home run and four RBI in four games; Waldrip's two-RBI double against Bucknell proved to be the game-winner...Junior Aaron Elias allowed just one run over seven innings and struck out eight without walking a batter in the team's win over Bucknell...The Gamecock pitchers have allowed just five runs over their last 27.0 innings on the mound and have struck out 21 batters, while walking just four; JSU has a team ERA of 3.42, which includes Tanner Freshour's 0.51 ERA in 17.2 innings and Jordan Beistline's 0.84 ERA in 21.1 innings...True freshman Coty Blanchard continues to lead the team and is batting .485 on the season while posting a .636 slugging percentage and a .551 on-base percentage; his 11 multiple-hit games ranks second in the OVC and is currently riding an eight-game hitting streak...Junior Sam Eberle has the Gamecocks' longest active hitting streak at nine games and leads the team with six multiple-RBI games and 26 RBI...Jacksonville State will host nationally-ranked Auburn on Tuesday and play at Alabama on Wednesday before opening OVC play by hosting UT Martin this weekend...JSU has won nine straight games against OVC foes.

Morehead State (3-17, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State continued its home stand last week by losing a mid-week game to in-state foe Georgetown College before winning one of its three games against Miami University (Ohio) over the weekend...In last week's action Luke Bainer hit .467 (7-for-15) with a double, five RBI and two stolen bases...Michael Fear added

2011 OVC TOURNAMENT

This year marks the second at Pringles Park for the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The tournament made its debut in Jackson, Tenn. in 2010 after nine years in Paducah, Ky. The 2011 OVC Baseball Championship will be held May 25-28 (29). Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn DiamondJaxx), the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement in 2009, guaranteeing tournaments through 2012 will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 11th year the tournament has been held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Jacksonville State was 3-0 in its way to its third OVC Tournament Championship and first since the 2006 season. The Gamecocks topped Eastern Illinois and then Tennessee Tech twice to win the title.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

seven hits as he hit .438 (7-for-16) with three doubles and three RBI...Daniel Pugh had six hits during the week and is currently has a 13-game hitting streak which is the second longest streak in the league entering this week's games...This week the Eagles will host Canisius in non-conference action on Tuesday and Pikeville College on Wednesday...MSU will begin OVC play on Saturday when it plays a three-game series at Southeast Missouri State.

Murray State (8-11, 0-0 OVC): Murray State was winless in four road games last week, losing to in-state foe Kentucky (7-6) before dropping a three-game series at Georgia State over the weekend...MSU allowed 42 total runs in the three-game series in Atlanta, losing by margins of 17-6, 11-6 and 14-10...That week with the Thoroughbreds a 12.94 E.R.A. for the four games, as the team walked more batters (22) than it struck out (18)...Reliever Tyler Saltsman did make two appearances, striking out five in 4.2 innings of work...Cody Larson hit .417 (5-for-12) in three appearances last week, scoring four runs and recording two doubles, a triple and driving in five RBI...Zach Noonan also drove in five runs and is tied for second in the OVC with six multi-RBI games this year...Murray State will host Mid-Continent on Tuesday before preparing to open OVC play this weekend when Austin Peay comes to town.

Southeast Missouri (11-9, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri played five games last week, splitting a non-conference series at Missouri State during the mid-week and losing two of three at home to Wright State...The Redhawks needed 13 innings on Tuesday at Missouri State but finally pulled out the 8-7 victory before losing to their rival 2-1 the next day...Senior Casey Jones hit .429 (9-for-21) last week with three runs scored, four doubles and three RBI...Jones was 5-for-5 with two doubles and two RBI on Saturday as the Redhawks topped Wright State 5-1; Jones has a team-best seven doubles on the year...Senior pitcher Corey Harness made two relief appearances last week, striking out six and walking only one in 3.0 innings of work; he picked up the win in the team's extra-inning contest with Missouri State on Tuesday, pitching 2.2 innings and striking out the side in the bottom of the 13th inning to seal the win...This week the Redhawks will host in-state rival Saint Louis University on Tuesday before opening OVC play by hosting Morehead State this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (5-14): SIUE began last week with a mid-week loss at in-state foe Illinois State before returning home to host Valparaiso and Creighton for weekend action...On Friday night it was Spencer Patton who was on target once again this season, firing a complete game shutout to top Valpo 1-0...The senior allowed just four hits and struck out 11 batters as he improved to 2-2 on the season and lowered his E.R.A. to 1.17...The only run of that game came in the eighth inning when Travis Becherer bunted his way on base, was sacrificed to second, stole third base and came home to score on a chopper to third base after he was able to avoid a tag in a lengthy rundown attempt...The team closed out the week with a 4-3 loss to Creighton on Saturday and a 9-5 loss to Valpo on Sunday...SIUE will continue its 16-game home stand this week when it hosts Bradley on Wednesday and begins a three-game series with future OVC foe Tennessee Tech on Friday.

Tennessee Tech (8-12, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech concluded its seven-game home stand with four games last week, losing 6-5 to East Tennessee State during the mid-week before losing two of three to Big Ten foe Purdue over the weekend...Zephany Guyer, who has a current seven-game hitting streak was 7-for-15 (.467) in four games last week, scoring a pair of runs to go along with a double, triple and four RBI...Zach Stephens hit .438 (7-for-16) with a triple, home run and five RBI; Stephens currently leads the OVC in both multiple-hit games (12) and multiple-RBI contests (10)...Stephens has a .398 overall batting average and is slugging .699 in 20 total games...Matthew Shepherd picked up the team's lone victory last week, and also took a loss in his other appearance; Shepherd struck out five in 7.1 innings of work...For the season Shepherd is 2-3 with a 2.62 E.R.A....This week the Golden Eagles will play at the No. 2 team in the country in Vanderbilt (19-2) on Tuesday before playing a three-game series (Friday-Sunday) at future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville this weekend.

UT Martin (4-15, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin was 0-5 last week in five road games and has now lost nine of its last 10 games overall...Despite going winless on the week, the Skyhawks were competitive, as four of their five games were decided by two runs or less, including a 2-1, 12-inning loss at UAB on Saturday...Overall nine of the team's 15 losses in 2011 have been by two runs or less...UTM started the week with losses at Memphis and Arkansas State before being swept at UAB over the weekend...UT Martin held leads in the seventh inning or later in three of its games this week (at Arkansas State, Game 1 of the UAB series, Game 3 of the UAB series) before eventually falling; the Skyhawks were outscored 13-3 in the seventh inning or later in their five games this week...The last four starting pitchers for UT Martin this week (Cody Miller, Dan Tobik, Danny Kelley, Alex Boshers) combined for a 1.67 ERA in their 27 innings pitched...Kelley pitched the first nine innings of the team's 12-inning loss to UAB, allowing just four hits and one run (a fielder's choice RBI in the first inning) in getting a no-decision; Kelley has a 2.51 E.R.A. through five starts in 2011...Senior Cody Terry hit .381 (8-for-21) with a double and three RBI last week...The Skyhawks are now halfway through a 10-game road trip...The road swing continues with a mid-week game at Evansville before opening OVC play at Jacksonville State this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Pringles Park to Host 2011 OVC Baseball Championship: For the second year in a row Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. will host the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The Championship was held there for the first time last year as part of a three-year contract with the venue, which is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx), the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year the six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 25-29 and marks the 32nd OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (and was held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. for nine years). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Generals box office or by calling (731) 988-5299.

2012 OVC Schedule to Switch to Friday-Saturday-Sunday Format: In February 2011 the OVC announced a change in its Conference series format for the 2012 season. Currently the OVC plays a three-game series spread over two days, with the teams playing a doubleheader on Saturday (with one of those games being a 7-inning game, the other a 9-inning affair) and a single 9-inning game on Sunday. Starting in 2012 the series schedule will move to a three-game series over three days (Friday-Saturday-Sunday), with a single 9-inning game being played each day. Games on Friday will begin no earlier than 3 p.m. local time and no later than 6 p.m. local time. The item was unanimously approved by the OVC Board of Presidents at its meeting in early February. The OVC was previously one of just six Division I Conferences that consistently played a three-game series over just two days. One of the biggest advantages of the new schedule is the improvement of student-athlete welfare. The new format will lessen the burden of long Saturday doubleheaders (that in the past could last up to 9-10 hours) and help protect the teams from an increased risk of injury. It will also give OVC programs a competitive advantage as it will allow them to use their ace pitchers (who will normally pitch during the Friday contest) during important mid-week contests with the appropriate amount of rest, thus improving the league's performance in those key matchups. Another advantage is the flexibility in playing the three-game series when weather becomes an issue. Previously when the Saturday doubleheader was rained out, the teams played a doubleheader on Sunday if possible and missed at least an entire game in the series. Should weather be a factor with the new schedule, teams could play a doubleheader on either Saturday or Sunday and avoid missing as many key Conference games.

NCAA Institutes Pace of Play Rules for 2011 Season: Last July the NCAA Baseball Rules Committee voted to mandate the use of a timing device and implemented penalties for non-compliance this season (after the rules were used experimentally last season). The rule will require pitchers to start their delivery in no more than 20 seconds without runners on base. Pitchers who do not comply initially receive a warning with additional violations resulting in a ball being added to the count of the current batter. If the batter is at fault for the pitch not being thrown in 20 seconds, a warning will be given initially and additional violations will add a strike to the count. Additionally, in non-televised games, umpires will enforce a 90 second limit between innings. The new ruling allows conferences to choose to use a visible clock or assigned an umpire to administer the rules (in OVC games, the umpires will keep the clock).

College Baseball Gets New Bats for 2012: In NCAA baseball this season the Ball-Bat Coefficient of Restitution (BBCOR) standard has gone into effect (the standard was announced in Sept. 2008). The new BBCOR formula provides a better measure of the bat's performance and therefore allows the rules committee and bat testing laboratories to better predict field performance based on lab tests. The goal is that non-wood bats that meet this new standard will perform similarly to wood bats.

TTU's Oberacker Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** is one of 30 NCAA baseball student-athletes named as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. The list of candidates follows this release. Oberacker, the preseason OVC Player of the Year, is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®*, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

EKU's Purcell Named to NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List: Eastern Kentucky University senior closer **Ryne Purcell** was one of 45 players named to the initial watch list for the seventh annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year

Award, given to the top relief pitcher in all of Division I baseball. Purcell, who arrived at EKU from Kaskaskia College before last season, led the OVC and was 12th in the country with 12 saves in 2010. The right-hander from Vincennes, Ind. appeared in 30 games, all in relief, with a 2-1 record and 34 strikeouts in only 31.1 innings of work. He sealed the Colonels' first postseason victory since 2007 when he saved a 4-3 win over Murray State in the OVC Tournament on May 26. Of the 45 pitchers on the list, Purcell is the lone representative from the OVC. The Big 12, SEC and Conference USA led the way with four players each on this year's watch list. The Big 10, Atlantic 10 and Atlantic Sun each have three pitchers on the list. Nominations for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award were made by baseball sports information/media relations contacts. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 18, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 1, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in Omaha on the opening day of the College World Series on June 18.

Six OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season six of the 10 OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes third-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984), Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977) and SIUE's **Gary Collins** (1970).

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: Despite not having a preseason All-OVC selection, OVC head coaches still believed Jacksonville State was the top team in the league. After finishing 1.5 games out of first place in the regular season in 2010, JSU swept through the OVC Tournament, including besting regular season champion Tennessee Tech twice on its way to its third OVC Championship (2004, 2006, 2010) since joining the league in 2004. The Gamecocks did lose five positional starters from that team (three who were All-OVC selections). Jax State claimed four first-place votes and 59 total points to be picked as the favorites. Southeast Missouri finished next with three first-place votes and 55 points while Tennessee Tech, last year's regular season champions, were third with two first-place votes and 54 points. Eastern Illinois was picked fourth (36) and was followed by Eastern Kentucky (33), Murray State (28), Austin Peay (25), Morehead State (19) and UT Martin (10).

TTU's Oberacker, EIU's Hoekstra Earn Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** was named OVC Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Illinois junior hurler **Mike Hoekstra** was tabbed OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year in a vote of OVC head coach. Oberacker is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). Hoekstra started last season as EIU's No. 3 pitcher on paper and finished the season with a team-best 4.16 E.R.A. while winning four games in 11 starts. Hoekstra had a pair of complete games and a shutout on his resume during the season and walked only five batters in 67 innings of work (a mark that set a new OVC single-season record and ranked him first nationally in walks allowed per nine innings - 0.67).

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC next season (2011-12) and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition this year; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
