### PLAYER

**Zach Noonan, OF • Sr., 6-1, 185 • Louisville, Ky. • Murray State**

In four games last week Noonan hit .563 (9-for-16) with nine hits, five runs, three doubles, a triple, home run and nine RBI in leading the Thoroughbreds to a 3-1 overall record. His biggest game of the week came on Friday against North Dakota State, when the senior outfielder went 6-for-6 with three doubles, a grand slam and seven RBI in a 17-7 Murray State victory. The six hits tied a school record and the seven RBI established a new career-high for Noonan. He followed that performance by going 2-for-5 with at triple and two RBI in Sunday's first game with the Bison.

**Todd Hornsby, RHP • Jr., 6-4, 220 • Clay, Ala. • Jacksonville State**

Hornsby was a perfect 3-for-3 in save opportunities last week in helping Jacksonville State to a 4-1 overall record during the week. The junior picked up a save against Harvard on Friday and then closed both games in Sunday's doubleheader with the Crimson. In the first game on Sunday Hornsby struck out all three batters in the top of the ninth to preserve the 5-4 victory. In the second game of the doubleheader, he needed only 12 pitches over 1.2 innings to close out the game. Overall during the week Hornsby recorded five of his nine outs via strikeout, did not walk a batter and allowed just one hit.

## TEAM NOTES

**Austin Peay (6-3, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay played five games last week, dropping two at nationally-ranked Ole Miss to begin the week before splitting a doubleheader with Eastern Michigan and besting Alabama A&M as part of the Governors Invitational in Clarksville... The first Ole Miss contest went to 10 innings as APSU lost by one run while the first Eastern Michigan game also went to 10 frames, with EMU pulling out the 16-15 victory... So far this season the Govs have played three extra inning contests among its nine games... Freshman second baseman Jordan Hankins hit .667 (10-for-15) with five runs scored, two doubles, four RBI and a stolen base in five games last week... That included a 4-for-5 performance with two walks and a RBI in the Ole Miss opener... For the season he is hitting .667 with 21 hits in 31 total at-bats while also having a .903 slugging percentage and a .732 on-base percentage... After playing seven of its first nine games at home the Govs will host two more games (against South Dakota State on Tuesday and Wednesday) before playing a three-game weekend series at Arkansas State.

**Eastern Illinois (1-7, 0-0 OVC):** After losing its first six games of the season, Eastern Illinois picked up its first win of the year on Sunday by topping Evansville 7-4... The Panthers then lost the second game of a doubleheader to the Purple Aces by a 4-1 margin... The games were part of the Evansville Spring Tournament that saw its schedule re-arranged due to weather... Junior Mike Hoekstra, the OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year, struck out five and scattered four hits in five innings of work in picking up the victory on Sunday... Junior Zach Borenstein had two triples in the UE doubleheader and leads the team with 11 hits so far this season... Senior Shawn Ferguson hit .500 (4-for-8) in the Evansville doubleheader... So far this season EIU has managed to score just five total runs in the fifth through ninth innings... Eastern Illinois head coach Jim Schmitz is just six victories away from 600 for his career... This week the Panthers will travel to Tuscaloosa for a three-game series with Alabama.

**Eastern Kentucky (3-7, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky split a home doubleheader with Western Carolina to begin last week and then lost two games as part of the Memphis Classic Tournament (and saw a third cancelled by weather)... After missing out on playing Southern Illinois on Friday, the Colonels finally got to play host Memphis late on Saturday night, losing 11-2... The tournament ended with a 3-1 loss to Oral Roberts on Sunday... Freshman Bryan Soloman was 6-for-16 (.375) for the week with a home run and three RBI... His best game came on Tuesday against Western Carolina when he was 5-for-6 with a double, home run, four runs scored, three RBI and a stolen base... Senior hurler Stephen Heffler allowed three unearned runs on Sunday after ORU; he scattered four singles and struck out four batters... Shortstop Richie Rodriguez saw his eight-game hitting streak end last week; Rodriguez leads the team with a .514 average (19 hits) so far this season... This week EKU will play at Kentucky and then host UNC Asheville for a three-game series.

**Jacksonville State (7-3, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State has won seven of its last eight games after sweeping a four-game series with Harvard over the weekend... The Gamecocks started the week with a non-conference loss at UAB before coming home to sweep the Crimson... Todd Hornsby was named adidas® OVC Pitcher of the Week after going 3-for-3 in save opportunities during the week; the junior struck out five batters in 3.0 innings of work, allowing just one hit and not walking a batter... Freshman Coty Blanchard hit .429 (9-for-21) with eight runs scored, two doubles, a home run, three RBI and three stolen bases in five games last week... Blanchard hit 8-for-10 (.800) as the team's leadoff hitter, including a solo home run to lead off Friday's first game with Harvard... In the second game of that series he was 4-for-5 with a pair of doubles... After spending the fall with the football team (where he was the backup quarterback and starting punter), Blanchard is now leading the Jax State team with a .485 average and 16 hits (in eight total games played)... The team's 7-3 start is the best under head coach Jim Case and the best for the program since opening the 2000 season with a 9-2 mark... This week the team will host former OVC rival Samford for a single game and then host Southern Illinois for a three-game weekend series.

**Morehead State (1-11, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State dropped four games last week, losing at nationally-ranked Louisville before falling in three games at the University of Tennessee Tournament, losing to Indiana in extra innings and also to Bradley and the host Volunteers... Junior Andrew Deeds had a big week, hitting .500 (7-for-14) with two runs scored, two doubles, a triple, home run, three RBI and two stolen bases... Deeds had a hit and stole two bases against the nationally-ranked Cardinals and was 2-for-4 with a double, triple and two walks in the loss to Indiana... He capped the weekend by going 3-for-4 against UT, blasting a home run and driving in two runs... Nick Duff is currently leading the team with a .343 average for the season while Taylor Davis leads the way with 12 RBI... The Eagles play at Lipscomb on Wednesday before returning home to host LaSalle in a three-game series this weekend.

**Murray State (5-6, 0-0 OVC):** After starting the season 0-4, the Thoroughbreds have rebounded by winning five of its last seven including three of four last week... After beginning last week with a loss to Arkansas State, Murray State rebounded by sweeping North Dakota State in a series that was affected by weather; the two teams played one game on Friday

## 2011 OVC TOURNAMENT

This year marks the second at Pringles Park for the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The tournament made its debut in Jackson, Tenn. in 2010 after nine years in Paducah, Ky. The 2011 OVC Baseball Championship will be held May 25-28 (29). Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn DiamondJaxx), the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement in 2009, guaranteeing tournaments through 2012 will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 11th year the tournament has been held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Jacksonville State was 3-0 in its way to its third OVC Tournament Championship and first since the 2006 season. The Gamecocks topped Eastern Illinois and then Tennessee Tech twice to win the title.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

and two on Sunday with MSU winning by margins of 17-7, 12-7 and 2-1...Senior outfielder Zach Noonan was named adidas® OVC Player of the Week after hitting .563 (9-for-16) with five runs, three doubles, a triple and nine RBI in four games...His biggest success can in Friday's victory over NDSU, as Noonan was 6-for-6 with three doubles, a grand slam and seven RBI...The six hits tied the school record while the seven RBI was a career-high for the senior...Senior lefty Jake Donze picked up a victory on Sunday with a seven-inning complete game against North Dakota State; Donze scattered seven hits and struck out six while walking just one...In three appearances this season Donze is 1-0 with a 1.40 E.R.A. in 19.1 innings of work...This week Murray State will continue its 13-game home stand with a single game with Belmont and a four-game series with IPFW.

**Southeast Missouri (7-5, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri swept a mid-week doubleheader with Central Arkansas to improve to 7-2 on the year before going to Troy this past weekend and being swept by the Trojans...Junior infielder Taylor Heon continued his good early season play by hitting .412 (7-for-17) with four RBI in the five games...In the eighth inning with the team down by two runs and facing two strikes and two outs, Heon drove a double down the line that scored two runs as Redhawks tied the game which they would eventually win 6-5 in 11 innings...Through 12 games this season Heon (who has played in 10 contests), leads the team with a .316 batting average...Senior pitcher Jordan Underwood got a no-decision on Friday against the best pitcher in the Sun Belt Conference; Underwood allowed just two hits and struck out two in six innings of work against Troy, who entered the game with the best RPI in the nation...In three starts this season Underwood is 1-0 with a 1.23 E.R.A. in 14.2 innings of work...This week the Redhawks will play two games at Arkansas-Little Rock and then return to Capaha Field for a three-game set with North Dakota.

**SIU Edwardsville (1-10):** After picking up its first win of the season last Sunday at Oral Roberts, SIU Edwardsville was 0-5 last week, dropping a game to Saint Louis University before falling in four games at the Bethune-Cookman Tournament in Daytona Beach...In Florida the Cougars lost twice to Michigan State, once to Boston College and once to host Wildcats...So far this season SIUE is being led in hitting by Mitch Matecki, who is batting .407...This week SIUE will play Seton Hall in a neutral site game in Florida before returning home to play a three-game weekend series with Chicago State.

**Tennessee Tech (4-8, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech was able to squeeze in four games last week around some heavy dose of rain as the Golden Eagles topped Belmont and Berea College during the week before losing two of three at home to Ohio University over the weekend...Catcher Ben Burgess hit .450 (9-for-20) during the week with six runs scored and a double while Austin Wulf was 8-for-19 (.421) with two RBI...Wulf has hit in 11-straight games (all but the first game of the season), which is the longest streak in the OVC...Newcomer Zach Stephens leads the OVC with 17 RBI so far this season; he has six multi-RBI games this year, which is also the most in the Conference...Stephens is hitting .404 through 12 games this year and has a .500 on-base percentage...This week the Golden Eagles will play two games at Charlotte before hosting Youngstown State for a three-game series.

**UT Martin (3-7, 0-0 OVC):** UT Martin played three games last week, dropping a mid-week game to Evansville before splitting two games with South Dakota State...The first game of the SDSU series began on Friday and the teams played just two innings before the game was suspended due to weather; the squads picked that game up on Sunday and topped the Jackrabbits 14-5...The two teams then turned around and played the second game of the series, which South Dakota State won 2-0...The two teams will salvage the third of what was scheduled to be a four game series with a single game on Monday...Freshman Phil Sorensen hit .417 (5-for-12) with a run, two doubles, a home run and four RBI last week...In the first game against the defending Summit League champion Jacks, Sorensen had three hits and drove in four RBI (including a three-run homer) in leading UTM to a 14-5 victory...Sophomore pitcher Alec Mills earned a victory in the 14-5 victory, going six innings and allowing nine hits and two runs (one earned)...UTM is in the middle of a season-long 11-game home stand...After the game with SDSU on Monday, the team will host Purdue for three games this weekend.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

**Pringles Park to Host 2011 OVC Baseball Championship:** For the second year in a row Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. will host the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. The Championship was held there for the first time last year as part of a three-year contract with the venue, which is the home of the Jackson Generals (formerly the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx), the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year the six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 25-29 and marks the 32nd OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (and was held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. for nine years). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Generals box office or by calling (731) 988-5299.

**2012 OVC Schedule to Switch to Friday-Saturday-Sunday Format:** In February 2011 the OVC announced a change in its Conference series format for the 2012 season. Currently the OVC plays a three-game series spread over two days, with the teams playing a doubleheader on Saturday (with one of those games being a 7-inning game, the other a 9-inning affair) and a single 9-inning game on Sunday. Starting in 2012 the series schedule will move to a three-game series over three days (Friday-Saturday-Sunday), with a single 9-inning game being played each day. Games on Friday will begin no earlier than 3 p.m. local time and no later than 6 p.m. local time. The item was unanimously approved by the OVC Board of Presidents at its meeting in early February. The OVC was previously one of just six Division I Conferences that consistently played a three-game series over just two days. One of the biggest advantages of the new schedule is the improvement of student-athlete welfare. The new format will lessen the burden of long Saturday doubleheaders (that in the past could last up to 9-10 hours) and help protect the teams from an increased risk of injury. It will also give OVC programs a competitive advantage as it will allow them to use their ace pitchers (who will normally pitch during the Friday contest) during important mid-week contests with the appropriate amount of rest, thus improving the league's performance in those key matchups. Another advantage is the flexibility in playing the three-game series when weather becomes an issue. Previously when the Saturday doubleheader was rained out, the teams played a doubleheader on Sunday if possible and missed at least an entire game in the series. Should weather be a factor with the new schedule, teams could play a doubleheader on either Saturday or Sunday and avoid missing as many key Conference games.

**NCAA Institutes Pace of Play Rules for 2011 Season:** Last July the NCAA Baseball Rules Committee voted to mandate the use of a timing device and implemented penalties for non-compliance this season (after the rules were used experimentally last season). The rule will require pitchers to start their delivery in no more than 20 seconds without runners on base. Pitchers who do not comply initially receive a warning with additional violations resulting in a ball being added to the count of the current batter. If the batter is at fault for the pitch not being thrown in 20 seconds, a warning will be given initially and additional violations will add a strike to the count. Additionally, in non-televvised games, umpires will enforce a 90 second limit between innings. The new ruling allows conferences to choose to use a visible clock or assigned an umpire to administer the rules (in OVC games, the umpires will keep the clock).

**College Baseball Gets New Bats for 2012:** In NCAA baseball this season the Ball-Bat Coefficient of Restitution (BBCOR) standard has gone into effect (the standard was announced in Sept. 2008). The new BBCOR formula provides a better measure of the bat's performance and therefore allows the rules committee and bat testing laboratories to better predict field performance based on lab tests. The goal is that non-wood bats that meet this new standard will perform similarly to wood bats.

**TTU's Oberacker Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award:** Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** is one of 30 NCAA baseball student-athletes named as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. The list of candidates follows this release. Oberacker, the preseason OVC Player of the Year, is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®*, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

**EKU's Purcell Named to NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List:** Eastern Kentucky University senior closer **Ryne Purcell** was one of 45 players named to the initial watch list for the seventh annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to

the top relief pitcher in all of Division I baseball. Purcell, who arrived at ECU from Kaskaskia College before last season, led the OVC and was 12th in the country with 12 saves in 2010. The right-hander from Vincennes, Ind. appeared in 30 games, all in relief, with a 2-1 record and 34 strikeouts in only 31.1 innings of work. He sealed the Colonels' first postseason victory since 2007 when he saved a 4-3 win over Murray State in the OVC Tournament on May 26. Of the 45 pitchers on the list, Purcell is the lone representative from the OVC. The Big 12, SEC and Conference USA led the way with four players each on this year's watch list. The Big 10, Atlantic 10 and Atlantic Sun each have three pitchers on the list. Nominations for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award were made by baseball sports information/media relations contacts. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 18, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 1, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in Omaha on the opening day of the College World Series on June 18.

**Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater:** This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes third-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

**Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite:** Despite not having a preseason All-OVC selection, OVC head coaches still believed Jacksonville State was the top team in the league. After finishing 1.5 games out of first place in the regular season in 2010, JSU swept through the OVC Tournament, including besting regular season champion Tennessee Tech twice on its way to its third OVC Championship (2004, 2006, 2010) since joining the league in 2004. The Gamecocks did lose five positional starters from that team (three who were All-OVC selections). Jax State claimed four first-place votes and 59 total points to be picked as the favorites. Southeast Missouri finished next with three first-place votes and 55 points while Tennessee Tech, last year's regular season champions, were third with two first-place votes and 54 points. Eastern Illinois was picked fourth (36) and was followed by Eastern Kentucky (33), Murray State (28), Austin Peay (25), Morehead State (19) and UT Martin (10).

**TTU's Oberacker, EIU's Hoekstra Earn Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors:** Tennessee Tech senior All-American outfielder **Chad Oberacker** was named OVC Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Illinois junior hurler **Mike Hoekstra** was tabbed OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year in a vote of OVC head coach. Oberacker is the only returning All-American from the OVC last season. Despite being drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 19th round, the outfielder decided to return to school for one more season. Last year he was third nationally with a .452 batting average while setting OVC single-season records for hits (108) and doubles (29). Hoekstra started last season as EIU's No. 3 pitcher on paper and finished the season with a team-best 4.16 E.R.A. while winning four games in 11 starts. Hoekstra had a pair of complete games and a shutout on his resume during the season and walked only five batters in 67 innings of work (a mark that set a new OVC single-season record and ranked him first nationally in walks allowed per nine innings - 0.67).

**SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC:** On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC next season (2011-12) and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition this year; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
