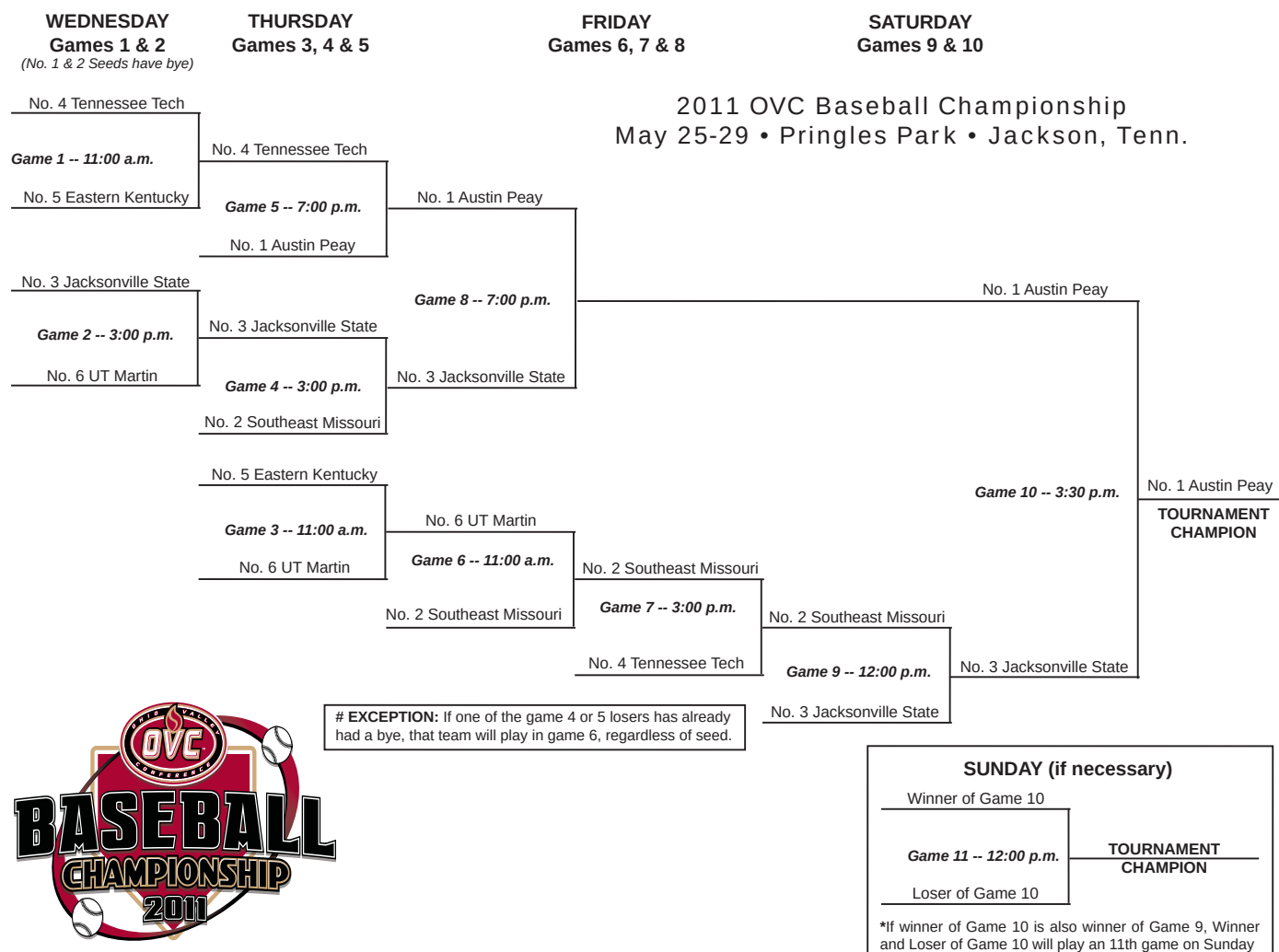

All-Time OVC Record: 21-66

AUSTIN PEAY NOTES

Austin Peay Back in the NCAA Tournament: Austin Peay is back in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2007. The No. 1 seed in the OVC Tournament, the Governors swept through the Championship by going 3-0 with wins over Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State (twice). The appearance is the fourth all-time for Austin Peay who also appeared in the NCAA's in 1996, 2005 and 2007. The last time Austin Peay was in the NCAA Tournament, the Governors nearly upset No. 1 overall national seed Vanderbilt and David Price, taking the Commodores to extra innings before losing 2-1 on an unearned run in the bottom of the 11th. Austin Peay would go on to beat Memphis in its second game of the Regional only to lose to Vanderbilt in the next game. APSU is 1-6 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

Governors Claim Fourth OVC Tournament Crown: After not appearing in either the 2009 or 2010 OVC Tournament field (by finishing outside the top six), Austin Peay got back into the field this year after winning the OVC Regular Season Championship. It marked only the second time in league history that a team had failed to make the OVC Tournament field the previous year and then gone on to win the Championship in the following year (Tennessee Tech in 2001 was the other team).

More on the OVC Championship: This season marked the 33rd OVC Baseball Tournament, as the first event was held in 1979. Prior to the 1979 event, the winner of each division matched up in a three-game series to determine who the OVC champion was in that season. Since 2001 the tournament has been played at a neutral site (prior to that, the event was held at the No. 1 seed and regular season champion). From 2001-09 that neutral site was Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.; the 2010 and 2011 events were each played at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. and the 11th time the event has been held at a neutral site.

Snodgrass Named OVC Tournament MVP: Senior left-handed pitcher Jack Snodgrass was named MVP of the OVC Tournament after his performance against Jacksonville State on Friday night at the event. His victory helped the Governors stayed undefeated in the tournament and advanced them to the Championship Round. Snodgrass pitched 7.2 innings, scattering nine hits and allowing just one unearned run while striking out 11 batters (which tied a season-high by any APSU pitcher) and walked only two. Snodgrass kept the game scoreless until the sixth inning, when JSU scored the first run of the game; that marked the longest scoreless game by both teams to start an OVC Tournament contest since the event moved to a neutral site in 2001. The last Austin Peay pitcher named MVP of the OVC Tournament was Matt Reynolds in 2007; Reynolds is now pitching for the Colorado Rockies.

Austin Peay Wins 2011 OVC Regular Season Championship: After not qualifying for the OVC Tournament each of the last two seasons and being picked seventh in the coaches preseason poll, Austin Peay completed quite the turnaround in 2011 going from seventh place (8-13) in the OVC to being regular season champions in 2011 (17-6). It marked the sixth time since divisional play ended that Austin Peay has been the regular season champions; the team also won in 1994, 1996, 2003, 2004 and 2007. Austin Peay also claimed divisional crowns in 1971 and 1984; in 1971 the Gobs went on to win a three-game playoff series and were deemed "OVC Champions" but in 1984 the team lost in the four-team OVC Tournament and was not deemed the "champion" that season. The Governors are one of just two OVC teams to fail to qualify for the tournament one year (meaning they finished seventh or worst in the league) and win the regular season the following year. The other team was Samford in 2006.

McClure Second All-Time in Wins in OVC History: Austin Peay head coach Gary McClure, now in his 24th season at his alma mater, enters the NCAA Championship with 711 career wins, which is second in OVC history. He trails OVC all-time leader Johnny Reagan (Murray State) by just 65 wins. McClure was named OVC Coach of the Year this season, the fifth time he has won the award, joining honors he earned in 1992, 1994, 2003 and 2007. The five awards are tied for second most in OVC history (with Eastern Kentucky's Jim Ward), and is just two off the all-time record of seven held by Murray State's Johnny Reagan (who also holds the OVC record for wins).

Austin Peay Among National Leaders: Among the most recent set of NCAA statistical leaders, Austin Peay ranks 18th nationally in sacrifice flies (33), 20th in stolen bases/game (1.73), 26th in batting average (.306), 27th in home runs/game (0.82) and 29th in scoring (6.9 runs/game). Individually sophomore John Hogan ranks 23rd in RBI (1.13/game) and sacrifice flies (7) while Michael Blanchard is 25th in stolen bases/game (0.53).
