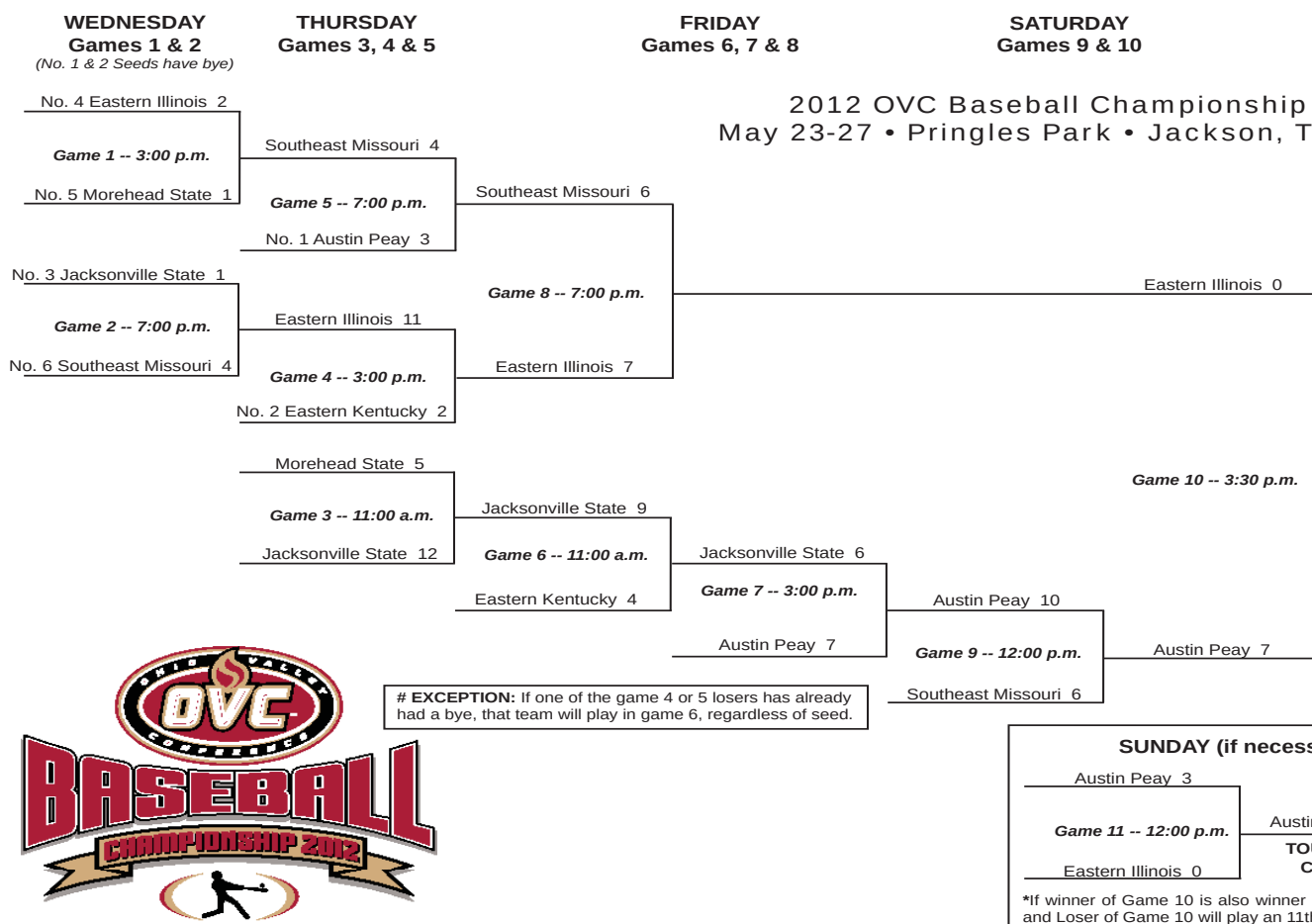

AUSTIN PEAY NOTES

Repeat Squared: For the first time in OVC history, Austin Peay pulled off a "repeat squared" winning back-to-back OVC regular season championships and back-to-back OVC tournament championship in 2011 and 2012.

Austin Peay Back in the NCAA Tournament: Austin Peay is back in the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year. The No. 1 seed in the OVC Tournament, the Governors lost its opening game to No. 6 seed Southeast Missouri but won four-straight elimination games to claim the 2012 Championship. The NCAA Tournament appearance is the fifth all-time for Austin Peay who also appeared in the NCAAs in 1996, 2005, 2007 and 2011. Last year Austin Peay topped host Georgia Tech in the first game of the Atlanta Regional before falling to Mississippi State and losing the rematch to Georgia Tech to be eliminated. In 2007 the Governors nearly upset No. 1 overall national seed Vanderbilt and David Price, taking the Commodores to extra innings before losing 2-1 on an unearned run in the bottom of the 11th. APSU is 2-8 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

Recent OVC Success in NCAA Play: Despite not winning a NCAA Regional, OVC teams have been competitive in NCAA Regional play, winning at least one game in three of the last five years.

Austin Peay Wins 2012 OVC Regular Season Championship: Austin Peay finished the regular season 19-7 overall in OVC play, tying Eastern Kentucky for the 2012 OVC Championship. The title marked the seventh time since divisional play ended that Austin Peay has been the regular season champions; the team also won in 1994, 1996, 2003, 2004, 2007 and 2011. Austin Peay also claimed divisional crowns in 1971 and 1984; in 1971 the Gobs went on to win a three-game playoff series and were deemed "OVC Champions" but in 1984 the team lost in the four-team OVC Tournament and was not deemed the "champion" that season.

Governors Claim Fifth OVC Tournament Crown: Austin Peay won its fifth OVC Tournament Championship this season and second in a row. The Gobs have also won OVC Tournament Championships in 1996, 2005, 2007 and 2011. APSU was the first time under the OVC Tournament format (around since 2005 where the No. 1 and 2 seeds get a bye) to lose its opening game in the OVC Championship and come back through the loser's bracket to win the Championship. The Gobs shutout Eastern Illinois 3-0 in the Championship Game, marking the first time the deciding game was decided by shutout since 2005 (when Austin Peay shutout Jacksonville State to win the title).

More on the OVC Championship: This season marked the 34th OVC Baseball Tournament, as the first event was held in 1979. Prior to the 1979 event, the winner of each division matched up in a three-game series to determine who the OVC champion was in that season. Since 2001 the tournament has been played at a neutral site (prior to that, the event was held at the No. 1 seed and regular season champion). From 2001-09 that neutral site was Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.; the 2010-12 events were each played at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. and the 12th time the event has been held at a neutral site.

Bachman Named OVC Tournament MVP: Senior third baseman Greg Bachman was named MVP of the OVC Tournament after his performance in five games in leading the Governors to the OVC Championship. Bachman hit .545 (12-for-22) with four runs scored, a double, home runs, seven RBI, a .727 slugging percentage and a .600 on-base percentage. After striking out with the bases loaded to end the Southeast Missouri game to open the Championship, Bachman followed that with a 4-for-5 performance in an elimination game against Jacksonville State and was 4-for-5 with four RBI in an elimination game against Southeast Missouri.

McClure Second All-Time in Wins in OVC History: Austin Peay head coach Gary McClure, now in his 25th season at his alma mater, enters the NCAA Championship with 750 career wins, which is second in OVC history. He trails OVC all-time leader Johnny Reagan (Murray State) by just 26 wins. McClure has been named OVC Coach of the Year in each 1992, 1994, 2003, 2007 and 2011. The five awards are tied for second most in OVC history (with Eastern Kentucky's Jim Ward), and is just two off the all-time record of seven held by Murray State's Johnny Reagan (who also holds the OVC record for wins).

Austin Peay Among National Leaders: Among the most recent set of NCAA statistical leaders, Austin Peay ranks third nationally in base on balls (296), 10th in home runs/game (1.0), 10th in double plays (60), 11th in runs (404), 14th in on-base percentage (.397) and 18th in hits (620). Individually senior Greg Bachman ranks seventh in RBI (67), 12th in home runs (12) and 12th in total bases (146). Senior Jon Clinard is ninth in sacrifice bunts (18) while sophomore Jordan Hankins is 15th in RBI (63). Junior closer Tyler Rogers is 28th in saves (11) while senior starter Zach Toney is 23rd in hits allowed per nine innings (6.29).
