## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

**ISSIAN REDDING • F, SR., 6-6, 220 • SANDUSKY, OH • MURRAY STATE**

Redding averaged 17.5 points and 7.0 rebounds while helping guide Murray State to OVC-opening victories against Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State. Versus EKV, the senior forward re-set his personal best for the second straight game with 25 points on 9-of-12 shooting, including a career-high six 3-pointers. The Sandusky, Ohio, native then posted his first career double-double in the Morehead State game, netting 10 points and a career-best 10 rebounds. For the week, Redding was 13-of-23 from the field (56.5%), including 6-of-12 from 3-point range.

### NEWCOMER

**COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, JR., 6-5, 215 • UTICA, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE**

Bradley pulled down 19 rebounds and ran his streak of double-figure scoring games to five as he helped lead Jacksonville State to its first 2-0 start since joining the OVC. The junior forward opened with 15 points and seven boards in a non-conference loss to Delaware State, then collected 27 points and 12 caroms in road wins over Samford and UT Martin. A native of Utica, Miss., Bradley finished the week shooting 53.6 percent from the field (15-of-28) and 80 percent at the free throw line (12-of-15) while also dishing out four assists and grabbing three steals.

### FRESHMAN

**DRAKE REED • F, FR., 6-5, 220 • CLARKSVILLE, TN • AUSTIN PEAY**

Reed made the most of his first career starts as Austin Peay improved to 2-1 in OVC action with back-to-back wins over Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky. The freshman forward's best effort came against the Eagles, where he netted 14 points, grabbed six rebounds and blocked four shots. He then added six points and three boards versus the Colonels. Seven of the Clarksville, Tenn., native's nine rebounds on the week were offensive boards. He was 9-of-16 from the field (56.3%) and 2-of-4 from the charity stripe in the two contests.

# 2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

## AROUND THE OVC...

**AUSTIN PEAY (4-4 overall; 2-1 OVC):** Austin Peay opened the OVC and home portions of its schedule in strong fashion, picking up wins over Morehead State (66-55) and Eastern Kentucky (79-63)...The victories put the Governors at the .500 mark for the first time since the second game of the 2004-05 season...Five APSU players scored in double figures versus ECU, including sophomore **Derek Wright**, who committed just one turnover while dishing out a career-high nine assists and scoring 12 points...Freshmen forwards **Kyle Duncan** and **Drake Reed** had solid outings in their first two games as starters...Reed led the team with 15 points and four blocked shots against the Eagles, finishing the week with 20 points and nine rebounds, including seven offensive...Duncan contributed 20 points on 8-of-13 shooting with nine boards in the two contests...After registering 42 turnovers in their previous two outings, the Govs committed just six in the ECU contest, the fewest allowed by an APSU squad since the 2002-03 season...APSU plays host to non-conference foe East Tennessee on Saturday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-5 overall; 0-1 OVC):** Eastern Illinois' season-opening woes continued as the Panthers dropped a tough 83-80 overtime decision to Tennessee Tech...The game was tied 20 times with 18 lead changes...EIU has lost five straight in 2005-06 and seven in a row dating back to the 2005-06 campaign...Senior **Josh Gomes** topped the 1,000-point mark for his career (1,007 pts.) as he led four EIU players in double figures with 24...Gomes shot 60 percent from the floor, including 4-of-7 from 3-point range, and was a perfect 8-of-8 at the charity stripe while also handing out four assists...Freshman **Mike Robinson** had a team-high five assists while extending his streak of double-figure scoring efforts to four games with 16 points...Sophomore **George Tandy's** bid for a triple-double fell short as he ended the game with 14 points, nine rebounds and six blocked shots...His six rejections matched an OVC single-game high for the season...Freshman **Billy Parrish** netted 10 points in his first career start...The Panthers entertain Tennessee State on Dec. 12 in their lone contest of the week.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (2-6 overall; 0-2 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky is 0-2 in OVC action for the first time in four years following road losses to Murray State (80-51) and Austin Peay (79-63)...The loss to the Racers marked the 14th straight for the Colonels, who haven't beaten Murray State since a 100-90 decision on Jan. 25, 1992...Senior **Jason McLeish** tied a career-high with 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting at APSU...He is the only ECU player to reach double figures in all eight games this season, and leads the team with a 16.3 scoring average...Sophomore **Darnell Dials** pulled down a career-best 13 boards in the APSU contest...Senior **Matt Witt** has attempted a school-record 570 career 3-pointers (10th all-time in OVC), and is seven ticks shy of the ECU mark for made treys with 204 thus far...He has also climbed into seventh place on the OVC's all-time list with 540 career assists...Opponents are averaging a 53 percent shooting average (97-of-183) over the last three games, compared to a 46 percent effort (73-of-158) for the Colonels...ECU takes the week off to concentrate on final exams.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (4-2 overall; 2-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State snapped a 20-game road losing streak with a 62-61 triumph over Samford (62-61), then defeated UT Martin (93-84) to pick up back-to-back road wins for the first time since the end of the 2002-03 season...With the victories, JSU is off to its first 2-0 OVC start since joining the league in 2003-04...Earlier in the week, the Gamecocks saw their 17-game home win streak against non-conference opponents come to an end with a 73-62 loss to Delaware State...Junior **Courtney Bradley** stretched his streak of double-figure scoring games to five, averaging 14.0 points and 6.3 rebounds last week...He shot 53.6 percent from the field (15-of-28) and 80 percent from the foul line (12-of-15) over the three contests...Senior **Walker Russell** dished out 16 assists to go with 39 points for the week...After hitting just 23 of their 58 shot attempts versus DSU (39.7%), the Gamecocks bounced back to hit at least 50 percent from the field against both Samford and UT Martin...JSU travels to Jackson, Miss. for a Dec. 15 meeting with Mississippi State.

**MOREHEAD STATE (1-5 overall; 0-2 OVC):** Morehead State found the road a tough place to be on OVC-opening weekend, dropping contests at Austin Peay (66-55) and Murray State (92-40)...After netting a game-high 24 points at APSU, junior **Shaun Williams** was held to just four points at Murray State, ending his string of double-figure scoring outings at five...Williams is one of six OVC players shooting better than 50 percent from the field while averaging five+ made shots per game, ranking second (54.9%)...Senior **Quinton Smith** has moved into a tie for 20th place on the school's all-time assists list with 202 handouts...Senior **Quenton Pryor** was the only Eagle to reach double figures in both games, contributing 11 points at APSU and 12 at Murray State...He also dished out seven assists while committing one turnover...Of the 1,200 minutes played by Eagles this season, 984 (82%) of them have been played by individuals in their first season of four-year college basketball, and over half of those minutes (502) have been played by freshmen...The Eagles take the week off for final exams.

**MURRAY STATE (4-2 overall; 2-0 OVC):** Murray State is taking its preseason pick as OVC favorite seriously, jumping out to a 2-0 Conference start with wins over Eastern Kentucky (80-51) and Morehead State (92-40)...The Racers enjoyed a 90-54 rebounding advantage in the two games while combining to hold the Colonels and the Eagles to 37.8 percent field goal shooting (39-of-103), including a miserly 4-of-30 (13.3%) from 3-point range...Senior **Issian Redding** recorded a career-high in scoring for the second straight game with 25 points against ECU...In addition to his double-double (11 pts./11 rbs.), senior **Pearson Griffith** matched a career-high with six blocked shots versus Morehead State as the Racers set a new school record with 14 rejections overall...Also registering double-doubles against the Eagles were Redding (10 pts./10 rbs.) and sophomore reserve **Rob Kennedy** (career-highs 14 pts./12 rbs.)...Freshman reserve **Tyler Holloway** had another hot night from behind the arc, going 4-of-7 to finish with 14 points versus the Eagles...Murray State takes the week off for final exams.

**SAMFORD (3-4 overall; 0-1 OVC):** Samford lost its OVC opener for the first time in school history, dropping a 62-61 heartbreaker to arch-rival Jacksonville State...The loss was the Bulldogs' first to the Gamecocks since Feb. 24, 2004...Sophomore **Travis Peterson** tossed in a game-high 16 points, going 5-of-10 from the floor and 6-of-6 from the charity stripe...As a team, the Bulldogs converted all 12 of their foul attempts...Peterson leads the league with a 59.1 shooting percentage behind the arc (13-of-22)...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** and junior **Randall Gulina** tied for game-high honors with six rebounds apiece while contributing 10 and 11 points, respectively...After boasting the nation's second-best 3-point shooting percentage a year ago (41.9%), the Bulldogs continue to struggle with their long-range shots in 2005-06, hitting just 36.1 percent (52-of-144) of their trey attempts thus far...For the second consecutive game, the Bulldogs came away even in the rebounding category, matching the Gamecocks with 24 boards apiece...Samford takes the week off for final exams.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-4 overall; 1-2 OVC):** Southeast Missouri split its OVC outings last week, edging Tennessee State, 70-69, before falling to Tennessee Tech, 79-65...Senior **Roy Booker** went 6-of-12 from 3-point land while pumping in a career-high 27 points in the TSU contest...He added 11 points versus Tech to stretch his streak of double-figure scoring outings to seven...Junior **Andrais Thornton** was the only other Redhawk in double figures against the Tigers with 13 points on 4-of-5 shooting and a team-high seven rebounds...Senior **Ketshner Guerrier** notched his second career double-double (13 pts./11 rbs.) versus Tech...Freshman reserve **Eric Jones**, nearly 100 percent after being sidelined with a broken finger, has been dealt another setback, this time a sprained ankle that may keep him out for the next three games...Jones turned in his best effort to date against Tech, tossing in a career-high 12 points while going 4-of-5 from the field with a pair of 3-pointers...The Redhawks close out their three-game homestand Friday against Central Methodist.

## AROUND THE OVC...

**UT MARTIN (4-2 overall; 1-1 OVC):** UT Martin ran its streak of non-conference home victories to 28 with a 79-59 win over Spalding, but saw its four-game overall win streak come to an end in a 93-84 loss to Jacksonville State...Junior **McKale Jones** cleared eight rebounds in each of the two games and also chipped in 24 points for the week...Seniors **Jeremy Kelly** and **Jared Newson** each tallied a double-double against JSU....Kelly finished with game-highs of 26 points and 11 assists while Newson had 17 points and a game-best 12 rebounds...Senior **Cleve Woodfork** was 10-of-11 from the field as he netted back-to-back double-figure scoring efforts for the first time this season to finish with 24 points and nine rebounds on the week...Against Spalding, senior **Jason Thompson** poured in a game- and season-high 22 points on 9-of-11 field and 4-of-5 free throw shooting...Kelly dished out 19 assists on the week and leads the league with a 6.7 average...Newson is second in the OVC in both scoring (19.2 ppg) and rebounding (8.2 rpg)...The Skyhawks take the week off for final exams.

**TENNESSEE STATE (1-2 overall; 0-1 OVC):** Tennessee State suffered a tough 70-69 loss in its OVC opener at Southeast Missouri, then dropped an 82-72 non-conference decision at Georgia Tech...The Tigers struggled with a 3-of-19 effort (15.8%) from 3-point range at Southeast...Senior **Kareem Grant** scored 17 points to lead four TSU players in double figures in the contest, while senior **Courtney Bohannon** pulled down a game-high 14 rebounds in just 21 minutes of action off the bench...At Georgia Tech, TSU trailed by just four points early in the second half, but a 16-1 run by the Yellow Jackets kept the Tigers at bay...Junior **Clarence Matthews** led the Tigers with a career-high 22 points at Tech while junior **Bruce Price** scored all 18 of his points in the second half...Price and sophomore **Reiley Ervin** dished out 12 assists and grabbed five steals apiece over the two games...Senior **Wayne Arnold** went 6-of-10 from the field to finish with 17 points and a team-high eight boards...The Tigers close out their five-day, three-game schedule Monday night at Eastern Illinois.

**TENNESSEE TECH (6-1 overall; 3-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech extended its win streak to six games and remained undefeated in league action with an 83-80 overtime win at Eastern Illinois and a 79-65 victory at Southeast Missouri...Senior **Milone Clark** cleared eight rebounds and led four Golden Eagles in double-figure scoring at EIU with 17 points, while sophomore **Anthony Fisher** added 16 points off the bench and **Derek Stribling** chimed in with 14...Senior **Keyon Boyd** scored in double digits in both contests, recording his first double-double of the year (10 pts./10 rbd.) at EIU and just missing out on another with 13 points and nine boards at Southeast...After being held scoreless in the EIU contest, junior **Antjuan Koger** hit four 3-pointers to aid his team-high 16-point effort in a reserve role against the Redhawks...Fisher added 12 points to stretch his number of double-figure scoring games to four...Tech shot a season-low 32.5 percent from the field at EIU, including just 5-of-24 (20.8%) from 3-point land...The Golden Eagles visit Cincinnati on Saturday for the first round of the Las Vegas Holiday Classic.

**BLOCK PARTY:** Murray State senior forward **Pearson Griffith** has been holding a one-man block party early in the 2005-06 campaign...The product of St. Thomas, Barbados, has turned away at least five shot attempts on three different occasions this season and leads the league with 25 rejections overall (4.2 bpg)...A junior college transfer in his second season with the Racers, Griffith is currently second among OVC active career leaders with 59 blocks.

**ON THE TUBE:** The second of eight ESPN2 contests in the 2005-06 OVC television package hits the airwaves on Dec. 19 as Eastern Kentucky plays host to Eastern Illinois...Calling Thursday's action will be **Dave Weekley** and **Nate Ross**...Overall, the league will have at least 12 men's basketball contests televised during the upcoming 2005-06 season...ESPN2 will carry two of those games, a Jan. 28 regular-season matchup between Murray State and Southeast Missouri, and the O'Reilly OVC men's Tournament Championship contest on March 4...Additionally, ESPN2 will carry both semifinal games in the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Men's Basketball Tournament.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Ohio Valley Conference teams boast a 21-9 record (.700) at home thus far in 2005-06, including four teams that are unbeaten on their home turf...**Tennessee Tech** (4-0) has won 17 straight in the Eblen Center, stretching back to Nov. 23, 2004, while **Austin Peay** (2-0) sports a seven-game run that dates back to Jan. 15, 2005...**Murray State** is 3-0 at home this season...**Tennessee State** has won its lone home contest of 2005-06, giving the Tigers a three-game streak, dating back to this past February.

**BUSTIN' BRACKETS:** For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event...Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year record of 1-2, with first-year participant Murray State earning a 69-63 victory against host Rice last season...Austin Peay will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearances.

**TOP SCORERS RETURN:** Eight of the OVC's top 15 scorers from a year ago return in 2005-06...Back are Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** (16.8 ppg), Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt** (16.5 ppg), UT Martin guard/forward **Jared Newson** (15.4 ppg), Austin Peay guard **Maurice Hampton** (14.7 ppg), Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** (14.5 ppg), Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** (14.5 ppg), Eastern Kentucky guard **Matt Witt** (14.4 ppg) and Tennessee State guard **Bruce Price** (13.7 ppg).

**DISHING IT OUT:** Nine of the OVC's top 10 assist men from last season are back for 2005-06, including at least one player who will finish his career ranked among the league's all-time leaders for handouts...Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is ranked seventh in the OVC in career assists with 540, just 159 ticks shy of the all-time record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81)...Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** lurks just outside the OVC's top 10 all-time list with 427 career assists after leading the league for each of the last two seasons, ranking fourth nationally a year ago (7.3 apg) while dishing out a school-record 211 handouts.

**ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES:** The 2004-05 All-OVC teams were laden with senior veterans and as a result, only four of the 10 players who earned all-Conference recognition a year ago are back again this season. Returning from the All-OVC first team is Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** and Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt**, while Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** and Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** are back after capturing All-OVC second team honors last season. In addition, Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** returns to the hardwood after garnering the OVC Freshman of the Year award in 2004-05.
