OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

JARED NEWSON • F, SR., 6-5, 215 • BELLEVILLE, IL • UT MARTIN

Newson averaged 23.0 points and 9.0 rebounds while helping UT Martin to a 2-0 record last week. After tallying 19 points and seven rebounds in an 80-77 overtime win versus Arkansas State, the senior forward collected his first double-double of the season (27 pts./11 rbd.) in a 72-60 victory against Southeast Missouri in the Skyhawks' OVC opener. For the week, the Belleville, Ill., native shot 63 percent from the field (17-of-27), including going 3-of-4 from behind the arc. He also had four steals, three assists and a pair of blocked shots over the two games.

NEWCOMER

BELTON RIVERS • G, JR., 6-4, 180 • ATLANTA, GA • TENNESSEE TECH

Rivers tossed in 34 points and dished out six assists in a pair of Tennessee Tech victories last week. Following a 15-point outing in Tech's 72-67 win over UW-Milwaukee, the junior guard recorded a team-high 19 points in the Golden Eagles' OVC-opening victory against Austin Peay. A native of Atlanta, Ga., Rivers finished the week shooting 63.6 percent from the field (14-of-22), including 5-of-10 from 3-point range. He also had four rebounds and six steals in the two games.

FRESHMAN

MIKE ROBINSON • G, FR., 5-10, 185 • CHICAGO, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Robinson knocked down nine 3-pointers on his way to team-high scoring honors in outings against Western Illinois and Indiana State last week. At WIU, the freshman point guard from Chicago, Ill., registered season-highs of five treys, 21 points, four assists and three steals. He then extended his streak of double-figure scoring to three games with 16 points versus ISU. Robinson finished the week with 37 points, five rebounds, eight assists and four steals.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (2-4 overall; 0-1 OVC): Austin Peay opened OVC play on a sour note, dropping a 78-61 decision at Tennessee Tech...The Govs committed 26 turnovers in the contest, the most by an APSU squad since the 1994-95 season when they had 27 against Cincinnati...On the bright side, the Govs pulled down 17 offensive rebounds for the second consecutive game, holding a 43-33 edge over the Golden Eagles on the glass...Sophomore **Fernandez Lockett** led the effort on the boards, clearing a career-high 10 rebounds...Freshman reserve **Drake Reed** chipped in eight points and eight rebounds in just 18 minutes of action off the bench...Sophomore walk-on **Justin Hunter** has elected to leave the team after appearing in two of the Govs' first five games...Seniors and lead scorers **Maurice Hampton** (14.8 ppg) and **Zac Schlader** (14.3 ppg) have been the only double-figure scorers in three of APSU's four losses...After playing away from the Dunn Center for the first six games of the season, the Govs officially kick off the home portion of their schedule, welcoming OVC foes Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 8 and 10, respectively...APSU also plays the second of two exhibition games on Monday against Lambuth.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois saw its season-opening losing skid stretch to four games following setbacks to Western Illinois (76-68) and Indiana State (66-58)...The Panthers have lost six in a row dating back to last season...Freshman **Mike Robinson** was the team's top scorer in both contests, knocking down nine 3-pointers while tallying 37 points for the week...Robinson, who has emerged as the Panthers' starting point guard, leads the team in scoring (14.0 ppg) and is averaging a league-high 3.5 treys per game.... Offense has been hard to come by for the young Panthers, who are managing just 51.5 points a game while surrendering 72.8 points to their opponents...Sophomore **George Tandy** registered career-highs of 16 points and 11 rebounds in the WIU contest for his first-ever double-double...After missing the 2004-05 season with a back injury, sophomore **Wes Wilkin** got his first career start against WIU, responding with five points and five rebounds...EIU begins OVC play and continues its three-game homestand with a Dec. 8 date against Tennessee Tech.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (2-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a pair of non-conference outings last week, cruising to an 88-46 win over West Virginia Wesleyan before falling to in-state rival Western Kentucky, 97-89...The loss to the Hilltoppers was the Colonels' 10th straight in the Battle of the Bluegrass, and marked an end to EKU's 11-game home win streak against non-conference opponents...Sophomore **Darnell Dials** hit all nine of his field goal attempts en route to a career-high 25 points against WKU...He also had nine rebounds in the contest, finishing with 14 for the week, including seven offensive boards...Senior **Matt Witt** led the team with a 19.5 scoring average for the week and moved into EKU's top 10 all-time scoring list with 1,373 points...Senior **Alonzo Hird** notched the team's first double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds versus WVWU...EKU was a perfect 17-of-17 from the free throw line in the second half of the WKU contest, finishing with an 83.3 percentage overall (20-of-24)...The Colonels kick off league action on the road, visiting Murray State on Dec. 8 and Austin Peay on Dec. 10...Thursday's game against the Racers will be televised live on ESPNU with a 6:30 p.m. Central tip.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (2-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State extended to 16 its streak of consecutive home wins against non-conference opponents with a 97-70 rout of Tennessee Temple...Senior **B.J. Spencer** hit a season-high five 3-pointers en route to a team-best 23 points in the contest...Senior **Walker Russell** improved his assists/turnover ratio to 1.64 after dishing out 12 assists while turning the ball over just four times...Senior **Anthony Wilson** added 19 points, converting 7-of-11 from the field and 3-of-4 from the free throw line, to go with five steals...As a team, the Gamecocks recorded 20 thefts, the most by a JSU squad during head coach **Mike LaPlante's** six-year tenure...Jax State scored 51 points off Tennessee Temple's 29 turnovers...Junior **Courtney Bradley** fell just shy of a double-double with 10 points and eight rebounds...The Gamecocks wrap up their three-game homestand Monday against Delaware State, then hit the road for the start of their OVC slate, visiting long-time rival Samford on Thursday and UT Martin on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Morehead State's losing skid stretched to three games as the Eagles dropped a 65-59 decision to Maryland-Eastern Shore...With UMES boasting a post tandem that measured 6-11 and 6-9, Morehead State shot just 32.8 percent from the field and was outrebounded, 41-32...Despite their offensive struggles, coach **Kyle Macy's** young and inexperienced Eagles continue to play good defense, forcing 23 turnovers in the contest...Junior **Shaun Williams** netted a game-high 21 points and grabbed a team-best eight rebounds while shooting a blistering 64.3 percent from the field (9-of-14)...Senior forward **Cory Burns**, sidelined since the start of practice in October with a shoulder injury, had nine points and three rebounds in his first appearance of the season...Senior **Quinton Smith** missed all 12 of his field goal attempts, including six from 3-point range, but did hit both of his free throws to finish with two points, five rebounds, four assists and only one turnover...The Eagles open Conference play on the road against Austin Peay (Dec. 8) and Murray State (Dec. 10).

MURRAY STATE (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Murray State split a pair of outings last week, dropping a 64-53 decision to Tennessee before rallying for a 79-75 overtime victory at Texas-San Antonio...In their first meeting with the Vols since 1945, the Racers took a lead into the final eight minutes...The UT contest was played at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in Nashville, Tenn., site of the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament...Senior **Issian Redding** averaged 17.5 points and 6.5 rebounds for the week...He tossed in 19 points at UTSA, including a 3-pointer and a jumper in the final 30 seconds of regulation to help the Racers extend the game...Sophomore **Justin Orr** tossed in a career-high 21 points at UTSA while senior **Keith Jenifer** grabbed a career-high nine rebounds...Senior **Pearson Griffith** was credited with 10 blocked shots in the two contests, including six at UTSA...Freshman reserve **Tyler Holloway** came off the bench against UT to hit three consecutive treys on his way to a career-high 11 points...The Racers return home to kick off OVC action against Eastern Kentucky (Dec. 8) and Morehead State (Dec. 10)...Thursday's game against the Colonels will be televised live on ESPNU with a 6:30 p.m. Central tip.

SAMFORD (3-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Samford went 1-1 in a pair of non-conference contests last week, defeating Southern Miss, 52-33, before falling to South Alabama, 55-52...The Bulldogs are 2-3 in road outings this season...Junior point guard **Jerry Smith** scored a career-high 16 points and matched another career mark with 10 rebounds in the USA contest for his second career double-double...He finished the week with 28 points, 14 boards and nine assists while going 11-of-22 from the field...The Bulldogs are holding opponents to a league-low 54.5 scoring average while forcing 15.7 turnovers each time out...Sophomore **Travis Peterson** has connected on 13-of-21 three-point attempts to rank second in the league with a 61.9 percent conversion rate...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** extended his streak of double-figure scoring to four games with back-to-back 15-point efforts...After boasting the nation's second-best three-point shooting percentage a year ago (41.9%), the Bulldogs are having some early trouble with their long-range shots in 2005-06, hitting just 35.4 percent (45-of-127) of their trey attempts thus far...Samford returns home to kick off a four-game homestand with its OVC opener on Thursday against arch-rival Jacksonville State.

AROUND THE OVC...

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (2-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped its OVC opener, 72-60, to UT Martin last week...Junior **Terrick Willoughby** scored 16 consecutive points to help the Redhawks rally from a 13-point deficit and pull within three points early in the second half...He finished with a game-high 24 points on 60 percent field goal shooting (9-of-15), including five 3-pointers...Senior **Roy Booker** added 16 points while junior **Andrais Thornton** fell shy of a double-double with 10 points and eight rebounds...After sitting out last season following his transfer from Montana, Booker has gotten off to a fast start for the Redhawks, scoring in double figures in each of his first five games to lead the team with an 18.6 average...Thornton (7.0 rpg) and senior **Ketshner Guerrier** (6.2 rpg) top the squad in rebounds...Junior college transfer **David Johnson** will be sidelined indefinitely following surgery to repair a hernia...Southeast returns to the Show Me Center to open up a three-game homestand with Tennessee State (Dec. 8) and Tennessee Tech (Dec. 10).

UT MARTIN (3-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): UT Martin ran its win streak to three games with an 80-77 overtime victory against Arkansas State and an OVC-opening 72-60 win over Southeast Missouri...The Skyhawks' 3-1 start is their best since opening the 2001-02 season with a 6-1 mark...Senior **Jared Newson** posted his first double-double of the season with 27 points and 11 rebounds in the ASU contest...He finished the week with 46 points and 18 boards while shooting 63 percent from the field (17-of-27)...Senior **Jeremy Kelly** dished out 12 assists to go with 39 points and eight rebounds in the two games, while junior **McKale Jones** contributed 17 points and five rebounds off the bench...The win over ASU was UT Martin's first overtime victory since the 2003-04 season...Junior **Will Lewis** recorded his best effort of the season with 12 points and eight boards versus Southeast...The Skyhawk defense limited the Redhawks to just three points during a 9:20 span in the first half of Saturday's game...UT Martin wraps up a five-game homestand against Spalding (Dec. 5) and OVC foe Jacksonville State (Dec. 10).

TENNESSEE STATE (1-0 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State was idle last week...The Tigers return to action for the first time since Nov. 21 when they travel to Southeast Missouri for their OVC opener on Dec. 8...After a 16-day layoff, TSU will play three road games in five days, sandwiching a Dec. 10 trip to Georgia Tech between their Conference outings at Southeast Missouri and Eastern Illinois (Dec. 12).

TENNESSEE TECH (4-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): After picking up a 72-67 win over Wisconsin-Milwaukee, Tennessee Tech began defense of its 2004-05 OVC regular-season title with a 78-61 triumph versus Austin Peay in its Conference opener...Senior **Derek Stribling** led the team with 20 points against UWM while sophomore **Belton Rivers** had a game-high 19 points off the bench in the APSU contest...Rivers knocked down seven field goals in each of the two games, finishing the week with 34 points overall...Sophomore **Amadi McKenzie** cleared 11 rebounds in the two games, including a career-high eight against UWM...After being held scoreless in the UWM contest, senior **Milone Clark** bounced back for 12 points and a team-high six boards versus APSU...He finished the week with 11 rebounds...Tech takes its four-game win streak on the road, traveling to Eastern Illinois (Dec. 8) and Southeast Missouri (Dec. 10).

ON THE TUBE: The first of eight ESPNU contests in the 2005-06 OVC television package hits the airwaves on Dec. 8 as **Murray State** plays host to **Eastern Kentucky**...Calling Thursday's action will be **Dave Weekly** and **Larry Conley**...Overall, the league will have at least 12 men's basketball contests televised during the upcoming 2005-06 season...ESPN2 will carry two of those games, a Jan. 28 regular-season matchup between **Murray State** and **Southeast Missouri**, and the OVC Men's Tournament championship contest on March 4...Additionally, ESPNU will carry both semifinal games in the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Men's Basketball Tournament.

HOME SWEET HOME: Ohio Valley Conference teams boast a 15-4 record (.789) at home thus far in 2005-06, including six teams that are unbeaten on their home turf...**Tennessee Tech** (4-0) has won 13 straight in the Eblen Center, stretching back to Nov. 23, 2004, while **UT Martin** (3-0) is enjoying a four-game run that dates back to February, 2005 and **Jacksonville State** (2-0) and **Tennessee State** (1-0) each have three-game streaks, also dating back to this past February...**Samford** and **Murray State** are each 1-0 at home thus far.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event...Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year record of 1-2, with first-year participant Murray State earning a 69-63 victory against host Rice last season...Austin Peay will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearances.

TOP SCORERS RETURN: Eight of the OVC's top 15 scorers from a year ago return in 2005-06...Back are Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** (16.8 ppg), Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt** (16.5 ppg), UT Martin guard/forward **Jared Newson** (15.4 ppg), Austin Peay guard **Maurice Hampton** (14.7 ppg), Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** (14.5 ppg), Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** (14.5 ppg), Eastern Kentucky guard **Matt Witt** (14.4 ppg) and Tennessee State guard **Bruce Price** (13.7 ppg).

DISHING IT OUT: Nine of the OVC's top 10 assist men from last season are back for 2005-06, including at least one player who will finish his career ranked among the league's all-time leaders for handouts...Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is ranked eighth in the OVC in career assists with 525, just 174 tics shy of the all-time record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81)...Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** lurks outside the OVC's top 10 all-time list with 411 career assists after leading the league for each of the last two seasons, ranking fourth nationally a year ago (7.3 apg) while dishing out a school-record 211 handouts.

ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES: The 2004-05 All-OVC teams were laden with senior veterans and as a result, only four of the 10 players who earned all-Conference recognition a year ago are back again this season. Returning from the All-OVC first team is Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** and Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt**, while Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** and Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** are back after capturing All-OVC second team honors last season. In addition, Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** returns to the hardwood after garnering the OVC Freshman of the Year award in 2004-05.
