OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

JARED NEWSON • F, SR., 6-5, 215 • BELLEVILLE, IL • UT MARTIN

Newson averaged 24.0 points and 7.5 rebounds a game as UT Martin registered OVC wins against Tennessee State and Eastern Illinois. The senior forward opened with 25 points and seven boards against TSU, then followed that with a 23-point, eight-rebound effort in the EIU contest. The Belleville, Ill., native also registered five 3-pointers, five assists, two blocked shots and a steal while going 13-of-29 from the field (44.8%) and 17-of-23 from the charity stripe (73.9%). Newson boasts an active streak of five consecutive games with 20 or more points.

NEWCOMER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, JR., 6-5, 215 • UTICA, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley notched his sixth double-double of the season with a 16-point, 11-rebound effort in Jacksonville State's win at Tennessee Tech last week. The junior forward, who is tied for the league lead in double-double performances this season, went 6-of-15 from the floor with a pair of 3-pointers and also hit 2-of-4 at the free throw line. A native of Utica, Miss., Bradley has scored in double figures in eight straight games while shooting just under 55 percent during that span.

FRESHMAN

DRAKE REED • F, FR., 6-5, 220 • CLARKSVILLE, TN • AUSTIN PEAY

Reed helped Austin Peay to a pair of key OVC victories last week. Against Eastern Illinois, the freshman forward pulled down a team-high seven rebounds while tossing in 12 points. In an overtime meeting with Samford, the Clarksville, Tenn., finished with 14 points and eight rebounds, including five on the offensive glass, while going 5-of-8 from the field. For the week, Reed shot 69.2 percent (9-of-13) from the floor and also had four assists and two steals.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (15-11 overall; 10-7 OVC): Austin Peay defeated Eastern Illinois (70-61) and Samford (74-68 in overtime) to push its win streak to three games...With a 10-7 mark in league play and three OVC games left on the schedule, the fourth-place Govs have assured themselves of their 13th straight season with a .500 finish or better in Conference play...Senior **Maurice Hampton** has continued his late-season resurgence, leading the team in scoring over the last three games (19.7 ppg) and converting 60 percent from the field during that stretch... Freshman **Kyle Duncan** notched his first career double-double (10 pts./11 rbd.) against Samford...He combined with fellow frosh **Drake Reed** for 45 points, 32 rebounds and 63.6 percent floor shooting last week...APSU sits three victories shy of reaching the program's 1,000th win in school history... Head coach **Dave Loos** is also within striking distance of another milestone, needing two more wins to give him 250 for his 16-year APSU tenure...The Govs visit Tennessee State on Monday and host non-conference foe Arkansas State on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-18 overall; 4-13 OVC): Eastern Illinois saw its losing skid stretch to four games with setbacks to Austin Peay (70-61) and UT Martin (85-61)...The ninth-place Panthers have lost six of their last seven games, dropping them to 4-13 in Conference play and eliminating them from OVC tourney contention...Senior **Josh Gomes** has led the team or tied for game-high scoring honors in eight consecutive contests and ranks 11th in the league with a team-high 15.2 points per game...Ranked 10th in the OVC in field goal shooting (45.5%), Gomes is also among the Conference's top 3-point shooters, boasting a league-high 50 percent conversion rate from beyond the arc while ranking eighth in trey average (2.09 pg)...Sophomore **George Tandy** has pulled down at least four rebounds in all but one game this season and ranks fourth in the OVC with a 7.2 average on the glass...After closing out the road portion of their 2005-06 schedule with a Wednesday night visit to Southeast Missouri, the Panthers return home to entertain Eastern Michigan in a non-conference tilt on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (11-13 overall; 8-8 OVC): Eastern Kentucky dropped decisions to Morehead State (78-66) and Murray State (62-45), then put an end to the four-game slide with an 80-51 triumph over Southeast Missouri...Senior **Matt Witt** became the second EKV player ever to reach the 1,700 career point plateau (1,710 pts.) and now sits 14 ticks shy of establishing a new school record...He also dished out 13 assists to move him into fifth place on the league's all-time list for assists (603)...Junior **Michael Brock** reached double-digits for the first time in 12 games with a 12-point outing against Morehead State...Senior **Jason McLeish** missed the first game of his two-year EKV career, sitting out against the Eagles with an injury...EKU has used a different starting lineup in each of the last seven games...The Colonels committed a season-low four turnovers in the win over the Redhawks...EKU wraps up the OVC portion of its road schedule this week with dates at Samford (Feb. 14) and Jacksonville State (Feb. 16) before playing host to non-conference foe UNC Asheville on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (11-11 overall; 9-7 OVC): Jacksonville State won its lone game of the week, picking up a 74-68 road victory at Tennessee Tech...The Gamecocks' four OVC road wins are the most by a JSU squad in league play since picking up five Conference road wins in 1999-00 as a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference...Senior **Walker Russell** went 10-of-10 from the free throw line while netting 16 of his game-high 19 points in the second half...Russell also dished out six helpers to move into seventh place on the league's all-time assists list (543)...Through games of Feb. 6, he ranks fourth nationally in assists (6.6 apg)...Junior **Courtney Bradley** notched his sixth double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds...Four Gamecock starters are averaging double figures, led by senior **B.J. Spencer** (15.2 ppg) and Bradley (15.0 ppg)...Fifth-place JSU closes out the home portion of its regular-season schedule this week against Morehead State (Feb. 14), Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 16) and non-conference opponent New Orleans (Feb. 18).

MOREHEAD STATE (4-18 overall; 3-13 OVC): Morehead State won back-to-back games for the first time this season, defeating Eastern Kentucky (78-65) and Southeast Missouri (62-59), before having the two-game run end with a 71-56 loss to Murray State...Senior **Quinton Smith** led the team with 46 points and 12 assists over the three-game stretch...He has scored in double figures five times in the last six games, averaging 12.2 points during that span...Smith is also now tied for eighth place on the school's all-time assists list with 249...After missing all of last season with an injury, senior **Quentin Pryor** has averaged 13.9 points a game over the last 11 outings, reaching twin digits in all but one of those contests...Senior **Cory Burns** has missed the last five games with a recurring shoulder injury...Despite winning three of their last six games, the Eagles have been mathematically eliminated from qualifying for the OVC tourney...Following trips to Jacksonville State (Feb. 14) and Samford (Feb. 16), 10th-place Morehead State closes out the road half of its schedule with a non-conference outing at Central Michigan on Saturday...Thursday's game at Samford will be nationally-televised on ESPN.

MURRAY STATE (18-5 overall; 15-2 OVC): League-leading Murray State pushed its win streak to eight games with a pair of road victories last week, defeating Eastern Kentucky (62-45) and Morehead State (71-56)...The Racers need one more Conference win to clinch at least a share of the OVC regular-season crown and two to claim it outright...Sophomore **Justin Orr** averaged 14.0 points and 8.5 rebounds over the two-game stretch, including tallying his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds at Morehead State...Freshman **Tyler Holloway** averaged 6.0 points off the bench...The Racers have held opponents to less than 80 points in 41 consecutive games...Two more wins would give Murray State its second 20-win season in head coach **Mick Cronin's** three-year tenure...The Racers' eight-game win streak is tied for seventh nationally among active runs...After wrapping up a three-game road trip at Tennessee State on Thursday, Murray State returns home to square off against non-conference foe Illinois-Chicago on Saturday in the first-ever meeting between the two squads.

SAMFORD (16-7 overall; 12-4 OVC): Samford dropped its only outing of the week, a 74-68 overtime decision at Austin Peay...The second-place Bulldogs are a win shy of clinching a home game for the first round of the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament...Senior **J. Robert Merritt**, who entered the week as the nation's leader in 3-point shooting percentage, went 5-of-12 from beyond the arc en route to a game-high 25 points...With the five treys, Merritt re-set his own single-season school mark for made 3-pointers, topping last year's record of 85 (currently at 87)...Merritt has made at least one 3-pointer in 57 consecutive games...After playing host to Eastern Kentucky on Valentine's Day, the Bulldogs close out the home portion of their regular-season schedule with an ESPNU-televised contest against Morehead State on Thursday...Samford also visits defending Mid-American Conference champion Ohio on Feb. 18 as part of the *BracketBusters presented by eBay* event...Saturday's game will be broadcast on ESPN360 and Sirius Satellite Radio, channel 117.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-17 overall; 3-14 OVC): Southeast Missouri saw its losing streak stretch to 10 games with road setbacks at Morehead State (62-59) and Eastern Kentucky (80-51)...The 11th-place Redhawks, who have been mathematically eliminated from OVC tourney action, saw their already thin roster suffer another blow on Thursday when junior **Terrick Willoughby** left the Morehead State contest with a shoulder injury...He is listed as questionable for this week's action...If Willoughby is unable to go, that would leave head coach **Gary Garner** with just six scholarship players among seven available bodies...League-leading scorer **Roy Booker** (22.5 ppg) entered the week ranked 13th among the nation's leading scorers...He has reached double figures in points in all 23 games...Sixes were wild last week for sophomore point guard **Paul Paradossi**, who registered six 3-pointers, six rebounds, six assists and six steals en route to 16 points over the two-game stretch...The Redhawks top the OVC and rank among national leaders in free throw shooting (74.7%)...After the EIU contest on Wednesday, Southeast heads west for a non-conference outing at UC Riverside on Saturday.

AROUND THE OVC...

UT MARTIN (12-12 overall; 9-9 OVC): UT Martin vaulted into sixth place in the OVC standings with victories over Tennessee State (71-68) and Eastern Illinois (85-61)...The senior tandem of **Jared Newson** and **Jeremy Kelly** combined to score 79 points over the two-game stretch, including identical 23-point efforts against EIU...Kelly also dished out 13 assists and grabbed 11 steals on the week while Newson pulled down 15 rebounds...The Skyhawks went 34-of-50 at the free throw line against TSU, marking the second time this season they have tallied at least 30 points from the stripe...Overall, UT Martin converted 72.2 percent of its free throw attempts (52-of-72) in the two contests...The Skyhawks' five-game OVC win streak is their longest Conference win streak since joining the league in 1992...UT Martin finishes regular-season play on the road, visiting Tennessee Tech on Thursday before heading up to Evansville for a non-conference outing on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (9-13 overall; 8-8 OVC): Tennessee State split a pair of OVC outings last week, dropping a 71-68 decision at UT Martin before completing an in-season sweep of Tennessee Tech and ending a three-game slide with a 70-65 victory over the Golden Eagles...The Tigers' effort over the two-game stretch was a study in contrasts as TSU blew a double-digit halftime lead en route to the loss at UT Martin, then rallied from a 12-point deficit for the win against Tech...Senior **Kareem Grant** shot 57.1 percent from the field (16-of-28) while posting back-to-back 20-plus scoring performances...Senior **Wayne Arnold** provided a double-double from the backcourt against the Golden Eagles with 14 points and 10 rebounds...The Tigers, who entered Saturday's contest with the league's lowest free throw shooting percentage (64%), converted 18-of-22 chances at the charity stripe (82%) en route to the win...TSU closes out the home portion of its regular-season schedule with Austin Peay (Feb. 13) and Murray State (Feb. 16) before heading north for a non-conference meeting with Ball State.

TENNESSEE TECH (16-10 overall; 11-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech has a tenuous hold on third place in the OVC standings following losses to Jacksonville State (74-68) and Tennessee State (70-65)...Sophomores **Anthony Fisher** (16.0 ppg) and **Amdai McKenzie** (12.5 ppg) scored in double figures in both contests to lead the Golden Eagles' offensive efforts...Despite combining for only 13 starts between them, Fisher, McKenzie and junior **Belton Rivers** are making their presence known...Fisher (12.7 ppg) and Rivers (12.3 ppg) are the team's top two scorers while McKenzie (5.2 rpg) leads the squad in rebounding...Junior **Francis Kabore** is the lone Golden Eagle to be in the starting lineup for all 26 games, while seniors **Milone Clark** and **Derek Stribling** have missed only one starting call in '05-06...Clark is 45 points shy of reaching 1,000 for his career...Tech hosts UT Martin on Thursday, then hits the road for a non-conference visit with Bradley on Saturday.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: Just two weeks remain in the regular-season and several teams continue to jockey for one of four first-round hosting opportunities for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament...League-leading **Murray State** (15-2) has already secured a first-round game on its home court, while second-place **Samford** (12-4) is within reach of its own home tourney contest...The other two hosting spots are up for grabs as only two games separate the No. 3 through No. 8 teams in the standings.

IT'S ALL ACADEMIC: For the second straight year, Austin Peay's **Zac Schlader** has been named to the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District first team, as voted on by the College Sports Information Directors of America...A health and wellness promotion major, Schlader carries a 3.71 grade point average in the classroom while averaging 15.0 points and 5.3 rebounds a game on the court...The senior center was the only OVC player to earn academic all-district honors this season.

SAMFORD SIZZLING: **Samford** leads the league and ranks among the nation's top shooting squads...Through games of Feb. 6, the Bulldogs were sixth in the NCAA in both 3-point field goal percentage (41.3%) and trey average (9.5 pg) while ranking 12th in overall field goal shooting (49.1%)...Additionally, Samford's defensive efforts are limiting opponents to just under 60 points a game (12th best in NCAA).

ON THE TUBE: **Morehead State** and **Samford** square off in an ESPNU-televised contest on Thursday, February 16, at 8:00 p.m. Central...Calling the action live from Seibert Hall in Birmingham, Ala., will be **Dave Weekley** and **Stan Lewter**.

SAMFORD ON ESPN360: **Samford's** Feb. 18 game at Ohio, part of the *BracketBusters presented by eBay* event, will air on ESPN360, ESPN's customized broadband service...ESPN360 is available via a high-speed computer data connection by logging on to www.ESPN360.com...The contest, which tips off at 7:00 p.m. Central, will be available to students and faculty members on both campuses...In addition, ESPN360 will work with the two schools to provide a link through their athletic websites which will allow fans to view the game.

GETTIN' SIRIUS: Three of this week's games involving OVC teams will be carried on Sirius Satellite Radio...The Feb. 14 league tilt between **Morehead State** and **Jacksonville State** will air on channel 117, while the Feb. 16 Conference meeting between JSU and **Eastern Kentucky** will air on channel 126...In addition, **Samford's** Feb. 18 non-conference outing at Ohio will air on channel 117.

DOUBLING UP: Five OVC players registered double-doubles last week, including Jacksonville State's **Courtney Bradley**, who had 16 points and 11 rebounds Feb. 9 against Tennessee Tech for his third double-dip performance in six games...The junior forward has six double-doubles this season and is tied with Tennessee State junior forward **Clarence Matthews** for the league lead.

HOLDING COURT: **Murray State** (9-0) is the only team that remains unbeaten at home in OVC play this season...Dating back to the 2004-05 campaign, the Racers have won 11 consecutive regular-season games against league opponents in the Regional Special Events Center.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker D. Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking fifth (603) and seventh (543), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking third in 3-point attempts (713) and tied for fifth in made treys (244)...In addition, Samford senior **J. Robert Merritt** is sixth in the league in career made 3-pointers (230).

DIAL "J" FOR LONG-DISTANCE: Samford's **J. Robert Merritt** entered last week's action ranked first in the nation in 3-point field goal shooting (50%) and fifth in trey average (3.7 pg)...The senior forward has canned 278 career treys, 230 of which have come in the three years since Samford joined the OVC, moving him into sixth place all-time in the Conference.
