OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

MATT WITT • G, SR., 6-0, 180 • TIPP CITY, OH • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Witt averaged 26.7 points last week to become Eastern Kentucky's all-time scoring leader while guiding the Colonels to a 2-1 mark. The senior guard reached the milestone with a career-high 33 points in the Colonels' triumph at Samford, matching a school record with seven 3-pointers in the process. Two nights later, Witt hit the game-winning free throw with one second remaining to lift EKV past Jacksonville State, finishing the contest with 19 points. The Tipp City, Ohio, native closed out the week with a 28-point performance in a non-conference outing against UNC Asheville to push his career scoring record to 1,790 points. Witt finished the three-game stretch shooting 50 percent from the field (28-of-56), including going 16-of-34 (47.1%) from behind the arc. He also had 14 assists, eight boards and two steals for the week.

NEWCOMER

CLARENCE MATTHEWS • JR., F, 6-7, 250 • BEAUMONT, TX • TENNESSEE STATE

Matthews averaged a double-double (14.7 ppg/13.0 rpg) while helping Tennessee State to a 2-1 mark last week. In the Tigers' win over Austin Peay, the junior forward pulled down a career-high 19 rebounds to go with 18 points and five blocked shots. He then followed that with 11 points and 13 rebounds versus Murray State, and a 15-point, seven-board effort in a non-conference win at Ball State. He finished the week with a total of 10 blocks, six assists and three steals while shooting 56.3 percent from the field (18-of-32). A native of Beaumont, Texas, Matthews has netted double-double efforts in seven of his last 10 games and leads the OVC with eight overall.

FRESHMAN

TYKE COCKERHAM • G, FR., 6-2, 175 • INDIANAPOLIS, IN • MOREHEAD STATE

Cockerham contributed 36 points and 12 rebounds in a trio of Morehead State losses last week. The freshman guard's best outing came in the Eagles' non-conference trip to Central Michigan on Saturday where he led the team with a career-high 21 points as a member of the starting rotation. A native of Indianapolis, Ind., Cockerham hit four 3-pointers on the week as part of a 13-of-27 shooting effort from the field, and also recorded five assists and four steals.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (16-12 overall; 10-8 OVC): After dropping Monday night's OVC outing with Tennessee State (80-58), Austin Peay assured itself of finishing the 2005-06 season with a winning record by virtue of a 92-71 triumph over Sun Belt Conference foe Arkansas State...Senior **Maurice Hampton** went 8-of-14 from 3-point range and averaged 23.0 points, extending his streak as the Govs' high-scorer to five games... Freshman **Kyle Duncan** helped led the team's rebounding efforts, grabbing 10 boards while tossing in 16 points over the two-game stretch... Senior **Zac Schlader** scored his 1,000th career point in the ASU contest and now sits four boards shy of becoming only the 13th player in school history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds...Sophomore **Derek Wright** tossed in a career-high 18 points against ASU, going 7-of-8 from the floor...Nearly half (45 pts.) of the Govs' 92 points in the ASU contest came off of 22 Indian turnovers...Tied for fourth in the OVC standings, Austin Peay closes out the regular season on the road with trips to Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 23) and Morehead State (Feb. 25).

EASTERN ILLINOIS (6-19 overall; 5-13 OVC): Eastern Illinois picked up a 60-49 road win in OVC action at Southeast Missouri but was unable to make it back-to-back victories, dropping a 65-50 decision to Mid-American Conference opponent Eastern Michigan...Freshman **Mike Robinson** dished out 11 assists and grabbed six steals to go with 16 points over the two-game stretch...The ninth-place Panthers, who have lost seven of their last nine games, look to end the 2005-06 campaign on a winning note when they play host to Jacksonville State (Feb. 23) and Samford (Feb. 25) to close out the season.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-14 overall; 10-8 OVC): Eastern Kentucky posted a 2-1 mark last week, picking up a pair of key OVC road wins at Samford and Jacksonville State before kicking off a three-game homestand with an 83-77 loss to Big South Conference opponent UNC Asheville...Senior **Matt Witt** averaged 26.7 points over the three-game stretch to become the school's all-time leading scorer (currently at 1,790 points)...He reached the milestone in the Samford contest, pumping in a career-high 33 points while also matching an ECU single-game mark with seven 3-pointers in the contest...Witt finished the week with 16 treys overall to move into fourth place on the OVC's career list for made 3-pointers (260)...EKU's five OVC road wins are the most for a Colonel squad since posting a 5-2 mark in league road action during the 1970-71 season...Tied for fourth in the league standings, ECU entertains Austin Peay (Feb. 23) and Tennessee State (Feb. 25).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (13-12 overall; 10-8 OVC): Jacksonville State split a pair of OVC outings before taking a 79-74 win over Sun Belt Conference opponent New Orleans on Saturday...The Gamecocks defeated Morehead State, 77-68, but lost a 72-71 heartbreaker to Eastern Kentucky...Senior **Walker Russell** registered his second double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 assists in the UNO contest...He also had 24 points in the ECU game, 17 of which came in the second half...Junior **Courtney Bradley** pulled down 16 rebounds against Morehead State, two shy of the school's Division I record, to go with 14 points, marking his seventh double-double of the season...Tied for fourth, JSU wraps up regular-season action on the road with trips to Eastern Illinois (Feb. 23) and Southeast Missouri (Feb. 25).

MOREHEAD STATE (4-21 overall; 3-15 OVC): Morehead State's skid stretched to four games with setbacks to Jacksonville State (77-68), Samford (76-52) and Mid-American Conference opponent Central Michigan (87-76)...Junior **Shaun Williams**, the team's top scorer (16.3 ppg) and rebounder (6.3), posted his third double-double of the season (14 pts./10 rbs.) in the CMU contest and finished the week averaging 16.3 points and 6.7 rebounds while shooting 55.6 percent (20-of-36) from the field over the three-game stretch...Freshman **Tyke Cockerham** made the most of his fifth start of the season, tossing in a career-high 21 points at CMU...Junior **Quentin Pryor** is listed as questionable for the Eagles' final two games of the season after suffering a sprained wrist at JSU...Senior **Quinton Smith** took over sole possession of eighth place on the school's career assist list (251)...The Eagles broke loose to outrebound their opponents by a 99-90 margin last week...Morehead State closes out the 2005-06 campaign at home against Tennessee State (Feb. 23) and Austin Peay (Feb. 25).

MURRAY STATE (20-5 overall; 16-2 OVC): Murray State clinched the OVC regular-season title with a 77-52 win over Tennessee State, then rallied from a nine-point deficit to earn a 72-68 victory over Horizon League opponent Illinois-Chicago on Saturday...With Thursday's win over TSU, the Racers wrapped up their first outright OVC crown since 1998-99 and first since sharing the title in 1999-00...Junior **Trey Pearson**, who sat out the Feb. 9 and Feb. 11 contests due to personal reasons, rejoined the squad last week and responded with 25 points over the two-game stretch...He canned five 3-pointers on the week, including the go-ahead trey with 1:59 left in the UIC contest...Senior **Pearson Griffith** has moved into ninth place on the school's list for career blocks (96)...Murray State has hit the 20-win plateau for the second time in three years under head coach **Mick Cronin**...The Racers' 10-game winning streak is the longest of Cronin's tenure and the longest for the Racers since winning 12 straight heading into the 1998 NCAA Tournament...Murray State visits Tennessee Tech on Thursday in an ESPNU-televised contest, then returns home to host UT Martin on the final day of regular season action.

SAMFORD (17-9 overall; 13-5 OVC): Samford went 1-1 in OVC action last week, dropping a 75-70 decision to Eastern Kentucky before earning a 76-52 victory over Morehead State...The Bulldogs also lost a 64-52 outing at Ohio as part of Saturday's *BracketBusters presented by eBay* event...The win over the Eagles guaranteed Samford home-court advantage for first-round action when the O'Reilly OVC Tournament kicks off next Tuesday...Sophomore **Travis Peterson** turned in back-to-back 20-point outings for the first time, following a career-high 25 points in the ECU contest with 23 against Morehead...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** canned seven 3-pointers en route to a 23-point outing versus the Eagles, his third game this season with seven treys...The second-place Bulldogs finish regular season action on the road, visiting Southeast Missouri (Feb. 23) and Eastern Illinois (Feb. 25).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-19 overall; 3-15 OVC): Southeast Missouri saw its losing streak extend to 12 games with losses to OVC foe Eastern Illinois (60-49) and Big West Conference opponent UC Riverside (69-61) last week...The Redhawks' last win was Jan. 5 at EIU (72-60)...Senior **Roy Booker** remains the league's top scorer, ranking 13th among national leaders with a 22.2 average...Junior **Terrick Willoughby**, who continued to play last week despite being hampered by a sprained left shoulder, went 6-of-12 from the field, including 4-of-8 from behind the arc, for 16 points at UCR...Senior **Waylon Francis** collected his first career double-double in the EIU contest, scoring 10 points and pulling down a career-high 12 rebounds...The Redhawks will be looking for their 200th win in the Show Me Center when they close out the 2005-06 campaign at home against Samford (Feb. 23) and Jacksonville State (Feb. 25).

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

UT MARTIN (13-13 overall; 9-10 OVC): UT Martin's five-game win streak came to an end with a 74-72 loss to Tennessee Tech, but the Skyhawks quickly got back on the winning side of the ledger, staging a 69-62 triumph over Missouri Valley Conference opponent Evansville... Senior **Jared Newson** averaged 25.5 points over the two-game stretch while going 17-of-34 from the field...He has scored double figures in nine consecutive games, including six straight with 20 or more points...Newson and fellow senior **Jeremy Kelly** combined for 49 of the Skyhawks' 62 points in the win over the Purple Aces...Kelly finished the week with a 24.5 scoring average...After coming off the bench for most of the season, junior college transfer **Zerek Knight** has started each of the last six games, averaging nearly 26 minutes of action during that span...The Skyhawks have won six of their last seven games heading into their regular-season finale Saturday at Murray State.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-14 overall; 9-9 OVC): Tennessee State posted a 2-1 mark last week...After picking up an 80-55 win over Austin Peay and dropping a 77-52 decision to Murray State in OVC action, the Tigers earned a 70-69 road victory over Mid-American Conference opponent Ball State as sophomore **Reiley Ervin** hit a free throw with seven-tenths of a second remaining...Junior **Clarence Matthews** turned in one of his best efforts to date, registering 18 points, a career-high 19 rebounds and five blocked shots in the APSU contest...He also had a double-double against Murray State (11 pts./13 rlds.) and now leads the league with eight overall...Matthews, who was 9-of-9 from the field in against the Govs, continues to top the OVC with a 54.5 shooting percentage...The Tigers also got a career-high 27 points versus APSU from senior **Wayne Arnold**, who went 6-of-8 from beyond the arc...He averaged 22.0 points and 4.0 assists for the week while shooting 57.9 percent from 3-point land...Seventh-place TSU wraps up regular-season action on the road, visiting Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky.

TENNESSEE TECH (17-11 overall; 12-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech retained its number three spot in the OVC standings with a 74-72 win over UT Martin, but was unable to extend the momentum into Saturday's meeting with Missouri Valley Conference opponent Bradley as the Golden Eagles fell to the Braves, 77-62...Junior **Belton Rivers** posted back-to-back 15-point outings to lead Tech's offensive efforts...The Golden Eagles play their regular-season finale on Thursday, hosting Murray State in an ESPNU-televised contest.

RACERS TAKE REGULAR-SEASON CROWN: **Murray State** has captured the OVC regular-season title for a Conference-record 20th time...The Racers, who last earned an outright crown in 1998-99 before sharing the title in 1999-00, were previously tied with former OVC member Western Kentucky for most regular-season crowns...Behind WKU, the team with the next highest number of OVC regular-season titles is **Morehead State** (9).

ON THE TUBE: **Murray State** and **Tennessee Tech** square off in an ESPNU telecast on Thursday, February 23, at 8:00 p.m. Central... Calling the action live from the Eblen Center in Cookeville, Tenn., will be **Larry Conley** and **Dave Weekley**.

BRACKET TAKING SHAPE: Just two games remain in the regular-season schedule and the eight-team bracket for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament is beginning to take shape...Regular-season champion and top seed **Murray State** has already secured home-court advantage for first-round action, along with **Samford** and **Tennessee Tech**...The final hosting spot is up for grabs among **Austin Peay**, **Jacksonville State**, **Eastern Kentucky**, **Tennessee State** and **UT Martin**.

SAMFORD SIZZLING: **Samford** leads the league and ranks among the nation's top shooting squads...Through games of Feb. 13, the Bulldogs were fifth in the NCAA in 3-point average (9.5 pg) while ranking 9th in 3-point shooting (40.7%) and 11th overall (48.9%)...Additionally, Samford's defensive efforts are limiting opponents to just under 60 points a game (17th best in NCAA).

DOUBLING UP: Five OVC players registered double-doubles last week, including Tennessee State's **Clarence Matthews**, who posted back-to-back double-dip performances against Austin Peay (18 pts./career-high 19 rlds.) and Murray State (11 pts./13 rlds.)...The junior forward has registered double-double efforts in seven of his last 10 games and leads the league with eight overall this season.

SCHLADER SHEARS LOCKS FOR SIS: After going through a midseason shooting slump following a haircut a year ago, Austin Peay senior center **Zac Schlader** (14.9 ppg) planned to wait until the end of the current season before paying a visit to the barber...That all changed, however, when Schlader's 18-year-old sister, MegAnn, began losing her hair as a result of treatments she was receiving for her recently-diagnosed Hodgkin's Disease...With the blessings of his teammates and coaches, Schlader went under the razor and surprised MegAnn with his new buzz cut prior to Saturday's home game against Arkansas State.

HOLDING COURT: **Murray State** (9-0) is the only team that remains unbeaten at home in OVC play this season...Dating back to the 2004-05 campaign, the Racers have won 11 consecutive regular-season games against league opponents in the Regional Special Events Center.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker D. Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking fifth (617) and seventh (564), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking third in 3-point attempts (747) and fourth in made treys (260)...In addition, Samford senior **J. Robert Merritt** is sixth in the league in career made 3-pointers (241).

DIAL "J" FOR LONG-DISTANCE: Samford's **J. Robert Merritt** entered last week's action ranked third in the nation in 3-point field goal shooting (49.4%) and tied for fourth in trey average (3.8 pg)...The senior forward has canned 289 career treys, 241 of which have come in the three years since Samford joined the OVC, ranking him sixth all-time in the Conference.
