OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

JARED NEWSON • F, SR., 6-5, 215 • BELLEVILLE, IL • UT MARTIN

Newson averaged 24.3 points a game while shooting over 50 percent from the field as UT Martin posted a 3-0 record in OVC action last week. The senior forward opened with a season-high 29 points against Eastern Kentucky, followed by 21 points versus Tennessee Tech and 23 at Southeast Missouri. Newson, a native of Belleville, Ill., hit seven 3-pointers as part of a 26-of-49 effort from the floor during the three-game stretch, and also tallied 14 rebounds, five steals and three assists while going 14-of-17 from the charity stripe (82.4%).

NEWCOMER

CLARENCE MATTHEWS • F, JR., 6-7, 250 • BEAUMONT, TX • TENNESSEE STATE

Matthews became the first OVC player to record double-doubles in three consecutive games this season, heading up Tennessee State's efforts with 48 points and 36 rebounds on the week. Highlighting the trio of outings was a 22-point, 14-board performance against Samford. A native of Beaumont, Texas, Matthews shot 47.4 percent from the floor (18-of-38) and 60 percent at the free throw line (12-of-20) during the three-game span. Matthews, who now has a league-high six double-doubles, also finished with seven blocks, six steals and five assists.

FRESHMAN

KYLE DUNCAN • F, FR., 6-5, 180 • INDIANAPOLIS, IN • AUSTIN PEAY

Duncan came up big while helping Austin Peay to a 2-1 mark last week. The freshman forward contributed nine points and three assists in a win over Southeast Missouri and also had 10 points and four rebounds in a seven-point victory over Tennessee State, including back-to-back offensive boards down the stretch that led to the game-tying and go-ahead baskets. Overall, the Indianapolis, Ind., native tallied 24 points, 13 rebounds, five assists and three steals while hitting a pair of 3-pointers and going 9-of-16 (56.3%) from the field.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (13-11 overall; 8-7 OVC): Austin Peay moved into a two-way tie for fifth place in the OVC standings after posting a 2-1 mark last week, bookending a tough 69-68 overtime loss to Murray State between wins over Southeast Missouri (73-62) and Tennessee State (70-63)...Freshman **Kyle Duncan** contributed 24 points and 13 rebounds to the Govs' efforts over the three-game stretch...Senior **Maurice Hampton** snapped out of a month-long shooting slump with a 7-of-11 effort from the field versus TSU, including four 3-pointers...The Govs shot better than 50 percent in back-to-back contests for the first time this season, going a combined 49-of-90 against the Racers (55.6%) and Tigers (53.3%)...The Murray State contest marked the first time in six outings this year APSU lost a game while hitting better than 50 percent from the floor...Austin Peay visits Eastern Illinois on Thursday before returning home for a Saturday meeting with Samford.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-16 overall; 4-11 OVC): Eastern Illinois slipped to ninth following back-to-back losses to Jacksonville State (66-51) and Samford (58-55)...The Samford contest featured seven ties and 15 lead changes...Senior guard **Josh Gomes** moved into 15th place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,257 points...The team's top scorer (15.0 ppg), Gomes has converted 42-of-84 attempts from behind the arc this season, tying him for first in the league in 3-point shooting (50%) while ranking him ninth in trey average (2.0 pg)...Sophomore **George Tandy** has pulled down at least four rebounds in 20 of 21 games and is third in the league with a 7.3 average on the glass...The Panthers have lost four of their last five outings and are without a road win since a Dec. 30 outing at Missouri-Kansas City...EIU hosts Austin Peay on Thursday, then closes out the road portion of its regular-season schedule at UT Martin (Feb. 11) and Southeast Missouri (Feb. 15).

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-11 overall; 7-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky held on to the number four slot despite a pair of road losses to UT Martin (90-83) and Tennessee Tech (78-58)...After putting together a pair of three-game win streaks earlier in the season, the Colonels have lost three of their last four and sit just over the .500 mark in Conference play at 7-6...Senior **Matt Witt** has 1,674 career points, 49 shy of equaling the school record...Senior **Jason McLeish** netted just seven points in the loss to Tech, ending his season-long streak of double-figure scoring at 20 games...EKU continues its stretch of seven contests in 15 days, kicking off a three-game homestand on Monday against long-time OVC rival Morehead State...The last seven meetings between EKU and Morehead have been decided by an average of 6.2 points, with only one of those contests ending with more than a 10-point margin...The Colonels also host Murray State (Feb. 9) and Southeast Missouri (Feb. 11).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (10-11 overall; 8-7 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped into a two-way tie for fifth following a 1-2 effort last week, squeezing in a 66-51 win over Eastern Illinois between road setbacks at Tennessee State (83-80) and Murray State (78-72)...The loss at TSU snapped a season-long three-game win streak for the Gamecocks...Senior **B.J. Spencer** knocked down a school-record eight 3-pointers en route to a career-high 26 points against EIU...After going 0-for-3 from long-range in a Jan. 19 outing against Eastern Kentucky, Spencer has canned at least three treys in each of the last six games, converting 27-of-51 attempts (52.9%) during that span...He currently ranks third in the OVC in 3-point shooting (46.7%) and trey average (3.0 pg)...Senior **Walker Russell** continues in his quest to lead the league in assists for a third consecutive season, currently boasting a league-high 6.6 average...JSU visits Tennessee Tech on Thursday.

MOREHEAD STATE (2-17 overall; 1-12 OVC): Morehead State lost a tough 69-66 decision to Tennessee Tech in its only outing of the week...Senior **Quinton Smith** moved into a tie for ninth place on the school's all-time assists chart with 237 handouts...He currently ranks sixth among active OVC career assists leaders...Freshman **Clinton Reisz** played a season-high 22 minutes off the bench against Tech, going 3-of-6 from the field and 4-of-4 at the charity stripe to finish with career-best totals of 10 points and seven rebounds...Junior forward **Shaun Williams**, the team's top scorer and rebounder, has been suspended indefinitely for a violation of team rules...In his first season with the Eagles, Williams is averaging 17.4 points and 6.3 rebounds through 19 games...Morehead State visits long-time OVC rival Eastern Kentucky on Monday before returning home to host Southeast Missouri (Feb. 9) and Murray State (Feb. 11).

MURRAY STATE (16-5 overall; 13-2 OVC): League-leading Murray State extended its win streak to six games with triumphs over Samford (59-38), Austin Peay (69-68, OT) and Jacksonville State (78-72)...In Monday night's showdown between then OVC co-leaders Murray State and Samford, the Racers limited the Bulldogs to just 28.3 percent shooting and 39 points, the lowest output for a Murray State opponent since a 34-point victory against Evansville in 1985...Senior **Trey Pearson's** putback with three seconds remaining in overtime was the difference in Thursday's win at APSU, marking the Racers' first victory in five trips to Clarksville, dating back to 1999...Senior **Pearson Griffith** tallied double-digit rebounds in all three contests for a 10.3 average on the boards...The Racers boast a 39-game streak in which they have not given up more than 80 points...Murray State kicks off a three-game road stretch at Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 9) and Morehead State (Feb. 11).

SAMFORD (16-6 overall; 12-3 OVC): Samford picked up wins over Tennessee State (64-54) and Eastern Illinois (58-55) but fell a full game back of Murray State with Monday's 59-38 setback to the Racers...The Bulldogs still boast the league's best road record in league play (6-1) despite the loss at Murray...Junior **Randall Gulina** knocked down the game-winning trey with 5.8 seconds remaining in the EIU contest...After being held to 3-of-12 long-range shooting at Murray, the league's top 3-point threat, senior **J. Robert Merritt**, bounced back to go a combined 10-of-19 from behind the arc against TSU and EIU...He averaged 16.3 points for the week to take over sole possession of 10th place on the school's all-time scoring chart (1,423 pts.)...He also climbed into the OVC's Top 10 for career 3-pointers, boasting 225 made treys since Samford joined the league in 2003-04...The second-place Bulldogs visit Austin Peay in their lone outing of the week.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-15 overall; 3-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri remains in ninth place following losses to Austin Peay (73-62) and UT Martin (66-55)...Senior and league-leading scorer **Roy Booker** pushed his streak of 20-point outings to nine, hitting his season average of 22.5 over the two-game span...The Redhawks continue to deal with a dwindling roster following the indefinite suspension of top rebounder **Andrais Thornton** (6.6 rpg)...Southeast now has seven scholarship players among eight available for action...Senior **Ketshner Guerrier** enters the week having made his last 14 free throws...Southeast closes out the road portion of its OVC slate this week with visits to Morehead State (Feb. 9) and Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 11)...With an eight-game losing streak accompanying them to Morehead, the Redhawks are hoping to turn the tables on an Eagle squad that ended its own 15-game slide earlier in the season with a 60-55 win at Southeast.

AROUND THE OVC...

UT MARTIN (10-12 overall; 7-9 OVC): UT Martin put the brakes on a four-game skid, posting wins over Eastern Kentucky (90-83), Tennessee Tech (88-78) and Southeast Missouri (66-55)...The three-game win streak is the Skyhawks' second-longest of the 2005-06 campaign...Senior **Jared Newson** registered 20-point performances in all three outings, including a season-high 29 against EIU, to move into fourth place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,220 points...Junior newcomer **Zerek Knight** earned his first start of the season in the EIU contest and responded with a career-high 17 points...He ended the week with 33 points, 10 rebounds, nine assists, eight steals and a 10-of-20 percent shooting effort from the field, including five 3-pointers... Eighth-place UT Martin wraps up the home portion of its regular-season schedule this week as Tennessee State (Feb. 9) and Eastern Illinois (Feb. 11) visit the Elam Center on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (8-12 overall; 7-7 OVC): Tennessee State opened the week with an 83-80 win over Jacksonville State, then dropped back-to-back outings against Samford (64-54) and Austin Peay (70-63)...Junior **Clarence Matthews** recorded double-doubles in all three contests, including a 22-point, 14-rebound performance versus Samford, to finish with 48 points and 36 rebounds on the week...He also blocked seven shots and now ranks third in the OVC with 30 on the year...Junior **Larry Turner** joined the block party with five rejections... Senior **Kareem Grant** also tossed in 48 points over the three-game stretch, going 20-of-38 from the field (52.6%) with six 3-pointers...Fellow senior **Wayne Arnold** averaged 14.7 points a game and also dished out 12 assists while committing just three turnovers...The seventh-place Tigers visit UT Martin on Thursday before returning home to open a three-game homestand Saturday against Tennessee Tech.

TENNESSEE TECH (16-8 overall; 11-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech remains in third place after a 2-1 showing last week...The Golden Eagles won a 69-66 decision at Morehead State, then bounced back from an 88-78 loss at UT Martin with a 78-58 triumph over Eastern Kentucky...Junior **Belton Rivers** knocked down 12 three-pointers en route to a trio of double-figure scoring performances last week...He has reached twin digits in 10 of his last 11 outings, including four straight, and leads the team with 12.7 points per game...Senior **Derek Stribling** registered his first double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds at UT Martin...Sophomore **Justin Taylor** matched a career-high, scoring 10 points against EIU while fellow sophomore **Amadi McKenzie** notched his second double-digit rebound effort with 10 caroms...The Golden Eagles host Jacksonville State on Thursday, then make the short trip up Interstate 40 to Tennessee State on Saturday.

DOUBLING UP: Four OVC players recorded double-doubles last week, including Tennessee State newcomer **Clarence Matthews**, who became the first player to do so in three consecutive games this season with his efforts against Jacksonville State (15 pts./11 reb.), Samford (22 pts./14 reb.) and Austin Peay (11 pts./11 reb.)...The junior forward leads the league with six double-dips overall while Murray State senior forward **Shawn Witherspoon** and Jacksonville State junior forward **Courtney Bradley** are tied with five apiece.

HOLDING COURT: **Murray State** (9-0) is the only team that remains unbeaten at home in OVC play this season...Dating back to the 2004-05 campaign, the Racers have won 11 consecutive regular-season games against league opponents in the Regional Special Events Center.

ON THE TUBE: **Morehead State** and **Samford** square off in an ESPNU-televised contest on Thursday, February 16, at 8:00 p.m. Central... Calling the action live from Seibert Hall in Birmingham, Ala., will be **Dave Weekley** and **Stan Lewter**.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking seventh (590) and eighth (537), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking fourth in 3-point attempts (688) and sixth in made treys (236)...In addition, Samford senior **J. Robert Merritt** is eighth in the league in career made 3-pointers (225).

DIAL "J" FOR LONG-DISTANCE: Samford's **J. Robert Merritt** went 13-of-31 (41.9%) from long-distance last week to move into the league's Top 10 list for all-time 3-pointers...The senior forward has canned 273 career treys, 225 of which have come in the three years since Samford joined the OVC, ranking him eighth all-time in the Conference...He currently leads the league in 3-point shooting (50%, 3.7 pg) and enters the week ranked among the nation's Top 10 long-range threats...Merritt has made at least one 3-point basket in 56 consecutive contests.

BOOK IT: Southeast Missouri's **Roy Booker** has been a welcome addition for the Redhawks after sitting out last season following his transfer from Montana...The senior forward has reached double figures in all 21 games to date, scoring 473 points to account for over 30 percent of Southeast's offense while boasting the league's top average (22.5 ppg)...To date, he has tallied 20 or more points on 16 occasions...Among his current streak of nine consecutive 20-point outings is a pair of 30-point performances, including a career-high 33 against Austin Peay.

THREE OVC TEAMS RANKED AMONG TOP 150 IN RPI: Three OVC teams were ranked among the top 150 in the nation according to the latest RPI ratings compiled by Collegiate Basketball News...Through Feb. 5, **Samford** leads the trio with a #81 ranking, followed by **Murray State** at #89 and **Tennessee Tech** at #132...As a league, the OVC is #19 while boasting the nation's top strength of schedule.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: **Samford** has been selected to appear in one of 13 televised games as part of the *BracketBusters presented by eBay event*, scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 18...The Bulldogs will travel to Athens, Ohio to take on defending Mid-American Conference champion Ohio...Game time has not yet been announced.
