OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

MATT WITT • G, SR., 6-0, 180 • TIPP CITY, OH • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Witt racked up 68 points while helping Eastern Kentucky to a 2-1 record last week, including OVC wins over Morehead State and Eastern Illinois. In a non-conference outing at Xavier, the senior guard tossed in a career-tying 27 points while knocking down seven 3-pointers, matching a school record for made treys in a game. Witt, who has scored in double figures in nine straight outings, followed that with a game-high 22 points against MSU and 19 versus EIU. For the week, the Tipp City, Ohio, native averaged 22.7 points while shooting 51.2 percent from the field, including 16-of-33 from 3-point range, and a perfect 8-of-8 at the charity stripe. He also dished out 15 assists.

NEWCOMER

BELTON RIVERS • G, JR., 6-4, 180 • ATLANTA, GA • TENNESSEE TECH

Rivers led Tennessee Tech's scoring efforts with a combined 44 points in Conference road wins over Jacksonville State and Samford. The junior guard opened with 17 points, five steals, four assists and two rebounds at JSU, then followed that with 27 points, four rebounds and three assists in the Golden Eagles' overtime win at Samford. A native of Atlanta, Ga., Rivers knocked down six 3-pointers as part of a 42.4 percent field shooting effort on the week and went 10-of-11 from the free throw stripe.

FRESHMAN

MIKE ROBINSON • G, FR., 5-10, 185 • CHICAGO, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Robinson did a little bit of everything while helping Eastern Illinois to a 1-2 mark last week. The freshman guard scored 18 points with nine assists and five steals in a one-point loss at league-leading Murray State, then grabbed six rebounds while picking up his first career double-double (14 points/10 assists) in the Panthers' overtime win against UT Martin. He closed out the week with four points, four assists and five steals versus Eastern Kentucky. For the week, the Chicago, Ill., native was 12-of-16 at the free throw line (66.7%) and 11-of-36 from the floor, including a pair of 3-pointers.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (10-6 overall; 5-3 OVC): Austin Peay slipped into a two-way tie for fourth place after splitting a pair of OVC contests last week, falling to Murray State (67-56) before picking up its first OVC road win of the season in a 63-56 victory at Southeast Missouri...The Govs shot 47.6 percent in the second period at Southeast, ending a streak of five sub-40 percent shooting halves...Despite struggling with a 34 percent shooting effort from the field over the two-game stretch, the Govs kept their poise at the free throw line, converting 40-of-50 attempts (80%)...Senior **Maurice Hampton** accounted for nearly half of the team's success at the stripe, hitting 19 of his 21 tries to offset a 3-of-23 effort in the field...Senior **Zac Schlader** recorded his second double-double of the season (fifth career) with 13 points and 11 rebounds against the Racers while sophomore **Fernandez Lockett** pulled down a career-high 13 boards off the bench and sophomore **Derek Wright** matched a career-best with five steals...Freshman **Landon Shipley** scored 11 points at Southeast, the school where his father Dave was a 1,000-point scorer in the late 1970s...APSU looks to defend its 11-game home win streak in OVC outings against Tennessee Tech (Jan. 16) and UT Martin (Jan. 19)...The Govs also have a Jan. 21 non-conference date at Chattanooga.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (3-12 overall; 2-7 OVC): Eastern Illinois remains in 10th place after posting a 1-2 mark in Conference play last week, sandwiching an 80-70 overtime win against UT Martin between losses to Murray State (66-65) and Eastern Kentucky (71-46)...The Panthers have lost four of their last five, but are 1-1 in overtime contests this season...Freshman **Mike Robinson** did a little bit of everything over the three-game stretch, finishing with 36 points, 14 rebounds, 23 assists and 13 steals...Sophomore **Jake Byrne** provided a spark off the bench, contributing eight points, six boards and four assists versus UT Martin before tossing in a career-high 14 points with four caroms in the EIU contest...Byrne finished the week shooting a blistering 68.8 percent (11-of-16) from the field while going 7-of-10 at the charity stripe...Sophomore **George Tandy** was 14-of-24 from the field (58.3%) en route to a 31-point effort for the week...He also cleaned the glass for 20 rebounds...After matching their season-high with 80 points against the Skyhawks, the Panthers managed just 46 points against EKU, their second-lowest output of the 2005-06 campaign...EIU closes out a three-game homestand Monday with Murray State, then hits the road for dates at Tennessee Tech (Jan. 19) and Tennessee State (Jan. 21).

EASTERN KENTUCKY (8-8 overall; 5-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky pulled into a two-way tie for fourth place after going 2-0 in OVC action with road wins over Morehead State (65-63) and Eastern Illinois (71-46)...The Colonels also dropped an 82-63 non-conference decision at Xavier...Senior **Matt Witt** equaled a career-high with 27 points against Xavier, matching a school record by knocking down seven 3-pointers...For the week, he was 16-of-33 from beyond the arc as part of a 51.2 shooting percentage overall...Witt, who extended his streak of double-figure scoring outings to nine, poured in 68 points over the three-game stretch to move into sixth place on the school's all-time scoring list (1,558 points)...The Morehead State and EIU contests marked the Colonels' first road victories of the season and also gave EKU back-to-back wins on their opponents' home turf since the 2003-04 season...EKU is at the .500 mark (8-8) for the first time since a 1-1 record in late November...The Colonels' 48 percent (12-of-25) shooting effort from beyond the arc at Xavier marked the highest for a Musketeer opponent this season...Xavier had entered the contest with the nation's best 3-point shooting defense (25.7%)...EKU returns home this week for meetings with Jacksonville State (Jan. 19) and Samford (Jan. 21).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (6-8 overall; 4-4 OVC): Jacksonville State holds on to sixth place after splitting a pair of Conference tilts, dropping a 79-67 decision to Tennessee Tech before snapping a four-game slide with a 77-75 win over Tennessee State...Sophomore **Dorien Brown** was the team's top scorer and rebounder over the two-game stretch with 28 points and 10 boards...Senior **B.J. Spencer** was held out of the starting lineup for the first time this season against TSU...He ended the game with 11 points and a trio of 3-pointers off the bench and finished the week with 27 points on 10-of-15 field shooting, including a 5-of-7 effort (71.4%) from 3-point land...Senior **Walker Russell** hit a pair of free throws with two seconds left to play in the TSU contest to break a 75-75 tie and lift the Gamecocks to victory...He upped his league-leading assists tally to 92 (6.6 apg), dishing out 12 helpers to go with 17 points...At 6-8, JSU sits one game shy of matching its total wins from a year ago...The Gamecocks play two on the road this week, visiting Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 19) and Morehead State (Jan. 21).

MOREHEAD STATE (1-13 overall; 0-8 OVC): Morehead State saw its losing skid stretch to 13 games after a pair of close setbacks last week...The Eagles dropped a two-point decision to in-state rival Eastern Kentucky, then lost a five-point outing in overtime at UT Martin...Junior **Quentin Pryor** tossed in a team-high 19 points against EKU, then followed that with 14 at UT Martin...He also had 10 rebounds, eight steals and three assists over the two-game stretch...Freshman **Cordaryl Ballard** also turned in back-to-back double-scoring efforts with 13 points versus EKU and a team-high 18 at UT Martin...He knocked down a trio of 3-pointers and was 13-of-24 (54.2%) from the field overall...The Eagles outrebounded their opponents in back-to-back contests for the first time this season, enjoying a 72-56 advantage on the boards for the week...Morehead State has shot 40 percent or better from the field in each of its last three games...Junior newcomer **Shaun Williams** has tallied double figures in points in all but two games this season and is the Eagles' top scorer (17.3 ppg) and rebounder (5.7 rpg)...He leads the league with a 53.2 field shooting percentage and ranks sixth and ninth in scoring and rebounding, respectively...The Eagles return home to entertain OVC foes Samford and Jacksonville State.

MURRAY STATE (10-4 overall; 7-1 OVC): Murray State retained its spot atop the OVC standings with wins over Eastern Illinois (66-65) and Austin Peay (67-56)...The Racers' five-game win streak is their best since opening the 2003-04 season with an 8-0 mark...Senior **Darnell Hopkins** poured in a career-high 23 points against EIU on 8-of-8 field shooting, including six 3-pointers...Freshman **Tyler Holloway** came off the bench in the APSU contest to lead the team with a career-high 16 points while senior **Shawn Witherspoon** notched his sixth career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds...Witherspoon is the only player in the OVC currently leading his team in points (11.1 ppg), rebounds (8.4 rpg) and assists (4.1 apg)...Senior **Pearson Griffith** was credited with four blocked shots last week, upping his league-leading total to 41...No team has scored 40 points on the Racers in the first half of play this season and only two squads have hit the mark in the second half...Murray State leads the OVC with a +11.1 scoring margin while ranking second and third, respectively, in scoring defense (62.5 ppg) and offense (73.6 ppg)...After closing out their six-game homestand with a 5-1 mark, the Racers will play seven of their next 10 on the road, beginning with dates at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 16) and UT Martin (Jan. 21).

SAMFORD (10-5 overall; 6-2 OVC): Samford slipped into a two-way tie for second place after splitting a pair of home OVC outings last week...The Bulldogs cruised to a 68-48 win over Tennessee State, then saw their seven-game win streak come to an end with an 88-85 overtime loss to Tennessee Tech...Junior **Randall Gulina** turned in consecutive career-high 21-point efforts, extending his double-figure scoring streak to nine games...Since Dec. 8, he is averaging 16.2 points on 55.7 percent field shooting...After knocking down 25 three-pointers over a four-game span, senior **J. Robert Merritt** cooled down a bit last week, going 4-of-10 from beyond the arc...The league's top 3-point shooter (50.5%, 3.2 pg), Merritt has shot 55 percent or better from the field overall in five of his last six outings to rank fourth in the OVC (49.7%)...He leads the team in both scoring (17.0 ppg) and rebounding (4.8 rpg)...As a team, the Bulldogs lead the Conference in both 3-point (43.0%) and overall (50.8%) field goal shooting, as well as made 3-pointers (9.2 pg)...Samford hits the road with trips to Morehead State (Jan. 19) and Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 21)...The Bulldogs are 4-3 on the road this season, but sport a perfect 3-0 mark in road games against Conference opponents.

AROUND THE OVC...

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-9 overall; 3-6 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped its lone contest of the week, a 63-56 decision to Austin Peay...Senior **Roy Booker** canned five 3-pointers and went 10-of-12 from the free throw line en route to a career-high 33 points...Booker, who ranked 24th nationally in scoring through games of Jan. 9, has scored in double figures in all 15 games this season and leads the league with a 21.5 average...Senior **Waylon Francis** pulled down 11 rebounds, his second double-digit effort on the glass in four games...He leads the team and ranks fifth in the league with a 7.1 average on the glass...Junior **Terrick Willoughby** was held without a field goal (0-of-7) for the first time this season...He entered Saturday's contest with a 57.7 shooting percentage (15-of-26) over his previous three outings, including a 7-of-13 (.538) effort from 3-point range....Sophomore point guard **Paul Paradossi** is seventh in the OVC with a 4.0 average in handouts...His assist/turnover margin (1.76) is fifth-best in the Conference...Southeast leads the league in defensive rebounds (25.8 rpg) and is one of only two OVC teams outrebounding its opponents this season, ranking second with a +2.6 margin...The ninth-place Redhawks go on the road this week, visiting Tennessee State (Jan. 19) and Tennessee Tech (Jan. 21).

UT MARTIN (7-8 overall; 4-5 OVC): UT Martin moved into seventh place after splitting a pair of overtime contests against OVC opponents...The Skyhawks fell to Eastern Illinois (80-70) before ending a three-game slide with a 71-66 win over Morehead State...UT Martin sports a 4-6 record in overtime games played during head coach **Bret Campbell's** seven-year tenure...Four of those 10 overtime contests have been against EIU...Junior **Bubba Tolliver** came off the bench in both games to contribute 26 points and seven rebounds...He went 4-of-6 from 3-point land and finished with a 60 percent shooting effort overall (9-of-15)...Junior **Will Lewis** hauled in 17 rebounds over the two-game stretch, including 10 on the offensive end...Senior **Jared Newson** has scored in double figures in 26 consecutive games, dating back to Jan. 20, 2005...He leads the team and ranks fourth in the OVC in both scoring (17.5 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg)...Senior **Jeremy Kelly** is 22 points shy of becoming the 11th Skyhawk to top the 1,000-point plateau for his career...He ranks fourth in the league in assists (4.6 apg) and is the team's second-leading scoring (15.5 ppg)...After making a Jan. 19 visit to Austin Peay, UT Martin returns home for a Jan. 21 date with Murray State.

TENNESSEE STATE (4-9 overall; 3-4 OVC): Tennessee State had a tough road trip to Alabama, falling to Samford (68-48) and Jacksonville State (77-75)...At Samford, TSU trailed by only one at intermission, but was outscored by 19 points in the second half...In the JSU contest, the Tigers lost a double-digit lead in the second half and saw the Gamecocks convert a pair of game-winning free throws in the waning seconds...Junior **Clarence Matthews** scored in double figures in both contests, including a career-high 25 points at JSU, where he torched the nets with 9-of-10 field shooting to go along with eight rebounds and two blocked shots...He is converting a team-high 53 percent from the floor and is one of three Tigers averaging over 12 points a game...Senior **Kareem Grant** and sophomore **Reiley Ervin** had four treys apiece to account for 80 percent of the Tigers' 3-point production...Senior **Wayne Arnold**, who entered the week with the nation's third-best 3-point shooting percentage (55.8%) was a rare 0-of-7 from beyond the arc over the two-game stretch...Senior **Courtney Bohannon** contributed 14 points and 12 rebounds off the bench...The eighth-place Tigers return to the Gentry Center to kick off a three-game homestand, beginning with Southeast Missouri (Jan. 19) and Eastern Illinois (Jan. 21).

TENNESSEE TECH (11-5 overall; 6-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech grabbed two road wins on its Alabama swing, defeating Jacksonville State (79-67) and Samford (88-85), the latter of which required overtime...The Golden Eagles have now won three straight and sit in a two-way tie for second place in the OVC standings...Sophomore **Belton Rivers** was the Golden Eagles' top scorer for the week (22.0 ppg), canning six 3-pointers and going 10-of-11 from the charity stripe...Sophomore **Anthony Fisher** and senior **Milone Clark**, who went a combined 5-of-8 from 3-point range at Samford, each accounted for a buzzer-beating trey in the contest...Fisher's shot tied the score at 76-76 and sent the game into overtime, while Clark's bucket broke an 85-85 tie to give Tech the win...Clark finished the week with 33 points and 14 boards...Fisher is playing the "sixth-man" role to near perfection this season, leading the team with a 12.2 scoring average while coming off the bench in 15 of 16 outings...As a team, Tech shot 52.5 percent from the field while going 17-of-38 from 3-point range over the two games...The Golden Eagles close out a three-game road stretch Monday at Austin Peay before returning home for dates with Eastern Illinois (Jan. 19) and Southeast Missouri (Jan. 21).

GAMECOCKS AND COLONELS ON SIRIUS: The Jan. 19 meeting between **Jacksonville State** and **Eastern Kentucky** will be aired on Sirius Satellite Radio, Channel 181.

TREY-RIFFIC: OVC players account for six of the nation's top single-game performances in 3-point shooting this season, including two -- Samford senior **J. Robert Merritt** and Tennessee State senior **Wayne Arnold** -- who have combined for four such outings between them...Arnold converted 7-of-8 attempts (87.5%) from beyond the arc in games against Ohio State and **Eastern Illinois** to tie for third, while Merritt went 7-of-8 versus Campbellsville and 7-of-10 (70%) against **Jacksonville State** to tie for third and 17th, respectively...Eastern Illinois senior **Josh Gomes** (7-of-8 vs. UMKC) and Eastern Kentucky senior **Matt Witt** (7-of-10 vs. Xavier) are also listed among those top single-game performances.

HOME SWEET HOME: **Austin Peay** boasts an 11-game home win streak that is tied for 17th nationally...The Govs haven't lost in the Dunn Center since a 67-63 setback to **Eastern Kentucky** on Jan. 13, 2005...APSU has won all four of its home games against league opponents and joins **Murray State** (6-0) and **Tennessee State** (2-0) as the only teams that remain unbeaten at home in OVC play.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking seventh (568) and ninth (490), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking sixth in made 3-pointers (231) and tied for seventh in trey attempts (641).
