OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

J. ROBERT MERRITT • F, SR., 6-6, 220 • OKLAHOMA CITY, OK • SAMFORD

Merritt averaged 18.3 points a game as Samford closed out 2005 with a trio of victories. After netting 16 and nine points, respectively, in OVC wins over Southeast Missouri and Murray State, the senior forward capped off the effort with a career-high 33 points against Campbellsville. A native of Oklahoma City, Okla., Merritt fell one basket shy of tying the OVC record for most consecutive field goals made in a game, connecting on his final 12 attempts out of 13 in the CU contest, including a 7-of-8 effort from 3-point range. For the week, Merritt shot 58.8 percent from the floor (20-of-34), including going 12-of-19 from beyond the arc (63.2%). He also grabbed eight rebounds and four steals while dishing out three assists without a turnover.

NEWCOMER

ROY BOOKER • G, SR., 6-3, 205 • PORTAGEVILLE, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Booker topped the 20-point mark in all three of Southeast Missouri's road outings over the holiday break, averaging 24.3 points and 3.7 rebounds during the three-game span. The senior guard from Portageville, Mo., opened with 24 points on 9-of-18 field shooting at Samford, then followed that with 23 points at Jacksonville State and 26 at sixth-ranked Illinois. For the week, Booker shot 41.1 percent from the field (23-of-56), including 10 three-pointers, and 85 percent at the stripe (17-of-20) while dishing out seven assists.

FRESHMAN

LONDON SHIPLEY • G, FR., 6-1, 170 • ST. LOUIS, MO • AUSTIN PEAY

Shipley turned in two solid efforts in a reserve role as Austin Peay recorded non-conference wins over Evansville and Middle Tennessee during the holiday break. The freshman guard opened with a team-high 24 points versus the Purple Aces, going 6-of-7 from the field, including a 5-of-5 performance from beyond the arc that set a Dunn Center record for three-point shooting. He was also 7-of-9 at the free throw line. The St. Louis, Mo., native then netted his third straight double-figure game off the bench with 11 points and a career-high five assists against MTSU, going 6-of-6 at the line in the process. For the week, Shipley was 8-of-10 from the field, 6-of-6 from 3-point range and 13-of-15 from the stripe.

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (7-4 overall; 2-1 OVC): Austin Peay ran its win streak to five games with non-conference victories over Evansville (74-71) and Middle Tennessee (83-67) during the holiday break...The Govs finished with a 5-1 record for the month, marking the highest December winning percentage (.833) in head coach **Dave Loos'** 16-year tenure...The win over MTSU snapped the Govs' six-game road losing streak and also ended a 20-game non-conference road losing streak...APSU shot a season-high 50 percent (6-of-12) from behind the arc in the MTSU contest...After seeing his 12-game double-figure scoring streak end with nine points versus Evansville, senior **Zac Schlader** bounced back for a 22-point effort at MTSU...Senior **Maurice Hampton** sits seven points shy of 1,000 for his career after averaging 21.5 points in the two contests...Freshman **Landon Shipley** pushed his streak of double-figure scoring games to three, including a season-high 24 points off the bench versus Evansville...He went 5-of-5 from 3-point land in that contest, pushing his season trey percentage to 47.6% (10-of-21)...Fellow frosh **Drake Reed's** first career double-double (10 pts./13 rbd.) against Evansville marked the most boards by an APSU player in nearly three years...The Govs' backcourt is short a couple of players as redshirt freshman **Brandon Burney** has been ruled academically ineligible for the spring semester and junior **Brandon Harriford** is out indefinitely with a jaw fracture...APSU returns to OVC play, visiting UT Martin (Jan. 2) before putting its nine-game home win streak on the line vs. Jacksonville State (Jan. 5) and Eastern Illinois (Jan. 7).

EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-8 overall; 1-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois went 2-2 during a four-game road stretch over the holiday break, picking up wins at Morehead State (57-56) and UMKC (72-67) while falling to Eastern Kentucky (57-50) and Missouri (68-56)...The victory over the Eagles snapped the Panthers' nine-game losing streak...Sophomore **Bobby Catchings** pumped in a career-high 32 points at UMKC, hitting 12-of-18 field attempts, including 5-of-7 from 3-point range, while senior **Josh Gomes** followed with a season-high 27 points, shooting a blistering 81.8 percent (9-of-11) from the field while knocking down 7-of-8 from behind the arc...Gomes' seven treys matched a career-high...Overall, the Panthers shot a season-high 50 percent (25-of-50) from the floor against the Roos...EIU's 72 points in the UMKC contest marked only the second time this season the Panthers had topped the 70-point mark, the other being an 83-80 overtime loss to Tennessee Tech...Freshman **Mike Robinson** dished out 23 assists while contributing 27 points over the four-game stretch...He is tied for fifth in the league with 4.3 handouts per game...Sophomore **George Tandy** hauled in 35 rebounds and leads the league with an 8.6 average on the glass...He also blocked seven shots to rank second in the league with 16 total rejections...After opening the season 0-7, EIU has won two of its last three games heading into the meat of its OVC schedule...The Panthers return home for a lone game against Southeast Missouri (Jan. 5) before hitting the road again with a Jan. 7 visit to Austin Peay.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-6 overall; 2-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky heads into the 2006 portion of its schedule riding a three-game win streak following victories over Eastern Illinois (57-50), UT Martin (75-61) and Coastal Carolina (60-51)...Senior **Matt Witt** averaged 19.3 points a game over the break and became the school's career leader for made 3-pointers (211) after hitting a pair against CCU...The Colonels are 5-0 when they hold the opposition under 70 points and 0-6 when they don't...The CCU contest featured season-low shooting performances by both squads (EKU-36.7%, CCU- 35.1%)...Colonel starters accounted for 54 of EKU's 57 points in the win over EIU...Junior **Michael Brock** pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds against UT Martin, finishing with 25 boards overall during the three-game stretch...Sophomore **Darnell Dials** also had 25 caroms during the break, and is averaging 9.5 boards over the last four games...Senior and top scorer **Jason McLeish** (16.3 ppg) is the only Colonel to reach double figures in every game this season...He has shot 50 percent from the field in six of his last seven contests and leads the league with a 53 percent (61-of-115) effort overall...Freshman **Mike Rose** was held scoreless for the first time in his collegiate career against CCU...Junior **Julian Mascoll** saw his first action of the season versus UT Martin and grabbed a career-high six steals in the CCU contest...Witt will play his 100th game as a Colonel on Monday when EKU visits OVC foe Southeast Missouri for a nationally-televised contest on ESPNU...The Colonels continue league play on Thursday, returning home to entertain Tennessee Tech.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (5-5 overall; 3-1 OVC): Jacksonville State went 1-2 during the holiday break, sandwiching a win over Southeast Missouri (82-72) between losses to Murray State (91-72) and Auburn (87-83)...The Gamecocks canned a season-high 11 three-pointers in the four-point loss at Auburn, but also committed a season-high 21 turnovers...Senior **Walker Russell**, who moved into third place on the school's Division I career scoring list (906 pts.), averaged 16.3 points and 7.7 assists during the three-game stretch, including his first double-double of the season (20 pts./10 asts.) against Southeast...He also hit 10-of-11 free throw attempts overall to remain the OVC's top foul shooter (93.3%)...Russell, on pace to lead the league in assists for the third straight season, has 458 career handouts, five shy of cracking the OVC's Top 10 list for all-time leaders...Junior **Courtney Bradley** posted his third double-double of the season (20 pts./10 rbd.) at Auburn...He has pulled down at least four boards in each of his 10 games this season and is fourth in the OVC with a team-high 7.6 average on the glass...Senior **B.J. Spencer** has netted double figures in each of his last nine games and ranks among the league's top 10 this season in scoring (15.8 ppg), field goal shooting (46.6%), 3-point shooting (41.5%) and trey average (2.7 pg)...He matched a season-high with five treys at Auburn...The Gamecocks are off to their best OVC start (3-1) since joining the league in 2003...JSU resumes Conference play with a Jan. 5 trip to Austin Peay and a home meeting with long-time rival Samford (Jan. 7).

MOREHEAD STATE (1-9 overall; 0-4 OVC): Morehead State struggled to an 0-4 mark over the holiday break, dropping home OVC outings to UT Martin (80-67) and Eastern Illinois (57-56) and non-conference road decisions to No. 2 Connecticut (129-61) and East Tennessee (82-70)...The Eagles have lost nine straight following their 123-83 rout of Kentucky Christian in their season opener...Junior **Shaun Williams** was the Eagles' top scorer in two of the four contests, dropping in 31 points against UT Martin and 25 at UConn...He finished the stretch with 78 points (19.5 ppg), 22 rebounds (5.5 rpg) and five blocked shots...Williams is the only Morehead State player averaging double figures this season, ranking fourth in the league in scoring (18.6 ppg) and second in field goal shooting (52.8%)...The Eagles' season-high 12 blocked shots against EIU is the second-highest tally by an OVC squad this season...Junior **Quentin Pryor** tossed in a career-high 21 points at ETSU, hitting 8-of-14 from the field (57.1%), including 4-of-8 from 3-point range...Senior **Cory Burns** had a streak of 18 consecutive made free throws broken in the ETSU contest...The run dated back to the 2004-05 season...The Eagles had a tough time getting to the stripe over the break as their opponents made 35 more free throws than Morehead State attempted...The Eagles return to OVC action, wrapping up a four-game road swing with trips to Tennessee State (Jan. 2) and Tennessee Tech (Jan. 7).

MURRAY STATE (6-4 overall; 3-1 OVC): Murray State posted a .500 mark during the holiday break, defeating Jacksonville State (91-72) and Rice (83-65) while losing to Samford (61-50) and Southern Illinois (57-53)...The loss to SIU ended a three-game win streak and was the Racers' first setback at home this season...Senior **Pearson Griffith** was the only Racer to average double figures over the four-game stretch, shooting 58.3 percent from the field (21-of-36) while contributing 11.5 points a game, including a career-high 19 points at Samford...He also blocked seven shots overall to up his league-leading total to 33...Freshman **Tyler Holloway** continues to be the Racers' three-point specialist off the bench, knocking down 4-of-9 treys over the four games to put his season average at 44.4 percent (16-of-36)...Junior **Shawn Witherspoon** notched his third double-double of the season (fourth career) with 15 points and 15 rebounds versus Rice, the highest rebounding effort by an OVC player this season and the most by a Racer in nearly two years...Murray State's Dec. 19 win at JSU, which came following a nine-day layoff, was the 50th career victory for third-year head coach **Mick Cronin**...The Racers are 33-1 under Cronin when reaching the 80-point mark and 17-20 when failing to hit that mark...The Samford contest marked the third straight season in which the Bulldogs have handed the Racers their first OVC loss...In search of the program's 500th OVC victory, Murray State continues its six-game homestand with Tennessee State (Jan. 5) and Southeast Missouri (Jan. 7).

SAMFORD (6-4 overall; 2-1 OVC): Samford closed out the 2005 calendar year with a trio of home victories as the Bulldogs knocked off OVC rivals Southeast Missouri (68-53) and Murray State (61-50) before cruising to a 91-56 non-conference win over Campbellsville...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** poured in a career-high 33 points against Campbellsville, missing his first field goal attempt before drilling his final 12, including a 7-of-8 effort from three-point range...Merritt's 33-point output is the most by an OVC player this season...He leads the team and ranks 10th in the OVC with a 14.9 scoring average...Sophomores **Travis Peterson** and **Ryan Woolsey** netted career-highs of 18 and 11 points, respectively, against Murray State...Peterson, the team's top shot-blocker (11 blocks) is converting just over half of his field goal attempts this season (34-of-67) and leads the Bulldogs with a 54.4 percent effort from beyond the arc (18-of-33)...Junior **Randall Gulina** drained 14-of-16 free throw attempts over the three-game stretch and ranks second in the league with an 84.4 conversion rate at the stripe...In the last three games, Samford has shot 57 percent from the field and averaged 73.3 points...The Bulldogs have also knocked down 45.3 percent from 3-point range while limiting opponents to 53 points a game during that span...Samford leads the OVC in both overall (47.5%) and 3-point (39.3%) field goal shooting, as well as trey average (8.6 pg) and scoring defense (54.8 ppg)...The Bulldogs open the '06 half of their slate with a three-game OVC road trip, featuring stops at Tennessee Tech (Jan. 2), UT Martin (Jan. 5) and Jacksonville State (Jan. 7).

AROUND THE OVC...

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-7 overall; 1-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri went winless in three road outings during the holidays, falling to Samford (68-53), Jacksonville State (82-72) and Illinois (89-64)...Senior **Roy Booker** led the Redhawks with a 24.3 scoring average over the three-game stretch, including 26 points at sixth-ranked Illinois...Booker, who leads the league with 20.5 points a game, received his bachelor's degree in university studies on Dec. 17 and will continue to play for the Redhawks while taking graduate courses...Junior **Andrais Thornton** pulled down 24 rebounds over the break, adding to his team-high and OVC fifth-ranked average of 7.5 boards per game...Sophomore Paul Paradoski has quickly emerged as one of the league's top point guards, tying for third in the OVC in both assists (4.36 apg) and assist/turnover ratio (2.0) this season...During the 2004-05 campaign, his 2.61 A/T ratio was tops in the Conference...Junior **Jared Ritter**, grandson of Southeast's all-time leading scorer and two-time All-American Carl Ritter, has joined the Redhawks as a walk-on...A 5-11 guard, Ritter played one year of college hoops at Hannibal La Grange and spent last season at Three Rivers Community College where he did not play basketball...Junior **John Chappell** has left the team and plans to transfer to another school...Southeast returns home Jan. 2 to entertain Eastern Kentucky in a nationally-televised contest on ESPNU, then hits the road again for dates at Eastern Illinois (Jan. 5) and Murray State (Jan. 7)...Monday's contest can also be seen locally on UPN-The Beat.

UT MARTIN (5-5 overall; 2-2 OVC): UT Martin posted a 1-3 mark during the holidays, opening a four-game road stretch with an 80-67 win at Morehead State before dropping contests at Eastern Kentucky (75-61), Purdue (62-54) and sixth-ranked Illinois (84-46)...The Skyhawks averaged a disappointing 36 percent shooting effort (80-of-223) from the field over the four-game span, including a 15-of-58 performance from 3-point land (25.9%), but managed to hit convert 66-of-90 from the free throw line (73.3%)...Seniors **Jared Newson** and **Jeremy Kelly** pumped in 63 points apiece over the four-game stretch (15.8 ppg) with Newson also pulling down a team-high 33 rebounds...Kelly is third in the league in scoring (18.7 ppg) while Newson ranks fifth (17.8 ppg)...Both players are closing in on the 1,000-point marks for their careers (Newson-998 pts./Kelly-932 pts.)...Newson also leads the OVC in steals (2.1 spg) and ranks fourth in field goal shooting (47.5%) while Kelly is tied for fifth in assists (4.3 apg)...Junior **Bubba Tolliver** made his Skyhawk debut at Morehead State, finishing with six points, seven assists, two rebounds and three steals...He finished the stretch with 16 points, 17 assists and 10 steals overall...Junior **McKale Jones** was credited with six blocked shots in the four games, upping his team-high total to nine...The losses to Purdue and Illinois dropped UT Martin's record against Big Ten teams to 0-7...The Skyhawks' win against the Eagles was their first in Morehead since 1999...UT Martin returns home to entertain OVC foes Austin Peay (Jan. 2) and Samford (Jan. 5), then visits Tennessee State on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-6 overall; 1-1 OVC): Tennessee State went 0-4 over the break...The Tigers got off to fast starts in their three road contests, building double-digit leads before falling to Southern Miss (84-74), Ohio State (74-65) and Iowa State (59-51)...In a home setback to Middle Tennessee (67-57), a 17-percent shooting performance in the first half resulted in a 16-point deficit, but the Tigers fought back to get within one, only to see MTSU pull away down the stretch...Junior **Clarence Matthews** collected his first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds at Southern Miss...He converted 52.8 percent of his field attempts (19-of-36) over the four-game stretch and also recorded six blocked shots, including three at nationally-ranked Ohio State...Matthews and senior **Wayne Arnold** are netting 12.8 points a game, while fellow Los Angeles Community College product **Kareem Grant** is right behind them with a 12.0 scoring average...The big news out of Tiger camp is the loss of junior starter and top scorer **Bruce Price**, who tore an ACL in the OSU game and is out for the season with surgery scheduled for later this week...Price was averaging 19.3 points and 5.8 assists per game...The Tigers did have some good news with the addition of Oklahoma transfer **Larry Turner**, who made his debut in the USM contest and has stepped into the starting lineup with the loss of Price...Turner contributed 27 points and 30 rebounds over the four-game stretch...The Tigers now jump back into OVC play, sandwiching a Jan. 5 trip to Murray State between home contests against Morehead State and UT Martin.

TENNESSEE TECH (8-3 overall; 3-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech won two of three outings over the holidays, stretching its home win streak to 18 games with an 85-41 victory over Brevard before squeaking out a 66-65 victory in Las Vegas against Florida A&M...Tech finished the Las Vegas Holiday Classic with a 2-1 mark, losing only to Cincinnati on Dec. 17...Down by only three at the half, Tech gave ninth-ranked Michigan State a fight before eventually falling, 80-63...The Golden Eagles boast the league's top record at 8-3 overall...The FAMU contest marked only the fourth time in 11 games the Golden Eagles have failed to crack the 70-point plateau, but was the first in a victorious effort...Senior **Derek Stribling** led Tech's scoring with 37 points over the three-game stretch, also grabbing 12 rebounds along the way, while senior **Milone Clark** torched the nets for a 63.6 percent performance (14-of-22) en route to 30 points...Clark and junior **Jonathan Jones** each pulled down a team-high 14 rebounds...Sophomore **Anthony Fisher** saw his streak of double-figure scoring games end at seven with a six-point effort against Michigan State...He ranks second on the team behind Stribling's 12.1 scoring average with 11.9 points a game...Tech's 18-game winning streak in Eblen Center currently ranks fifth nationally...The Golden Eagles resume OVC play, sandwiching a Jan. 5 road trip to Eastern Kentucky between home meetings with Samford (Jan. 2) and Morehead State (Jan. 7).

BLOCK PARTY: Murray State senior forward **Pearson Griffith** has been holding a one-man block party early in the 2005-06 campaign...The product of St. Thomas, Barbados, has turned away at least five shot attempts on three different occasions this season and leads the league with 33 rejections overall while ranking fifth nationally (4.0 bpg)...A junior college transfer in his second season with the Racers, Griffith currently ranks first among OVC active career leaders with 67 blocks.

ON THE TUBE: The fourth of eight ESPNU contests in the 2005-06 OVC television package hits the airwaves on Jan. 2 as Southeast Missouri plays host to **Eastern Kentucky**...Calling Monday's action will be **Dave Weekley** and **Tim McCormick**.

HOME SWEET HOME: OVC teams boast a 33-15 record (.688) at home thus far in 2005-06, including two squads, **Tennessee Tech** (5-0) and **Austin Peay** (4-0) who are unbeaten on their home turf...Tech ranks fifth in the country with an 18-game win streak in the Eblen Center that stretches back to Nov. 23, 2004, while **Austin Peay** (4-0) sports a nine-game run dating back to Jan. 15, 2005.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event...Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year mark of 1-2, with first-year participant **Murray State** earning a 69-63 victory against host Rice last season...**Austin Peay** will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearances.

TOP SCORERS RETURN: Eight of the OVC's top 15 scorers from a year ago return in 2005-06...Back are Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** (16.8 ppg), Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt** (16.5 ppg), UT Martin guard/forward **Jared Newson** (15.4 ppg), Austin Peay guard **Maurice Hampton** (14.7 ppg), Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** (14.5 ppg), Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** (14.5 ppg), Eastern Kentucky guard **Matt Witt** (14.4 ppg) and Tennessee State guard **Bruce Price** (13.7 ppg).

DISHING IT OUT: Nine of the OVC's top 10 assist men from last season are back for 2005-06, including at least one player who will finish his career ranked among the league's all-time leaders for handouts...Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is ranked seventh in the OVC in career assists with 546, just 153 ticks shy of the all-time record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81)...Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** lurks just outside the OVC's top 10 all-time list with 458 career assists after leading the league for each of the last two seasons, ranking fourth nationally a year ago (7.3 apg) while dishing out a school-record 211 assists.

ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES: The 2004-05 All-OVC teams were laden with senior veterans and as a result, only four of the 10 players who earned all-Conference recognition a year ago are back again this season. Returning from the All-OVC first team is Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** and Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt**, while Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** and Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** are back after capturing All-OVC second team honors last season. In addition, Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** returns to the hardwood after garnering the OVC Freshman of the Year award in 2004-05.
