OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

CLARENCE MATTHEWS • F, JR., 6-7, 250 • BEAUMONT, TX • TENNESSEE STATE

Matthews averaged 22.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while leading Tennessee State to a pair of home victories last week. The junior forward followed a 16-point, six-rebound effort against Southeast Missouri with a double-double performance of 28 points and 10 boards versus Eastern Illinois. The Beaumont, Texas, native was near-perfect in the EIU contest, converting 8-of-9 tries from the field and 12-of-13 attempts from the free throw line. For the week, Matthews shot 68.2 percent from the floor and 82.4 percent at the charity stripe while also registering four blocked shots, two steals and an assist.

NEWCOMER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, JR., 6-5, 215 • UTICA, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley turned in back-to-back 20-point performances in a pair of OVC outings last week. The junior forward opened with a career-high 25 at Eastern Kentucky, then scorched the nets with a 9-of-11 shooting effort for 23 points at Morehead State. The Utica, Miss., native was also the game-high rebounder in both contests, counting six offensive boards among 15 overall. Bradley was 3-of-5 from 3-point range while finishing the week with a 63.3 percent shooting effort overall. He also went 7-of-9 at the charity stripe and had three steals, one assist and one blocked shot.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (11-8 overall; 6-4 OVC): Austin Peay sandwiched a 96-88 win over UT Martin between losses to Tennessee Tech (79-75) and non-conference foe Chattanooga (77-67)...The loss to Tech ended APSU's home winning streak at 11 games...Senior **Zac Schlader** matched a career-high with 27 points at UTC, going 8-of-10 from the floor and hitting all 11 of his free throw attempts...He averaged 20.7 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists for the week while shooting 67.7 percent from the field (21-of-31) and 80 percent at the stripe (20-of-25)...APSU has shot 70 percent or better from the foul line in 15 of 19 contests this season to rank second in the OVC (75.1%)...Freshman **Kyle Duncan** was a perfect 6-of-6 from the floor against UT Martin for a career-high 18 points...Sophomore **Fernandez Lockett** has pulled down eight or more boards in four of his last five outings, including a career-high 16 against UT Martin...He ranks seventh in the league with a 6.5 average on the glass...Tied for fourth, APSU hits the road for OVC dates at Jacksonville State (Jan. 26) and Samford (Jan. 28).

EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-14 overall; 3-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois opened the week with a 59-54 upset of Murray State but was unable to keep the momentum going in road losses to Tennessee Tech (75-70) and Tennessee State (73-57)...The Panthers have lost six of their last seven and sit a half-game back of Southeast Missouri in 10th place...The win over Murray State was EIU's first since 2002, snapping a 10-game losing streak to the Racers...Offense has been hard to come by as EIU has topped the 70-point plateau just twice in its last 12 games, ranking last in the OVC in scoring (59.6 ppg)...Senior **Josh Gomes** had a team-high 32 points last week, moving into 16th place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,207...Sophomore **Jake Byrne** moved into the starting lineup for all three games and responded with a 13-point, nine-rebound effort at Tech...Sophomore **George Tandy** had another solid week on the glass, pulling down 15 caroms...He is third in the OVC (7.3 rpg)...After playing eight games during a 17-day stretch, the Panthers have a full week off before hosting Morehead State on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (9-9 overall; 6-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky moved above .500 for the first time this season with an 86-78 victory over Jacksonville State, but an 85-66 loss to Samford knocked the Colonels down to an even 9-9 and ended their win streak at three games...Senior **Matt Witt**, the league's second-best scorer (18.1 ppg), knocked down nine 3-pointers and led the team with a 22.5 average for the week...He moved into fourth place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,603 points...Junior **Julian Mascoll** tossed in a career-high 15 points on 6-of-6 field shooting against JSU...Senior **Jason McLeish** is the only EKV player to score in double figures in all 18 games this season...He is averaging 20.3 points a game in OVC action and ranks third in the league overall (17.7 ppg)...EKU has shot 41 percent or better from the field in each of the last seven games...The Bulldogs are the only OVC team to defeat the Colonels at home in each of the last two years...Tied for fourth, EKV kicks off a three-game Conference road swing with visits to Tennessee State (Jan. 26) and UT Martin (Jan. 30).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (7-9 overall; 5-5 OVC): Jacksonville State slipped into seventh place after going 1-1 last week, dropping an 86-78 decision to Eastern Kentucky before bouncing back for an 88-65 win at Morehead State...Junior **Courtney Bradley** turned in back-to-back 20-point efforts for the second time this season, dumping in a career-high 25 at EKV before shooting lights out (9-of-11) for 23 points at Morehead...He also finished with 15 boards on the week...Senior **Walker Russell**, currently ranked among the top five nationally in assists, has topped the century mark for the third straight season with a league-high 110...He now sits eighth on the league's all-time list with 508 assists...Sophomore **Dorien Brown** upped his number of blocked shots to 19 on the year after swatting away six attempts over the two-game stretch...At 5-5 in OVC action and 7-9 overall, the Gamecocks have already more than doubled their number of Conference wins from a year ago while matching their overall win total...JSU returns home to entertain Austin Peay (Jan. 26) and UT Martin (Jan. 28).

MOREHEAD STATE (1-15 overall; 0-10 OVC): Morehead State saw its losing skid stretch to 15 games with setbacks to Samford (65-64) and Jacksonville State (88-65)...Prior to the 17-point loss to JSU, the Eagles had lost their four previous games by an average of just 4.2 points...Junior **Shaun Williams** had 29 points and 14 rebounds over the two-game stretch...He ranks sixth (16.9 ppg) in the OVC in scoring (16.9 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (5.9 rpg)...Senior **Quentin Pryor** continues to improve after missing all of last season due to hand surgery, averaging 17.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists last week...Senior **Quinton Smith** climbed into the school's Top 10 list for all-time assists (231)...He is tied for 10th with former Eagle and current Kentucky House of Representatives majority floor leader Rocky Adkins...Another former Eagle standout, Chez Marks (2000-04), is making a name for himself overseas...He currently leads the British Basketball League in scoring (23.0 ppg) while playing for the London Towers...Morehead State visits Southeast Missouri (Jan. 26) and Eastern Illinois (Jan. 28).

MURRAY STATE (11-5 overall; 8-2 OVC): Murray State slipped into a two-way tie for second place after going 1-1 in OVC road action last week, dropping a 59-54 decision to Eastern Illinois before rebounding for a 79-73 win at UT Martin...Senior **Pearson Griffith** continues to be a force in the middle, rejecting five shot attempts to up his league-leading total of blocked shots to 48...He ranks 10th nationally, while the Racers are 25th as a team (3.0 bpg)...Murray State also boasts the NCAA's seventh-best assist tally (18.6 apg)...With 82 career blocks, Griffith sits two shy of passing former Racer standout Popeye Jones for eighth place on the school's all-time list...The loss to EIU snapped a 10-game win streak for the Racers...UT Martin is one of three OVC squads to whom third-year head coach **Mick Cronin** has not lost...In addition to sporting a 5-0 record against the Skyhawks, Cronin is 6-0 versus Morehead State and 3-0 against Jacksonville State...After hosting league-leading Tennessee Tech on Thursday, the Racers travel to Southeast Missouri on Saturday for an ESPN2-televvised contest.

SAMFORD (12-5 overall; 8-2 OVC): Samford stretched its road win streak to five games, capturing a 65-64 victory over Morehead State before rolling to an 85-66 win at Eastern Kentucky...After getting a buzzer-beating layup from junior **Jerry Smith** to escape with the win at Morehead, the Bulldogs made sure they didn't need any last-second heroics at EKV, torching the nets for 73.1 first-half shooting en route to the victory...Junior **Randall Gulina** netted career-highs of 22 points and five assists at Morehead, then turned in his fourth-straight 20-plus effort with 20 points at EKV...Gulina has scored in double figures in 11 straight games, averaging 17.1 points and shooting 56.9 percent from the field during that stretch...Sophomores **Travis Peterson** and **Curtis West** also had solid outings at EKV...Peterson notched his first-ever double-double with 21 points and a personal-best 11 rebounds while West tallied a career-high 17 points...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** ranks fifth nationally in 3-point shooting (50.9%)...Tied for second, the Bulldogs host UT Martin (Jan. 26) and Austin Peay (Jan. 28).

AROUND THE OVC...

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-11 overall; 3-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri finds itself in the midst of a four-game slide following losses at Tennessee State (68-63) and Tennessee Tech (87-76)...Senior **Roy Booker** upped his league-leading scoring average to 22.4 points after dropping in 57 over the two games...He has scored in double figures in all 17 outings, including a pair of 30-point efforts...Nearly one-third of his offense has come at the charity stripe, where he has converted 103-of-125 attempts (82.4%)...Junior guard **Eric Burtin** (5.8 ppg, 2.8 rpg) is out for the remainder of the season after breaking his leg last Thursday at TSU...He played in 16 games this season, starting six...Burtin joins fellow junior college transfer **David Johnson**, who was sidelined earlier this year following hernia surgery...Senior **Ketshner Guerrier** has converted his last 11 free throws to raise his season average to 18-of-26 (69.2%)...The ninth-place Redhawks play a two-game stretch at home against Morehead State (Jan. 26) and Murray State (Jan. 28), the latter of which will be televised live on ESPN2.

UT MARTIN (7-10 overall; 4-7 OVC): UT Martin fell into eighth place after going 0-2 in OVC action with losses to Austin Peay (96-88) and Murray State (79-73)...Senior **Jeremy Kelly** tossed in 25 points last week to become the second Skyhawk this season and 11th overall to top the 1,000-point mark for his career...He currently has 1,003 points, joining senior teammate **Jared Newson**, who is the program's sixth all-time leading scorer with 1,113 points...Newson had eight points at APSU, ending his streak of consecutive double-figure scoring efforts at 26 games...Kelly and Newson account for 44.3 percent of the Skyhawks' offense this season, averaging 17.2 and 15.2 points, respectively...Junior **McKale Jones** added 25 points and 14 rebounds off the bench...Three of UT Martin's last four losses have been by eight points or less...The Skyhawks are 1-7 on their opponents' home turf this season with a lone road win at Morehead State and will be looking to snap a six-game road losing streak when they visit Samford (Jan. 26) and Jacksonville State (Jan. 28).

TENNESSEE STATE (6-9 overall; 5-4 OVC): Tennessee State remained unbeaten at home in OVC action, picking up wins over Southeast Missouri (68-63) and Eastern Illinois (73-57)...The victories put the Tigers back above the .500 mark in Conference play, moving them up two spots into sixth place...Senior **Kareem Grant** sparked Thursday's win over the Redhawks with 20 points on 8-of-10 field shooting, the only misses coming from 3-point range...Junior **Clarence Matthews** also had a big week, following a 16-point outing against Southeast with a 28-point effort versus EIU...He was near-perfect, converting 8-of-9 field goal and 12-of-13 free throw attempts...Senior **Wayne Arnold** broke out of a mini-shooting slump to drain six 3-pointers over the two-game stretch...Arnold is second in the OVC and 14th nationally with a 47-percent conversion rate behind the arc...TSU is 4-0 against OVC foes in the Gentry Center this season...After closing out a three-game homestand on Thursday with Eastern Kentucky, the Tigers visit Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (14-5 overall; 9-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech has won six straight and sits alone atop the OVC standings at 9-2 after dispatching Austin Peay (79-75), Eastern Illinois (75-60) and Southeast Missouri (87-76) last week...Sophomore **Anthony Fisher** pumped in a career-high 22 points at APSU, then followed that with 14 and 21 points against EIU and Southeast, respectively, to stretch his streak of double-figure scoring games to seven...He drained 9-of-15 three-pointers and went 14-of-15 at the charity stripe...Junior **Belton Rivers** averaged 16.7 points last week, giving him six straight games in double digits...He hit all three of his 3-point attempts at APSU and finished the week with six treys...The Golden Eagles' top scorer and top rebounder can be found in key reserves Fisher (19.0 ppg) and **Amadi McKenzie** (4.9 rpg)...Redshirt freshman **Ra'Shun Bryant** pulled down a career-best eight boards against EIU...The Golden Eagles visit Murray State on Thursday before returning home to entertain Tennessee State on Saturday.

ON THE TUBE: **Murray State** and **Southeast Missouri** square off in an ESPN2-televised contest on Saturday, January 28, at 3:00 p.m. Central...Calling the action live from the Show Me Center in Cape Girardeau, Mo., will be **Bucky Waters** and **Jerry Punch**.

HOLDING COURT: **Murray State** (6-0) and **Tennessee State** (4-0) are the only teams that remain unbeaten at home in OVC play this season...Dating back to last season, the Racers have won eight consecutive regular-season games against league opponents in the Regional Special Events Center, while the Tigers have won six straight OVC contests at the Gentry Center.

ROAD WARRIORS: While the Racers and Tigers are protecting their home turf, **Samford** is taking care of business on the road...Since opening the 2005-06 campaign with consecutive losses at nationally-ranked Texas and Oklahoma as well as South Alabama, the Bulldogs have reeled off five straight road wins in Conference play...Samford's five-game streak is its longest since rattling off eight consecutive road wins en route to its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 1998-99.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking seventh (577) and eighth (508), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking fifth in 3-point attempts (659) and sixth in made treys (240).

THREE OVC TEAMS RANKED AMONG TOP 150 IN RPI: Three OVC teams were ranked among the top 150 in the nation according to the RPI ratings compiled by Collegiate Basketball News through games of Jan. 22...**Tennessee Tech** leads the trio with a #72 ranking, followed by **Samford** at #84 and **Murray State** at #141. The OVC is #21 as a league while boasting the nation's top ranking for strength of schedule.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event...Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year mark of 1-2, with first-year participant **Murray State** earning a 69-63 victory against host Rice last season...**Austin Peay** will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearances...Pairings for the Feb. 18 event will be announced the week of January 30.
