OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

KAREEM GRANT • F, SR., 6-6, 190 • MIDDLETOWN, CT • TENNESSEE STATE

Grant registered back-to-back career-highs of 31 points as Tennessee State posted a 1-1 record in OVC action last week. The senior forward did most of his damage from long-range, canning a career-best six 3-pointers against Eastern Kentucky, then topping that with seven treys in a road upset of Tennessee Tech. A native of Middletown, Conn., Grant finished the week shooting 61.9 percent from behind the arc (13-of-21) while going 21-of-35 overall (60%). He also pulled down seven rebounds, grabbed five steals and hit all seven of his free throw attempts over the two-game stretch.

NEWCOMER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, JR., 6-5, 215 • UTICA, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley became the first OVC player to record back-to-back double-doubles this season as Jacksonville State went 2-0 in Conference play last week. The junior forward opened with a career-high 31 points and 10 rebounds against Austin Peay, then added 22 points and 12 boards two days later versus UT Martin. A native of Utica, Miss., Bradley hit three 3-pointers and ended the week with a 57.1 shooting percentage from the field (20-of-35) overall. He also tallied seven steals and went 10-of-13 at the charity stripe (76.8%).

FRESHMAN

MIKE ROBINSON • G, FR., 5-11, 185 • CHICAGO, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Robinson contributed 13 points in Eastern Illinois' lone outing of the week, an 80-65 win over Morehead State. The freshman guard from Chicago, Ill., hit a trio of 3-pointers in the first six minutes to help stake the Panthers to a 14-5 lead before finishing the game with a 5-for-8 effort from the field (62.5%). He also tallied four assists, three rebounds and three steals in the contest.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (11-10 overall; 6-6 OVC): Austin Peay tumbled to seventh place in the OVC standings after going 0-2 on last week's Alabama swing, falling to Jacksonville State (91-86) and Samford (84-68)...Freshman **Drake Reed**, who tallied career-bests of 20 points and 14 rebounds in his first meeting with JSU, just missed tallying another double-dip vs. the Gamecocks, finishing with 18 points and eight boards... The Govs boast the league's second-best conversion rate at the stripe (74.9%) with league-highs in both attempted (491) and made free throws (368)...The loss at Samford was APSU's worst in OVC action since a 19-point setback (66-47) at Tennessee Tech in 2002-03...JSU (50%) and Samford (55.8%) are the first opponents since 2000-01 to touch the Govs' defense for 50 percent shooting in back-to-back games...APSU plays a three-game homestand against Southeast Missouri (Jan. 30), Murray State (Feb. 2) and Tennessee State (Feb. 4).

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-14 overall; 4-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois won its lone outing last week, posting an 80-65 triumph over Morehead State...Senior **Josh Gomes** went 5-of-7 from behind the arc, finishing with a game-high 24 points and five assists...Sophomore **Jake Byrne** tossed in a career-high 22 points, going 8-of-9 from the field while nailing all six of his free throw attempts...Freshman **Mike Robinson** canned a trio of 3-pointers within the first six minutes on his way to a 13-point outing...The Panthers matched a season-high in points while shooting a season-best 53.8 percent from the floor...Sophomore **George Tandy** recorded his third double-double of the season with 10 points and 13 rebounds...Tied for eighth in the OVC standings, EIU hits the road for dates at Jacksonville State (Feb. 2) and Samford (Feb. 4).

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-9 overall; 7-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky rallied from a 20-point deficit with less than eight minutes to play for a 79-74 road win at Tennessee State in EKU's lone game of the week...The Colonels are the first OVC team to beat the Tigers on their home court this season...Senior **Matt Witt** posted his eighth 20-point outing of the season with a team-high 26 points in the contest to move into third place on the school's career scoring chart (1,629 pts)...He went 5-for-11 from 3-point range to climb into fourth and fifth place, respectively, on the league's all-time lists for 3-point attempts (670) and made treys (229)...EKU has won three straight road games in OVC action for the first time since 1994-95...The Colonels boast a streak of nine straight games with at least one player hitting the 20-point mark...Fourth-place EKU closes out a three-game road stretch with visits to UT Martin (Jan. 30) and Tennessee Tech (Feb. 4).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-9 overall; 7-5 OVC): Jacksonville State vaulted into fifth place with OVC wins over Austin Peay (91-86) and UT Martin (85-80)...The Gamecocks have won four of their last five league tilts, including three straight, and now sit a half-game back of fourth-place Eastern Kentucky...Junior **Courtney Bradley** averaged 26.5 points and 11.0 rebounds with back-to-back double-doubles while extending his streak of 20-point outings to four, including a career-high 31 against APSU...He has shot 50 percent or better from the field in each of his last nine games to rank third in the OVC (53.3%)...Senior **Walker Russell** tossed in 37 points over the two-game stretch to become the 17th member of the school's 1,000-point club and the second Gamecock to register 1,000 points and 500 assists in a career...Jax State sandwiches a home game with Eastern Illinois (Feb. 2) between road dates at Tennessee State (Jan. 30) and Murray State (Feb. 4).

MOREHEAD STATE (2-16 overall; 1-11 OVC): Morehead State snapped a 15-game losing streak and picked up its first road win of the 2005-06 campaign with a 60-55 victory at Southeast Missouri...The Eagles were unable to make it two in a row, however, falling to Eastern Illinois (80-65)...Thursday's win was the Eagles' first in league play this season, ending a 12-game OVC losing streak that stretched back to Feb. 22, 2005...Junior **Shaun Williams** was the team's top scorer in both contests, averaging 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds...Senior **Quinton Smith** canned 5-of-10 three-pointers, finishing the week with a 12.5 scoring average...Senior **Cory Burns** missed both games with a shoulder injury, the same one that sidelined him for the first three games of the season...Freshman **Cordaryl Ballard** registered back-to-back double-figures scoring efforts (11.0 ppg) while going 9-of-16 from the field (56.3%)...The Eagles converted 45-of-98 floor attempts (45.9%) over the two-game stretch...Morehead State entertains Tennessee Tech on Monday, closing out a 12-day, five-game stretch for the Eagles.

MURRAY STATE (13-5 overall; 10-2 OVC): Murray State regained a share of the OVC lead with victories over Tennessee Tech (55-51) and Southeast Missouri (76-69)...Junior **Trey Pearson** scored 15 of his 17 points in the first half of the Southeast contest...The Racers' upset of then league-leading Tech marked the first time Murray State had won a game without placing any players in double-figure scoring...Senior **Pearson Griffith** sits two blocks shy of passing former standout Popeye Jones for ninth place on the school's all-time list...He ranks first among OVC active career leaders with 85 rejections...Murray State will be looking for its first OVC win against Samford when the team square off Monday night in Murray...The Racers also visit Austin Peay on Thursday before returning home to host Jacksonville State on Saturday.

SAMFORD (14-5 overall; 10-2 OVC): Samford extended its current win streak to four games with triumphs over UT Martin (67-60) and Austin Peay (84-68)...The Bulldogs have won 11 of their last 12 games and sit tied with Murray State atop the OVC standings...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** continues to dial it up from long distance, going 11-of-19 from 3-point range (57.9%) last week while averaging 22.0 points and 7.0 rebounds...He enters the week as nation's third-ranked 3-point shooter, topping the OVC with a 51.9 percent conversion rate and 3.6 average beyond the arc...The Bulldogs put their 5-0 OVC road record on the line with Jan. 30 and Feb. 2 dates at Murray State and Tennessee State, respectively, before returning home to welcome Eastern Illinois on Feb. 4...Samford has won all three of its previous OVC meetings with Murray State, including a 61-50 decision earlier this season in Birmingham.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-13 overall; 3-10 OVC): Southeast Missouri saw its losing skid stretch to six games with setbacks to Morehead State (60-55) and Murray State (76-69)...Senior **Roy Booker** hit all 12 of his free throw attempts against the Racers and finished the week with 48 points over the two-game stretch...The league's leading scorer (22.5 ppg), Booker has reached double figures in all 19 games this season and sports a streak of seven straight outings with 20 or more points, including a pair of 30-point efforts...Freshman **Eric Jones** contributed five points and six rebounds off the bench in the Morehead State contest...The two losses dropped the Redhawks to 10th place in the OVC standings...Southeast visits Austin Peay on Monday and hosts UT Martin on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (7-12 overall; 4-9 OVC): UT Martin struggled on last week's road trip to Alabama, dropping contests at Samford (67-60) and Jacksonville State (85-80)...The Skyhawks have lost seven of their last nine games and the current four-game slide is their longest of the season...Each of their last six losses has been by 10 points or less...Junior **Will Lewis** posted his first double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds at JSU, just missing out on another with 10 points and nine boards at Samford...After being held scoreless in the Skyhawks' Jan. 12 overtime loss at Eastern Illinois, senior **Jeremy Kelly** has reached double digits in five consecutive games, averaging 13.6 points during that stretch...He has canned a team-high 30 three-pointers this season and leads the squad with 84 assists...Tied for eighth, the Skyhawks host Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 30) and Tennessee Tech (Feb. 2) before paying a visit to Southeast Missouri (Feb. 4)...Thursday's game will be aired on ESPNU, marking the first time in school history the Skyhawks will play at home in front of a national audience.

AROUND THE OVC...

TENNESSEE STATE (7-10 overall; 6-5 OVC): Tennessee State went 1-1 in OVC action last week, losing a 67-60 decision to Eastern Kentucky before picking up an 85-80 victory at Tennessee Tech...The EKV contest marked TSU's first home loss in Conference play this season, snapping the Tigers' four-game win streak in the Gentry Center...Senior **Kareem Grant** had a monster week, draining 13-of-21 shots from 3-point land (61.9%) while posting back-to-back career-highs of 31 points...Junior **Clarence Matthews** posted his third double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds at Tech...Freshman point guard **Reiley Ervin** hit a trio of 3-pointers in the Tech contest, including one that expanded TSU's lead to six points as the Golden Eagles made a late run...The sixth-place Tigers return home for dates with Jacksonville State (Jan. 30) and Samford (Feb. 2) before heading over to Austin Peay on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (14-7 overall; 9-4 OVC): Tennessee Tech tumbled from the top spot to third place after suffering back-to-back losses for only the second time this season, falling to Murray State (55-51) and Tennessee State (72-63)...Junior **Belton Rivers** had four 3-pointers against TSU, scoring all 18 of his points in the final 4:21, including 15 straight that pulled the Golden Eagles to within three with 2:17 left to play...Senior **Keyon Boyd** hit a pair of 3-pointers and led the team with 13 points at Murray State...Sophomore **Amadi McKenzie** just missed his second double-double of the season with nine points and nine rebounds in the TSU contest...Tech plays two of three on the road this week, visiting Morehead State (Jan. 30) and UT Martin (Feb. 2) before coming home to host Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 4)...Thursday's game at UT Martin will be televised live on ESPNU.

SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE: Monday's key matchup between league co-leaders **Murray State** and **Samford** pits the team with the best OVC home record (MSU, 7-0) against the squad with the best OVC road mark (Samford, 5-0)...The Racers and the Bulldogs are tied at 10-2 apiece in Conference play...Samford has won all three of its previous meetings with Murray State since joining the league in 2003.

ON THE TUBE: UT Martin and **Tennessee Tech** square off in an ESPNU-televised contest on Thursday, February 1, at 8:00 p.m. Central...Calling the action live from the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center in Martin, Tenn., will be **Bob Wischusen** and **Mark Adams**...UPN The Beat (Cape Girardeau, MO) will broadcast the game on a tape-delayed basis that same evening, beginning at 9:30 p.m. Central.

DIAL "J" FOR LONG-DISTANCE: Samford's **J. Robert Merritt** continues to light it up beyond the arc...The senior forward leads the league in 3-point shooting (51.9%, 3.6 pg) and enters the week as the nation's third-ranked shooter from beyond the arc...He has canned 260 career 3-pointers, 212 of which have come in the three years since Samford joined the OVC, putting him within reach of the league's Top 10 list for all-time treys...Merritt has made at least one 3-point basket in 53 consecutive contests.

GRANTING TREYS: Tennessee State's **Kareem Grant** is also doing some damage from long-range...The senior forward has re-set his career-bests in made 3-pointers in each of his last three games while shooting a blistering 62 percent (18-of-29) from beyond the arc during that span...He knocked down five 3-pointers in the Tigers' Jan. 21 win over Eastern Illinois, then followed that with six and seven treys, respectively, against Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee Tech last week...He has made at least two treys in seven straight games to rank third in the league in 3-point shooting (46.1%) and seventh in trey average (2.06 pg).

BOOK IT: Southeast Missouri's **Roy Booker** has been a welcome addition for the Redhawks after sitting out last season following his transfer from Montana...The senior forward has reached double figures in all 19 games to date, scoring 428 points to account for 34.4 percent of Southeast's offense while boasting the league's top average (22.5 ppg)...To date, he has tallied 20 or more points on 14 occasions...Among his current streak of seven consecutive 20-point outings is a pair of 30-point performances, including a career-high 33 against Austin Peay.

DOUBLING UP: Five OVC players recorded double-doubles last week, including Jacksonville State newcomer **Courtney Bradley**, who became the first OVC player to do so in back-to-back games this season with his efforts against Austin Peay (31 pts./10 reb.) and UT Martin (22 pts./12 reb.)...The junior forward leads the league with five double-dips overall while Murray State senior forward **Shawn Witherspoon** and Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** are tied with four apiece.

HOLDING COURT: **Murray State** (7-0) is the only team that remains unbeaten at home in OVC play this season...Dating back to last season, the Racers have won nine consecutive regular-season games against league opponents in the Regional Special Events Center.

ROAD WARRIORS: While the Racers are protecting their home turf, **Samford** is taking care of business on the road...Since opening the 2005-06 campaign with consecutive losses at nationally-ranked Texas and Oklahoma as well as South Alabama, the Bulldogs have reeled off five straight road wins in Conference play...Samford's five-game streak is its longest since rattling off eight consecutive road wins en route to its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 1998-99.

RECORDS WATCH: Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** and Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** will finish their careers as two of the OVC's top 10 all-time assists leaders, currently ranking seventh (583) and eighth (518), respectively...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking fourth in 3-point attempts (670) and fifth in made treys (229).

THREE OVC TEAMS RANKED AMONG TOP 150 IN RPI: Three OVC teams were ranked among the top 150 in the nation according to the latest RPI ratings compiled by Collegiate Basketball News...Through Jan. 29, **Samford** leads the trio with a #81 ranking, followed by **Tennessee Tech** at #109 and **Murray State** at #121...As a league, the OVC is #20 while boasting the nation's top strength of schedule.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: **Samford** has been selected to appear in one of 13 televised games as part of the *BracketBusters* presented by eBay event, scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 18...The Bulldogs will travel to Athens, Ohio to take on defending Mid-American Conference champion Ohio...Game time has not yet been determined...The remaining matchups for the other 11 OVC squads in the *BracketBusters* presented by eBay pool will be announced on Tuesday, Feb. 1.
