OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

J. ROBERT MERRITT • F, SR., 6-6, 220 • OKLAHOMA CITY, OK • SAMFORD

Merritt averaged 23.7 points and 6.7 rebounds a game while leading Samford to a trio of OVC road victories last week. After netting 17 and 22 points against Tennessee Tech and UT Martin, respectively, the senior guard capped off the week with his second 30-point effort in two weeks, tossing in a game-high 32 points at Jacksonville State. Merritt, who moved into 12th place on the school's all-time scoring list (1,259 pts.) with his offensive outburst, also registered his first double-doubles of the season by pulling down a game-high 10 rebounds versus both Tech and JSU. For the week, the Oklahoma City, Okla., native connected on 72 percent (18-of-25) of his shots from beyond the arc while also going 9-of-10 at the charity stripe.

NEWCOMER

ROY BOOKER • G, SR., 6-3, 205 • PORTAGEVILLE, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Booker extended his season-opening stretch of double-figure scoring efforts to 14 games while guiding Southeast Missouri to a 2-1 mark in OVC action last week. The senior guard led the Redhawks with a 21.3 scoring average during the three-game stretch, firing in 18 points against Eastern Kentucky, 26 at Eastern Illinois and 18 at Murray State. A native of Portageville, Mo., Booker was near-perfect from the free throw line, converting 19-of-21 attempts (90.5%) while also shooting 41.2 percent from the field (21-of-51) overall. He also contributed 14 rebounds and nine assists for the week.

FRESHMAN

DRAKE REED • F, FR., 6-5, 220 • CLARKSVILLE, TN • AUSTIN PEAY

Reed averaged 13.3 points and 8.7 rebounds while helping Austin Peay to a 2-1 record in OVC play last week. The freshman forward's best effort came in a win over Jacksonville State, where he went 9-of-12 from the floor en route to career-highs of 20 points and 14 rebounds for his second double-double of the season. That performance came on the heels of an 11-point, 5-rebound effort at UT Martin. He capped off his week with nine points and a team-high seven rebounds against Eastern Illinois. For the week, the Clarksville, Tenn., native shot 57.7 percent from the field (15-of-26) while also contributing three steals, two assists and a blocked shot.

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (9-5 overall; 4-2 OVC): Austin Peay dropped an 84-75 decision on the road at UT Martin, but returned home to pick up back-to-back victories over Jacksonville State (95-82) and Eastern Illinois (62-56)...The Govs have won all six of their outings in the Dunn Center this season, giving them an 11-game home win streak that dates back to the 2004-05 campaign...Senior **Maurice Hampton** was the team's top scorer in all three games, including a career-high 28-point performance at UT Martin...Freshman **Drake Reed** continues to impress, averaging 13.3 points and 8.7 rebounds a game last week...He notched his second double-double of the season with career-highs of 20 points and 14 rebounds against JSU...After missing the UT Martin contest with an infection, senior **Zac Schlader** returned to the lineup versus JSU, scoring 17 points while handing out a career-high seven assists...The Govs' 95-point performance off a season-high 19 assists in the JSU contest marked the highest-scoring effort by an APSU squad in five-plus seasons, a span of 171 games...Tied for third in Conference play at 4-2, Austin Peay hits the road for dates at Murray State (Jan. 12) and Southeast Missouri (Jan. 14)...Thursday's meeting with the Racers will be televised nationally on ESPNU and regionally on UPN The Beat.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-10 overall; 1-5 OVC): Eastern Illinois lost a pair of OVC outings last week, falling to Southeast Missouri (72-60) at home and Austin Peay (62-56) on the road...The Panthers continue to struggle offensively, averaging a league-low 58.8 points per game...Senior **Josh Gomes** recorded his third 20-point effort of the season, converting 10-of-15 field attempts for 25 points at APSU...Gomes leads the team and ranks 10th in the league with a 14.7 scoring average...He also ranks third and sixth, respectively, in the OVC in 3-point (49%) and overall (47%) field goal shooting percentages...Sophomore **George Tandy** has blocked a team-high 17 shots and boasts a Conference-best 8.1 rebounding average...After surrendering a season-low nine turnovers against Southeast, the Panthers committed 17 miscues in the APSU contest, leading to 20 points for the Govs...The 10th-place Panthers, who are playing a total of eight games over a 17-day stretch, visit Murray State on Monday before returning to Lantz Arena to kick off a three-game homestand with UT Martin (Jan. 12) and Eastern Kentucky (Jan. 14).

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-7 overall; 3-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to Southeast Missouri, 68-62, then bounced back to score a season-best 93 points in a win over Tennessee Tech (93-75)...Senior **Jason McLeish** went 6-of-7 from the field in the second half of the Tech contest en route to career-highs of 29 points and eight rebounds...He has shot 50 percent or better from the floor in eight of his last nine games and boasts a 53.8 shooting percentage overall...Senior **Matt Witt** added 20 points against Tech, making McLeish and Witt the first Colonel duo to reach the 20-point plateau in the same game in nearly two years...Freshman **Mike Rose** grabbed 13 rebounds last week, including a career-high eight against Tech...The Colonels' 45 boards versus the Golden Eagles marked a season-high for the team...After opening Conference play with back-to-back losses, EKU has won three of its last four OVC tilts to sit tied for sixth in the league standings at 3-3...The Colonels will be looking for their first road win of 2004-05 when they visit non-conference foe Xavier (Jan. 9) and OVC rivals Morehead State (Jan. 12) and Eastern Illinois (Jan. 14)...The Xavier contest will be televised regionally on FSN Ohio, while the Morehead State game will be aired regionally by WYMT-TV and UPN Lexington.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (5-7 overall; 3-3 OVC): Jacksonville State saw its losing skid stretch to three games with setbacks to Austin Peay (95-82) and Samford (90-69)...After opening the season with a 4-2 mark, the Gamecocks have struggled lately, winning just one of their last six outings...Junior **Courtney Bradley** tossed in a career-high 23 points at APSU, 19 of which came in the second half on 7-of-8 shooting...Bradley also cleared nine rebounds, adding to his team-high average of 7.1 boards...Senior **Walker Russell** climbed into ninth place on the OVC's all-time list for career assists (473), dishing out 15 helpers last week to go with his 34 points...Russell canned a career-best six 3-pointers en route to a season-high 24 points as JSU shot a season-best 57.1 percent from behind the arc (12-of-21) in the Samford contest...Senior **B.J. Spencer** saw his streak of double-figure outings end at nine games with a nine-point effort against the Bulldogs...He leads the team and ranks ninth in the league with a 15.1 scoring average...All five members of JSU's starting rotation are shooting 40 percent or better from the field, led by sophomore **Dorien Brown's** 52.1 percent...Tied for sixth in the OVC, Jax State closes out its three-game homestand vs. Tennessee Tech (Jan. 12) and Tennessee State (Jan. 14).

MOREHEAD STATE (1-11 overall; 0-6 OVC): Morehead State fell to Tennessee State (76-49) and Tennessee Tech (61-52)...The Eagles' 11-game losing streak is their longest since a 13-game slide at the start of the 1991-92 season...Junior **Shaun Williams** continues to provide a spark in his first season as an Eagle...He is third in the OVC in scoring (18.0 ppg), tied for third in steals (1.83 spg), tied for sixth in blocked shots (0.83 bpg) and 13th in rebounding (5.2 rpg) while also boasting the league's top field goal shooting percentage (53.9%)...Williams and sophomore **Ryan Allen** have 10 blocked shots apiece this season...After hitting over 70 percent of their free throws in each of the last seven years, the Eagles are converting just 67.9 percent (112-of-165) of their trips to the charity stripe in 2004-05...Thursday's contest against Eastern Kentucky will be televised regionally by WYMT-TV and UPN Lexington...The 11th-place Eagles also make a Jan. 14 visit to UT Martin.

MURRAY STATE (8-4 overall; 5-1 OVC): Murray State made it three wins in a row with victories over Tennessee State (75-67) and Southeast Missouri (81-68)...The TSU contest marked the Racers' 11th triumph over the Tigers in Murray...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** shot a blistering 63.1 percent from the field (12-of-19) for the week while leading the team with 31 points, 12 rebounds and 11 assists...Senior **Chuck Johnson** saw his streak of consecutive made free throws end at 11 with a 2-of-4 effort at the stripe against TSU...Four Racers scored in double figures in each of the two games...Murray State committed just two turnovers in the Southeast contest, a school record...In eight seasons at the Regional Special Events Center, the Racers boast an 89-16 mark (.848), including a 31-5 record during head coach **Mick Cronin's** tenure...The Racers are 206-25 since 1990 when scoring 80 or more points...Murray State, tied atop the OVC standings at 5-1, close out their six-game homestand this week against Eastern Illinois (Jan. 9) and Austin Peay (Jan. 12)...Thursday's game versus the Governors will be televised nationally on ESPNU and regionally on UPN The Beat.

SAMFORD (9-4 overall; 5-1 OVC): Samford extended its winning streak to six games with road triumphs over Tennessee Tech (68-43), UT Martin (79-65) and Jacksonville State (90-69)...The Bulldogs' eight-game run is their longest since putting together a six-game streak at the start of Conference play last season...Senior **J. Robert Merritt** torched the nets with a 72 percent shooting effort from 3-point range (18-of-25) while averaging 23.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists last week...He topped the 30-point plateau for the second time in two weeks with 32 against JSU and moved into 12th place on the school's all-time scoring list (1,259 pts.)...Samford's three-game road win streak is its longest since reeling off four straight during the 2000-01 campaign...All five starters shot 54 percent or better from the field during the three-game stretch as the Bulldogs posted a 59.1 percent team effort for the week...Samford leads the league in both 3-point (42.2%) and overall (50.1%) field goal shooting while limiting opponents to a Conference-low 55.8 points per game...In their last six outings, the Bulldogs have averaged a +20.2 margin of victory...Tied at 5-1 atop the OVC standings, Samford returns home for a pair of contests against Tennessee State (Jan. 12) and Tennessee Tech (Jan. 14).

AROUND THE OVC...

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-8 overall; 3-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri posted a 2-1 mark in OVC action last week, defeating Eastern Kentucky (68-53) and Eastern Illinois (82-72) before dropping an 89-64 decision to Murray State...Senior **Roy Booker** extended his streak of double-figure scoring efforts to 16, averaging 21.3 points a game...He converted 19-of-21 free throw attempts and now ranks fifth in the league with an 82 percent conversion rate at the stripe...Booker, in his first season as a Redhawk, also leads the OVC with a 20.7 scoring average and is among the Conference's top 3-point shooters, ranking fourth and seventh, respectively, in trey average (2.5 pg) and percentage (34.7%)...Junior **Andrais Thornton** leads the team and ranks fifth in the league in rebounding with a 7.4 average on the glass...Southeast plays host to Austin Peay on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (6-7 overall; 3-4 OVC): UT Martin went 1-2 in Conference play last week, picking up an 84-75 win over Austin Peay before falling to Samford (79-65) and Tennessee State (85-82)...The road loss to the Tigers was the Skyhawks' first in seven meetings in the Gentry Center...Senior **Jared Newson** averaged 16.7 points last week to become the 10th UT Martin player to reach the 1,000-point plateau...Newson, who has scored in double-figures in 24 consecutive games, has 1,048 career points, just three ticks shy of No. 9 on the school's scoring chart...Fellow senior **Jeremy Kelly** is fast closing in on the same milestone with 967 career points...The Skyhawks hit a season-high eight 3-pointers against TSU...Kelly and Skyhawk newcomer **Bubba Tolliver** each dished out seven assists at TSU as UT Martin handed out 18 helpers overall, the most by the Skyhawks in an OVC game this season...Junior **Will Lewis** returned to the starting lineup last week after sitting out four games...He chipped in 32 points and 14 rebounds over the three-game stretch...UT Martin visits Eastern Illinois on Thursday before returning home to host Morehead State on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (4-7 overall; 3-2 OVC): Tennessee State sandwiched a 75-67 loss to Murray State between wins over Morehead State (76-49) and UT Martin (85-82)...The Tigers did not allow the Eagles a field goal the final 7:37 of the contest...Senior **Wayne Arnold** drained 47.6 percent of his 3-point attempts (10-of-21) on the week while averaging 17.7 points a game...He leads the league and ranks third nationally with a 52.2 conversion rate behind the arc...Junior **Larry Turner** chimed in with 29 points and 18 rebounds for the week while shooting a blistering 62.5 percent from the field...Junior **Clarence Matthews** pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds against Morehead State as the Tigers held a 48-24 advantage on the boards over the Eagles...He finished the week with 27 boards overall, including 15 on the offensive end, and ranks third in the league with a 7.9 average on the glass...TSU placed all five starters in double figures in the UT Martin contest...Sophomore point guard **Reiley Ervin** dished out 16 assists to go with his 16.3 scoring average last week...The Tigers hit the road for dates at Samford (Jan. 12) and Jacksonville State (Jan. 14).

TENNESSEE TECH (9-5 overall; 4-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped outings against Samford (68-43) and Eastern Kentucky (93-75) before ending its three-game slide with a 61-52 win over Morehead State...The loss to the Bulldogs snapped Tech's 18-game home win streak...Sophomore **Anthony Fisher** posted a pair of double-figure scoring efforts, including a season-high 17 points against EKV, to lead the team with a 12.3 scoring average for the week...The Tech coaching staff mixed up the starting rotation against Morehead State as walk-on freshman **Zac Walker** and sophomore **Amadi McKenzie** made their first career starts while sophomore **Justin Taylor** was in the starting lineup for the second time in his career and the first time this season...McKenzie, who netted 27 points and 15 rebounds over the two-game stretch, finished with a 57.9 shooting percentage from the field (11-of-19) while senior **Milone Clark** added 34 points on a 53.8 percent shooting effort (14-of-26)...Junior **Jonathan Jones** pulled down 11 rebounds in just 30 minutes of action for the week...Tech kicks off a three-game road stretch with trips to Jacksonville State (Jan. 12) and Samford (Jan. 14).

HAMPTON HOT: After failing to top the 20-point plateau in his first eight games this season, Austin Peay senior guard **Maurice Hampton** has gone on a tear of late, pumping in 25 or more points in four of his last six outings, including a career-high 28 against UT Martin on Jan. 2...The senior guard leads the league with 27 steals and also ranks second in scoring (18.3 ppg) and free throw shooting percentage (83.7%) and ninth in field goal shooting (41.9%) and made 3-point average (1.7 pg).

TREY-RIFFIC: Three OVC players account for four of the nation's top single-game 3-point shooting percentages through contests of Jan. 2...Eastern Illinois' **Josh Gomes**, Samford's **J. Robert Merritt** and Tennessee State's **Wayne Arnold** have each posted a 7-for-8 (87.5%) performance from behind the arc, with Arnold boasting two such efforts...Merritt is also among a trio of OVC players who rank among the nation's best in single-game shooting percentages overall, tying for third with his 12-of-13 (92.4%) performance against Campbellsville...Tennessee Tech's **Derek Stribling** is tied for first (100%, 10-10) in that category while Murray State's **Shawn Witherspoon** is tied for 13th (83.3%, 10-12).

STREAKING: After opening Conference play with a narrow 62-61 loss to in-state rival **Jacksonville State**, **Samford** has reeled off five straight OVC victories and currently sits tied with **Murray State** atop the league standings at 5-1 each...The Bulldogs have won six in a row overall, tying for the nation's 11th-best active win streak...Meanwhile **Austin Peay** boasts an 11-game home win streak that is tied for 14th nationally...The Govs haven't lost in the Dunn Center since a 67-63 setback to **Eastern Kentucky** on Jan. 13, 2005.

RECORDS WATCH: Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** has climbed into the OVC's top ten list for all-time assists, ranking ninth with 473 handouts...Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is currently seventh with 553 assists, just 146 shy of the OVC record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81)...Witt is also listed among the league's all-time leaders in 3-point shooting, currently ranking ninth in trey attempts (608) and tied for 10th in made 3-pointers (215).

ON THE TUBE: The fifth of eight ESPNU contests in the 2005-06 OVC television package hits the airwaves on Jan. 12 as **Murray State** plays host to **Austin Peay**...Calling Monday's action will be **Larry Conley** and **Dave Weekley**.
