## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

**JEREMY KELLY • G, SR., 6-5, 205 • LOUISVILLE, KY • UT MARTIN**

Kelly pumped in 31 points in a season-opening Murray State loss to Louisville on Saturday. Playing in front of the hometown crowd, the Louisville, Ky., native helped the Skyhawks enjoy an early lead against the seventh-ranked Cardinals, scoring 15 points in the first half. A senior guard, Kelly played 39 of 40 minutes in the contest, hitting five 3-pointers and going 8-of-16 from the field while also shooting 10-of-13 from the free throw line and tying for a team-high with nine rebounds.

### NEWCOMER

**BELTON RIVERS • G, JR., 6-4, 170 • ATLANTA, GA • TENNESSEE TECH**

Rivers posted a 14.0 scoring average to lead Tennessee Tech to a 1-1 record in the Golden Eagles' first weekend of action. A native of Atlanta, Ga., Rivers registered his best outing in a 90-62 rout of Oregon State, going 8-of-11 from the field, including 5-of-5 from behind the arc, for 22 points. The junior transfer from East Carolina also nailed a pair of treys in Tech's season-opening loss to Dayton, finishing the week with a 58.3 conversion rate from 3-point range as part of a 10-of-18 effort from the field overall. He also had five rebounds, four assists and a steal for the week.

### FRESHMAN

**MIKE ROSE • G, FR., 6-3, 185 • NAPERVILLE, IL • EASTERN KENTUCKY**

Rose averaged 16.0 points as Eastern Kentucky opened the season with a 1-1 mark at the 2005 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam. The freshman guard tallied a game-high 18 points in his collegiate debut in the Colonels' 67-60 win over Norfolk State, then added 14 points and seven rebounds in a double-overtime loss to Wisconsin. A native of Naperville, Ill., Rose finished the week with nine rebounds, four assists and four steals while converting 11-of-16 field goal attempts (68.8%), including five 3-pointers.

## AROUND THE OVC...

**AUSTIN PEAY (0-2 overall; 0-0 OVC):** A young Austin Peay squad lost its season opener for the first time in four years, dropping an 83-54 decision on the road to Western Kentucky...The Govs also fell to Rutgers, 66-46, in first-round action of the South Padre Island Invitational to start 0-2 for the first time since the 2001-02 season...Senior C **Zac Schlader** played all 40 minutes against both WKU and Rutgers, finishing with 22 points and 11 rebounds for the week...After being held to eight points against the Hilltoppers, senior G **Maurice Hampton** doubled that with a team-high 16 points at Rutgers...Sophomore guards **Derek Wright** and **Todd Babington** have earned early spots in the starting rotation after turning in solid freshman campaigns a year ago...APSU visits Kent State on Tuesday before traveling to South Padre Island, Texas over the Thanksgiving holiday to continue tourney action against Delaware State on Friday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** The **Mike Miller** era got off to a rocky start as Eastern Illinois fell to host Xavier, 80-35, on Saturday...Miller is in his first year at the helm of the Panther program after serving the past five years as associate head coach at Kansas State...EIU shot just 18.4 percent from the field (9-of-49) against the Musketeers, setting a school record for lowest shooting percentage while also recording the program's fewest points ever at the Division I level...The Panthers converted just 2-of-15 three-point attempts and were also outrebounded 44-30...Senior G **Josh Gomes** was the only EIU player in double figures with 11 points...Gomes and reserve **Jake Sinclair** are the lone returning upperclassmen from the 2004-05 squad as three freshmen, six sophomores and junior transfer **Ross Laux** round out the Panthers' roster in '05-06... EIU plays the second of three consecutive road games Tuesday at Saint Louis.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky kicked off the **Jeff Neubauer** era with a trip to the U.S. Virgin Islands for the 2005 Paradise Jam...The Colonels got off to a 1-1 start in tourney play, dropping a 95-89 overtime decision to Wisconsin on Saturday before handing Neubauer his first victory as a collegiate head coach with a 67-60 win Sunday over Norfolk State...Senior G **Matt Witt** moved into 12th place on the school's all-time scoring list, netting a team-high 25 points against the Badgers while connecting on 6-of-10 three-pointers...He finished the week averaging 19.0 points while shooting 41.9 percent from the field (13-of-31), including going 8-of-17 from 3-point range...Freshman G **Mike Rose** tossed in 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds in his collegiate debut versus Wisconsin, then netted a game-high 18 points against NSU...He shot 68.8 percent from the field over the two games (11-of-16) while also averaging 4.5 rebounds...EKU plays Georgia in Monday's consolation finals.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (0-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State fell to host Vanderbilt, 67-46, in its season opener on Friday... The contest marked the third time in the last seven seasons JSU has opened the year against a squad from the Southeastern Conference...Jax State has now lost 10 straight on their opponents' home courts, dating back to Dec. 29, 2004...Senior G **B.J. Spencer** was the lone Gamecock in double figures at Vandy, going 7-of-14 from the field for 16 points...JSU shot 45.8 percent in the opening half, compared to a 38.5 percent effort by the Commodores, and only trailed by four at the break (31-27) before Vandy turned up the heat over the final 20 minutes, shooting a sizzling 63.6 percent from the field to pull away for the win...Junior transfer **Courtney Bradley** had nine points in his Gamecock debut...JSU kicks off the home portion of its schedule on Monday versus Coastal Carolina.

**MOREHEAD STATE (1-0 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State topped the century mark in a season-opening 123-83 rout of Kentucky Christian...Junior transfer **Shaun Williams** torched the nets for 32 points in his Eagle debut, hitting 14-of-21 shots from the field (66.7%) and all four free throws...All five starters shot better than 58 percent from the field to lead the Eagles to a 61.4 team percentage...Freshman G **Tyke Cockerham** took over point guard duties for an injured **Quinton Smith** and responded with his first collegiate double-double (18 points/11 assists)...Smith, recovering from eye and wrist injuries, should be available for the Eagles' upcoming road contests at Dayton and Texas Tech...The team's only other returnee, senior F **Cory Burns**, also missed the KCC game and will sit out this week's action as well with a shoulder injury...The Eagles visit Dayton on Wednesday and Tech on Saturday.

**MURRAY STATE (0-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Murray State dropped a tough 79-75 overtime decision to host Cincinnati on Saturday, snapping the Racers' 11-game winning streak in season openers...After trailing by two at the break (35-33), MSU took the lead with 13:30 left to play in regulation and held it until the overtime period...OVC Preseason Player of the Year **Trey Pearson** went 8-of-8 at the free throw line and led the team with 18 points while junior F **Shawn Witherspoon** turned in his second career double-double (12 points/12 rebounds)...Cincinnati native **Justin Orr** added 13 points on 6-of-11 field shooting in front of the hometown crowd...Neither team shot the ball particularly well as the Racers managed just a 38.6% effort to Cincy's 39.4%... Ranked No. 21 in the preseason *CollegeInsider.com* poll, Murray State kicks off the home portion of its schedule on Wednesday against Campbellsville.

**SAMFORD (1-2 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Samford opened the 2005-06 campaign against some challenging opponents, posting a 52-49 win over Sacramento State before falling to top-10 teams Texas (77-33) and Oklahoma (68-41)...The Bulldogs' outings with SSU and Texas were part of the 2005 Guardians of the Game Classic...The No. 2 Longhorns were the highest-ranked opponent ever played by a Samford squad...Senior F **J. Robert Merritt** led the Bulldogs' offensive efforts in two of the three contests, finishing the week with a 12.0 scoring average and 17 rebounds...Samford's perimeter shooting, which ranked second in the nation a year ago (41.9%), never got on track last week as the Bulldogs shot a lackluster 25.4 percent from 3-point range (16-of-63) over the three contests...Against SSU and Texas, sophomore C **Travis Peterson** was the lone bright spot in Samford's struggling perimeter game as he went 7-of-9 from behind the arc while contributing 23 points...The Bulldogs tip off their home slate on Saturday against Bryan College.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (1-0 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri rallied for a 59-56 win over Truman State in its season opener...Montana transfer **Roy Booker** hit the game-winning 3-pointer with two seconds remaining to cap off a game-high 17-point effort in his Redhawk debut...He also pulled down eight rebounds...Junior college transfer **David Johnson**, sidelined for the Redhawks' two exhibition contests with a sprained thumb, added 11 points off the bench...Senior F/C **Ketshner Guerrier** saw his first regular-season action after sitting out most of the 2004-05 campaign with a knee injury...He collected eight points and five boards before fouling out...Southeast opens its home slate on Monday against IPFW, then hits the road for a Thanksgiving Day outing at South Dakota State and a Sunday meeting with Nebraska.

## AROUND THE OVC...

**UT MARTIN (0-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** UT Martin opened the season with a 78-61 loss at No. 7 Louisville...The Skyhawks enjoyed an early lead and managed to stay within striking distance for most of the contest, trailing by only eight points with 6:56 left to play before the Cardinals put the game away...Louisville native **Jeremy Kelly**, who is working his way back into the starting lineup after sitting out the 2004-05 season, exploded for 31 points on 8-of-16 field shooting in front of the hometown crowd...He hit five 3-pointers in the contest and went 10-of-13 at the charity stripe while also clearing nine rebounds...Senior G/F **Jared Newson** was the only other Skyhawk to score in double figures, tossing in 14 points and grabbing six caroms...The Cardinals are one of two 2005 Final Four squads on the Skyhawks' schedule this season...UT Martin tips off the home side of its slate on Saturday versus Webster.

**TENNESSEE STATE (0-0 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee State begins the 2005-06 campaign on Monday at home against in-town rival Fisk, looking for its second straight win over the Bulldogs...Returning to lead the Tigers in their third season under the direction of head coach **Cy Alexander** are junior guard **Bruce Price** and seniors **Wayne Arnold** and **Kareem Grant**...TSU rolled to exhibition wins over Carson-Newman and Trevecca...Arnold should be at full strength after missing the Trevecca contest with a thumb injury....Following Monday's contest, the Tigers are off until a Dec. 8 OVC meeting at Southeast Missouri.

**TENNESSEE TECH (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech split its first two outings of the 2005-06 campaign, dropping an 81-60 road decision to Dayton before staging a 90-62 rout of Oregon State in the Golden Eagles' home opener...Senior F **Derek Stribling** led the team in nearly every category versus the Flyers, finishing with 16 points and six rebounds...He followed that with 11 points on 5-of-10 shooting against OSU...East Carolina transfer **Belton Rivers** went 5-of-5 from behind the arc en route to a team-high 22 points versus the Beavers...Six Tech players reached double figures in the OSU contest while leading the squad to a 60.7 percent shooting performance, including a school- and OVC-record 9-of-10 effort from three-point range...Tech continues its four-game homestand on Tuesday vs. Bluefield College.

**BUSTIN' BRACKETS:** For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event. Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year record of 1-2, with first-year participant Murray State earning a 69-63 victory over host Rice last season. Austin Peay will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearance.

**ON THE TUBE:** The Ohio Valley Conference will have at least 12 men's basketball games televised during the upcoming 2005-06 season. ESPN2 will carry two those games, a Jan. 28 regular-season matchup between **Murray State** and **Southeast Missouri**, and the OVC Men's Tournament championship contest on March 4. Additionally, the OVC will participate in the first full season of television coverage on ESPNU, airing eight regular-season contests as well as both semifinal games in the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Men's Basketball Tournament.

**EVERYBODY PLAYS TWICE:** Effective with the 2005-06 season, the OVC schedule will consist of a 20-game, double round-robin format with each member institution playing a home-and-home series against the other 10 schools. This marks the highest number of Conference games every to be played in the 58-year history of the league, with the previous high being an 18-game schedule played from 1996-00.

**RACERS AND VOLS AT THE GEC:** The Nov. 30 contest between **Murray State** and Southeastern Conference opponent Tennessee will take place at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in Nashville, Tenn., site of the 2006 O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Tournament.

**SUTTON UPDATE:** Tennessee Tech head coach **Mike Sutton** continues his recovery after being stricken this past April with Guillain-Barre Syndrome, an inflammatory disorder of the peripheral nerves that causes paralysis. The timetable for the fourth-year skipper's return to the court is uncertain as he continues a rigorous physical rehabilitation schedule at Cookeville Regional Medical Center. In Sutton's absence, associate head coach **Steve Payne** is handling the day-to-day duties.

**WELLS ON THE BENCH:** A familiar face returns to Austin Peay as former Governor standout **Bubba Wells** begins his first season as an assistant coach on **Dave Loos'** staff. Wells enjoyed a successful collegiate career in which he was a three-time All-OVC selection, two-time OVC Male Athlete of the Year and the 1996-97 OVC Player of the Year. A 1997 second-round NBA draft pick by the Dallas Mavericks, Wells spent the past eight years playing at the professional level, the last two of which were with the Harlem Globetrotters.

**TOP SCORERS RETURN:** Eight of the OVC's top 15 scorers from a year ago return in 2005-06. Back are Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** (16.8 ppg), Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt** (16.5 ppg), UT Martin guard/forward **Jared Newson** (15.4 ppg), Austin Peay guard **Maurice Hampton** (14.7 ppg), Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** (14.5 ppg), Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** (14.5 ppg), Eastern Kentucky guard **Matt Witt** (14.4 ppg) and Tennessee State guard **Bruce Price** (13.7 ppg).

**DISHING IT OUT:** Nine of the OVC's top 10 assist men from last season are back for 2005-06, including at least one player who will finish his career ranked among the league's all-time leaders for handouts. Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is ranked eighth in the OVC in career assists with 504, just under 200 ticks shy of the all-time record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81). Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** lurks outside the OVC's top 10 all-time list with 398 assists after leading the league for each of the last two years, ranking fourth nationally a year ago (7.3 apg) while dishing out a school-record 211 handouts.

**ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES:** The 2004-05 All-OVC teams were laden with senior veterans and as a result, only four of the 10 players who earned all-Conference recognition a year ago are back again this season. Returning from the All-OVC first team is Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** and Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt**, while Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** and Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** are back after capturing All-OVC second team honors last season. In addition, Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** returns to the hardwood after garnering the OVC Freshman of the Year award in 2004-05.
