OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

ROY BOOKER • G, SR., 6-3, 205 • PORTAGEVILLE, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Booker extended his season-opening streak of double-figure scoring games to four, averaging 20.0 points in a trio of outings last week. The senior guard opened with 25 points in a 65-64 loss to IPFW, then tossed in 12 in a 75-68 win at South Dakota State. In a 69-54 loss to Nebraska, the Portageville, Mo., native capped off the week with 23 points and 11 rebounds for his first double-double as a Redhawk. In addition to his scoring contributions, Booker finished the week with 16 rebounds, six assists and five steals.

NEWCOMER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, JR., 6-5, 215 • UTICA, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley netted his first career double-double in Jacksonville State's 82-71 win over Coastal Carolina with career-highs of 17 points and 14 rebounds. A junior forward from Utica, Miss., Bradley was a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw while also going 5-of-11 from the field (45.5%), blocking a shot and grabbing three steals.

FRESHMAN

MIKE ROSE • G, FR., 6-3, 185 • NAPERVILLE, IL • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Rose picks up his second OVC Freshman of the Week honor after helping to lead Eastern Kentucky's scoring efforts in outings against Southeastern Conference foes Georgia and Tennessee. The rookie guard from Naperville, Ill., netted 12 points in a 76-68 loss to Georgia at the Paradise Jam, then had a team-high 13 points in his first career start at Tennessee. For the week, Rose shot 58.8 percent from the field (10-of-17) while also netting one assist and a steal.

2005-06 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (2-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay completed its participation in the South Padre Island Invitational with a 2-2 record, losing a 94-67 decision to Kent State before wrapping up tourney play with back-to-back wins over Delaware State (57-51) and Texas Southern (82-70 in OT)...The nine-day odyssey took the Governors to New Jersey, Ohio and Texas...After being outrebounded by a 15.7 margin over each of its first three games, APSU finally won the battle of the boards against DSU, 33-30...Senior C **Zac Schlader** netted his first double-double of the season (14 pts./11 reb.) against Texas Southern and was named to the all-tournament team after averaging 17.7 points and 6.7 rebounds in tourney play...Sophomore G **Todd Babington** set career-bests with 20 points and six 3-pointers in the TSU contest...The Govs kick off the OVC portion of their schedule with a Dec. 1 trip to Tennessee Tech.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois fell to Saint Louis, 69-45, in the second outing of a three-game road stretch...The Panthers held an early 17-10 lead but a long scoring drought allowed the Billikens to build a 30-19 lead en route to the victory...Freshman G **Mike Robinson** canned four 3-pointers to lead EIU with 16 points...Senior G **Josh Gomes** sits 34 points shy of tallying 1,000 for his career after tapping in 12 points against the Billikens...After starting the season-opener against Xavier, sophomore G **Bobby Catchings** came off the bench for a team-high seven rebounds at SLU...The Panthers close out their season-opening road trip Tuesday at Western Illinois, then kick off the home portion of their schedule on Saturday against Indiana State.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky closed out its trip to the U.S. Virgin Islands with a 76-68 loss to Georgia to finish fourth in the Paradise Jam...The Colonels also lost a 92-58 meeting at Tennessee...Senior F **Alonzo Hird** was named to the all-tournament team after falling one rebound shy of a double-double against the Bulldogs (12 pts./9 reb.)...Four games into the season, Hird is torching the nets for a league-high 72.4 shooting percentage (21-of-29) from the field...Freshman G **Mike Rose** earned his first collegiate start in the UT contest, responding with a team-high 13 points...The Colonels open up the home portion of their schedule this week against West Virginia and Western Kentucky on Monday and Saturday, respectively...EKU has won seven consecutive home openers and also enters Monday's game with a seven-game home win streak after going 12-1 in McBrayer Arena last season.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State rallied from a 14-point second-half deficit to stage a 82-71 victory over Coastal Carolina last week...The Gamecocks limited the Chanticleers to 25 points in the final 20 minutes while improving their record in home openers to 28-4...Junior F **Courtney Bradley** netted his first career double-double (17 pts./14 reb.), going 7-of-7 from the free throw line and 5-of-8 from the field...His point and rebound totals marked career-highs...Bradley and senior G **Walker Russell** are each a perfect 8-of-8 from the free throw line thus far in 2005-06...Russell is also shooting 57.1 percent from behind the arc (4-of-7) to rank among Conference leaders...Freshman point guard **DeAndre Bray** came off the bench to dish out seven assists in 32 minutes of play...After a nine-day break, JSU wraps up its three-game homestand against Tennessee Temple on Dec. 1 and Delaware State on Dec. 5.

MOREHEAD STATE (1-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Morehead State went 0-2 on its road trip over the Thanksgiving break, falling to Dayton (67-41) and Texas Tech (76-42)...Junior college transfer **Shaun Williams** scored a game-high 15 points at Dayton, finishing with a 12.5 scoring average for the two contests...Williams is the early scoring leader for the Eagles, averaging 19.7 points while ranking among OVC leaders with a 56.5 shooting percent from the field (26-of-46)...Through three starts, freshman G **Tyke Cockerham** has just four turnovers and leads the team with 13 assists and seven steals, ranking second in the OVC in assist/turnover margin (+3.25)...He joined Williams as the only Eagles in double-figure scoring at TTU with 11 points...Morehead State returns home to host Maryland-Eastern Shore on Saturday...The Eagles knocked off UMES, 62-45, last season and lead the series, 5-1.

MURRAY STATE (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Murray State won its 16th straight home opener, defeating Campbellsville, 76-51...The Racers haven't lost a home opener since opening the 1989-90 campaign with a setback to Southern Illinois...Four players scored in double figures, led by senior G **Trey Pearson's** 21 points...Pearson had five 3-pointers in the game, the sixth time he has matched that feat during his career...After going 0-of-6 in the first half of a season-opening loss to Cincinnati, Pearson has hit 12-of-18 from the field for 32 points over the last three 20-minute periods...Senior C **Pearson Griffith** left the game with an ankle injury but is expected to be ready for the Racers' Nov. 30 meeting with Tennessee at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in Nashville...The Racers will be looking for their first win over an SEC opponent since a 1997 victory against Arkansas...Following Wednesday's contest, Murray State travels to Texas-San Antonio for a Dec. 3 date.

SAMFORD (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Samford cruised to a 96-45 win over visiting Bryan College in the Bulldogs' home opener...The team's 96 points and 51-point margin of victory were the most since the 1999-2000 season...After struggling with poor rebounding and shooting in earlier road losses to Texas and Oklahoma, the Bulldogs found their stroke against the Lions, hitting a blistering 66.1 percent from the field (37-of-56), including going 15-of-24 from 3-point range (62.5%), while posting a 32-19 advantage on the glass...Senior F **J. Robert Merritt** led six Bulldogs in double-figure scoring with a game-high 18 points...He has reached double figures in 21 of his last 22 games...Freshman G **Jason Black** tossed in a season-high 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting in 18 minutes of action off the bench...Samford returns to the road, visiting Southern Miss on Monday and South Alabama on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri sits at .500 after a 1-2 effort last week, picking up a 75-68 road win over South Dakota State while falling to IPFW (65-64) and Nebraska (69-54)...After sitting out last season following his transfer from Montana, senior G **Roy Booker** is off to a fast start for the Redhawks, averaging 19.3 points and 6.0 rebounds through four games...Last week, he led the team with 60 points and 16 rebounds, extending his season-opening streak of double-figure scoring to four games and also recording his first double-double as a Redhawk with 23 points and 11 rebounds against the Cornhuskers...Senior F/C **Ketschner Guerrier** also notched his first double-dip of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds earlier in the week against IPFW...Junior college transfer **David Johnson** led the team with 16 points and seven boards at SDSU, but is questionable for this week due to a medical condition that limited his playing time at Nebraska...Southeast tips off Conference play on Saturday with a visit to UT Martin.

AROUND THE OVC...

UT MARTIN (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): UT Martin picked up its first win of the 2005-06 campaign with a 94-72 rout of Webster University...Senior G/F **Jared Newson** sits 143 points shy of hitting 1,000 for his career after leading the Skyhawks with game-highs of 23 points and eight rebounds...Newson and senior G **Jeremy Kelly** combined for 19 of the team's 38 field goal attempts as the Skyhawks finished with a 58.5 percent effort on the night (38-of-65)...Kelly had 21 points and a game-high seven assists, while senior G **Aaron Ferrell** blocked four shots...Senior C **Jason Thompson** recorded his first double-double of the season (10 pts./10 reb.)...Head coach **Bret Campbell** is 7-0 in home openers during his tenure at UT Martin...After entertaining Arkansas State on Thursday, the Skyhawks continue their five-game homestand and kick off OVC action with a Dec. 3 date against Southeast Missouri.

TENNESSEE STATE (1-0 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State registered a season-opening 72-63 win over in-town rival Fisk...TSU built as much as a 21-point lead in the first half, only to watch Fisk pull even down the stretch...Free throw shooting saved the Tigers, who finished the game with a 37-of-55 (67.3%) effort at the stripe after being held without a field goal for more than 12 minutes the second half...The two squads combined for 64 fouls and 86 trips to the free throw line...Junior G **Bruce Price** went just 2-of-8 from the field but hit 20-of-26 foul shots to finish with a game-high 25 points...He also dished out five assists and grabbed four steals...In his first game as a Tiger, junior college transfer **Clarence Matthews** contributed 16 points, two blocked shots and a team-high nine rebounds...TSU is off until beginning OVC play with a Dec. 8 trip to Southeast Missouri.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech picked up its second straight win of the 2005-06 season with a 117-85 thrashing of Bluefield College...Senior F **Derek Stribling** was a perfect 10-of-10 from the field, including a pair of 3-pointers, to lead the Golden Eagles with 22 points...He also had six rebounds, four steals and five assists...In three games, Stribling has dished out 12 assists while committing just two turnovers for a league-leading 6.0 assist/turnover ratio...Junior G **Belton Rivers** added 13 points off the bench...Junior F **Antjuan Koger** led all Tech reserves with a career-high 21 points, including a 10-of-11 effort at the free throw line...Junior F **Francis Kabore** just missed out on a double-double, tallying 10 points and eight boards...The Golden Eagles wrap up their four-game homestand against Wisconsin-Milwaukee on Monday and Austin Peay on Thursday, the latter of which kicks off Tech's OVC schedule.

RACERS AND VOLS AT THE GEC: The Nov. 30 contest between **Murray State** and Southeastern Conference opponent Tennessee will take place at the Gaylord Entertainment Center in Nashville, Tenn., site of the 2006 O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Tournament.

RACE FOR OVC CROWN BEGINS: Due to the league's new 20-game Conference schedule, the race for the 2005-06 OVC title gets off to an early start this season. For the first time in recent memory, league action will get underway in December, with **Austin Peay** and **Tennessee Tech** kicking things off on Thursday, Dec. 1, followed by a **Southeast Missouri-UT Martin** matchup on Saturday, Dec. 3. The 20-game schedule marks the most Conference games ever to be played in the 58-year history of the league, with the previous high being an 18-game schedule played from 1996-00.

BUSTIN' BRACKETS: For the first time since its inception in 2003, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference institutions will compete to take part in ESPN's Bracket Buster Saturday Series event. Over the past two years, the OVC has posted a two-year record of 1-2, with first-year participant Murray State earning a 69-63 victory over host Rice last season. Austin Peay will be included in the event for the third straight year, while the remaining nine OVC institutions will be making their first appearance.

ON THE TUBE: The Ohio Valley Conference will have at least 12 men's basketball games televised during the upcoming 2005-06 season. ESPN2 will carry two those games, a Jan. 28 regular-season matchup between **Murray State** and **Southeast Missouri**, and the OVC Men's Tournament championship contest on March 4. Additionally, the OVC will participate in the first full season of television coverage on ESPNU, airing eight regular-season contests as well as both semifinal games in the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Men's Basketball Tournament.

TOP SCORERS RETURN: Eight of the OVC's top 15 scorers from a year ago return in 2005-06. Back are Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** (16.8 ppg), Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt** (16.5 ppg), UT Martin guard/forward **Jared Newson** (15.4 ppg), Austin Peay guard **Maurice Hampton** (14.7 ppg), Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** (14.5 ppg), Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** (14.5 ppg), Eastern Kentucky guard **Matt Witt** (14.4 ppg) and Tennessee State guard **Bruce Price** (13.7 ppg).

DISHING IT OUT: Nine of the OVC's top 10 assist men from last season are back for 2005-06, including at least one player who will finish his career ranked among the league's all-time leaders for handouts. Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Matt Witt** is ranked eighth in the OVC in career assists with 504, just under 200 tics shy of the all-time record of 699, set by former Colonel standout Bruce Jones (1977-81). Jacksonville State senior guard **Walker Russell** lurks outside the OVC's top 10 all-time list with 398 assists after leading the league for each of the last two years, ranking fourth nationally a year ago (7.3 apg) while dishing out a school-record 211 handouts.

ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNEES: The 2004-05 All-OVC teams were laden with senior veterans and as a result, only four of the 10 players who earned all-Conference recognition a year ago are back again this season. Returning from the All-OVC first team is Murray State guard **Trey Pearson** and Samford forward **J. Robert Merritt**, while Eastern Illinois guard **Josh Gomes** and Jacksonville State guard **Walker Russell** are back after capturing All-OVC second team honors last season. In addition, Eastern Illinois sophomore center **George Tandy** returns to the hardwood after garnering the OVC Freshman of the Year award in 2004-05.
