THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-PLAYER

Anthony Ottrando, INF • So., 5-11, 185 • Ocala, Fla. • Eastern Kentucky

Ottrando hit .533 (8-for-15) with five runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in four games last week. By collecting eight hits, Ottrando raised his batting average to .350 on the season, which is 14th in the Conference. He was 2-for-3 with four RBI in the Colonels non-conference win over Western Kentucky during the week. In the team's Conference series at UT Martin, he was 2-for-5 with two runs and a grand slam in game one, 2-for-3 with two runs and a three-run shot in game two and 2-for-4 in the finale.

CO-PLAYER

Steven Leach, INF • Jr., 6-2, 195 • Decatur, Ala. • Jacksonville State

Leach hit an impressive .778 (7-for-9) with five runs scored, a home run and six RBI in three games last week as Jacksonville State swept an OVC series from Southeast Missouri over the weekend. In doing so Leach raised his batting average by 34 points (to a team-high .367) and helped JSU pull to within half of a game of Samford's OVC lead. Leach was 3-for-3 in Jax State's 16-6 game one victory and followed that by a 1-for-3 performance in game two of that doubleheader. In JSU's 9-6 victory on Sunday, Leach was 3-for-3 with a three-run home run and four RBI. Leach, who has a current eight-game hitting streak, also drew five walks during the week and had a 1.111 slugging percentage and .857 on-base percentage.

PITCHER

Nick Hetland, RHP • Sr., 6-3, 215 • Apple Valley, Minn. • Jacksonville State

Hetland had his best outing of the season for Jacksonville State, pitching 6.1 innings of relief in the Gamecocks 16-6 victory over Southeast Missouri on Saturday. Taking over for the starter in the second inning Hetland limited one of the OVC's top hitting teams to just two singles during his stint. He also struck out a career-high seven in the outing and walked only one.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (15-18, 5-7 OVC): Austin Peay had a tough week, losing all five of its games overall. The Governors played a pair of SEC teams during the week, losing a slugfest (16-13) at Tennessee and falling 8-1 to No. 13 Vanderbilt. The week ended with three losses to OVC-leader Samford and APSU fell to 5-7 overall in OVC play. If the OVC Tournament would be this week APSU, the defending champions, would be on the outside looking in, as they are currently in seventh place in the standings. Matt Kole hit .400 (8-for-20) with five runs, five doubles and two RBI in five games. Trey Lucas and Will Hogue each hit a home run and drove in three runs for the Governors. Austin Peay will look to end its losing streak this week when they host Belmont on Tuesday and then play at Middle Tennessee on Wednesday. The Gobs will host Tennessee Tech in a weekend OVC series.

Eastern Illinois (16-15, 8-4 OVC): Eastern Illinois continued its hot stretch, winning two of four games last week, including winning the Murray State series to improve to 8-4 in the OVC, which places them in third place overall, just a game and a half out of first place. Overall the Panthers have won 13 of their last 19 games entering this week. Sophomore OF Curt Restko hit .353 (6-for-17, including 5-for-12 in the MSU series) last week with five runs scored and three RBI. Restko, who is the toughest player statistical in the OVC to strike out, fanned just once in 18 plate appearances last week. Freshman hurler Josh Mueller struck out nine batters in just six innings last week, as he allowed only one run and picked up a win over the Thoroughbreds. The only run he surrendered was a one-out solo home run in the sixth inning. This year Mueller has struck out 34 in just 26 innings of OVC play. Jordan Kreke hit a three-run home run in the third inning of EIU's victory on Sunday. Following a half-hour rain delay Zach Skidmore also homered, marking the first time since May 2005 that the Panthers had hit back-to-back home runs. Eastern's bullpen trio of Tyler Brandon, Mike Recchia and Brian Morrell were not charged a run in a combined 11 innings of work. This week Eastern Illinois will play Illinois at a neutral site in Mattoon, Ill. then travel to Saint Louis University. The weekend series at home (where the team is 8-2 on the year) against Jacksonville State will pit the second and third place teams in the OVC standings.

Eastern Kentucky (15-14-1, 7-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky turned in a 3-1 overall record last week to go above .500 on the season and 7-5 in OVC play. That 7-5 record puts the Colonels into a tie for fourth place in the Conference standings. Sophomore infielder Anthony Ottrando was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after hitting .533 (8-for-15) with five runs, two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI. That performance raised his batting average to .350 on the season, a mark that is 14th overall in the Conference. He was 2-for-3 with four RBI in the win over WKU and had multiple hits in each of the games with UT Martin, including a grand slam in game one and a three-run blast in game two. Lefty hurler Christian Friedrich picked up his fourth victory of the season by pitching six innings and allowing five hits, walking two and striking out six against UT Martin. Friedrich now has a 1.95 ERA and has struck out 71 in 50.2 innings of work. This week the Colonels will host Marshall in a doubleheader and then host Murray State in a Conference series.

Jacksonville State (16-16, 9-3 OVC): Jacksonville State played only a three-game Conference series, as they swept Southeast Missouri at home to improve to 9-3 in Conference play, which puts them just a half of a game out of first place Samford in the standings. It marked the team's first Conference sweep of the season and marked the teams seventh straight OVC series win, a streak that dates back to last season. The Gamecocks, who are now at .500 for the first time this season, are 9-1 in one-run games this season. Sophomore infielder Steven Leach was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after hitting .778 (7-for-9) with five runs, a home run and six RBI. Leach raised his batting average 34 points (to a team-best .367) during the week and had a 1.111 slugging percentage and .857 on-base percentage during the week. Senior pitcher Nick Hetland was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after pitching 6.1 innings of relief and limited the Redhawks to just two hits while striking out a career-high seven. After entering the game in the second inning, Hetland gave up just two singles and walked one during his stint on the mound. Hetland leads JUS with a 2.79 ERA and 23 strikeouts (vs. only two walks) in OVC games this season. After batting just .230 to open Conference play, JSU has now raised its team batting average to .274. The Gamecocks have four players hitting .400 or better in OVC games this season, led by Clay Whittemore (.444) and Bert Smith (.440). Smith has a nine-game hitting streak this season and has hit safely in all 12 OVC games this year and 20-straight OVC games dating back to last year. This week JSU plays at Troy and hosts Alabama State before hitting the road for a weekend series at Eastern Illinois.

Morehead State (12-20, 3-9 OVC): Morehead State had one of its best weeks of the season, winning four of its five games to improve to 12-20 overall and 3-9 in the OVC. The Eagles topped Marshall and Alice Lloyd in non-conference play and then went to Tennessee Tech and won two of three from the Golden Eagles, winning an OVC series for the first time under first-year head coach Jay Sorg. Senior OF Eric Allen hit .333 (6-for-18) with nine runs, two doubles, three home runs and seven RBI in five games last week. Allen had a .944 slugging percentage and a .478 on-base percentage and hit a home run against each of the Eagles three opponents. Junior pitcher Matt Clark pitched seven innings, scattering six hits (all singles) and striking out three in his team's 6-3 victory over Tech on Sunday. Senior 1B Marc Midden had four RBI in Sunday's series finale with TTU. This week the team will make-up some games that were postponed earlier this season due to poor weather. MSU will play at nationally-ranked Kentucky on Wednesday and then host

Last season the Austin Peay Governors won the championship by defeating Jacksonville State 3-2 in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

Georgetown (Ky.) College on Thursday. The Eagles will then host UT Martin for a three-game weekend OVC series.

Murray State (12-17, 3-8 OVC): Murray State dropped a pair of non-conference games last week - at Southern Illinois and home against Evansville - before they hosted Eastern Illinois for a weekend series. EIU, who is now in third place in the Conference standings, took two of three from the Thoroughbreds as MSU fell to 3-8 in OVC play. Following a 6-5 loss to Evansville, Murray State is now 4-9 in one-run games this season. Daniel Calhoun tossed a complete game victory in game two of the EIU series; it marked the fourth straight week that Murray State has tossed a complete game in a Conference series. Overall, Calhoun has two complete games in 2008 while Chris Craycraft has added three. This week Murray State will host Memphis and play at Arkansas State in non-conference play and then travel to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game weekend series.

Samford (21-11, 9-2 OVC): Samford, who has won 15 of its last 20 games overall, remained one of the hottest teams in the OVC by winning four of its five games last week. The Bulldogs topped Troy 4-3 in 11 innings and fell to UAB 10-6 in non-conference play before sweeping defending OVC Austin Peay over the weekend. Samford is now 9-2 overall in the OVC which puts them half of a game up on Jacksonville State in the OVC standings. Michael Rutledge hit .438 (7-for-16) with three runs scored, a home run, three RBI and two stolen bases in five games. He hit .600 (6-for-10) against Austin Peay, a series in which he slugged .900 and had a .636 on-base percentage. Junior pitcher Jonathan Stephens improved to 5-0 on the season by pitching his third complete game of the season on Saturday. Stephens went nine innings and scattered six hits and struck out six without walking a batter in Samford's 5-3 victory. Stephens now has a 2.51 ERA (a mark that is third in the OVC) in 57.1 innings of work this season. Samford compiled a 4-0 mark at home this week and are now 16-2 overall at J.L. Griffin Field in 2008. This week the Bulldogs will host Mercer and travel to Troy in non-conference action and then play at Southeast Missouri over the weekend.

Southeast Missouri (14-14, 5-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri opened the week with a 11-4 victory over regional rival Southern Illinois and then dropped a 8-3 home decision to Arkansas State. The Redhawks traveled to Jacksonville State for an OVC series and were swept by the Gamecocks to fall to 5-5 overall in OVC play, which puts them into sixth place in the Conference standings. Sophomore catcher Jim Klocke led the way by hitting .500 (10-for-20) for the week with a double, home run and five RBI. OF Tyrell Cummings hit at a .435 (10-for-23) clip, including three doubles and four RBI. Tony Spencer was stole a pair of bases and as a team Southeast Missouri was 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts. This week might prove to be very important for the Redhawks who will play at Southern Illinois mid-week. This weekend they will host league-leading Samford for a three-game series.

Tennessee Tech (25-10-1, 7-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech compiled a 3-2 overall record last week, sweeping a non-conference doubleheader from Berea (Ky.) College and then winning the first game of an OVC series with Morehead State (9-5) before dropping the final two (3-2, 6-2). The Golden Eagles are now 7-5 overall in the OVC, which puts them in a tie for fourth place with Eastern Kentucky. Overall Tech's 25 wins on the season is the most of any OVC school, four more than Samford. Freshman A.J. Kirby-Jones picked up the save in Saturday's first game with MSU, pitching the final two innings and allowing just one batter to reach base. He has two of the team's seven saves on the season. Kirby-Jones also did it with his bat, hitting .538 (7-for-13) with four runs scored, a double, home run and five RBI while slugging .846. Chris King, who leads the OVC with a .445 batting average on the season, hit .529 (9-for-17) with six runs, a double, triples and five RBI in five games last week. Jake New, now is sixth in the OVC in batting (.378), hit .421 (8-for-19) in five games last week but more impressively stole seven bases in eight attempts. As a team the Golden Eagles are leading the OVC with a .327 average, 21 points higher than second place Samford. This week TTU hosts Milligan College in a non-conference game and then travels to Austin Peay for a OVC series this weekend.

UT Martin (4-26, 1-9 OVC): The Skyhawks dropped non-conference games to Evansville (15-10) and Lipscomb (10-9) this week before losing the first two of a weekend series to Eastern Kentucky. However, UT Martin responded with a 6-3 victory on Sunday as the team posted its first OVC victory of the season and just its fourth victory overall on the year. The win ended a seven-game losing skid for UTM. Offensively, Kyle Dudley led the Skyhawks with a .300 (3-for-10) average and drove in a pair of runs. On the mound, freshman Wes Patterson (who also plays first base), picked up his first collegiate save on Sunday, picking the ninth inning in the win over ECU. He inherited a runner and then gave up a walk and single before striking out the next batter and getting a double-play ball to end the game. Patterson also had a solo home run in the game, his fourth round-tripper of the season. Starter Calen Sutton picked up the win, lasting eight innings and allowing five hits, three runs and striking out one. It was his second start of the season and his team-leading 15th appearance of the season. UT Martin will play at Saint Louis on Tuesday and then against Memphis at a neutral site in Jackson, Tenn. on Wednesday. The Skyhawks will travel to Morehead State for an OVC series this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: In what was a jumbled OVC race just a week ago several teams have now distanced themselves in the OVC race after sweeps this past weekend...Samford and Jacksonville State both swept their opponents and are now first and second in the standings with Samford holding a one-half game lead over the Gamecocks (due to a rainout earlier this season)...Both of those teams are 7-3 in their last 10 games, which is also the mark that Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech have over their last 10 contests; EIU and TTU are currently third and fourth respectively in the Conference race...Eastern Kentucky is now tied with Tech for fourth while Southeast Missouri is No. 6 at 5-5 despite being swept at Jacksonville State this past weekend...The defending OVC Champions, Austin Peay, would be left out of the OVC Tournament (which takes the top 6 teams) if the event began today; the Governors are 5-7 in OVC play, which is a game behind Southeast for that No. 6 spot...Morehead State claimed its first OVC series victory for first-year head coach Jay Sorg this week, taking two of three at Tennessee Tech...UT Martin won its first OVC game (and first home game) of the year with a 6-3 victory over Eastern Kentucky on Sunday...A highlight on the non-conference schedule this week is Morehead State playing at nationally-ranked Kentucky; the OVC is 1-1 against ranked foes this season...This weekend's OVC games feature No. 2 Jacksonville State at No. 3 Eastern Illinois and No. 1 Samford at No. 6 Southeast Missouri...Other weekend games include Murray State at Eastern Kentucky, UT Martin at Morehead state and Tennessee Tech at Austin Peay.

Victories Over Ranked Opponents: Southeast Missouri State scored the OVC's first victory over a ranked opponent in 2008 with a 12-8 win over No. 6 Vanderbilt on April 2. OVC teams are now 1-1 against nationally-ranked teams this season. Last season the OVC compiled a 9-22 record against nationally-ranked foes, including a Tennessee Tech victory over No. 13 Alabama and a two-game sweep of No. 13 Mississippi State by Austin Peay.

APSU's Cunningham Ties OVC Record For Hits in a Game: Austin Peay junior **Chad Cunningham** tied the OVC record for hits in a game in a 26-4 win over Morehead State on April 5. Cunningham was 6-for-7 at the plate in the Govs victory. He tied a mark that is also held by eight other players.

Coaching Milestones: Southeast Missouri head coach **Mark Hogan** became the latest OVC coach to reach a career milestone, when he won his 400th game at Southeast Missouri on April 6. Hogan needs just 14 more wins to reach 800 overall for his career. Earlier this season Jacksonville State head coach **Jim Case** won his 200th career game and Samford coach **Casey Dunn** won his 100th career game. Tennessee Tech head coach **Matt Bragga** may be the next to reach a milestone, as he needs just three more wins for 100, while UT Martin head coach **Bubba Cates** needs four more for 400 for his career while Murray State head coach **Rob McDonald** needs 10 to reach 100.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed

closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah: For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2008 season, there were four players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Those players include: Jacksonville State's **Todd Jones** (Detroit), Morehead State's **Jon Rauch** (Washington), Austin Peay's **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and **Jaime Walker** (Baltimore). Three other players - Eastern Kentucky's **Josh Anderson** (Atlanta); Samford's **Ehren Wassermann** (Chicago White Sox) and Jacksonville State's **Bill White** (Texas) were on MLB rosters to end last season but are starting the season in the minors but are expected to be called up later this season.
