PLAYER

Drew Lee, SS • So., 5-11, 195 • Mt. Sterling, Ky. • Morehead State

In five games last week, Lee hit .609 (14-for-23) with seven runs, a double, three home runs and an amazing 16 RBI as Morehead State compiled a 3-2 overall record. Lee also had a 1.043 slugging percentage and .625 on-base percentage to go along with five multi-hit games and four multi-RBI outings. Lee had three hits and two RBI in a one-run loss at No. 17 Kentucky and two hits against Georgetown (Ky.) College. In the UT Martin series (in which MSU won two of three) Lee had three hits in the opener to go along with a home run and four RBI and added three hits in game two. In the finale Lee added three hits, two home runs and seven RBI. In that game he hit a grand slam and finished the series with home runs from both sides of the plate. Entering the week Lee had only seven RBI in 32 games this season.

Mike Perconte, RHP • Sr., 6-5, 170 • Lisle, Ill. • Murray State

Perconte tossed Murray State's first complete game shutout of the season on Saturday, as the Thoroughbreds topped Eastern Kentucky 6-0 in game one of a Conference doubleheader. Perconte allowed eight hits overall, but worked himself out of a bases loaded situation in the first inning and after that allowed only two other base runners to get into scoring position. Perconte walked one and struck out seven in completing the ninth game of his Murray State career. It also marked his third career shutout.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (18-20, 7-8 OVC): Austin Peay compiled a 3-2 overall record last week, winning every other game it played during the week. In non-conference action, the Governors beat Belmont 10-7 at home and lost at Middle Tennessee by a score of 11-9. APSU then hosted Tennessee Tech and took two of three from the Golden Eagles. That moved the Gobs record to 7-8 in OVC play, which places them in seventh place in the Conference standings, a game out of sixth place. Senior OF Rafael Hill hit .529 (9-for-17) with eight runs scored, three doubles, a home run and two stolen bases. Hill, the team's leadoff hitter, slugged .882 during the week and had a .619 on-base percentage. He was 3-for-5 with a double and two-run homer against Belmont, 3-for-5 against MTSU and a combined 4-for-12 in the TTU series. He now has a hitting streak of seven games and his 16 multi-hit games ranks fifth among OVC players. On the mound, sophomore lefty Stephen Huff tossed a complete game in the team's 10-5 win on Saturday. Huff struck out a career-high 12 in nine innings; the 12 strikeouts were just one off the school record for K's in a game and most since Jeff Mault fanned 12 against Morehead State in 2004. Overall the Gobs offense had 12 doubles and four home runs among its 49 hits last week. After starting the season 5-9 at Raymond C. Hand Park, Austin Peay has won seven of its last eight at home and is 6-3 in OVC games at home this year. APSU will host nationally-ranked Vanderbilt (#17) this week and then travel to play Evansville in non-conference action. In OVC play this weekend, the Governors will play at Southeast Missouri.

Eastern Illinois (18-18, 9-6 OVC): Eastern Illinois topped Illinois 13-3 in a neutral site game last week, lost at Saint Louis and then was 1-2 against league-leading Jacksonville State. The victory over Illinois at Grimes Field in Mattoon (Charleston's sister city) saw 1,777 fans in attendance as EIU scored all of its runs in the first four innings of the game. Following the Saint Louis loss, the Panthers scored 19 runs in a 19-2 win over Jax State. Following that game the EIU bats went silent, as JSU won the final two games 2-0 and 6-0. The Saturday win over Jacksonville State saw an eight-run second inning and also saw the team score 16 of its 19 runs in the first four innings. That marks the second time in as many years EIU has won the opener with JSU in big fashion only to drop the final two games of the series. Junior 3B Jordan Kreke hit .333 (6-for-18) during the week with four runs, a double, triple and seven RBI. He had three RBI apiece against each Illinois and JSU and delivered the lone RBI in the extra-inning loss to SLU. On the mound, junior Brian Morrell did not allow an earned run in two appearances last week. He tossed seven scoreless innings of relief against JSU (the highest-scoring OVC team entering the week) and two innings against Saint Louis. In the Jacksonville State game he entered the contest following a two-hour rain delay and two of the three hits he allowed her in the ninth inning after EIU had blown the game wide open. Tyler Kehrer matched his career-high with eight strikeouts in 6.2 innings in game two of the JSU series. This week Eastern will play in O'Fallon, Mo. against No. 4 Missouri then at Bradley on Wednesday. This weekend they will play at second-place Samford in OVC action. EIU enters the week in third place in the OVC standings, 1.5 games behind Samford and two games behind JSU.

Eastern Kentucky (17-18-1, 8-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky played six games last week, compiling a 2-4 overall record. In non-conference action the Colonels were swept in a doubleheader by Marshall and then topped Thomas More College (16-6). EKV then dropped the first two games of a three-game set to Murray State, before rebounding to win the finale 7-4. That left Eastern at 8-7 overall in OVC play, which put them into a tie for fifth with Tennessee Tech. Junior Matt Davis hit .391 (9-for-23) on the week, with three runs scored, two triples, two home runs and six RBI. Davis had a .826 slugging percentage for the week; he was 5-for-10 overall in the Murray State series. EKV did not have All-American ace Christian Friedrich on the mound this week; Friedrich was nursing a slight injury from the previous weekend series and was held out of action against Murray State. This week the Colonels will host Berea College and Kentucky State before traveling to play at league-leading Jacksonville State this weekend.

Jacksonville State (20-17, 11-4 OVC): Jacksonville State won a pair of non-conference games last week - topping both Troy and Alabama State - before winning two of three at Eastern Illinois. The wins over EIU put the Gamecocks at 11-4 in OVC play, as they re-gained the first place standing from rival Samford; JSU now has a half-game lead over the Bulldogs, a team they won two of three from earlier this year. Overall JSU has won eight straight OVC series dating back to last season. The Gamecocks have also won nine of its last 11 OVC games this season. After losing game one to EIU by a 19-2 margin, Jax State rebounded with a pair of shutouts (6-0, 2-0), the first time they have had back-to-back shutouts since the 1995 season. It also marked the first back-to-back shutouts of a Conference opponent since 1993 (when the program was a member of the Gulf South Conference). Game one of Sunday's doubleheader (schedule for 7 innings) went into extra frames scoreless before JSU plated two runs in their final at bat of the ninth inning; it was JSU's seventh final at-bat win of the season. Overall JSU won its 20th game of the season, marking the 38th time in the last 40 years the program has won at least 20 games in a season. Reigning OVC Player of the Year Clay Whittemore hit .400 (8-for-20) last week with two runs, two doubles, a triple, home run and four RBI. He is hitting a team-best .436 in OVC play this season. Sophomore hurler Ben Tootle allowed just two hits over 7.1 innings in the team's 2-0 win over EIU. Tootle struck out seven and held the team to a .080 batting average. Reliever Alex Jones came on to retire the final five batters and combine for the shutout. Tootle is now 4-0 with a 3.48 ERA in OVC play this season. 2B Bert Smith moved into fourth place on JSU's career stolen bases chart last week (64). This week the team will play at UAB, host Troy and then host Eastern Kentucky in a three-game OVC series.

Morehead State (15-22, 5-10 OVC): The Eagles have now won seven of its last 10 games after splitting a pair of non-conference games and winning two of three OVC contests from UT Martin last week. Morehead State lost 6-5 at No. 17 Kentucky then topped Georgetown (Ky.) College 5-4. The team picked up its offensive output over the weekend, scoring 41 runs in three games against UTM. The Eagles won game one 16-8 and game three 13-8 while dropping the middle game of the series by a 16-12 margin. Sophomore SS Drew Lee had a fantastic week in earning OVC Player of the Week honors, putting up numbers that some players do not produce in a year.

2008 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held May 21-24 (25) at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

It marks the eighth consecutive year that the event will be held at a neutral site in Paducah. Prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites. The competition at the event has been incredibly close over the past eight years, as five different teams have claimed a tournament championship in that time frame.

Last season the Austin Peay Governors won the championship by defeating Jacksonville State 3-2 in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

In five games, Lee hit .609 (14-for-23) with seven runs, a double, three home runs and an amazing 16 RBI to go along with a 1.043 slugging percentage, .625 on-base percentage, five multi-hit games and four multi-RBI outings. Lee had three hits and two RBI against UK and two hits against Georgetown. In the UT Martin series Lee had three hits in the opener to go along with a home run and four RBI and added three hits in game two. In the finale Lee added three hits, two home runs and seven RBI. In that game he hit a grand slam and finished the series with home runs from both sides of the plate. Entering the week Lee had only seven RBI in 32 games this season. Freshman 3B Michael Fear also had a big week, hitting .524 with six runs scored, four doubles and four RBI; he had three hits (including two doubles) against Kentucky. Eric Allen added a .357 average with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI and 11 runs scored; he also walked 10 times in the five games during the week. This week the Eagles will look to continue their hot streak with a non-conference game at Cincinnati and three OVC games at Murray State.

Murray State (14-20, 5-9 OVC): Murray State dropped a pair of non-conference games last week, losing 17-14 in a home slugfest to Memphis and 3-2 at Arkansas State. But the Thoroughbreds responded with a Saturday doubleheader sweep at Eastern Kentucky, winning 6-0 and 7-3. In the final game of the series on Sunday, Eastern Kentucky tripped up MSU by a 7-4 margin. Senior hurler Mike Perconte was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after tossing the first complete game shutout of the season for Murray State. Perconte allowed eight hits, wiggling out of a bases loaded jam in the first and then allowing only two other runners to reach scoring position after that. He struck out seven batters and walked only one in his nine innings. In game two of that doubleheader (scheduled for 7 innings), Daniel Calhoun also tossed a complete game as the T'Breds won 7-3. It marked the first time this season the team had thrown back-to-back complete games. Overall Murray State has seven complete games this year, which is two more than any other OVC school (Tennessee Tech is second with 5). Offensively sophomore DH Wes Cunningham hit .421 (8-for-19) with three runs, a triple, home run and six RBI. Cunningham hit safely in all five games and has hit safely in 25 of 31 games this season. His .406 batting average ranks third in the OVC. This week the 'Breds will play at No. 21 Mississippi and then host Morehead State for a three-game OVC series. Murray State is just 2.5 games out of sixth place in the OVC standings, a spot that marks the final spot in the OVC Tournament.

Samford (23-14, 10-4 OVC): Samford split a pair of non-conference games last week before losing two of three at Southeast Missouri over the weekend. The Bulldogs topped Mercer 8-3 at home on Tuesday, marking the program's 16th straight home victory which currently stands at the longest streak among Division I programs nationally. The team has not lost at home since falling to Saint Louis on March 1. Samford then dropped a 9-1 game at Troy. In its OVC series at Southeast Missouri, the team took the opener 11-6 but dropped the second game by a run (11-10) in extra innings. In Sunday's finale, Samford tied the game late but fell victim to a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth as the Redhawks took the finale 7-6. The losses put the Bulldogs to 10-4 overall in the OVC, which dropped them one half game behind Jacksonville State for the league lead. Junior SS Michael Marsecro hit .500 (11-for-22) for the week, with 10 runs, three doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBI. He hit .600 (9-for-15) in the Southeast series and also posted a 1.267 slugging percentage. Marsecro also increased his hitting streak to a career-best 22 games, the longest active streak in the OVC. Marsecro's 19 multiple-hit game ranks second in the OVC this season. Junior pitcher Jonathan Stephens improved to 6-0 on the season by throwing seven innings in the opener. He allowed eight hits and three runs (one earned) while striking out five. The Bulldogs will play at Auburn on Tuesday and host UAB before hosting Eastern Illinois in a key three-game OVC series this weekend. EIU is currently in third place, 1.5 games behind Samford, in the OVC standings.

Southeast Missouri (16-16, 7-6 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped a non-conference game at regional rival Southern Illinois during the week before hosting Samford where they won two of three games from the team that entered last week as the OVC leaders. The wins improved the Redhawks to 7-6 in the OVC games, which puts them into fourth place in the Conference standings. After losing the opener to Samford (11-6), the Redhawks pushed the second game into extra innings and won 11-10 on a Tyrell Cummings RBI-single. The final game went to the bottom of the ninth inning with the score tied and this time true freshman Trenton Moses had the game-winning hit as Southeast evened its record at 16-16 overall on the season. For the week Cummings hit .444 (8-for-18) with two runs, three doubles, a home run and five RBI. This week the team will play at Arkansas State before hosting Austin Peay for a three-game weekend OVC series.

Tennessee Tech (26-13-1, 8-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech lost a non-conference game to Milligan College last week before traveling to Clarksville to face defending OVC Champions Austin Peay. The Golden Eagles dropped two of three to the Governors to slip to 8-7 in OVC play, which puts them into a tie for fifth place in the Conference standings. In the victory, Thomas Nelson drove in a pair of runs and pitcher Michael Alcorn went 4.2 innings in picking up his fifth victory of the season. Chris King continued to hit the ball well for Tech, as he leads the OVC with a .416 batting average. His 23 multiple-hit games ranks first in the OVC. In last week's NCAA statistical leaders, he ranked first nationally in total hits (65 - a new list will be released on Tuesday). This week the Golden Eagles will have to hit the road for all four games. Tech will play at Belmont on Tuesday and then travel to UT Martin for a weekend series.

UT Martin (5-30, 2-11 OVC): Last week UT Martin lost at Saint Louis (11-4), against Memphis at a neutral site (7-3) and then dropped two of three games at Morehead State. In the game they won at Morehead, UTM scored 16 runs in a 16-12 victory. Junior Miles Hartsfield had a great week, hitting .471 (8-for-17) with five runs, a double, two home runs and eight RBI. He hit both of his home runs in Sunday's 13-8 loss to the Eagles. In his five games last week, he slugged .882, had a .524 on-base percentage and three multiple-RBI games. Overall on the week the Skyhawks had four players hit .400 or higher, including Hartsfield, Scott Gladstone (.476), William Blackmon (.471) and Cody Terry (.400). Freshman Wes Patterson hit his fifth and sixth home runs of the season in Saturday's doubleheader split. Terry added his first collegiate home run - a grand slam - on Saturday as well. As a team UT Martin hit .343 last week. This week the team will play at Evansville and then host Tennessee Tech in a weekend OVC series.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Jacksonville State won two of three games at Eastern Illinois last week and took over the top spot in the OVC standings from Samford, who dropped two of three games at Southeast Missouri...The Gamecocks now have a 0.5 game lead over Samford while Eastern Illinois two games back in third place...If the OVC Tournament was to begin today the six teams to make the field would be JSU, Samford, EIU, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee Tech and Eastern Kentucky...Defending champion Austin Peay is one game out of sixth place at the midway point of the Conference season...Morehead State won two of three OVC games this weekend thanks in part to the bat of sophomore SS Drew Lee who was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .609 and driving in 16 RBI in five games; Lee had only seven RBI in 32 games entering the week...OVC teams will have a chance to make a national splash this week as three schools play nationally-ranked squads in No. 4 Missouri (Eastern Illinois), No. 13 Vanderbilt (Austin Peay) and No. 21 Mississippi (Murray State)...This weekend's set of OVC games is highlighted by second-place Samford hosting third-place Eastern Illinois...Other games include Austin Peay at Southeast Missouri, Eastern Kentucky at Jacksonville State, Morehead State at Murray State and Tennessee Tech at UT Martin.

Home Winning Streaks: Entering this week Samford currently has the longest home winning streak among Division I teams. The Bulldogs have won 16 in a row and will host UAB on April 23. Following the Bulldogs are Oral Roberts (13), Monmouth (12) and Michigan/San Francisco/UW-Milwaukee (11).

Victories Over Ranked Opponents: Southeast Missouri State scored the OVC's first victory over a ranked opponent in 2008 with a 12-8 win over No. 6 Vanderbilt on April 2. OVC teams are now 1-2 against nationally-ranked teams this season. This Tuesday OVC school are facing a trio of ranked teams in No. 4 Missouri, No. 13 Vanderbilt and No. 21 Mississippi. Last season the OVC compiled a 9-22 record against nationally-ranked foes, including a Tennessee Tech victory over No. 13 Alabama and a two-game sweep of No. 13 Mississippi State by Austin Peay.

APSU's Cunningham Ties OVC Record For Hits in a Game: Austin Peay junior **Chad Cunningham** tied the OVC record for hits in a game in a 26-4 win over Morehead State on April 5. Cunningham was 6-for-7 at the plate in the Govs victory. He tied a mark that is also held by eight other players.

Coaching Milestones: Southeast Missouri head coach **Mark Hogan** became the latest OVC coach to reach a career milestone, when he won his 400th game at Southeast Missouri on April 6. Hogan needs just 14 more wins to reach 800 overall for his career. Earlier this season Jacksonville State head coach **Jim Case** won his 200th career game and Samford coach **Casey Dunn** won his 100th career game. Tennessee Tech head coach **Matt Bragga** may be the next to reach a milestone, as he needs just two more wins for 100, while UT Martin head coach **Bubba Cates** needs three more for 400 for his career and Murray State head coach **Rob McDonald** needs eight to reach 100.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the

The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah: For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2008 season, there were four players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Those players include: Jacksonville State's **Todd Jones** (Detroit), Morehead State's **Jon Rauch** (Washington), Austin Peay's **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and **Jaime Walker** (Baltimore). Three other players - Eastern Kentucky's **Josh Anderson** (Atlanta); Samford's **Ehren Wassermann** (Chicago White Sox) and Jacksonville State's **Bill White** (Texas) were on MLB rosters to end last season but are starting the season in the minors but are expected to be called up later this season.
