William Blackmon, DH • Sr., 6-6, 220 • Fort Worth, Texas • UT Martin

Blackmon hit .538 (7-for-13) with five runs, three doubles, two home runs and eight RBI in four games last week as the Skyhawks compiled a 3-1 overall record including winning two of three against Tennessee Tech in a weekend OVC series. In the first game of a doubleheader sweep of TTU, Blackmon hit two home runs (a 3-run shot and solo blast) and followed that with a three-run double in the second game of the doubleheader. Blackmon, who now has a nine-game hitting streak, had a 1.231 slugging percentage and .600 on-base percentage during the week.

Jarry pitched the first complete game of his career on Sunday as Samford topped Eastern Illinois 11-1 to complete a three-game sweep in the OVC series. Jarry scattered three hits (all singles) in holding the Panthers to a .097 batting average for the game. Jarry retired the first nine batters of the game and allowed only one hit before the eighth inning. He also retired 12 straight from the end of the fourth inning to the eighth. In total Jarry did not walk a batter and struck out four as he improved to 2-2 on the season.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (21-22, 9-9 OVC): Austin Peay compiled a 3-2 record last week including winning two of three at Southeast Missouri State over the weekend. The Governors claimed game one 6-5 and game two 7-6 before falling 10-9 to the Redhawks in the finale. Those wins gave APSU a 9-9 OVC record on the season and pushed them from seventh place into a four-way tie for third place. In non-conference action, the Govs lost to No. 10 Vanderbilt (9-8) and topped Evansville 5-2. Senior OF Rafael Hill hit .400 (8-for-20) last week with eight runs, two doubles, a home run, three RBI and four stolen bases. Sophomore reliever Daniel Tenholder recorded saves in each of APSU's wins last week, increasing his season total to an OVC-best 10. He struck out three in 1.1 innings at Evansville, pitched an inning in game one against Southeast and 1.2 innings in game two. Opponents hit only .071 (1-for-14) against him for the week. Senior SS Tyler Farrar batted in both game-winning RBI in the Southeast Missouri series. After starting the season 5-9 at home, the Austin Peay has won seven of its last nine and will play their next five games at home. That begins this weekend when UT Martin comes to town for a three-game set.

Eastern Illinois (18-23, 9-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois lost all five of its games last week and has now lost seven in a row overall. The Panthers lost by two runs (8-6) to No. 4 Missouri in O'Fallon, Mo. last week, then dropped a game at Bradley before being swept at second-place Samford over the weekend. EIU is now just 3-15 in true road games this season following that sweep. After scoring a season-high 19 runs in an April 19 win over Jacksonville State, Eastern has scored just 15 total runs over its seven-game skid. They were outscored by a combined 18-3 margin at Samford. Jordan Tokarz homered and tripled in his first two at-bats against nationally-ranked Mizzou. Tyler Brandon, who led the nation in E.R.A. in last week's NCAA rankings, pitched two innings of scoreless relief against Missouri, but gave up three runs in game one of the Samford series. Brett Nommensen was hit by pitch four times last week, increasing his season total to 13. He has now been hit by pitch more times than he has struck out (11). Curt Restko did not strike out for the second straight week and increased his league-leading strikeout ratio to 21.7 at-bat per strikeout. This week the Panthers will host Southeast Missouri in a crucial series. The Panthers are currently in a four-way tie for third place in the Conference standings.

Eastern Kentucky (20-21-1, 8-10 OVC): The Colonels started last week with three straight victories - wins over Berea and a doubleheader sweep of Kentucky State - before being swept in a weekend OVC series at Jacksonville State. All of the losses were close, however, as JSU won by scores of 3-2 (in 10 innings), 7-5 and 5-3. Eastern Kentucky is now 8-10 in the OVC standings and in seventh place. Freshman infielder Jayson Langfels powered the EKU offense this past week. He hit .381 (8-for-21) with eight runs, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI and two stolen bases. He smacked his league-leading sixth triple against KSU, which tied him for the most in EKV single-season history. He also hit home runs in his first two games of the week, marking the third straight game overall he had hit a blast (he homered in the team's final game of last week), becoming the first Eastern Kentucky player to ever achieve that feat. This week the Colonels will play a home-and-home series with Miami (Ohio) and then host Samford in a key OVC series.

Jacksonville State (23-18, 14-4 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a non-conference game against Troy but rebounded to sweep Eastern Kentucky in OVC play to remain a half game up in the Conference standings over rival Samford. It marked the team's first three-game sweep of EKV since joining the league in 2004. The Gamecocks, pre-season OVC favorites, are now 14-4 in Conference play with nine games remaining. Jax State has now won nine straight OVC series dating back to last season and 10 of 12 OVC games overall this year. JSU continues to excel in close games, claiming their eighth and ninth final at-bat victories this season. They have also posted a 10-1 record in one-run games this season (6-0 in one-run OVC games). Since joining the OVC Jacksonville State is 44-19 in one-run games and 24-6 in one-run OVC games. Senior OF Clay Whittemore hit .357 (5-for-14) with two doubles and three RBI last week. Whittemore now has 218 career hits, which is tied for third in JSU history. He also now has 69 career multiple-hit games and 40 multiple-RBI games. Senior pitcher Brian Booth made two appearances last week and did not allow a run in 7.1 innings of work. Opponents hit just .217 against Booth who tossed the final four innings in Saturday's 3-2 win against EKV to pick up the victory. Sophomore Ben Tootle is now 5-0 in OVC play this season with a 4.14 ERA and 41 strikeouts against only 12 walks; he is 9-1 in OVC play over his two seasons with JSU. This week the Gamecocks will play at Alabama State and then travel to Morehead State for a weekend series.

Morehead State (16-25, 6-12 OVC): Morehead State dropped a non-conference game at Cincinnati and then two of three games at Murray State over the weekend. The Eagles are now 6-12 overall in OVC games, which puts them in ninth place. Drew Lee, last week's OVC Player of the Week, continued his torrid pace by hitting .467 (7-for-15) last week with two runs, two doubles and two RBI. He hit safely in all four MSU games and extended his hitting streak to a team-best 11 games. Freshman 3B Michael Fear raised his batting average to .299 after hitting .429 overall last week; he had six hits, scored two runs and batted in two runs. Sophomore pitcher Clay Muntz picked up the victory in the Eagles 8-5 game one victory over Murray State. He did that by pitching two

scoreless innings of relief and improved to 4-0 on the year. All of Muntz's decisions have come since April 8 and two have been OVC decisions. Morehead State will play at Louisville this week and then host league-leading Jacksonville State this weekend.

Murray State (16-22, 7-10 OVC): Murray State lost at nationally-ranked Mississippi to begin last week and then dropped game one of a three-game set to Morehead State, before rebounding to claim the final two games from the Eagles. Those wins improved the Thor-oughbreds to 7-10 in OVC play, which puts them just a 1.5 games out of sixth place in the OVC standings (the top six teams make the OVC Tournament). MSU has now won two straight OVC series. Sophomore Wes Cunningham continued his recent success by hitting .462 (6-for-13) last week with five runs score, a RBI and a stolen base. He has now hit safely in 28 of 35 games this season and reached base safely in 33 of 35 games, including 32 straight contests. He is now hitting an OVC-best .412 on the season. Sophomore lefty Daniel Calhoun tossed a complete game in the team's 3-1 win over Morehead State in game two of Saturday's doubleheader. He allowed one unearned run, five hits, walked one and struck out four over seven innings. The T'Breds have had a pitcher toss a complete game now in seven-straight weekend series (which includes all six OVC weekends so far this season). This week Murray State will play at Evansville, host Southern Illinois and then travel to Tennessee Tech. The Golden Eagles are one of the teams just 1.5 games ahead of them in the OVC standings.

Samford (27-15, 13-4 OVC): Samford won four of five games last week to improve to 27-15 overall and 13-4 in OVC play. The Bulldogs are still just one-half game behind Jacksonville State for first place in the league standings. Samford opened the week with a 12-11 victory at SEC power Auburn but then faltered at home, losing 16-8 to UAB. That loss snapped the team's 16-game home winning streak, which had been the longest in the nation. But the team rebounded with a sweep of Eastern Illinois to close the week. Samford is now 9-0 in OVC play at home this season. Junior pitcher Michael Jarry was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after tossing a complete game in Sunday's 11-1 win over EIU. Jarry scattered three singles and struck out four without issuing a walk. He is the first Samford pitcher to be honored with the award this season. Junior SS Michael Marseco hit .429 (9-for-21) on the week as he extended his hitting streak to a career-long 27 games (which is the longest streak in the OVC this season). Marseco scored six runs, had two doubles, two RBI and stole three bases. This week the Bulldogs will look to knock off another in-state SEC foe (Alabama) before traveling to Georgia State. This weekend they will play at Eastern Kentucky in OVC action.

Southeast Missouri (18-18, 8-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri topped Arkansas State in non-conference action last week and then lost two of three in OVC play at home to Austin Peay. That left the Redhawks at .500 (8-8) in OVC play which puts them into a four-team tie for third place in the standings. Junior OF Tyrell Cummings hit .438 (7-for-16) last week with seven runs, a double and three RBI in four games. He was one of four Southeast players to hit above .400 for the week, as Nick Harris (.429), Matt Wagner (.429) and Tony Spencer (.400) also did. Pitcher Lance Rhodes pitched five innings of scoreless relief in the team's game three victory over Austin Peay. For the week Rhodes did not allow a run in 6.1 innings of work, as he struck out five and walked three. This week the Redhawks will play a weekend OVC series at Eastern Illinois.

Tennessee Tech (29-15-1, 9-9 OVC): Tennessee Tech won three of its five games last week, topping non-conference foes Belmont and Alabama A&M on the road and then winning one of three at UT Martin in OVC action. The Golden Eagles are now 9-9 in OVC play and in a four-way tie for third place overall. Senior infielder Matt Mihoci hit .500 (9-for-18) last week with six runs, a double and seven RBI. He was 3-for-4 with five RBI and two runs scored against Belmont and had a 3-for-4 and 3-for-5 performance in the final two games of the UTM series. Junior pitcher Ryan Dennick appeared in two games and compiled a 0.96 E.R.A. in 9.1 innings of work last week in picking up a pair of victories. Dennick went five innings against Belmont, allowing one earned run and four hits and followed that up with 4.1 innings against UT Martin, allowing one unearned run. Pitcher Matt Kearney made his 71st career appearance last week which set the Tennessee Tech career record in that category. TTU needs just one more victory to become the first OVC team to win 30 games this season. They can do that this week with a three-game home OVC series with Murray State.

UT Martin (8-31, 4-12 OVC): UT Martin had one of its best weeks of the season last week, winning three of its four contests including sweeping a Conference doubleheader from Tennessee Tech on Saturday. The Skyhawks beat Evansville 13-12 in non-conference action and topped TTU 5-4 and 5-0 on Saturday before losing 8-1 on Sunday. Senior DH William Blackmon was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .538 (7-for-13) with five runs, three doubles, two home runs and eight RBI last week. He hit a pair of home runs (a 3-run blast and solo shot) in game one of the Tech series and followed that up with a three-run double in game two. For the week he slugged 1.231 and had an on-base percentage of .600. Senior hurler Calen Sutton tossed a seven-inning complete game shutout in game two of the series (a 5-0 UT Martin win). He scattered four hits and walked three while striking out five. He is now 3-1 on the season. The wins over Tech marked the squad's first back-to-back OVC wins of the season. The second win on Saturday marked the 400th of head coach Bubba Cates coaching career. This week UTM will host Belmont for a doubleheader and then play at Austin Peay this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: The OVC race has turned into a two-team affair as Jacksonville State and Samford have put some distance between themselves and the rest of the league...Jacksonville State now has a half-game lead over Samford and Samford is 4.5 games ahead of four games who are tied for third place...There are currently three weekends of OVC games left before the OVC Tournament which will be held in Paducah, Ky. once again this season; the top six teams will make the OVC Tournament...Samford saw its nation's-best 16-game home winning streak come to an end last week with a loss to UAB...The Bulldogs might have another nation's-best, however, as SS Michael Marseco now has a 27-game hitting streak, which is believed to be one of the longest streak's in the nation this season...Marseco (.409 batting average) is one of two OVC players (along with Murray State's Wes Cunningham - .412) currently hitting over .400 on the season...EIU's Tyler Brandon was last week's national leader in E.R.A. but will fall back slightly this week after allowing three runs last week should slip in the rankings; Brandon still has an impressive 1.29 E.R.A. in 42 innings this season...This week's games feature Southeast Missouri at Eastern Illinois, which involves two of the four teams tied for third place in the standings...Other games include league-leading Jacksonville State at Morehead State, second place Samford at Eastern Kentucky, Murray State at Tennessee Tech and UT Martin at Austin Peay.

Friedrich Named to Dick Howser Trophy Watch List: Eastern Kentucky junior pitcher **Christian Friedrich** has been named to the 2008 Dick Howser Trophy Watch List, given annually to college baseball's premier player. The list, composed of 50 players, was released April 24 by the National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association (NCBWA). Friedrich is 4-1 this season with a 1.95 ERA, a .149 opponent batting average and 71 strikeouts in only 50.2 innings of work. His 12.60 strikeouts per nine innings is sixth best in the nation, and he recently became ECU's career strikeout leader with 290. A preseason All-American, Friedrich is rated by Baseball America as the sixth-best MLB prospect in college baseball. The southpaw from Evanston, Ill. has already been named a finalist for the Brooks Wallace and Roger Clemens Awards, and was voted the 2008 preseason OVC Pitcher of the Year earlier this year. The membership of the NCBWA will choose the Dick Howser Trophy based on three rounds of voting. The 2008 winner will be announced at the College World Series in Omaha on Saturday, June 14, at 10:00 a.m. CDT. The Dick Howser Trophy, given in memory of the former Florida State University All-America shortstop and major league player and manager who died of brain cancer in 1987, is regarded by many as college baseball's most prestigious award.

Victories Over Ranked Opponents: Southeast Missouri State scored the OVC's first victory over a ranked opponent in 2008 with a 12-8 win over No. 6 Vanderbilt on April 2. OVC teams are now 1-5 against nationally-ranked teams this season. Last season the OVC compiled a 9-22 record against nationally-ranked foes, including a Tennessee Tech victory over No. 13 Alabama and a two-game sweep of No. 13 Mississippi State by Austin Peay.

APSU's Cunningham Ties OVC Record For Hits in a Game: Austin Peay junior **Chad Cunningham** tied the OVC record for hits in a game in a 26-4 win over Morehead State on April 5. Cunningham was 6-for-7 at the plate in the Govs victory. He tied a mark that is also held by eight other players.

Coaching Milestones: UT Martin head coach **Bubba Cates** became the latest OVC coach to reach a career milestone when he won his 400th career game on April 26. Earlier in the week Tennessee Tech head coach **Matt Bragga** also hit a milestone, as he reached his 100 career victory. Earlier this season Jacksonville State head coach **Jim Case** won his 200th career game, Samford coach **Casey Dunn** won his 100th career game and **Mark Hogan** won his 400th game at Southeast Missouri. Hogan may reach another milestone this season as he needs 10 more wins to reach 800 overall for his career. Murray State head coach **Rob McDonald** needs only six wins to reach 100 for his career.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball.

From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah: For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2008 season, there were four players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Those players include: Jacksonville State's **Todd Jones** (Detroit), Morehead State's **Jon Rauch** (Washington), Austin Peay's **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and **Jaime Walker** (Baltimore). Three other players - Eastern Kentucky's **Josh Anderson** (Atlanta); Samford's **Ehren Wassermann** (Chicago White Sox) and Jacksonville State's **Bill White** (Texas) were on MLB rosters to end last season but are starting the season in the minors but are expected to be called up later this season.
