THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Tyler Farrar, 3B • Sr., 6-0, 170 • Nashville, Tenn. • Austin Peay

Farrar hit .550 (11-for-20) over five games last week, adding seven runs, five doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI and two stolen bases. Farrar had hits in four of five games last week, as the Governors played at Mississippi State and swept a weekend OVC series with Morehead State. In the first game against Morehead State, a 26-4 Austin Peay win, Farrar was 5-for-5 with two doubles, a grand slam and school-record eight RBI. After being held hitless in game two of the series, he bounced back with a 3-for-4 performance with two doubles, a solo home run and three RBI. Farrar now shares the OVC lead with 34 RBI on the season.

CO-PITCHER

Stephen Huff, LHP • So., 6-1, 200 • Murfreesboro, Tenn. • Austin Peay

Huff took a no-hitter into the seventh inning against Morehead State in game one of Saturday's doubleheader and ended up pitching seven innings in picking up the victory. Huff went 6.1 innings without allowing a hit and then surrendered two in the seventh inning. He also issued two walks while striking out a season-high eight batters. Huff is now 1-1 with a 1.27 E.R.A. in Conference-only games this season (and 3-3 with a 2.74 E.R.A. overall).

CO-PITCHER

Dustin Renfrow, RHP • Sr., 6-3, 215 • West Plains, Mo. • Southeast Missouri

Renfrow picked up a pair of victories last week as he helped the Redhawks to an upset victory over No. 6 Vanderbilt and tossed a seven-inning complete game against Murray State. On Tuesday Renfrow allowed one run and struck out two in three innings against the nationally-ranked Commodores, as he picked up the victory by pre-arrangement. He came back in game two of Saturday's Conference doubleheader, and allowed five hits and two runs while striking out seven Thoroughbred batters. For the week Renfrow compiled a 2.70 E.R.A. and nine strikeouts in 10 innings of work. For the season he is 3-1 with a 2.91 E.R.A. while holding batters to a .181 batting average.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (15-13, 5-4 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a pair of games at Mississippi State last week, falling 13-4 and 10-2. A year ago the Governors swept a two-game series from then No. 13 MSU. Upon returning home to host Morehead State in OVC play, APSU swept the Eagles, winning by scores of 26-4, 4-3 and 8-2. After three week of OVC play, Austin Peay is 5-4 overall and tied for sixth place in the Conference standings. Senior 3B Tyler Farrar hit .550 (11-for-20) for the week with seven runs, five doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI. He was 5-for-5 with a school-record eight RBI in the opener against Morehead State; he had two doubles and a grand slam in the Govs blowout victory. In the series finale he was 3-for-4 with two doubles, a solo home run and three RBI. Sophomore hurler Stephen Huff had a no-hitter through 6.1 innings on Saturday; he finished the game by tossing seven innings, allowing two hits, two walks and striking out eight. Junior Chad Cunningham set the APSU record and tied the OVC record by registering six hits in game one against Morehead State; he was 6-of-7 at the plate for the contest. Also in game one of that series, freshman Brooks Hunton had home runs in both of his at-bats, a two-run and three-run blast. The 26 runs scored in that game were the most in a single-contest at Raymond C. Hand Park. This week the Govs will challenge two SEC foes - at Tennessee on Tuesday and at Vanderbilt on Wednesday - and then travel to Samford for a weekend OVC series.

Eastern Illinois (14-13, 6-3 OVC): After being swept in an OVC series last weekend, Eastern Illinois ran off five straight wins over the week including sweeping UT Martin (6-4, 8-6, 13-2) in an OVC series. The Panthers are now 6-3 in OVC play and are in a three-way tie for third place; they are just half of a game out of first place. In non-conference play last week EIU topped both Monmouth College (4-3) and Chicago State (5-2) at home. EIU is now 8-1 at home this season; the team played its first 14 games of the year away from home. Since starting the season 0-7, Eastern has won 14 of its last 20 games overall. Sophomore catcher Richie Derbak hit .667 (6-9) with four runs, a double, home run and nine RBI in three games last week. He was 4-for-4 with runners in scoring position over the weekend after sitting out both non-conference games due to a blister on his throwing hand. He had multiple-RBI in each weekend game, highlighted by a career-high four-RBI performance in the finale. He also hit his first career home run on Sunday. Sophomore left-handed pitcher Tyler Kehrer pitched seven innings and allowed seven hits while striking out seven in the series finale against UTM. With the performance he picked up his first career victory in OVC play. EIU turned a program-record five double plays in Sunday's win over UT Martin. Josh Mueller struck out nine batters in the UTM series opener, earning his third win of the season; over his last four starts he has struck out 32 batters. Brett Nommensen finished the week 11-for-20 (.550) with six runs scored; he also delivered a game-winning, two-run double with two outs in the eighth inning against Monmouth. Freshman Cameron Strang was 6-for-10 with three RBI in the UTM series. This week the Panthers conclude their seven-game home stand with games against Illinois College and Indiana State. This weekend they play at Murray State.

Eastern Kentucky (12-13-1, 5-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky lost three of its four games last week but remained above .500 (5-4) in OVC play and are tied for sixth place entering this week's games. The Colonels started the week with a 12-7 non-conference loss to Georgetown (Ky.) College and had a Wednesday game with that same team rained out. EKU then hosted Tennessee Tech and took game one 6-1 behind a strong pitching performance from All-American Christian Friedrich. However, the team lost games two (7-4) and three (7-6 in 8 innings) to end the week. Friedrich pitched seven innings, allowing just three hits and walking two while striking out 11. Friedrich's 65 strikeouts this season are 20 more than the next-closest OVC competitor. He continues to rank among the top 10 nationally in strikeouts-per nine innings (13.10). This week the Colonels will play at Western Kentucky before traveling to UT Martin for a weekend OVC series.

Jacksonville State (13-16, 6-3 OVC): Jacksonville State did not play a non-conference game last week, instead resting up for an OVC-series with league-leading Samford. The Gamecocks swept a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 7-6 and 11-4 before dropping the finale 9-6 on Sunday. JSU is now 6-3 in Conference play and in a three-way tie for third place overall; Jax State, however, is just half a game out of first place. By taking two of three from in-state rival Samford, JSU has won six straight OVC series dating back to last season. Jax State had won eight straight against the Bulldogs before losing the finale; overall JSU has won 19 of its last 22 against Samford. Freshman OF Todd Cunningham hit .545 (6-for-11) with four runs and a RBI last week; he leads the team with a .472 batting average over the past 10 games. In game one against Samford, the Gamecocks rallied for a 7-6 win in the final inning, marking its fifth final at-bat victory of the season. JSU is now 8-1 in one-run games this season. The Jacksonville State pitching staff has recorded 91 strikeouts versus only 30 walks in nine OVC games this season. 2B Bert Smith has recorded a hit in every OVC game of the season. For the second straight week the team will not play a mid-week non-conference game; this coming weekend JSU will host Southeast Missouri for a three-game OVC series.

Morehead State (8-19, 1-8 OVC): Morehead State won its non-conference game during the week, topping Marshall 6-3 in a home game. The contest was originally scheduled to be play in Huntington but changed due to an unplayable field. The Eagles then traveled to Austin Peay and dropped a three-game set to the Governors to fall to 1-8 in OVC play this season. Drew Lee, who has been filling in at shortstop for an injured Nick Nail, hit .313 last week with five runs and two RBI. He homered on a 3-2 counts with two outs in the seventh inning of Saturday's second game. That blast tied the game in which APSU would win, 4-3, in the bottom of the inning. MSU's catching tandem of Erick Parker and Casey Branham each hit .500 for the week. Branham had four hits, including two doubles, while Parker had three hits in six at-bats. Michael Bottoms pitched 5.2 innings in that contest, allowing four hits and striking out six. This week Morehead State will host

Murray State (11-13, 2-6 OVC): Murray State won a non-conference doubleheader with Belmont on Wednesday, sweeping the Bruins by scores of 4-3 and 7-4. The Thoroughbreds then played at Southeast Missouri, besting the Redhawks 5-3 in game one before losing the final two games of the series by margins of 3-2 and 9-8. Junior infielder Brooks Thornton hit .368 (7-for-19) with four runs, a double, home run and eight RBI in five games last week. He was 5-for-8 with a home run and four RBI in the doubleheader sweep of Belmont and began the Southeast series with a bases-clearing double in the first inning of what proved to be a 5-3 Murray State victory. Sophomore pitcher Chris Craycraft tossed his third complete game of the season on Friday. He needed just 106 pitches over the nine innings as he allowed the Redhawks six hits and two walks while striking out three. Craycraft also enticed three double-play balls and he improved to 3-1 on the season. He has thrown at least seven innings in five of his six starts this season. The 'Breds are now 4-8 in one-run games this season. Tyler Owen has hit safely in eight straight games and 10 of his last 11 overall; during that period he raised his batting average 216 points. After the mid-week sweep of Belmont, Murray State is 5-2 on the season in mid-week games. Murray State plays at Southern Illinois on Monday and then hosts Evansville on Wednesday. This weekend the 'Breds will host Eastern Illinois for an OVC series.

Samford (17-10, 6-2 OVC): Samford won a pair of non-conference games last week - 10-6 at Mercer and 11-6 at home against Georgia State - before losing two of three games at Jacksonville State over the weekend. The Bulldogs lost a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 7-6 and 11-4 before bouncing back with a come-from-behind 9-6 win on Sunday. In that contest Samford scored six runs in the top of the eighth inning to win. The Bulldogs are now 6-2 in league play, which puts them in first place overall, but are just a half of a game above four other teams in what is shaping up to be a tight OVC race. Senior catcher Bear Burnett hit .600 (12-for-20) with eight runs, two doubles, a home run and four RBI. He slugged .850 over his five games last week. Junior pitcher Michael Jarry started two games last week, both of which were wins for Samford. He went four innings and gave up four hits and three runs against Georgia State and then went eight innings against JSU, allowing five runs and striking out a career-best seven batters. This week it will be a pair of in-state teams that Samford is playing, as they battle Troy at home on Tuesday and UAB on the road on Wednesday. In weekend OVC play, the Bulldogs will host Austin Peay for three games.

Southeast Missouri (13-10, 5-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri, who is in second place in the OVC with a 5-2 conference mark, scored the biggest win of the season for the OVC on Tuesday, knocking off No. 6 Vanderbilt 12-8 in Nashville. The Redhawks opened up a 6-1 lead midway through the fourth inning and then held off a VU comeback effort. Southeast added two runs in the sixth and four more in the eighth to pull off the upset in a game that was only scheduled the day before due to rainouts both teams had experienced. Southeast then dropped a road game at Evansville the next day, falling in UE's last at-bat, and bounced back with two wins in three games against Murray State over the weekend. Junior OF Tyrell Cummings hit .333 (7-for-21) last week with seven runs scored, three home runs, eight RBI and a stolen base. Cummings' three home runs all came in Sunday's 9-8 win over Murray State; his final blast of the day put the Redhawks on top for good. In the victory over Vandy, Cummings had two RBI including the go-ahead run in the eighth inning. Cummings leads the OVC with nine home runs and is tied for the league-lead in RBI (34). Senior Dustin Renfrow got the start at Vanderbilt, allowing one earned run while striking out two in three innings of work. On Saturday, he tossed a seven-inning complete game against Murray State, registering seven strikeouts. On the season he is holding opposing batters to a .181 batting average. With the 9-8 victory over MSU on Sunday, Redhawks head coach Mark Hogan recorded his 400th victory at Southeast Missouri. The Redhawks will host Southern Illinois and Arkansas State in non-conference play this week before playing at Jacksonville State this weekend.

Tennessee Tech (22-8-1, 6-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech topped SEC foe Tennessee on Tuesday and then won two of three against Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. Overall the Golden Eagles reached the 20-win plateau on the season, doing so in only 28 games, which was the quickest in school history. Overall the team is 6-3 in OVC play, which puts them into a three-way tie for third place, although they are only one half game out of first place. The win over UT marked only the second time in the last 32 meetings between the schools. TTU then lost the opening game at Eastern Kentucky (6-1) before winning game two (7-4) and three (7-6 in 8 innings). Junior OF Alex Henry hit .438 (7-for-16) with five runs, two doubles, two triples, three RBI and a stolen base. Henry had a slugging percentage of .813 and drove in the game-winning runs in each of the final two games against EKU. Senior pitcher Matt Kearney made two appearances last week, registering the save against Tennessee and holding EKU scoreless over the final 3.1 innings in game one of that series. This week Tech will host Berea in a Tuesday doubleheader before hosting Morehead State this weekend in OVC play.

UT Martin (3-22, 0-7 OVC): UT Martin snapped a 10-game losing streak with a pair of non-conference victories during the week. The Skyhawks went on the road to beat Arkansas State 9-8 and then topped Lipscomb 9-8 in 10 innings at a neutral site game in Union City, Tenn. The win over Lipscomb came on a sacrifice bunt by freshman Cody Terry in the 10th. UTM still has not won a road game this season but have scored two road wins and a neutral site victory. NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Just three weeks into the nine-week OVC schedule, the Conference race is as tight as ever, as a half a game in the standings is all that separates first place to fifth place...Samford, who had one game rained out earlier this year, is on top of the standings with a 6-2 record after they dropped their first two OVC games of the season at Jacksonville State this past weekend...Southeast Missouri, who has had two games eliminated by rain this season, is in second place at 5-2...Southeast is followed by Tennessee Tech, Eastern Illinois and Jacksonville State, who are all tied with identical 6-3 records...Austin Peay and Eastern Kentucky are tied with 5-4 marks and share sixth place...This weekend's games feature Southeast Missouri and Jacksonville State battling to stay near the top of the league-lead, while league-leader Samford hosts defending champion Austin Peay...Other games include Eastern Kentucky at UT Martin, Eastern Illinois at Murray State and Morehead State at Tennessee Tech.

Victories Over Ranked Opponents: Southeast Missouri State scored the OVC's first victory over a ranked opponent in 2008 with a 12-8 win over No. 6 Vanderbilt on April 2. Last season the OVC compiled a 9-22 record against nationally-ranked foes, including a Tennessee Tech victory over No. 13 Alabama and a two-game sweep of No. 13 Mississippi State by Austin Peay.

APSU's Cunningham Ties OVC Record For Hits in a Game: Austin Peay junior **Chad Cunningham** tied the OVC record for hits in a game in a 26-4 win over Morehead State on April 5. Cunningham was 6-for-7 at the plate in the Govs victory. He tied a mark that is also held by eight other players.

Coaching Milestones: Southeast Missouri head coach **Mark Hogan** became the latest OVC coach to reach a career milestone, when he won his 400th game at Southeast Missouri on April 6. Hogan needs just 15 more wins to reach 800 overall for his career. Earlier this season Jacksonville State head coach **Jim Case** won his 200th career game and Samford coach **Casey Dunn** won his 100th career game. Tennessee Tech head coach **Matt Bragga** may be the next to reach a milestone, as he needs just six more wins for 100, while UT Martin head coach **Bubba Cates** needs five more for 400 for his career and Murray State head coach **Rob McDonald** needs 11 to reach 100.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of

the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah: For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2008 season, there were four players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Those players include: Jackson State's **Todd Jones** (Detroit), Morehead State's **Jon Rauch** (Washington), Austin Peay's **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and **Jaime Walker** (Baltimore).
