## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

**Michael Marseco, SS • Jr., 5-9, 132 • Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. • Samford**  
Marseco was named OVC Player of the Week for the second time in three weeks after hitting .625 (10-for-16) in four games last week as Samford went 3-1 as a team, including a three-game sweep of UT Martin to begin OVC play. Marseco scored six runs, had a double, triple, home run and eight RBI on the week to go with a 1.000 slugging percentage and .647 on-base percentage. The All-OVC shortstop hit safely in each game including registering three hits in each game of the UTM series. He was 3-for-5 with a triple, home run and four RBI in the series finale. Marseco's .413 batting average for the season currently ranks second in the OVC.

### CO-PITCHER

**Ben Tootle, RHP • So., 6-1, 190 • Oxford, Ala. • Jacksonville State**  
Tootle becomes the second Jacksonville State player honored with this award in 2008. The sophomore struck out a career-high 10 batters in 6.1 innings of work in the Gamecocks 2-1 victory over Murray State on Friday. Tootle scattered five hits and walked two while allowing just one earned run as he improved to 3-2 on the season.

### CO-PITCHER

**Dustin Renfrow, RHP • Sr., 6-3, 215 • West Plains, Mo. • Southeast Missouri**  
Renfrow becomes the second Southeast Missouri pitcher honored in as many weeks after tossing a complete game in the Redhawks 7-3 victory over Tennessee Tech on Saturday. Renfrow, who is now 1-1 on the season with a 3.00 E.R.A., allowed the Golden Eagles only four hits in nine innings, walked one and struck out six in picking up the win. He retired 11 TTU batters in a row at one stretch of the contest and allowed three runs, only one of which was earned.

## TEAM NOTES

**Austin Peay (9-9, 1-2 OVC):** Austin Peay had both of its non-conference games (Indiana State, Middle Tennessee) cancelled last week, prior to its OVC-opening series at Eastern Kentucky. The Governors dropped the opener by a run (2-1) and then bounced back to score an extra-inning affair (7-5) in game two. APSU also lost the finale 7-3 and finds itself two games out of first place after one weekend of play. The Governors started last season 0-3 in OVC play but went on to finish 19-8 and claim the OVC regular season (and tournament) championships. APSU senior OF Rafael Hill entered last week as the OVC's leading hitter, but was 0-for-12 on the weekend as he recorded just three walks in 15 at-bats; he now ranks 10th in the league in batting (.371). First baseman Matt Kole continued his fine early season play, leading APSU with a .400 average at EKU, hitting a pair of home runs, including the game-tying shot in game two of the series. Kole leads the OVC in walks (0.88/game). This week the Gobs will play a pair of non-conference games, Tuesday against Memphis at a neutral site in Jackson, Tenn. and Wednesday at Western Kentucky. This weekend the Gobs will host Jacksonville State, the team they topped last year in the OVC Tournament Championship game in Paducah.

**Eastern Illinois (8-9, 3-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois had its home opener with Monmouth College cancelled last Tuesday due to poor weather but finally got to open at home after 14 games away from home over the weekend. The Panthers hosted Morehead State in the OVC opening series for both teams and came out of the weekend with a 3-0 sweep with wins by margins of 3-2, 4-1 and 16-2. Junior OF Brett Nommensen had four hits, two doubles, scored three runs, drove in four runs and stole three bases during the series. He delivered a two-out, walk-off single to lift Eastern to a 3-2 victory in the series opener. Nommensen leads the OVC in stolen bases (0.53/game). In game two of the series, freshman Josh Mueller tossed a complete game victory in the 4-1 victory. Mueller allowed just two hits and walked two while striking out six in the seven-inning affair. Richie Derbak and Ryan Lindquist were each 5-for-10 with three RBI in the weekend series. Curt Restko was 5-for-6 in the series finale, posting the first five-hit game for an Eastern Illinois player since May 2006. The sweep of the Eagles marked the fourth straight year EIU has swept Morehead State in OVC play. After starting the season 0-7, the Panthers have won 8 of 10 and five in a row entering this week's games. This week the team play a home game with Southern Illinois, travels to Illinois State and then will play an OVC series at Tennessee Tech over the weekend.

**Eastern Kentucky (9-8-1, 2-1 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky opened OVC play this past weekend by hosting defending champion Austin Peay and taking two of three games from the Governors. EKV won the opener 2-1, lost the second game 7-5 in extra innings and came back the next day to win the finale 7-3. Colonels ace Christian Friedrich pitched through the flu on Friday, going six innings, allowing three hit, one run, walking two and striking out three as he claimed the victory. The All-American needs just five more strikeouts to become the school's all-time leader in that category. Junior Dylan McMaine had just three hits over the weekend, but two of those were home runs and he drove in three runs in providing a power punch for Eastern. He hit a two-run shot in game two of the series and a solo blast in game three. After the solo home run, McMaine did it with his glove, robbing APSU's Will Hogue of a three-run home run with a great catch in the outfield. EKV's leads the OVC with a 3.46 team E.R.A., which is 0.77 points lower than second place Southeast Missouri. This week the Colonels will host in-state foes Louisville and Kentucky State before traveling to Morehead State for a weekend OVC series.

**Jacksonville State (9-12, 2-1 OVC):** Jacksonville State was one of the few OVC teams to get around the weather and play a mid-week non-conference game, as the Gamecocks lost 4-3 at home to Georgia State. The two teams were supposed to play the next day in Atlanta, but that game was cancelled because of weather. Over the weekend Jax State hosted Murray State, sweeping a Friday doubleheader (4-3 and 2-1) before dropping the finale 8-6. Sophomore hurler Ben Tootle struck out a career-high 10 batters in the 2-1 game two victory over the Thoroughbreds. Tootle, who was named OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week, allowed one run on five hits and walked two in 6.1 innings as he picked up the victory. Senior OF Clay Whittemore is riding a team-best eight-game hitting streak as he has raised his batting average to .341, second-best on the JSU team. Steven Leach, who leads team in hitting (.351), was 4-for-5 in the 4-3 win over Murray State, as he drove in three runs. Jacksonville State is now 6-1 in one-run games this season. Sophomore pitcher Mitch Miller had a career-high 11 strikeouts in the series-opener while Nick Hetland struck out seven in five innings of work on Saturday. As a staff, Jax State pitchers struck out 39 and walked only eight over the weekend. JSU relievers Brian Booth (12) and Alex Jones (11) are at the top of the OVC leaders in appearances; Jones leads the league in saves (4). This week the team will play a home-and-away series with Alabama and then play at Austin Peay over the weekend.

**Morehead State (6-12, 0-3 OVC):** Morehead State had a game with No. 2 Kentucky rained out and then played their weekend OVC series at Eastern Illinois. The Eagles suffered a 3-0 sweep to EIU, marking the fourth straight year EIU has swept Morehead

The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held May 21-24 (25) at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

It marks the eighth consecutive year that the event will be held at a neutral site in Paducah. Prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites. The competition at the event has been incredibly close over the past eight years, as five different teams have claimed a tournament championship in that time frame.

Last season the Austin Peay Governors won the championship by defeating Jacksonville State 3-2 in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

State in OVC play. Morehead lost game one 3-2, game two 4-1 and then fell 16-2 in the finale. Sophomore pitcher Michael Bottoms lowered his season E.R.A. to 0.57 by not allowing an earned run in the opening game at EIU. Bottoms allowed only one hit and struck out four in 5.2 innings of work as he registered a no-decision. He served as MSU's designated hitter for both games of Friday's doubleheader, registering two hits and an RBI. This week the Eagles will play at West Virginia and then host Eastern Kentucky for an OVC series.

**Murray State (7-8, 1-2 OVC):** Murray State lost its first two games at Jacksonville State over the weekend (4-3 and 2-1) but rebounded to win the finale 8-6. Sophomore Wes Cunningham, extended his hitting streak to nine games as he was 5-for-10 with a triple and three RBI over the weekend. He was 3-for-5 with three RBI in the 8-6 win on Saturday. Sophomore Daniel Calhoun took a complete-game loss in game two of the series on Friday. He allowed only one earned run and walked one while striking out eight over six innings. The Thororoughbreds made just three errors over the weekend. Chris Craycraft got a no-decision in game one of the series despite going eight strong innings with allowing just one run. This week the T-Breds will play a home-and-away series with Lipscomb and then host Samford in OVC action.

**Samford (12-7, 3-0 OVC):** Samford opened the week with an 18-9 loss to Memphis but rebounded by sweeping UT Martin in a weekend OVC series. The Bulldogs topped the Skyhawks by scores of 5-3, 14-1 and 12-5 in Birmingham and are atop the OVC standings (with Eastern Illinois) after the first weekend of play. Junior SS Michael Marseco was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .625 (10-for-16), scoring six runs and adding a double, triple, home run and eight RBI in his four games. He had a 1.154 slugging percentage for the UT Martin series (1.000 for the week) and a .647 on-base percentage during the week. Junior pitcher Jonathan Stephens picked up an eight-inning victory in the game one 5-3 win. He allowed four hits and two runs while striking out two, as he held UTM batters to a .154 batting average. Stephens leads the league in innings pitched per game (6.60). Samford has won 9 of its last 11 games overall entering this week, including sweeping their last three weekend series. This week the Bulldogs will host Auburn at Regions Park on Wednesday and then travel to Murray State for a weekend series.

**Southeast Missouri (8-7, 2-1 OVC):** Southeast Missouri opened OVC play by taking two of three games from Tennessee Tech at home this past weekend. Sophomore catcher Jim Klocke was 6-for-9 (.667) at the plate with five runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. Klocke, last year's Freshman of the Year, slugged 1.556 for the weekend. He homered in consecutive at-bats in game one of the series (a 16-3 Southeast win) and in Sunday's finale had a pair of doubles. For the season Klocke is hitting .383 with six multiple-hit games; he leads the OVC in on-base percentage (.508). Junior OF Tyrell Cummings leads the OVC in home runs (0.33/game) and RBI (1.53/game). Senior hurler Dustin Renfrow, this week's OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week, tossed a complete game in the Redhawks 7-3 victory in the finale. He allowed four hits, walked only one and struck out six in nine innings. At one point of the contest he retired 11 straight Tech batters. James Leigh ran his record to 4-0 on the season, going seven innings and striking out eight in the Redhawks 16-3 victory in game one on Friday. His 0.75 E.R.A. ranks first in the OVC and should rank among the nation leaders when the first NCAA statistics are released on Tuesday. He also leads the OVC in strikeouts (13.50/game). As a team, Southeast's 4.23 E.R.A. is second (only behind EKU). That game saw Southeast Missouri hit six home runs. This week Southeast will play a home-and-home series with in-state rival Missouri State and then head to UT Martin for a weekend series.

**Tennessee Tech (14-7-1, 2-1 OVC):** Tennessee Tech was the only OVC team to get in a full week of action last week, playing two non-conference games with Dayton before traveling to Southeast Missouri for its OVC-opening series. TTU lost 14-8 to Dayton in the opener but came back to win 12-1 in a game that was limited to six innings due to poor weather conditions. Tennessee Tech then dropped the first and last games in the Southeast Missouri series, but managed a win in game two, 8-3. OF Jake New hit .429 (6-for-14) on the week, with a double, triple and team-best seven RBI. He drove in three runs in both the second game of the Dayton series and the second game of the Southeast series. Teammate Chris King extended his hitting streak to an OVC-best 21 games after hitting .400 (8-of-20) with three doubles and six RBI. Evan Webb's .414 average through 20 games leads the OVC while King is third (.413) and New fourth (.410). TTU's .330 team batting average is 16 points higher than second place Samford. Pitcher Adam Liberatore tossed a complete game against Dayton, allowing one unearned run, three hits and striking out three. The Golden Eagles will play at in-state rivals Middle Tennessee and East Tennessee this week before hosting Eastern Illinois.

**UT Martin (1-16, 0-3 OVC):** UT Martin played a weekend OVC series at Samford, dropping all three games by scores of 5-3, 14-1 and 12-5 in Birmingham. UTM did have a 4-1 lead early in the third game of the series before Samford's offensive punch proved to be too much. Junior Miles Hartsfield hit .417 in the three-game series, going 5-for-12 with three runs and a RBI. Freshman Wes Patterson hit .333 for the week, including a home run and five RBI. Junior Eric Walker pitched seven innings against Samford, striking out seven batters. UT Martin has now lost seven straight games entering this week's action. The Skyhawks will host Arkansas State on Tuesday, as new seating debuts at Skyhawk Field. The team will also travel to Southern Illinois and then host Southeast Missouri in OVC play this weekend.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

**OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights:** Week two of Conference play begins this week...Week one saw a pair of sweeps (Eastern Illinois over Morehead State and Samford over UT Martin) with the other three series ending 2-1...Eastern Illinois and Samford are atop of the standings but with 24 Conference games to be played anything can happen...Last season Austin Peay was swept the opening weekend but came back to finish 19-8 and claim the regular season (and later tournament) championship...Weather played havoc with OVC teams and their non-conference schedule last week, as nine games were cancelled or postponed due to the cold and/or wet weather; none of the 15 OVC games over the weekend were affected however...This weekend's games include in-state foes Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State facing off, undefeated Eastern Illinois at Tennessee Tech, Jacksonville State at Austin Peay in a re-match of last year's OVC Tournament Championship, Samford at Murray State and Southeast Missouri at UT Martin...OVC players will see where they rank among the nation's best players on Tuesday (March 25) when the first set of NCAA statistical leaders are released.

**Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award:** Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

**Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite:** In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

**Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year:** In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

**OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah:** For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.
