THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Matt Wagner, 1B • Jr., 6-4, 225 • Wahoo, Neb. • Southeast Missouri

Wagner hit .625 (5-for-8) in three games this week as the Redhawks split a pair of games with in-state rival Missouri State and won a Conference game at UT Martin before Mother Nature rained out the final two in that series. Wagner scored four runs, added a double, two home runs, eight RBI and a 1.500 slugging percentage in his three starts. He was 2-for-4 with a home run in a 6-2 win over Missouri State, the team's first win over their rival since 2004. The following day he added a clutch two-out, three-run double to put Southeast on top 6-5 in the seventh inning, although SEMO would eventually lose 7-6. In a five-inning rain-shortened game at UT Martin, Wagner hit a two-run home run and added three RBI.

Alcorn tossed a two-hit, complete game shutout in the Golden Eagles 1-0 eight-inning victory over Eastern Illinois on Saturday. Alcorn struck out 10 batters in the game and issued only one walk. The game was scheduled for seven innings but went into extra frames after no offensive could push a run across after seven innings. After allowing two hits and a walk in the first inning, Alcorn retired 22 consecutive EIU batters to end the game.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (12-11, 2-4 OVC): The Governors played five games last week, winning a pair of non-conference games before winning one of three against Jacksonville State in OVC play over the weekend. Austin Peay finds itself in seventh place in the Conference standings after two weeks of OVC play. Sophomore utility man Matt Kole had a great week, as he saw action at first base, designated hitter and on the mound. At the plate he hit .471 (8-for-17) with five runs, three doubles, a triple and seven RBI; he hit safely in all five games last week. Against Western Kentucky (a 9-3 APSU win) he had a two-run double and RBI triple that scored what was the winning run. He later came into that game as a reliever, throwing three innings of one-hit baseball. Austin Peay recorded its first blown save (after converting its first seven opportunities on the year) in a 7-6 12-inning loss to Jacksonville State on Saturday. The team recorded its eighth save of the season in Sunday's 4-1 win; the school record for saves in a season is 13 (2004 season). On the other hand, ASPU pitchers hit their 43rd batter of the season over the weekend; the school record for hit batters in a season is 73 and the NCAA record is 87 (New Mexico State in 1999). Third baseman Tyler Farrar hit three home runs on the week. This week the Govs will play a pair of games at Mississippi State and return home to host Morehead State in OVC play over the weekend.

Eastern Illinois (9-13, 3-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois split a pair of non-conference games last week - losing 3-1 to Southern Illinois and winning 7-5 in 11 innings at Illinois State - before being swept at Tennessee Tech in OVC play over the weekend. Two of those losses to TTU were by a 1-0 score and one of those went into extra innings. Freshman hurler Josh Mueller pitched into the eighth inning in the 1-0 eight-inning affair on Saturday. He surrendered just two hits and struck out 10, the first double-digit strikeout performance by an EIU pitcher since the 2005 season. He would suffer the loss as Eastern lost 1-0. The pair of losses by 1-0 scores marked only the third time since the 2004 season that EIU had played in a 1-0 game. Tyler Kehrner, who also started the SIU game, started the series finale with Tech on Sunday. He allowed just one earned run while striking out eight in 10.1 innings in the two contests. Mike Recchia made his collegiate debut against Illinois State. Richie Derbak would come into that game in relief and pick up the victory, after pitching four innings of one-hit baseball. Tristan Facer hit his first collegiate home run in the 11th inning at Illinois State on Wednesday to push the Panthers to the 7-5 victory. EIU will begin a season-long seven-game home stand this week. Monmouth College comes to town on Tuesday for a make-up game of a previously cancelled contest and will be followed by Chicago State on Wednesday. The team hosts UT Martin on Conference play this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (11-10-1, 4-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky lost its only non-conference game of the week - against Louisville - and then went on the road to win two of three games against Morehead State. That leaves the Colonels, picked third in the preseason poll, in a three-way tie for third place after two weekends of OVC play. The Colonels lost the opener with Morehead, falling 3-2 in 11 innings, before coming back to win 7-3 and 17-7 over the final two games. Freshman OF Ryan Faidley hit .467 (7-for-15) with three runs, three doubles, seven RBI and three stolen bases in four games. He raised his season batting average by 41 points (to .303) with the performance. Faidley has 10 steals on the season (0.50/game) which leads the Conference. Junior All-American Christian Friedrich struck out 13 batters in seven innings against MSU over the weekend. Friedrich struggled with his control early, not did not allow a run after the first inning and allowed only two hits for the entire game. He also became the Colonels career strikeout leader (273) and his 12.90 strikeouts per 9 innings ranks first in the OVC. This week EKV will play two games with Georgetown (Ky.) College, Tuesday at home and Wednesday at Applebee's Park in Lexington (home of the Class A Lexington Legends). The team hosts Tennessee Tech, who is also 4-2 in Conference action, in OVC play this weekend in what could prove to be an important series for both teams.

Jacksonville State (11-15, 4-2 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a pair of non-conference games against SEC-power Alabama during the week but bounced back by winning two of three games from OVC rival Austin Peay over the weekend in Clarksville. The two teams squared off in last year's OVC Tournament Championship; JSU has now won five of the last six regular season games between the teams. Overall Jax State, this year's OVC preseason favorite, has won five straight OVC series dating back to the end of last season. They are 4-2 in OVC play this year which puts them into a three-way tie for third place. Freshman OF Todd Cunningham hit .526 (10-for-19) with seven runs, a double, home run and four RBI last week. He posted a .737 slugging percentage for the week. Junior reliever Alex Jones continued to impress this season and he appeared in two games and came away with his fourth victory (to go along with four saves) of the season. He pitched a career-long 4.2 innings in the Gamecocks 7-6 12-inning win over Austin Peay in picking up the win. He recorded a career-best seven strikeouts in that game; Jones is tied for second in wins in the OVC. In JSU's 19-7 victory in game one of Sunday's doubleheader, head coach Jim Case picked up his 200th career victory as a head coach. Case has an impressive 76-38 (67%) record in OVC-only games in his career. JSU has been hitting the ball better lately and has double-digit hits in four of its last six games. Jax State is also now 7-1 in one-run games this season. The team will not have a mid-week non-conference game this week but will instead take the week off before hosting in-state rival Samford for OVC play this weekend.

Morehead State (7-16, 1-5 OVC): Morehead State dropped a mid-week non-conference tilt at West Virginia and then lost two of three games to in-state rival Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. The team's lone win, its first in OVC play this season, came in Saturday's opener, as MSU won 3-2 in 11 innings. Freshman Jake Helvey picked up the win over EKV in relief and made two appearances during the week. He pitched a perfect inning against WVU and then pitched the

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

final three innings against Eastern. In that stint he allowed only one hit and struck out five. In what was a true rarity at the "friendly confines" of Allen Field, neither Morehead State nor Eastern Kentucky hit a home run during the three-game weekend series. Sophomore Michael Bottoms hit a home run at West Virginia and finished the week with a .350 batting average and four RBI. Senior OF Eric Allen had a .609 on-base percentage for the week; he had four hits, walked nine times and was hit by a pitch. Allen is third in the OVC with 0.78 walks/game this season. MSU will play host regional rival Marshall on Wednesday (the game was originally scheduled in Huntington but changed due to field conditions) and then travel to Austin Peay for an OVC series this weekend.

Murray State (8-11, 1-4 OVC): The Thoroughbreds split a non-conference home-and-home series with Lipscomb last week and then dropped two OVC games at home to Samford. The team's final game with Samford was cancelled due to weather. Sophomore OF Wes Cunningham hit .538 (7-for-13) with two runs and three RBI in four games last week. He was 5-for-7 against Lipscomb and 2-for-3 in the two games against the Bulldogs. Sophomore pitcher Chris Craycraft tossed a complete-game against Samford but was saddled with the loss as his team fell 2-0. He pitched nine innings and allowed five hits, walked two and struck out nine. The team compiled only a 1-3 record this week but was only outscored by two total runs. Kyle Tiernan hit .429 (6-for-14) on the week with three runs, a double and triple. Elliot Frey batted .375 (6-for-16) with five runs and three RBI during the week. The T-Breds will host Belmont for a non-conference double-dip on Wednesday and then turn its attention to OVC play this weekend when they travel to Southeast Missouri.

Samford (14-8, 5-0 OVC): Samford dropped a neutral site decision to Auburn last week and then traveled to Murray State and swept a doubleheader from the Thoroughbreds. The series finale between the two teams was rained out on Sunday. Junior pitcher Jonathan Stephens tossed a complete game shutout in the Bulldogs 2-0 victory in game one against MSU. Stephens allowed six hits, walked one and struck out four over nine innings in picking up his fourth victory of the season. Stephens, who is now 4-1 with a 1.93 E.R.A. on the season, allowed Murray to hit only .194 against him. At the plate OF Wayne Miller hit .455 (5-for-11) with three runs, a double and two RBI. The Bulldogs continued their weekend success this year as they swept their fourth straight weekend series with the two wins over Murray State. Samford has swept each Miami (Ohio), Rider, UT Martin and Murray State over the past month and are 14-3 in weekend series games this season. On the other hand, Samford is 0-5 in midweek games this year. The Bulldogs, who are the only undefeated team in OVC play and are in first place, will play at Mercer and host Georgia State this week. Following those two non-conference games they will play at in-state rival and OVC preseason favorite Jacksonville State this weekend.

Southeast Missouri (10-8, 3-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri split a pair of games with in-state for Missouri State before winning the series opener with UT Martin over the weekend. But Mother Nature hurt the Redhawks the rest of the weekend, as the final two games against UT Martin was cancelled due to rain. Southeast remains 3-1 in OVC play, which is second behind Samford (5-0). Matt Wagner was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .625 (5-for-8) with four runs, a double, two home runs and eight RBI last week. He had a two-run in Tuesday's 6-2 win over Missouri State (SEMO's first against the Bears since 2004). In the second game of that series, he had a key two-out, three-run double that put his team ahead in the seventh inning. He homered in Saturday's five-inning, rain-shortened game against UT Martin. On the mound, junior Jake Kemper picked up a save in the win over Missouri State. He pitched the final four innings of the game, allowing just one hit and striking out six. Southeast head coach Mark Hogan now has 397 victories in his 13 years at SEMO and needs just three more wins to become the seventh coach in OVC history to reach the 400-win plateau. The Redhawks will play at Evansville on Wednesday (the game was originally scheduled for Capaha Field but changed last week) and then host Murray State in OVC play.

Tennessee Tech (19-7-1, 4-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech won all five of its games last week, including non-conference games at Middle Tennessee and East Tennessee, and a three-game home sweep of OVC foe Eastern Illinois. The Golden Eagles, the OVC's leading hitting team (.328) proved it could also pitch it last week, beating EIU by scores of 8-3, 1-0 (8 innings) and 1-0 in Cookeville. Michael Alcorn earned OVC Pitcher of the Week honors after tossing the eight-inning complete game shutout in game two. He allowed two hits and a walk in the first inning and then retired 22 consecutive Eastern batters to close out the game. Alcorn struck out a career-best 10 in the victory. In Sunday's finale, Jared Dobbs tossed a nine-inning complete game, allowing three hits, walking one and striking out five in the victory. Overall for the week, seven of the 10 TTU pitchers combined to pitch 33.0 innings in which they allowed just one earned run. Junior infielder Chris King saw his 24-game hitting streak come to an end during game two of Saturday's doubleheader. He did, however, hit .550 (11-for-20) for the week with seven runs, two doubles, five RBI and a stolen base. King leads the OVC with a .438 batting average. This week Tech will host Tennessee and then travel to Eastern Kentucky for a weekend OVC series.

UT Martin (1-19, 0-4 OVC): UT Martin lost a pair of non-conference games during the week - 12-6 vs. Arkansas State and 6-3 against Southern Illinois - before losing its only OVC game (19-6 in 5 innings) to Southeast Missouri. Mother Nature caused UTM to cancel its final two games against Southeast Missouri. The Skyhawks now find themselves having lost 10 in a row; they are the only OVC team not to win a Conference game yet this season. Starting catcher Chris Rezabek was injured early last week and missed the rest of the week; Jay Howard and Lucas Wilmore saw action in his place. Junior Scott Gladstone hit .500 with three runs, a double, home run, four RBI and a .900 slugging percentage during the week. He was 2-for-3 with a home run and four RBI off Southeast starter James Leigh, who had entered the week as the league's E.R.A. leader. Overall UT Martin tagged Leigh for eight hits and six earned runs in the five-inning affair on Saturday. UTM turned five double plays last week and now has 24 on the season; the squad ranked 21st nationally in double plays turned last week. The Skyhawks will play at Arkansas State and then battle Lipscomb at a neutral site in Union City on Wednesday. This weekend the team travels to Eastern Illinois for a three-game OVC series.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Mother Nature claimed three OVC contests last weekend, as poor weather led the cancellation of the final game of the Samford/Murray State series and final two games of the Southeast Missouri/UT Martin series...Per OVC policy those games will not be made up and could figure big into the final OVC standings at the end of the year...Samford did win two of three against Murray State and remains the only undefeated team in OVC play; the Bulldogs are 5-0 and have a 1.5 game lead over four teams in the Conference...UT Martin, on the other hand, lost its only OVC game and is the only winless team in the league...Tennessee Tech, the Conference's leading hitting squad (.328) proved it can pitch last weekend too, as a pair of pitchers tossed complete games shutouts in identical 1-0 victories over Eastern Illinois...Tech leads the Conference in eight different offensive team categories (average, slugging, on-base percentage, runs, hits, RBI, total bases, strikeouts)...TTU's Chris King saw a 24-game hitting streak come to an end last week; the streak was the longest by an OVC hitter this season...Eastern Kentucky is the top pitching team in the league with a 3.98 Team E.R.A.; Colby Brown leads the league in E.R.A. (1.84) while Christian Friedrich is third (2.15)...Samford's Jonathan Stephens is second in the OVC in E.R.A. (1.93) and tossed a nine-inning complete game in the Bulldogs 2-0 win over Murray State...This weekend's game feature the league's leading hitting team (Tennessee Tech) at the league's leading pitcher team (Eastern Kentucky), as well as Morehead State at Austin Peay, Murray State at Southeast Missouri, Samford at Jacksonville State and UT Martin at Eastern Illinois.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley Conference history to be listed as one of the 30 Baseball Nominees.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.
