THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Clay Whittemore, OF • Sr., 6-1, 180 • Cullman, Ala. • Jacksonville State
Whittemore picked up his second OVC Player of the Week award of the season after hitting an amazing .714 (15-of-21) last week as Jacksonville State compiled a 4-0 record. That record included a sweep of Morehead State, as the Gamecocks outscored the Eagles 53-16 in a three-game set. Whittemore scored 13 runs, had four doubles, four home runs and eight RBI to go along with a 1.476 slugging percentage. He raised his batting average by 42 points (to a team-best .401) on the week by posting three straight four-hit games and a three-hit game. He also set a JSU record with 11 total bases in Saturday's 18-5 victory in which he had a pair of home runs. Whittemore has hits in 17 of his last 19 games and leads JSU with 20 multiple-hit and 12 multiple-RBI games on the year.

PITCHER

Christian Friedrich, LHP • Jr., 6-3, 208 • Evanston, Ill. • Eastern Kentucky
Friedrich was nearly perfect in Eastern Kentucky's 10-0 victory over Samford on Saturday. In eight innings of work, he allowed only one base runner (a double in the second inning) while striking out nine and not walking a batter. After allowing the double, he retired the final 20 batters that he faced in improving to 5-1 with a 1.78 E.R.A. on the season. Opponents are now hitting just .142 against him on the season. It marks the third time this season he was won the award (March 3, March 17) and the fifth time in his career.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (23-23, 11-10 OVC): Austin Peay took two of three games from UT Martin this weekend (and dropped the third game in extra innings) as they improved to 11-10 in OVC play this season. That put the defending OVC Champions in a three-way tie for third place overall with six Conference games remaining. Just two weeks ago the Governors were in seventh place and on the outside looking in on the OVC Tournament race. Overall the Govs have won three straight Conference series. They took game one from UTM by a 13-3 margin before falling 4-2 in 10 innings. That snapped a streak of 13 straight wins against the Skyhawks. Sophomore Daniel Baggett notched his first collegiate home run - a grand slam - in the first game of the series. It was one of four APSU home runs in that game. Senior OF Will Hogue moved into Austin Peay's single season Top 10 doubles list (20). The team's other OF - senior Rafael Hill - has raised his batting average to .386 and is now fifth among all OVC players. Pitcher Stephen Huff is now fifth in the league in E.R.A. (3.53). This week the Govs will play non-conference games with Middle Tennessee and Evansville at home, and then travel to Eastern Illinois for a three-game OVC series. APSU and EIU are tied in the Conference standings with identical 11-10 marks.

Eastern Illinois (20-24, 11-10 OVC): Eastern Illinois won two of three games from Southeast Missouri over the weekend to improve to 11-10 in OVC play, which puts them in a three-way tie for third place. After losing the series opener 16-7, EIU bounced back with a 15-3 victory in game two of Saturday's doubleheader and finished off the Redhawks with a come-from-behind 6-5 win on Sunday. The momentum started for the Panthers in the bottom of the ninth of game one, as they scored five times and rode that momentum into the blowout in game two. That win snapped a season-long eight-game losing streak. In the finale Eastern scored three runs in the bottom of the ninth to pull off the win; Tristan Facer delivered the game-winning hit, a two-run bases loaded single with one out. Facer also picked up the win in game two on Saturday, pitching 4.1 innings of three-run ball. OF Brett Nommensen hit .700 (7-for-10) with four runs, four doubles and three RBI last week; he also registered four walks during the series and had a .786 on-base percentage for the week. Nommensen doubled in the first run of the ninth inning in Sunday's comeback victory. Junior Brian Morrell pitched 8.2 innings during the week, including seven in relief on Sunday. He struck out a career-high eight in that win, keeping the Panthers close and allowing the comeback. Zach Skidmore had a grand slam during the series, the first by an EIU player since March 2005. Curt Restko has not struck out in 51 consecutive at-bats and 60 straight plate appearances. This week EIU will play at Indiana State and Chicago State during the week and then host Austin Peay for a crucial OVC series. EIU and APSU are deadlocked at 11-10 in the OVC standings.

Eastern Kentucky (22-24-1, 9-12 OVC): Eastern Kentucky compiled a 2-3 overall record last week, splitting a pair of non-conference games with Miami (Ohio) and then taking one of three OVC games from Samford. The Colonels topped Miami at home (9-7) before losing in Oxford (14-6) during the week. In the opening game of their OVC series with Samford, junior All-American Christian Friedrich was un-hittable, shutting down the league's second place team. Friedrich allowed just one hit and one total base runner in the game, as EKU won 10-0. He allowed a double in the second inning and nothing else the rest of the game, as he struck out nine batters in eight innings. He was named OVC Pitcher of the Week for the third time this season and fifth in his career for the outing. Junior OF Dylan McMaine hit .471 (8-for-17) with seven runs, a double, two home runs, seven RBI and three stolen bases in five games. Freshman Jayson Langfels recorded his seventh triple of the season on Sunday, which gave him the EKU record for triples in a single season. The Colonels are currently in seventh place in the OVC standings with six Conference games to play; EKU is one game behind Southeast Missouri for sixth place, although both teams have nine wins. Those two teams will meet this weekend in Cape Girardeau in what should prove to be a pivotal series for both teams.

Jacksonville State (27-18, 17-4 OVC): Jacksonville State won all four of its games last week to run its win streak to seven games (they have won 14 of 16 overall). Overall the Gamecocks have won eight straight OVC games and 10 straight OVC series, dating back to last season. JSU is 17-4 in OVC and has a 1.5 game lead over Samford in the OVC standings; JSU has already clinched a spot in the six-team OVC Tournament. The Gamecocks entered last week with 15 total home runs on the season and had an incredible offensive week as they hit 16 home runs in four games. They scored 71 runs in four games, including outscoring Morehead State 53-16 in a three-game series. Senior All-American Clay Whittemore was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .714 (15-for-21) with 13 runs, four doubles, four home runs and eight RBI. He raised his batting average by 42 points and is now hitting .401 on the season. He had four hits in three straight games last week and ended the week with three hits in the finale against MSU. Whittemore now has 233 career hits, which is third in JSU history, 16 off the program's career record; his 157 RBI is now fifth all-time as well. He is batting .475 in league games this season. Brian Piazza also hit four home runs last week, while Steven Leach added three and Andrew Edge hit two. Overall in the Morehead State series the Gamecocks hit .478 with 64 hits, 53 runs, eight doubles, 15 home runs, 45 RBI and a .873 slugging percentage. Sophomore Ben Tootle improved to 6-0 on the year with a win on Saturday. Brian Booth is now 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA in OVC play this season. Freshman Jordan Beistline allowed just two hits over seven innings in Sunday's win. This week the Gamecocks will play at UAB (and also complete the suspended game with the Blazers from April 22) and then host Tennessee Tech.

2008 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held May 21-24 (25) at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

It marks the eighth consecutive year that the event will be held at a neutral site in Paducah. Prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites. The competition at the event has been incredibly close over the past eight years, as five different teams have claimed a tournament championship in that time frame.

Last season the Austin Peay Governors won the championship by defeating Jacksonville State 3-2 in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

Morehead State (16-29, 6-15 OVC): Morehead State dropped all four of its contests last week, falling 2-0 at in-state rival Louisville and then being swept by a hot-hitting Jacksonville State team in OVC play. JSU outscored the Eagles 53-16 in the three games. SS Drew Lee had a 14-game hitting streak stopped in Sunday's 13-1 loss to JSU. He had homered in both ends of Saturday's doubleheader. Lee had four hits on the week and leads Morehead with a .324 batting average for the season. Michael Fear led MSU with four RBI in four games last week; Fear is hitting .297 in 35 games this year. The Eagles are off during the week to take final exams but return to action this weekend with a three-game series at Samford, the OVC's second-place team.

Murray State (17-26, 8-12 OVC): Murray State dropped its first four games of the week before rebounding to claim its series finale with Tennessee Tech by a 3-1 margin. The Thoroughbreds are now 8-12 in OVC play 1.5 games out of sixth place in the OVC standings. In non-conference action last week, Murray State lost 6-5 in 11 innings at Evansville and fell 14-11 to Southern Illinois at home. Despite his team's struggles, junior 3B Tyler Owen had a great offensive week, hitting .619 (13-for-21) with four runs, two doubles, a triple and four RBI. He slugged .810 and had a .609 on-base percentage during the week. After starting the season 0-for-25, Owen has now raised his season batting average to .312. Senior pitcher Mike Perconte tossed a complete game in MSU's 3-1 win over TTU on Sunday. Perconte scattered five hits and walked one while striking out a career-best 12 batters in a 148-pitch effort (94 of which were strikes). It marked the second straight season he has thrown a complete game against Tech. It was his second complete game of the season and Murray State's 10th as a team. Wes Cunningham has now reached base in 37 straight games. His .402 batting average is second in the OVC (.014 points behind the Conference leader). As a team Murray State fifth in team E.R.A. (5.49) although three pitchers rank in the Top 10. Daniel Calhoun ranks fourth (3.22), Chris Craycraft is seventh (4.54) and Perconte is ninth (4.67). This week the Thoroughbreds will play host to UT Martin in OVC action.

Samford (29-18, 15-5 OVC): Samford dropped a pair of non-conference games and the opening game at Eastern Kentucky before rebounding to win the final two from the Colonels to improve to 29-18 overall and 15-5 in OVC play. The Bulldogs, who have clinched a spot in this year's OVC Tournament, are 1.5 games behind Conference leader Jacksonville State. They can clinch the No. 2 seed in the tournament (and first round bye) with two more OVC victories. Junior SS Michael Marseco extended his career-best hitting streak to 29 games with hits against Alabama and Georgia State to open the week. Entering last weekend, the 29 games was the longest active streak among Division I players; but the streak ended in a 10-0 loss on Saturday to ECU. His streak is believed to be the third longest in Division I this season. For the week Marseco hit .474 (9-for-19) with six runs, a double, home runs, three RBI and a stolen base. Junior lefty Kyle Nichols earned a win and save on the mound last week. He got the victory in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader and game back in the second game to pick up the save. In total, he pitched 3.2 innings, allowing only one hit, a walk and striking out three. This week the Bulldogs will play at Lipscomb in non-conference action and then host Morehead State in OVC play.

Southeast Missouri (19-20, 9-10 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped two of three games last week, winning the series opener from Eastern Illinois before dropping the final two games in the series. That left the Redhawks with a 9-10 overall record in OVC play, which puts them in sixth place in the standings with two weeks to play. Southeast is tied in the win column with Eastern Kentucky, but holds a game lead in the standings thanks to having played two less games. This week the two teams will meet this weekend in Cape Girardeau, which could go a long way to determining who the final team in this year's OVC Tournament will be. Sophomore catcher Jim Klocke hit .429 (6-for-14) with six RBI last week while Matt Wagner added five hits (.417 average) with three RBI. Senior pitcher Dustin Renfrow pitched 7.1 innings in the team's victory over EIU on Saturday. He allowed seven hits, two runs and struck out six in picking up the victory. The Redhawks have no mid-week games this week, as they only play ECU over the weekend.

Tennessee Tech (31-16-1, 11-10 OVC): Tennessee Tech became the first OVC game reach the 30-win plateau with a pair of victories over Murray State last weekend. The Golden Eagles swept a doubleheader from the Thoroughbreds on Saturday before dropping the finale 3-1. Tech is now 11-10 overall in OVC play, which puts them into a three-way tie for third place with two weeks to play. Chris King hit .400 (4-for-10) with two RBI while Evan Webb hit .364 (4-for-11) with two doubles and three RBI. Sophomore hurler Jared Dobbs closed out the game on Sunday, pitching the final three innings, striking out six and allowing only one hit. Michael Alcorn allowed six hits and three runs (two earned) over seven innings to pick up Tech's other victory on the mound. As a team the Golden Eagles still lead the OVC in batting (.323) and now rank third in team E.R.A. (4.90).

UT Martin (10-34, 5-14 OVC): UT Martin split a non-conference doubleheader with Belmont to begin last week and then took one of three from Austin Peay over the weekend. After dropping the opener to APSU, the Skyhawks rebounded with a 4-2, 10-inning victory on Sunday. Senior pitcher Calen Sutton pitched nine innings, allowing just two hits and walking five while striking six. Had a line drive been caught, he would have ended up not giving up any runs (he allowed two) and would have recorded his second straight shutout. After UTM scored twice in the top of the 10th, Wes Patterson came on to record the final three outs and pick up his fourth save of the season. He is now sixth in UTM history for career saves. Senior Will Blackmon hit two home runs in the victory over Belmont. Blackmon and Patterson are now tied for the team lead with eight round-trippers in 2008. Blackmon's 14-game hitting streak is now the longest active streak in the OVC. This week the Skyhawks will play at Murray State in their only action of the week.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Jacksonville State increased its lead in the OVC standings to 1.5 games over Samford this week, as the Gamecocks swept Morehead State and Samford dropped one of three games at Eastern Kentucky...Both of those teams have clinched spots in the 6-team OVC Tournament field; JSU can clinch a first round bye with one more victory while Samford can do the same with two more wins...Following those teams Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech are locked at 11-10 overall while Southeast Missouri State and Eastern Kentucky are sixth and seventh with both teams deadlocked at nine wins...This week Southeast Missouri and Eastern Kentucky will play a three-game set in Cape Girardeau, and the series will go a long way in determining the OVC Tournament field...Austin Peay and Eastern Illinois, who are deadlocked in the three-way tie for third, will also do battle this weekend...Jacksonville State will host Tennessee Tech while UT Martin and Murray State and Morehead State and Samford will also do battle.

Friedrich Named to Dick Howser Trophy Watch List: Eastern Kentucky junior pitcher **Christian Friedrich** has been named to the 2008 Dick Howser Trophy Watch List, given annually to college baseball's premier player. The list, composed of 50 players, was released April 24 by the National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association (NCBWA). Friedrich is 5-1 this season with a 1.78 ERA, a .142 opponent batting average and 86 strikeouts in only 65.2 innings of work. His 12.60 strikeouts per nine innings is sixth best in the nation, and he recently became ECU's career strikeout leader with 290. A preseason All-American, Friedrich is rated by Baseball America as the sixth-best MLB prospect in college baseball. The southpaw from Evanston, Ill. has already been named a finalist for the Brooks Wallace and Roger Clemens Awards, and was voted the 2008 preseason OVC Pitcher of the Year earlier this year. The membership of the NCBWA will choose the Dick Howser Trophy based on three rounds of voting. The 2008 winner will be announced at the College World Series in Omaha on Saturday, June 14, at 10:00 a.m. CDT. The Dick Howser Trophy, given in memory of the former Florida State University All-America shortstop and major league player and manager who died of brain cancer in 1987, is regarded by many as college baseball's most prestigious award.

Victories Over Ranked Opponents: Southeast Missouri State scored the OVC's first victory over a ranked opponent in 2008 with a 12-8 win over No. 6 Vanderbilt on April 2. OVC teams are now 1-5 against nationally-ranked teams this season. Last season the OVC compiled a 9-22 record against nationally-ranked foes, including a Tennessee Tech victory over No. 13 Alabama and a two-game sweep of No. 13 Mississippi State by Austin Peay.

APSU's Cunningham Ties OVC Record For Hits in a Game: Austin Peay junior **Chad Cunningham** tied the OVC record for hits in a game in a 26-4 win over Morehead State on April 5. Cunningham was 6-for-7 at the plate in the Govs victory. He tied a mark that is also held by eight other players.

Coaching Milestones: UT Martin head coach **Bubba Cates** became the latest OVC coach to reach a career milestone when he won his 400th career game on April 26. Earlier in the week Tennessee Tech head coach **Matt Bragga** also hit a milestone, as he reached his 100 career victory. Earlier this season Jacksonville State head coach **Jim Case** won his 200th career game, Samford coach **Casey Dunn** won his 100th career game and **Mark Hogan** won his 400th game at Southeast Missouri. Hogan may reach another milestone this season as he needs nine more wins to reach 800 overall for his career. Murray State head coach **Rob McDonald** needs only five wins to reach 100 for his career.

Whittemore Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior Class Award: Jacksonville State outfielder **Clay Whittemore** is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior Class Award, which is awarded to a senior baseball player who excels both on and off the field. Presented annually to NCAA Division I student-athletes in eight sports, the award focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. Whittemore was named the 2008 Ohio Valley Conference pre-season Player of the Year and is also a pre-season All-American by Collegiate Baseball. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched in 2001 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who fulfill their entire athletic eligibility and pursue their degree. Since that time, Lowe's, an official corporate partner of the NCAA, has expanded the award to include other NCAA sports including baseball. From the list of 30 nominees, a national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those ten names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. Whittemore becomes the first player in Ohio Valley

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches, Jacksonville State was picked as the favorite in the 10-team OVC. The Gamecocks finished second in both the regular season and tournament last season. The overall voting for the preseason poll was balanced and close, as three teams received first-place votes and only two points separated the favorite, Jacksonville State, from second-place, defending champion Austin Peay. Jacksonville State received four of the first-place votes and 76 total points, which put them ahead of the Governors, who actually received one more first-place vote (5 in total) but finished two points behind the Gamecocks in their overall points total (74). Eastern Kentucky received the other first place vote and was predicted to finish third (61 points). The Colonels were followed closely by Southeast Missouri State, who was picked fourth (59), and Samford, who was predicted to place fifth (55). Eastern Illinois was tabbed sixth (38), followed by Murray State in seventh (30), Tennessee Tech in eighth (29), Morehead State in ninth (15) and UT Martin in 10th (13).

Whittemore and Friedrich Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches Jacksonville State senior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** was picked as the Preseason Player of the Year while Eastern Kentucky junior left-handed pitcher **Christian Friedrich** was named the Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Whittemore claimed the Player of the Year award at the end of last season after hitting .391 with 93 hits, 53 runs and 69 RBI in 60 games. Whittemore was named a preseason All-American by several outlets (including *Collegiate Baseball News*) and is one of three OVC players on the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Watch List. Friedrich compiled a 5-4 record and 2.09 ERA in 81.2 innings pitched last season. He also tossed three complete games, limited opponents to a .155 batting average and struck out 101 batters. He also enjoyed a successful summer with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod League where he compiled a 4-1 record, 2.68 ERA and struck out 52 in 37.0 innings of work (7 starts). Friedrich is also on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List and has been named a preseason All-American.

OVC Baseball Championship to Once Again Be Held in Paducah: For the eighth consecutive season the Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games May 21-24 (25). The event has seen five different teams win a title in the last seven years with Austin Peay capturing the championship a year ago.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2008 season, there were four players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Those players include: Jacksonville State's **Todd Jones** (Detroit), Morehead State's **Jon Rauch** (Washington), Austin Peay's **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and **Jaime Walker** (Baltimore). Three other players - Eastern Kentucky's **Josh Anderson** (Atlanta); Samford's **Ehren Wassermann** (Chicago White Sox) and Jacksonville State's **Bill White** (Texas) were on MLB rosters to end last season but are starting the season in the minors but are expected to be called up later this season.
