THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Jordan Kreke, SS/P • Sr., 6-2, 200 • Bartelso, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Kreke earned his third OVC Player of the Week honor in the last four weeks after leading the nationally-ranked Panthers to three wins in four games last week. Kreke hit .588 (10-for-17) with nine runs scored, three home runs and 11 RBI in the four games. He was 5-for-6 with runners in scoring position and 4-for-4 with two outs. Kreke collected three hits in three of his team's four games last week. He hit a three-run home run against Indiana State to begin the week and posted his second multi-homer game of the season hitting two round-trippers against UT Martin on Saturday. In that game (a 30-3 Panther win), Kreke hit a grand slam and drove in six RBI. He also pitched a pair of 1-2-3 innings during the week, striking out three of the six batters he faced.

Chris Craycraft, RHP • Jr., 6-1, 190 • Lexington, Ky. • Murray State

Craycraft pitched eight solid innings in the Thoroughbreds 25-2 victory over Southeast Missouri State on Friday. Craycraft allowed just four hits, two unearned runs and two walks while striking out eight Redhawk batters. He retired the first seven hitters of the game he faced and struck out two batters in each the fourth and fifth innings. Craycraft improved to 5-2 on the season and carries a 3.83 E.R.A. in eight appearances.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (14-20, 2-6 OVC): Austin Peay started the week with a non-conference victory over Lipscomb but then dropped its final three games, losing at Evansville and dropping an OVC doubleheader at Morehead State on Saturday. By topping Lipscomb to begin the week the Governors extended its winning streak to a season-high four games. At Morehead State the team ran into poor weather, as one of the scheduled three games in the series was cancelled due to rain. On Saturday the team lost identical 3-1 decisions to the Eagles. Austin Peay is now just 2-12 on the road this season as opposed to 12-8 at home. Sophomore Greg Bachman led the team with a .467 (7-of-15) average last week. It was freshman Jeremy Dobbs who picked up the team's lone win; he allowed two runs and struck out nine in 6.2 innings of work against Lipscomb. After stealing 38-of-41 bases on the season entering last weekend's MSU series, the Gobs failed to steal a base against the Eagles. APSU will look to end its losing streak with a home game against Western Kentucky on Tuesday. The team will then play Memphis in Jackson, Tenn. and host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (24-6, 9-1 OVC): Eastern Illinois extended its winning streak to 13 games (the longest active streak in the nation at the time) with a non-conference victory over Indiana State and a win over UT Martin in game one of its doubleheader on Friday. But the streak came to an end when UTM won 10-3 in the second game of that doubleheader. The Panthers, however, rebounded with a convincing 30-3 victory over the Skyhawks in the finale to improve to 24-6 overall and 9-1 in the OVC. Overall the Panthers have won 18 of their last 20 games. In the 30-3 victory, the Panthers hit nine home runs (one shy of the program record) and scored 30 runs, which is the most by an EIU team since joining the OVC in 1996. The team has hit 47 home runs during its last 20 games. Eastern has scored 20 or more runs four different times this season (including twice last week) and had double-figure runs in 10 of its last 15 games. Senior Jordan Kreke was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .588 (10-of-17) with nine runs scored, three home runs and 11 RBI in four games last week. He had six RBI (including a grand slam) in the finale against UTM. It is the third time in the last four weeks he has been named OVC Player of the Week. Josh Mueller pitched a nine inning complete game on Friday, striking out nine to improve to 6-0 on the season. Mike Recchia is also 6-0 on the season and winning Sunday's game. Eastern Illinois will look to continue its hot streak this week when they play at in-state rival Illinois on Tuesday. Illinois is 21-8 overall and receiving votes in the national polls. The Panthers host Blackburn on Tuesday and then battle preseason OVC favorite Jacksonville State in a three-game set in Charleston this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (18-13, 6-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky entered last week having won seven of its last nine games. The Colonels had to go on the road for four contests last week and dropped each of those games, including three OVC contests at Tennessee Tech, to fall to 6-6 in Conference play. ECU started the week with a 24-23 11-inning loss at Western Carolina. In the five-hour slugfest, the Colonels trailed 17-9 heading into the seventh inning but outscored WCU 11-3 over the next three innings to force extra frame. The teams combined for 47 runs, 47 hits and 12 errors in the game that officially last five hours and six minutes. At Tech, ECU lost games by margins of 10-4, 8-2 and 4-3. The team played without two of its top hitters last week as Jayson Langfels has not batted since April 1 and senior Matt Davis missed Saturday's doubleheader with an injury. ECU is back in action this week when it hosts Georgetown College, travels to Marshall and then hosts Murray State in OVC action this weekend.

Jacksonville State (19-12, 5-4 OVC): The Gamecocks stepped out of OVC competition last week to top rival Samford (16-1) and win two games over Southern Illinois (8-5 and 6-3). The Gamecocks pitching staff posted a 2.67 E.R.A. for the week, recording 22 strikeouts and holding its opponents to a .233 batting average. Daniel Watts struck out nine in 6.2 innings of work, allowing just one earned run in a win over SIU on Saturday. Reliever Bill Henke earned his seventh save of the season on Saturday; he has allowed just one earned run in 11 games this season and leads the team with a 0.61 E.R.A. Todd Cunningham hit .467 (7-for-15) last week with five runs scored, a double, two triples, home run and four RBI. Cunningham's seven-game hitting streak is the longest active streak on the team and he has 11 multiple-hit games this season. Redshirt freshman Jake Welch leads the team with seven multiple-RBI games this season. The Gamecocks will host Kennesaw State on Tuesday and play at the Owls field on Wednesday. This weekend the preseason favorites (who are 5-4 and in third place in the OVC) will travel to Charleston, Ill. to face league-leader Eastern Illinois (9-1 in OVC play). Eastern Illinois knocked Jacksonville State a loss in last year's OVC Tournament on its way to claiming the title.

Morehead State (12-19, 5-6 OVC): Morehead State compiled a 2-1 record last week, losing to No. 28 Ohio State before taking two games from OVC foe Austin Peay over the weekend. A third game in the APSU series was cancelled due to rain. Senior Tyler Bess continued his dominance on the mound, tossing his third consecutive complete game (7 innings) in a 3-1 win over the Gobs on Saturday. He allowed only three hits (two of which were singles) and retired 17 of the final 19 batters he faced. Bess, who no doubt

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

pitchers in a "hitter's park" is now 4-2 on the season with a 3.38 E.R.A. The rest of the Eagles pitching staff has a 8.45 E.R.A. In six games at home this season Bess is 3-2 with a 2.61 E.R.A. Drew Lee hit .429 and had a .600 on-base percentage in the three games last week. His 19 multiple-hit games this season is tied for tops in the OVC. Michael Bottoms leads the squad and OVC in multiple-RBI games (12) in 2009. Sophomore Jeff Arnold gave the Eagles a strong outing in the second game of the doubleheader against APSU. He did not allow an earned run over 5.1 innings in a 3-1 MSU victory. Morehead State will play at No. 28 Vanderbilt on Wednesday before traveling to UT Martin for three games this weekend.

Murray State (20-13, 3-5 OVC): Murray State started the week with its five straight loss, an 11-6 decision against Evansville. But the Thoroughbreds snapped out of the streak in a big way, topping Southeast Missouri 25-2 in the first game of a three-game series. MSU won 3-1 in the second game of the series before falling 9-6 in the finale to SEMO. The 25 runs scored in Friday's game were the most since posting 26 against Morehead State in the 1997 season. Junior Chris Craycraft pitched eight innings in that blowout win, allowing four hits and two unearned runs while striking out eight. He improved to 5-2 on the season with the win. On Saturday Daniel Calhoun tossed his league-best fifth complete game, allowing two hits and a run in seven innings of work. Calhoun is now 7-1 with a 1.83 E.R.A. on the season. He has 57 strikeouts against just six walks this year. For the season the Thoroughbreds have 14 triples (sixth in a single-season at Murray State), while Wes Cunningham has five by himself (one off the school record). Kyle Tiernan hit .571 (8-for-14) with two doubles, a home run and five RBI last week. Murray State has non-conference games with Evansville and Belmont this week before traveling to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game set this weekend.

Southeast Missouri (19-13, 9-3 OVC): After week after handing Jacksonville State its first OVC series loss since the 2007 season, Southeast Missouri lost three of four games, including two of three at Murray State. The Redhawks lost 7-0 at Southern Illinois to begin the week and were then topped 25-2 by Murray State in game one of that series. Southeast lost 3-1 in the second game of the series before rebounding with a 9-6 victory in the finale. Despite the two OVC losses, the Redhawks are 9-3 in the OVC play, which puts them in second place, just a game behind league-leader Eastern Illinois. Senior outfielder Tyrell Cummings led the team with a .357 average (5-for-14) for the week; he scored two runs and drove in two additional runs. Kyle Guminey picked up the win on Saturday, allowing five runs in five innings of work. Southeast Missouri will host Southern Illinois and Saint Louis this week and SIU Edwardsville for a three-game set this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (7-21): After 23 games away from the road, SIU Edwardsville finally got to play a home game last week, hosting and defeating Saint Louis University 14-1. On the mound Spencer Patton struck out 10 in six innings while Michael Hopkins drove in four RBI. The next night the Cougars fell to the same SLU squad, 9-5 in Saint Louis. The weekend saw SIUE play three games at Memphis, losing the first two 6-3 and 5-1. But SIU Edwardsville would win the final game 3-2 behind another great effort from Patton. Patton once again struck out 10 batters in five innings of work. Hopkins added another good effort at the plate, going 3-for-3 with an RBI and a run scored. This week the Cougars will host Missouri-St. Louis and travel to Butler before heading to Cape Girardeau for a three-game set with future OVC foe Southeast Missouri.

Tennessee Tech (16-12, 4-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech played three OVC games last week, sweeping Eastern Kentucky to improve to 4-7 in Conference play. Alex Henry hit .636 (7-for-11) for the week with four runs, a home run and three RBI. The team's leadoff hitter, Henry had 10 total bases during the week and a slugging percentage of .909. On the mound sophomore Chad Oberacker hurled six strong innings against the Colonels. He struck out eight batters and allowed just five hits while striking out eight batters. He allowed the Colonels, the OVC's top hitting team, to hit just .238 for the game. The Golden Eagles will look to continue their hot streak this week with six games. Tech will host Covenant for a doubleheader on Tuesday, travel to East Tennessee on Wednesday and play an OVC series at Austin Peay this weekend.

UT Martin (11-19, 2-7 OVC): UT Martin won one of its four games last week, but that one win came against nationally-ranked Eastern Illinois (No. 27). The Skyhawks lost a non-conference game with Belmont (6-4) before hosting the Panthers for three games. EIU won the first game 10-3 before coming back to win the second game of Friday's doubleheader by a 13-3 margin. UTM lost the finale 30-3. With the win over EIU on Friday, the Skyhawks ended the nation's longest winning streak (13 games) and topped the top team in the OVC. Scott Gladstone had three hits and scored three runs, while Wes Patterson drove in three runs. On the mound Brendan Lozupone allowed three runs over five innings to pick up the win. For the week Gladstone hit .571 (8-for-14); he has a 26-game hitting streak, the longest in the OVC and one of the top hitting streaks in the country. Miles Hartsfield has the second longest hitting streak in the league (24 games). As a team UT Martin has 36 home runs on the season, two less than they hit all of last year. The Skyhawks now have 11 wins on the season, after having only 10 all of last year. UTM will host Saint Louis and travel to Lipscomb in non-conference action this week. This weekend the Skyhawks will host Morehead State in OVC play.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Eastern Illinois continues to lead the OVC, winning three of four games last week (including 2 of 3 OVC games) to improve to 24-6 overall and 9-1 (first place) in the OVC...EIU is ranked No. 29 nationally in this week's Collegiate Baseball Newspaper poll...The Panthers have a big non-conference game this week when they play at Illinois (21-8, receiving votes in national polls) on Tuesday night...The Panthers also have a big OVC series this weekend when preseason OVC favorite Jacksonville State comes to Charleston for a three-game series...The Gamecocks are 5-4 in OVC play so far this season, 3.5 games behind EIU...JSU has won the regular season series 2-1 from the Panthers each of the last two seasons, although Eastern won an OVC Tournament matchup a year ago...In other games this weekend Murray State plays at Eastern Kentucky, Morehead State will battle UT Martin and Tennessee Tech is at Austin Peay.

Nommensen Named a Mid-Season All-American by Baseball America: Eastern Illinois' **Brett Nommensen** has been one of 10 position players in the nation named to Baseball America's Midseason All-America Team. At the time of the honor, Nommensen entered the week leading the country in on-base and slugging percentages, while also ranking second in batting average. Baseball America's lead college writer Aaron Fitt selected a nine-player lineup based on positions along with a utility player (pitcher and hitter). The pitching staff featured six hurlers. Fresno State's Tom Mendonca (third base), San Diego State's Stephen Strasburg (starting pitcher) and Nommensen were the only three players among the 15 recognized that play for universities not affiliated with the big six BCS conferences.

Eastern Illinois Ranked No. 29 Nationally by Collegiate Baseball News: Eastern Illinois became the first OVC school in a long time (believed to be since the 1996 season) to break into the national polls when they entered the Collegiate Baseball News poll at No. 27 on April 6. It marked the first time the Panthers have been ranked at the Division I level. EIU has a win over then No. 15 ranked Oklahoma (the Sooners are No. 10 in this week's NCBWA poll). After a 3-1 record last week the Panthers are No. 29 in this week's CBN poll. Eastern Illinois is receiving votes in each the USA Today/ESPN Coaches Poll and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) polls. They are not ranked in the Baseball America poll. EIU is ranked 37th nationally in the latest Baseball RPI.

EIU Has Nation's Seventh Longest Home Winning Streak: Eastern Illinois has had some long streaks this season, including a 13-game winning streak which was the longest active streak nationally at its end on April 10. The Panthers enter this week with an 8-game home winning streak, the seventh longest active streak nationally. Manhattan currently has the longest home streak nationally at 17 games.

Nommensen Among Nation's Top Hitters: Eastern Illinois senior outfielder and OVC Preseason Player of the Year **Brett Nommensen** is blistering the ball this season. Although new NCAA statistical leaders will not be released until Tuesday, in last week's stats Nommensen ranked first nationally in on-base percentage (.642), first nationally in slugging (1.022) and second nationally in batting average (.516). Nommensen either improved or held steady on each of those averages, making it likely he'll be ranked first or second in each of those categories this week.

Other OVC Players Among National Leaders: **Brett Nommensen** is not the only OVC player putting up impressive numbers this season. Through last week's NCAA rankings, EIU's **Matt Davis** is first nationally in runs per game (1.89) and eight in batting average (.456). Teammate **Jayson Langfels** is first nationally in RBI/game (1.87) while Morehead State's **Drew Lee** is fourth nationally in total bases (98) and fifth in hits (55). EIU's **Mike Recchia** is third nationally in E.R.A. (0.92) while Murray State's **Daniel Calhoun** is seventh in victories (7). As for team's, Eastern Kentucky is second in batting average (.374), runs/game (10.7) and triples (0.78), fourth in slugging (.959) and seventh in stolen bases (2.48). Morehead State ranks fourth in double plays/game (1.32).

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2009 season, there were five players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having three former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore), reliever **Jamie Walker** (Baltimore) and rookie pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is a setup man in Arizona while former Eastern Kentucky outfielder **Josh Anderson** is a backup in Detroit. Two other former OVC players are on 40-man rosters but will not begin the season with the major league club. Those two players are Austin Peay catcher A.J. Ellis (L.A. Dodgers) and pitcher **Ehren Wassermann** (who played for Samford when they were in the OVC). One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox first base coach.

EIU's Morrell One of 30 Student-Athletes Up for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: For his all-around excellence as a student-athlete, **Brian Morrell** of Eastern Illinois baseball has been named one of 30 candidates nationally for the prestigious Lowe's Senior

CLASS Award. Morrell is a senior pitcher for the Panthers and has served as the bullpen's long-relief ace each of his upperclassman seasons. The Quincy native carries a 4.0 GPA while majoring in biological sciences. He was an ESPN the Magazine Second Team All-America honoree as a junior. The list of 30 candidates in baseball will be trimmed to a group of 10 finalists in April. Those 10 names will then be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote beginning April 15 and concluding May 31. Fan balloting will be coupled with votes from coaches and media to determine the recipient of the award. The award, given annually to senior student-athletes across nine NCAA Division I sports, has become one of the most prestigious honors in college athletics. The candidates were selected based on their dedication and achievement in four areas: Classroom, Character, Community, and Competition. The Lowe's Senior CLASS Award is distinctive from many other honors in that on-the-field performance is only one factor in determining candidacy – a major emphasis is placed on off-the-field commitments and personal character. An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School*, the award was launched during the 2001-02 season in response to the trend of college basketball players leaving college early to turn professional.

The awards are presented by the CBF and Diamond Sports and are nominated by college coaches, staff and baseball media relations contacts. Nommensen Named National Hitter of the Week by the NCBWA: Eastern Illinois outfielder **Brett Nommensen** was named the Pro-Line Athletic National Hitter of the Week by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association on April 6. Nommensen hit .769 (10-of-13) with seven runs scored, two doubles, three home runs and nine RBIs in the four EIU wins last week. He reached base safely in 14 of his 17 plate appearances, including in each of his first 13 trips to the plate. Nommensen homered twice in a 12-8 road win over Saint Louis, including leading off the game with a home run for the fourth time this season. He hit a two-run home run in game one against Murray State and knocked in the first run in the second game of that doubleheader (a 2-1 EIU victory). The NCBWA Board reviews candidates from every NCAA Division I conference each week and names winners on Tuesdays throughout the season. Founded in 1962, the NCBWA is dedicated to the advancement of college baseball. Membership is open to writers, broadcasters and publicists of the sport.

Murray State's Hill Named Louisville Slugger & Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week: Murray State junior outfielder **Daniel Hill** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and the Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on March 9. Hill (Germantown, Tenn.) helped the 'Breds to a 5-1 week by going 15-for-26 (.577) with two doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs and nine runs scored. He had a slugging percentage of 1.231 and an on-base percentage of .633. He started the week by going 3-for-4 with a pair of RBIs in a mid-week victory over Freed-Hardeman and followed it up the next day by going 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs against Arkansas State. Hill stepped up his game in the four-game series against North Dakota State as he led school-record 28-hit attack in the series opener by going 5-for-7 with a double, three home runs and eight RBIs in the 20-9 victory. He tied the MSU single-game record for hits and home runs in a game. In the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday, Hill did not get much to hit at the plate as he walked twice and was hit by a pitch in four plate appearances. The Bison did not fare so well in the second game as Hill was 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs. The series finale turned into a classic slugfest as the 'Breds rallied twice and survived a ninth-inning rally. Hill hit his fifth home run of the week and drove in three runs in the 13-11 victory.

Tootle Named to Brooks Wallace Award Watch List: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** has been named to the preseason Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List as announced by the College Baseball Foundation. The Wallace Award is dedicated to the memory of former Texas Tech player and assistant coach Brooks Wallace. Wallace was a slick-fielding shortstop at Texas Tech from 1977 to 1980. A four-year starter, he was named All-Southwest Conference and All-District his senior year. He led the Red Raiders to their first-ever appearance in the Southwest Conference Tournament in 1980. The Wallace Award is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The 2009 award banquet will be at 7 p.m., Thursday, July 2, in the United Spirit Arena on the campus of Texas Tech University.

JSU's Tootle Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Ben Tootle** has been named to the 2009 Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List by USA Baseball, marking the organization's first step toward identifying the top player in college baseball.

The watch list features 50 of the nation's top collegiate talents and will be presented in 2009 for the 32nd time. The award is sponsored by Major League Baseball. Last season Tootle was named first-team All-OVC after leading the conference with an impressive 10-2 record with two shutouts in 2008. He finished the season with 79 strikeouts, which was the second most in the OVC, and had a 3.87 earned run average. He was named OVC Pitcher of the Week three times during the season after going a perfect 8-0 against conference members. Baseball America named Tootle as the fourth-best prospect from this summer's Cape Cod League, while ESPN's Keith Law has named the Gamecock pitching ace as the 13th best prospect in the country for the 2009 season.

Austin Peay's Tenholder Named to NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List: Austin Peay relief pitcher **Daniel Tenholder** has been named to the initial 40-player watch list for the fifth annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball. Tenholder returns after posting a 4-1 record and an OVC-best 11 saves in 2008. He ranked 18th nationally in saves last season and is one of the nation's top seven returning relievers. Tenholder compiled a 2.72 ERA in 36.1 innings over 30 appearances, striking out 41 batters. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 16, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, May 27, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee will then select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in early June.

JSU's Tootle Named to Numerous Preseason All-American Teams: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** was named to four preseason All-American lists this year. Tootle was a first-team NCBWA selection, second-team Louisville Slugger pick and a third-team choice by Ping! and Baseball America. Eastern Illinois' **Brett Nommensen** was a third-team pick by Ping! while Southeast Missouri catcher **Jim Klocke** was a honorable mention pick by Ping!.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite For Second Straight Season: For the second year in a row, Jacksonville State has been picked as the preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The Gamecocks claimed the 2008 regular season championship with a 23-4 record last season but came up just short in the OVC Tournament. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as Jacksonville State, who received five first-place votes, edged Eastern Illinois, who had the other four first-place votes, by just one total point. Eastern Illinois swept through four games at the OVC Tournament last season on its way to team's first title since 1999 and a berth in the NCAA Regionals. Those two teams were followed by Austin Peay (48 points), Southeast Missouri State (42), Tennessee Tech (38), Murray State (23), Morehead State (22), Eastern Kentucky (20) and UT Martin (10).

Nommensen and Tootle Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: Jacksonville State junior right-hander **Ben Tootle** was tabbed the OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Eastern Illinois senior outfielder **Brett Nommensen** was picked the OVC Preseason Player of the Year in a preseason vote of league head coaches. Nommensen produced gaudy numbers last year in earning All-OVC first-team honors as well as being selected to the NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. He hit .402 with 82 hits, 56 runs, 18 doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI. His slugging percentage was .603 while his on-base percentage was a league-best .518. Nommensen also stole 18 bases. Tootle, who was named a preseason All-American by numerous outlets has been great in his first two seasons at JSU. In two years with Jax State, Tootle has compiled a 16-5 overall record, including an unblemished 8-0 mark against Conference opponents a season ago. Last season he struck out 79 batters and walked only 29 in 86 innings of work.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
