THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Brett Nommensen, OF • Sr., 5-10, 190 • Fox Grove, Ill. • Eastern Illinois
Nommensen earned his second OVC Player of the Week honor of the season after hitting .769 (10-of-13) with seven runs scored, two doubles, three home runs and nine RBI in four Eastern Illinois wins last week. He reached base safely in 14 of his 17 plate appearances during the week, including in each of his first 13 at-bats of the week. He homered twice in a 12-8 road win over Saint Louis, including leading off the game with a home run for the fourth time this season. Nommensen hit a two-run home run in game one against Murray State and knocked in the first run in the second game of that doubleheader (a 2-1 EIU victory). Nommensen ranked first nationally in on-base percentage in last week's NCAA statistics. He has led the Panthers to 11 straight wins and a No. 27 national ranking. EIU has now had the OVC Player of the Week in four straight weeks, the first time that has happened in OVC history.

PITCHER

Tyler Bess, RHP • Sr., 6-1, 190 • Brooksville, Ky. • Morehead State
Bess tossed a complete game in leading the Eagles to a 2-1 win over Tennessee Tech in game two of Saturday's doubleheader. Bess scattered five hits (four of which were singles) and struck out a career-high 10 in the seven-inning affair with the Golden Eagles. Bess allowed just one earned run in what is known as a hitter's park (the team has allowed 10.4 runs per game there in 21 home games this season).

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (13-17, 2-4 OVC): Austin Peay played four non-conference games last week. The Governors lost at home to in-state rival Middle Tennessee (18-8) but rebounded with three wins over future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville over the weekend. APSU won those games by scores of 7-5, 15-5 and 8-7 (11 innings). The three straight over SIUE marked the first three-game winning streak of the season for Austin Peay. The team's offense has shown some signs of life recently, batting .367 with 48 runs (9.6/game) over its last five contests. Prior to those games the team was batting just .265 and averaging 5.8 runs/game. The Govs have stolen at least three bases in five consecutive games, including a school-record tying nine in Saturday's win over the Cougars. They have stolen 28-of-30 bases (93.3%) over the last five games. Outfielder Adam Browett had nine hits during the week raising his average to .358. Reliever Ricky Marshall made three appearances in four games last week, striking out eight over 5.1 innings and finishing the week with a 1-0 record and 1.69 ERA. Austin Peay will host Lipscomb on Tuesday and then travel to Evansville on Wednesday night. The Govs host Morehead State for three OVC games this Friday/Saturday.

Eastern Illinois (21-5, 7-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois won all four of its games last week to stretch its winning streak to 11 games (the team has won 15 of its last 16 overall). The Panthers are now 21-5 overall (7-0 and first place in the OVC) and are ranked No. 27 in this week's Collegiate Baseball News Top 30 poll. It marks the first time EIU has been ranked at the Division I level and is the first time in a long time an OVC school has been nationally ranked. Brett Nommensen was named OVC Player of the Week for the second time this season after hitting .769 (10-of-13) with seven runs scored, three home runs and nine RBI in four games last week. He reached base safely in 14 of 17 plate appearances, including each of his first 13 at-bats of the week. EIU has had the OVC Player of the Week four straight weeks, the first time that has happened in OVC history. EIU had the final game of its series with Murray State rained out this weekend, the second OVC series in a row they have lost a game due to poor weather. Head coach Jim Schmitz recorded his 400th victory as EIU coach in Saturday's game one victory over the Thoroughbreds. Tyler Kehrer had a complete game three-hitter against Murray State where he struck out eight and did not issue a walk. EIU also handed Murray State hurler Daniel Calhoun his first loss of the season. EIU will host Indiana State on Wednesday and then play at UT Martin in OVC action this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (18-9, 6-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky, who has won seven of its last 10 games, compiling a 4-1 record last week. The Colonels topped Miami (Ohio) in non-conference action and then beat Kentucky State 49-1 in a non-conference tilt on Wednesday. In this weekend's OVC series, EKV won the first two from UT Martin (12-7 and 4-2) before losing the finale 10-9. That left the Colonels 6-3 in OVC play, which is third place after three weekends of play. As a team last week the Colonels hit .451. For the season the team is hitting .374, which is tops in the OVC and will be in the Top 5 nationally when the new NCAA statistical leaders this week (the team was No. 6 nationally last week at .364 as a team). Senior outfielder Matt Davis hit .565 (13-of-23) with 14 runs scored, three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and five stolen bases in five games last week. In the game two win against UTM, Davis scored the go-ahead run from second base on a wild pitch. In the win against Kentucky State, sophomore Jayson Langfels became the school's career record holder for triples (13); he currently ranks in the Top 20 nationally in triples per game. Pitcher Matt Fyffe won two games last week, striking out 14 batters in 10.1 innings of work. He went 6.1 innings and struck out eight in the win over Miami University to begin the week. The Colonels will play at Western Carolina this week and play at Tennessee Tech in OVC action this weekend.

Jacksonville State (16-12, 5-4 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped two of three games at Southeast Missouri over the weekend, ending the team's 14 straight OVC series winning streak dating back to the end of the 2007 season. The Gamecocks had won every OVC series in 2008. The team earned its only win over the weekend in dramatic fashion, scoring its seventh come-from-behind victory of the year to win 8-7. It marked the team's fifth final at-bat win of the season as JSU scored twice in the top of the ninth to pull out the one-run victory. Kyle Bluestein has raised his batting average by 114 points (from .259 to a team-best .373) over the last two weekends and now has a six-game winning streak. He has had four multiple-hit games in his last six contests. Blake Seguin and Steven Leach led the team with 13 multiple-hit games apiece this season. Leach leads the OVC with 23 walks this season. Reliever Bill Henke earned his sixth save of the season on Saturday and has allowed just one earned run in 10 appearances on the mound this season. His 0.71 ERA is tops on the team. Jacksonville State will host rival Samford on Tuesday and then travel to Southern Illinois for three games this weekend as the team has a week off from OVC competition. Overall the Gamecocks are 5-4 in OVC play, which puts them in fourth place in the standings.

Morehead State (10-18, 3-6 OVC): After going through a stretch where the Eagles lost 10 of 11 games, Morehead State rebounded by winning three of four games last week including winning its first OVC series of the season when it hosted Tennessee Tech. MSU is now 3-6 in OVC play in 2009, which ties them for fifth place in the standings. Morehead State began the week with a 21-10 win over Shawnee State and then lost 17-

Last season the Eastern Illinois Panthers went undefeated in the event and topped Southeast Missouri in the finals to claim the championship.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

16 in 10 innings to Tennessee Tech. But the team rebounded with 2-1 and 12-7 wins against the Golden Eagles. Senior Tyler Bess was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after tossing a seven-inning complete game against Tech. Bess allowed five hits (four singles) and one earned run while striking out 10 in the 2-1 win. The win was impressive considering the fact that MSU has allowed more than 10 runs per game in 21 home games this season. Sophomore outfielder Daniel Pugh hit .500 (8-for-16) with seven runs scored, three home runs, 10 RBI and two stolen bases in four games. He slugged 1.063 and had an on-base percentage of .556. He had a two-out, three-run homer against Tech in the bottom of the ninth against TTU, completing a six-run rally and forcing extra innings. For the week Morehead State had six players hit .467 or higher. J.D. Ashbrook hit .500 with 10 runs scored in his lead-off role. Sophomore Jeff Arnold made three appearances on the mound last week, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA. Junior SS Drew Lee has an OVC-best 18 multiple-hit games this season and has a 10-game hitting streak. MSU will play at Ohio State on Wednesday and then host Austin Peay in an OVC series this weekend.

Murray State (18-11, 1-4 OVC): Murray State dropped all three of its games last week. The Thoroughbreds lost 9-1 in 10 innings against Southern Illinois on Wednesday in Paducah. The game was 1-1 going into the 10th before SIU exploded for eight runs in the extra frame. The game took place at Brooks Stadium, site of the 2009 OVC Tournament. The first run came across the plate on a balk with runners on the corners and two outs and that was followed by three errors and another balk to account for seven unearned runs. Over the weekend Murray State lost two games to league-leading Eastern Illinois while a third game with the Panthers was lost to rain. Wes Cunningham saw his 20-game hitting streak come to an end in the second game against EIU on Saturday. He has reached base safely in 37 straight games and 74 of his last 75 games overall. Pitcher Daniel Calhoun suffered his first loss of the season in game two (2-1 loss) despite allowing just one earned run. Calhoun owns a 10:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio (51 strikeouts, 5 walks) this season. MSU has scored double-digit runs in 16 (of 29) games this season including in six of its last eight games. The T'Breds have 24 home runs this season after hitting only 10 all of last season. Murray State will host Evansville during the week and Southeast Missouri State this weekend in OVC play.

Southeast Missouri (18-10, 8-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri lost at Arkansas State to begin the week but took two of three games from Jacksonville State over the weekend, becoming the first OVC school since the end of the 2007 season to win a series from the Gamecocks (snapping JSU's 14 straight OVC series win streak). That left the Redhawks 8-1 in OVC play, just behind undefeated Eastern Illinois in OVC play. For the week Kenton Parmley hit .385 (5-for-13) with five runs scored and two RBI. Tony Spencer and Justin Wheeler each hit .357 (5-for-14) and combined for nine runs, four doubles, 11 RBI and three stolen bases. Spencer had a key two-out RBI single that proved to be the game-winner in the finale against Jax State. The Redhawks are back in action this week when they play at Southern Illinois in non-conference action and then head to Murray State for OVC action this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (5-18): SIU Edwardsville lost all four games last week, two of which came by one run in extra innings. The Cougars started the week with a 7-6 10-inning loss at Illinois. Then SIUE played three games at Austin Peay, losing 7-5, 15-5 and 8-7 in 11 innings. Josh Street continues to lead the team in hitting with a .404 average through 23 games. He has nine of the team's 22 home runs this year and a team-best 36 RBI. The Cougars are back in action on Tuesday when they play their first home game of the season after 23 straight away from home. Saint Louis University comes to town for that first game. The two teams will then play on Wednesday at SLU. SIUE will then play three games at Memphis this weekend.

Tennessee Tech (13-12, 1-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech split four games last week, topping East Tennessee 15-7 at home before losing two of three at Morehead State in OVC action over the weekend. Tech topped the Eagles 17-16 in 10 innings in the opener of their three-game series, a win that marked Tech's first Conference victory of the 2009 season. The Golden Eagles then lost 2-1 and 12-7 in the final two games in Morehead. Sophomore Casanova Donaldson hit .529 (9-for-17) with seven runs scored, two doubles, two RBI and three stolen bases last week. He tied a TTU record by going 5-for-5 against ETSU. Pitcher Chad Oberacker appeared in two games last week, picking up a win and a save and not allowing an earned run in 7.2 innings of work. He struck out seven in 7.2 innings of work. The Golden Eagles are now 3-0 this season in extra inning games. Tech will host Eastern Kentucky for three OVC games this weekend.

UT Martin (10-16, 1-5 OVC): UT Martin dropped its first three games of the week but closed the week with a 10-9 extra innings victory over Eastern Kentucky to pick up its first OVC victory of the season. Overall the Skyhawks have 10 wins in 26 games this season, matching its entire win total from the 2008 season. Senior Miles Hartsfield hit .474 (9-for-19) with two home runs and four RBI last week. He extended his hitting streak to 20 games and now has 14 multiple-hit and 10-multiple RBI games this year. Senior Scott Gladstone increased his hitting streak to 22 games, which is now the longest hitting streak in the OVC this season. UT Martin is now 2-2 in extra inning games this season. Starter Coty Green picked up his first save of the season on Sunday. UTM will host Belmont and then league-leading Eastern Illinois for games this week.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Due to the Easter holiday this weekend, the four OVC series to be played this weekend will be played on Friday/Saturday instead of the normal Saturday/Sunday schedule...Eastern Illinois has won a nation's best 11 straight games entering this week, are a perfect 7-0 and in first place in the OVC and are now ranked No. 27 in this week's Collegiate Baseball News Top 30 poll...It marks the first time EIU has been nationally ranked at the Division I level...Southeast Missouri State won two of three games against Jacksonville State this weekend, becoming the first team to win an OVC series from the Gamecocks since the end of the 2007 season (snapping a 14-straight series winning streak for JSU)...Southeast Missouri is now 8-1 in OVC play, just one loss behind EIU (those two teams won't play each other until the first weekend of May)...Eastern Kentucky (6-3) and Jacksonville State (5-4) are the only other OVC teams with winning Conference records at this point of the season...This weekend's matchups include Eastern Illinois playing at UT Martin, Southeast Missouri at Murray State, Austin Peay playing at Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky traveling to Tennessee Tech.

Eastern Illinois Ranked No. 27 Nationally by Collegiate Baseball News: Eastern Illinois became the first OVC school in a long time to break into the national polls when they entered the Collegiate Baseball News poll at No. 27 on Monday. It marks the first time the Panthers have been ranked at the Division I level. EIU has a win over then No. 15 ranked Oklahoma (the Sooners are No. 12 in this week's CBN poll). Eastern Illinois is receiving votes in each the USA Today/ESPN Coaches Poll and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) polls. They are not ranked in the Baseball America poll. EIU is ranked 38th nationally in the latest Baseball RPI.

EIU Has Nation's Longest Active Winning Streak; Second Longest Active Road Winning Streak: Eastern Illinois enters this week having won 11 straight games, the longest active streak among Division I teams. The Panthers have not lost since falling 7-1 to Bradley on March 18 at a neutral site in Florida. Dartmouth currently has the second longest winning streak nationally at nine games. The longest streak overall this season was a 19-game winning streak by Virginia earlier this season. The 11 straight by EIU is the fifth longest at any point of the 2009 season. EIU has also won six straight games on the road dating back to a March 10 loss at Indiana State. That is second only to a seven-game active road winning streak by Southern Miss.

Nommensen Among Nation's Top Hitters: Eastern Illinois senior outfielder and OVC Preseason Player of the Year **Brett Nommensen** is blistering the ball this season. Although new NCAA statistical leaders will not be released until Tuesday, in last week's stats Nommensen ranked first nationally in on-base percentage (.613), sixth nationally in slugging (.923) and seventh nationally in batting average (.474). And since last week Nommensen, this week's OVC Player of the Week, has increased all three of those stats, as he is now batting .516 with a 1.022 slugging percentage and a .613 on-base percentage.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2009 season, there were five players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having three former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore), reliever **Jamie Walker** (Baltimore) and rookie pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is a setup man in Arizona while former Eastern Kentucky outfielder **Josh Anderson** is a backup in Detroit. Two other former OVC players are on 40-man rosters but will not begin the season with the major league club. Those two players are Austin Peay catcher A.J. Ellis (L.A. Dodgers) and pitcher **Ehren Wassermann** (who played for Samford when they were in the OVC). One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox first base coach.

EIU's Morrell One of 30 Student-Athletes Up for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: For his all-around excellence as a student-athlete, **Brian Morrell** of Eastern Illinois baseball has been named one of 30 candidates nationally for the prestigious Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Morrell is a senior pitcher for the Panthers and has served as the bullpen's long-relief ace each of his upperclassman seasons. The Quincy native carries a 4.0 GPA while majoring in biological sciences. He was an ESPN the Magazine Second Team All-America honoree as a junior. The list of 30 candidates in baseball will be trimmed to a group of 10 finalists in April. Those 10 names will then be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote beginning April 15 and concluding May 31. Fan balloting will be coupled with votes from coaches and media to determine the recipient of the award. The award, given annually to senior student-athletes across nine NCAA Division I sports, has become one of the most prestigious honors in college athletics. The candidates were selected based on their dedication and achievement in four areas: Classroom, Character, Community, and Competition. The Lowe's Senior CLASS Award is distinctive from many other honors in that on-the-field performance is only one factor in determining candidacy - a major emphasis is placed on off-the-field commitments and personal character. An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achieve-*

Murray State's Hill Named Louisville Slugger & Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week: Murray State junior outfielder **Daniel Hill** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and the Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on March 9. . Hill (Germantown, Tenn.) helped the 'Breds to a 5-1 week by going 15-for-26 (.577) with two doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs and nine runs scored. He had a slugging percentage of 1.231 and an on-base percentage of .633. He started the week by going 3-for-4 with a pair of RBIs in a mid-week victory over Freed-Hardeman and followed it up the next day by going 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs against Arkansas State. Hill stepped up his game in the four-game series against North Dakota State as he led school-record 28-hit attack in the series opener by going 5-for-7 with a double, three home runs and eight RBIs in the 20-9 victory. He tied the MSU single-game record for hits and home runs in a game. In the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday, Hill did not get much to hit at the plate as he walked twice and was hit by a pitch in four plate appearances. The Bison did not fare so well in the second game as Hill was 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs. The series finale turned into a classic slugfest as the 'Breds rallied twice and survived a ninth-inning rally. Hill hit his fifth home run of the week and drove in three runs in the 13-11 victory.

Tootle Named to Brooks Wallace Award Watch List: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** has been named to the preseason Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List as announced by the College Baseball Foundation. The Wallace Award is dedicated to the memory of former Texas Tech player and assistant coach Brooks Wallace. Wallace was a slick-fielding shortstop at Texas Tech from 1977 to 1980. A four-year starter, he was named All-Southwest Conference and All-District his senior year. He led the Red Raiders to their first-ever appearance in the Southwest Conference Tournament in 1980. The Wallace Award is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The 2009 award banquet will be at 7 p.m., Thursday, July 2, in the United Spirit Arena on the campus of Texas Tech University.

JSU's Tootle Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Ben Tootle** has been named to the 2009 Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List by USA Baseball, marking the organization's first step toward identifying the top player in college baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top collegiate talents and will be presented in 2009 for the 32nd time. The award is sponsored by Major League Baseball. Last season Tootle was named first-team All-OVC after leading the conference with an impressive 10-2 record with two shutouts in 2008. He finished the season with 79 strikeouts, which was the second most in the OVC, and had a 3.87 earned run average. He was named OVC Pitcher of the Week three times during the season after going a perfect 8-0 against conference members. Baseball America named Tootle as the fourth-best prospect from this summer's Cape Cod League, while ESPN's Keith Law has named the Gamecock pitching ace as the 13th best prospect in the country for the 2009 season.

Austin Peay's Tenholder Named to NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List: Austin Peay relief pitcher **Daniel Tenholder** has been named to the initial 40-player watch list for the fifth annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball. Tenholder returns after posting a 4-1 record and an OVC-best 11 saves in 2008. He ranked 18th nationally in saves last season and is one of the nation's top seven returning relievers. Tenholder compiled a 2.72 ERA in 36.1 innings over 30 appearances, striking out 41 batters. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 16, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, May 27, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee will then select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in early June.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite For Second Straight Season: For the second year in a row, Jacksonville State has been picked as the preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The Gamecocks claimed the 2008 regular season championship with a 23-4 record last season but came up just short in the OVC Tournament. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as Jacksonville State, who received five first-place votes, edged Eastern Illinois, who had the other four first-place votes, by just one total point. Eastern Illinois swept through four games at the OVC Tournament last season on its way to team's first title since 1999 and a berth in the NCAA Regionals. Those two teams were followed by Austin Peay (48 points), Southeast Missouri State (42), Tennessee Tech (38), Murray State (23), Morehead State (22), Eastern Kentucky (20) and UT Martin (10).

Nommensen and Tootle Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: Jacksonville State junior right-hander **Ben Tootle** was tabbed the OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Eastern Illinois senior outfielder **Brett Nommensen** was picked the OVC Preseason Player of the Year in a preseason vote of league head coaches. Nommensen produced gaudy numbers last year in earning All-OVC first-team honors as well as being selected to the NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. He hit .402 with 82 hits, 56 runs, 18 doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI. His slugging percentage was .603 while his on-base percentage was a league-best .518. Nommensen also stole 18 bases. Tootle, who was named a preseason All-American by numerous outlets has been great in his first two seasons at JSU. In two years with Jax State, Tootle has compiled a 16-5 overall record, including an unblemished 8-0 mark against Conference opponents a season ago. Last season he struck out 79 batters and walked only 29 in 86 innings of work.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
