THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Jordan Kreke, SS/P • Sr., 6-2, 200 • Bartelso, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Kreke earned OVC Player of the Week honors for the second straight week after hitting .611 (11-for-18) with eight runs scored, three home runs and 10 RBI in four Panther victories. He collected multiple-hit and multiple-run scored games against each Chicago State, Illinois State and Tennessee Tech. In the first game of Sunday's doubleheader, Kreke tied the EIU single-game record with eight RBI against the Golden Eagles, where he was 5-for-5 at the plate. In that game he hit a pair of three-run home runs as Eastern won 25-6. For the week he was 6-for-6 with runners in scoring position and six of his 10 RBI came with two outs.

PITCHER

Ben Tootle, RHP • Jr., 6-2, 180 • Oxford, Ala. • Jacksonville State

Tootle, a preseason All-American, earned his first OVC Pitcher of the Week award of the season after tossing a complete game shutout in a 4-0 victory over Austin Peay on Saturday. Tootle did not allow a hit until the fourth inning and faced only four batters over the minimum. He allowed three hits in all and walked four while striking out 10 batters in the seven-inning game. It marked the second straight outing that Tootle had 10 or more strikeouts in a game. Opponents hit just .143 against him and only one batter reached second base, which occurred in the final inning after back-to-back walks. It marked his fourth complete game and third career shutout.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (10-16, 2-4 OVC): Austin Peay was 1-4 last week, dropping a pair of non-conference games before losing two of three on the road at Jacksonville State over the weekend. The Governors lost 10-5 at Vanderbilt and 8-7 at Evansville mid-week and dropped both ends of Saturday's doubleheader with Jax State (6-5 and 4-0). APSU rebounded with a win on Sunday, however, taking the series finale with the Gamecocks by a 10-9 margin. That left Austin Peay 2-4 in OVC play, which is sixth place in the standings. In the win on Sunday, Daniel Tenholder pitched the final 3.1 innings (his longest outing of the season) to pick up the victory. Junior Adam Browett led the Gobs with a .375 (6-for-16) average, including four RBI and the team's first inside-the-park home run since 2005. During the week the team was 13-for-15 in stolen bases, with Jon Clinard leading the way with three swipes. The team's 44 stolen bases on the season is second only to Eastern Kentucky in the league. Austin Peay has non-conference games at home with Belmont and Middle Tennessee State this week before hosting future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville for three games this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (17-5, 5-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois continued to be one of the hottest teams in the league, winning for the seventh time in a row and 11th time in its last 12 games last week. The Panthers opened up with a 16-1 road win against Chicago State and finally opened its home season on Wednesday when they topped Illinois State 9-5. EIU closed the weekend with two wins over Tennessee Tech (the third game was rained out) to improve to 5-0 in OVC play. Jordan Kreke was named OVC Player of the Week for the second week in a row, becoming the first OVC player to do so since the 2006 season. Kreke hit .611 (11-for-18) with eight runs scored, three home runs and 10 RBI. Eastern Illinois has had the OVC Player of the Week three weeks in a row, the first time that has been accomplished in the league since 1995. Although he did OVC Pitcher of the Week honors, Mike Recchia had another great week on the mound. He tossed a two-hit complete game (seven inning) shutout against Tennessee Tech. He struck out nine and walked only two. Recchia is now 5-0 on the season and his 0.92 E.R.A. is tops in the OVC. Josh Mueller struck out a season-high eight over six innings to improve to 4-0 on Sunday. During its seven-game winning streak, EIU has hit 22 home runs and now has 35 on the season (tying its mark from all of last season). Eastern Illinois will play at Saint Louis on Tuesday and host Chicago State on Wednesday before playing three games at home against Murray State this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (14-8, 4-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky won three of its five games last week, including taking two of three from Morehead State over the weekend to improve to 4-2 in the OVC, which puts the Colonels tied for third place in the league standings. Junior Anthony Ottrando hit .550 (11-for-20) with six runs scored and 10 RBI in five games last week. He was a combined 8-for-12 in the team's series with Morehead State. Sophomore hurler Matt Fyffe picked up his first victory of the season on Saturday, pitching 3.1 scoreless innings, allowing four hits and striking out six batters. The Colonels exploded for 25 runs in the finale against MSU, winning 25-6 on Sunday. As a team EKU is hitting .354 on the year, second in the OVC (to Eastern Illinois). Eastern will host Miami University and Kentucky State (doubleheader) in non-conference action this week before play host to UT Martin in OVC play this weekend.

Jacksonville State (15-10, 4-2 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a non-conference game to Troy to open last week and then won two of three from Austin Peay. It marked the 14th-straight OVC series victory for the Gamecocks dating back to the end of the 2007 season. It is believed to be an OVC record. Junior pitcher Ben Tootle was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after a three-hit, 10-strikeout complete game shutout of Austin Peay over the weekend. It marked his fourth career complete game and third career shutout victory. It was also his second straight outing with 10 or more strikeouts. His 11.3 strikeouts-per-9-innings is first in the league. Sophomore Blake Seguin saw his 19-game hitting streak come to an end this week but he hit .429 (6-for-14) with five RBI in four games. He leads JSU with 12 multiple-hit games. Reliever Bill Henke earned his fifth save of the season on Saturday and has allowed just one earned run in nine appearances this season; he leads JSU with a 0.77 E.R.A. The Gamecocks are currently 4-2 in OVC play and tied with Eastern Kentucky for third place. This week then play at Alabama State in non-conference action and then travel to Southeast Missouri State for a three-game OVC set.

Morehead State (7-17, 1-5 OVC): Morehead State did not play a non-conference game last week, instead concentrated on their OVC series at Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. EKU took game one 6-3 before the Eagles rebounded with a 7-3 victory in game two. That snapped a nine-game losing streak for the Eagles. Eastern Kentucky then took the finale by a 25-6 margin. Overall Morehead State has lost 10 of its last 11. In last week's action, J.D. Ashbrook hit .462 (6-for-13) with a triple and two RBI while Drew Lee hit .455 (5-for-11). Lee's .451 season average is third overall in the OVC. Tyler Bess pitched well in the team's win over EKU on Saturday, allowing just three

Last season the Eastern Illinois Panthers went undefeated in the event and topped Southeast Missouri in the finals to claim the championship.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

runs over seven innings to pick up the victory. He struck out four and did not walk a batter. This week the Eagles will host Shawnee State in non-conference action and then host Tennessee Tech for three OVC games over the weekend.

Murray State (18-8, 1-2 OVC): Murray State stepped out of league action last week and won four of five games overall. The Thoroughbreds took a doubleheader from Mid-Continent before hosting future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville, winning two of three from the Cougars. Junior Wes Cunningham, hit .706 (12-for-17) with 10 runs scored, two triples, two home runs and seven RBI last week. He tied the MSU school record for triples in a game (2) in the first game against Mid-Continent. Against SIUE he broke a 7-7 tie in the bottom of the sixth inning with a three-run home run as Murray State went on to win 11-7. Cunningham extended his hitting streak to an OVC-best 18 games and he has now reached base safely in all 26 games this season (and 33 games in a row dating back to last year). Overall Cunningham has reached base safely in 70 of 71 games dating back to last year. Chris Craycraft tossed a nine-inning complete game against SIUE over the weekend. He allowed one unearned run and struck out six while scattering five hits. He retired 10 straight Cougar batters in the middle of the game. His walk in the seventh inning put an end to a 33.2 inning streak without walking a batter, a streak that dated back to Opening Day. Daniel Calhoun improved to 6-0 on the year and is just one win behind the national leaders. His 1.98 E.R.A. is now second in the OVC. The team's 18-8 start is the best since the team started 19-6-1 in 1999. This week the T'Breds will play at Southern Illinois on Tuesday and then host the Salukis at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. (the site of the OVC Tournament). This weekend Murray State travels to Eastern Illinois for OVC action.

Southeast Missouri (16-8, 6-0 OVC): After two weeks of OVC play Southeast Missouri State finds itself on top of the OVC standings with a perfect 6-0 mark. After sweeping Tennessee Tech on the road last weekend, the Redhawks returned home to sweep past UT Martin. Senior first baseman Matt Wagner hit .417 (5-for-12) with three runs, two home runs and seven RBI. He now has nine home runs on the season, which is tied for the OVC lead. In Saturday's 6-5 win, it was Wagner who hit a walk-off home run in the 10th inning to push Southeast to victory. Wagner now has 27 home runs in his three-year career, a mark that ranks him eighth in school history. His 128 RBI ranks him sixth in SMO career history. Southeast closer Jim Klocke recorded his sixth save of the season on Saturday, moving him into third place on the team's single-season list after just 24 games. Klocke, also the team's starting catcher, is hitting .365 on the season. Southeast Missouri will host Evansville and travel to Arkansas State this week before hosting preseason favorite Jacksonville State for a key three-game set this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (5-14): SIU Edwardsville opened last week with a 12-3 neutral site victory over Saint Louis at GCS Ballpark in Sauget, Ill. Spencer Patton threw seven shutout innings for the Cougars, giving up just two hits and striking out eight to pick up his first victory of the season. Over the weekend SIUE traveled to Murray State to play three with the Thoroughbreds. Murray State won the first two in the series before the Cougars won game three 11-9. After MSU took a 9-7 lead in the bottom of the sixth inning (of a 7-inning contest), SIUE exploded for four runs in the top of the final inning to pull out the win. The Cougars will play at Illinois on Wednesday and then travel to Clarksville for three games with Austin Peay this weekend.

Tennessee Tech (11-10, 0-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech won a non-conference game with Belmont to start last week before losing two games at Eastern Illinois over the weekend. The third game of the EIU series was cancelled due to rain. The Golden Eagles find themselves winless in the OVC (0-5) after two weekends of play. The team is now 1-7 in its eight games after starting the season 10-3. Ben Burgess hit .583 (7-for-12) last week with two RBI. A.J. Kirby-Jones and Chad Oberaker each added four hits in 11 at-bats (.364 average). In the team's win over Belmont, Lee Henry picked up the win after pitching the final four innings of the game and scattering three hits while striking out four. The Golden Eagles will host Alabama A&M and East Tennessee State this week before traveling to Morehead State for three games this weekend.

UT Martin (9-13, 0-3 OVC): UT Martin won both of its non-conference games last week and then dropped three OVC games at Southeast Missouri State over the weekend. The non-conference games included a 20-11 and 12-3 home wins over Arkansas-Little Rock. For the week freshman Jordan Owen hit .471 (8-for-17) with six runs scored, three doubles, two home runs and eight RBI. Scott Gladstone extended his hitting streak to 18 games, which is tied for the longest streak in the OVC. Miles Hartsfield has a 16-game streak while Mark Hartsfield enters this week with a 12-game hitting streak. The Skyhawks 7-8-9 hitters combined for seven of the team's 17 hits and six of the team's seven RBI in Sunday's 12-8 loss to Southeast Missouri. UTM is back in action this week when they host Lipscomb, travel to Evansville and then play an OVC series at Eastern Kentucky.

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: After two weekends of OVC play, two teams remain undefeated in the conference with Southeast Missouri 6-0 and Eastern Illinois 5-0 (with one rainout) and sitting atop the standings...Southeast Missouri will host current third-place and preseason favorite Jacksonville State this coming weekend while Eastern Illinois will host Murray State...Jacksonville State is tied with Eastern Kentucky in the standings and EKU will host UT Martin for three games this weekend...The other OVC action will see Tennessee Tech travel to Morehead State.

EIU's Morrell One of 30 Student-Athletes Up for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: For his all-around excellence as a student-athlete, **Brian Morrell** of Eastern Illinois baseball has been named one of 30 candidates nationally for the prestigious Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Morrell is a senior pitcher for the Panthers and has served as the bullpen's long-relief ace each of his upperclassman seasons. The Quincy native carries a 4.0 GPA while majoring in biological sciences. He was an ESPN the Magazine Second Team All-America honoree as a junior. The list of 30 candidates in baseball will be trimmed to a group of 10 finalists in April. Those 10 names will then be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote beginning April 15 and concluding May 31. Fan balloting will be coupled with votes from coaches and media to determine the recipient of the award. The award, given annually to senior student-athletes across nine NCAA Division I sports, has become one of the most prestigious honors in college athletics. The candidates were selected based on their dedication and achievement in four areas: Classroom, Character, Community, and Competition. The Lowe's Senior CLASS Award is distinctive from many other honors in that on-the-field performance is only one factor in determining candidacy – a major emphasis is placed on off-the-field commitments and personal character. An acronym for *Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School*, the award was launched during the 2001-02 season in response to the trend of college basketball players leaving college early to turn professional.

Murray State's Hill Named Louisville Slugger & Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week: Murray State junior outfielder **Daniel Hill** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and the Pro-Line Athletic National Player of the Week by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on March 9. Hill (Germantown, Tenn.) helped the 'Breds to a 5-1 week by going 15-for-26 (.577) with two doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs and nine runs scored. He had a slugging percentage of 1.231 and an on-base percentage of .633. He started the week by going 3-for-4 with a pair of RBIs in a mid-week victory over Freed-Hardeman and followed it up the next day by going 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs against Arkansas State. Hill stepped up his game in the four-game series against North Dakota State as he led school-record 28-hit attack in the series opener by going 5-for-7 with a double, three home runs and eight RBIs in the 20-9 victory. He tied the MSU single-game record for hits and home runs in a game. In the first game of a double-header on Saturday, Hill did not get much to hit at the plate as he walked twice and was hit by a pitch in four plate appearances. The Bison did not fare so well in the second game as Hill was 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs. The series finale turned into a classic slugfest as the 'Breds rallied twice and survived a ninth-inning rally. Hill hit his fifth home run of the week and drove in three runs in the 13-11 victory.

Tootle Named to Brooks Wallace Award Watch List: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** has been named to the preseason Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List as announced by the College Baseball Foundation. The Wallace Award is dedicated to the memory of former Texas Tech player and assistant coach Brooks Wallace. Wallace was a slick-fielding shortstop at Texas Tech from 1977 to 1980. A four-year starter, he was named All-Southwest Conference and All-District his senior year. He led the Red Raiders to their first-ever appearance in the Southwest Conference Tournament in 1980. The Wallace Award is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The 2009 award banquet will be at 7 p.m., Thursday, July 2, in the United Spirit Arena on the campus of Texas Tech University.

JSU's Tootle Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Ben Tootle** has been named to the 2009 Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List by USA Baseball, marking the organization's first step toward identifying the top player in college baseball. be presented in 2009 for the 32nd time. The award is sponsored by Major League Baseball. Last season Tootle was named first-team All-OVC after leading the conference with an impressive 10-2 record with two shutouts in 2008. He finished the season with 79 strikeouts, which was the second most in the OVC, and had a 3.87 earned run average. He was named OVC Pitcher of the Week three times during the season after going a perfect 8-0 against conference members. Baseball America named Tootle as the fourth-best prospect from this summer's Cape Cod League, while ESPN's Keith Law has named the Gamecock pitching ace as the 13th best prospect in the country for the 2009 season.

Austin Peay's Tenholder Named to NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List: Austin Peay relief pitcher **Daniel Tenholder** has been named to the initial 40-player watch list for the fifth annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball. Tenholder returns after posting a 4-1 record and an OVC-best 11 saves in 2008. He ranked 18th nationally in saves last season and is one of the nation's top seven returning relievers. Tenholder compiled a 2.72 ERA in 36.1 innings over 30 appearances, striking out 41 batters. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 16, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, May 27, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee will then select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in early June.

JSU's Tootle Named to Numerous Preseason All-American Teams: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** was named to four preseason All-American lists this year. Tootle was a first-team NCBWA selection, second-team Louisville Slugger pick and a third-team choice by Ping! and Baseball America. Eastern Illinois' **Brett Nommensen** was a third-team pick by Ping! while Southeast Missouri catcher **Jim Klocke** was a honorable mention pick by Ping!.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite For Second Straight Season: For the second year in a row, Jacksonville State has been picked as the preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The Gamecocks claimed the 2008 regular season championship with a 23-4 record last season but came up just short in the OVC Tournament. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as Jacksonville State, who received five first-place votes, edged Eastern Illinois, who had the other four first-place votes, by just one total point. Eastern Illinois swept through four games at the OVC Tournament last season on its way to team's first title since 1999 and a berth in the NCAA Regionals. Those two teams were followed by Austin Peay (48 points), Southeast Missouri State (42), Tennessee Tech (38), Murray State (23), Morehead State (22), Eastern Kentucky (20) and UT Martin (10).

Nommensen and Tootle Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: Jacksonville State junior right-hander **Ben Tootle** was tabbed the OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Eastern Illinois senior outfielder **Brett Nommensen** was picked the OVC Preseason Player of the Year in a preseason vote of league head coaches. Nommensen produced gaudy numbers last year in earning All-OVC first-team honors as well as being selected to the NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. He hit .402 with 82 hits, 56 runs, 18 doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI. His slugging percentage was .603 while his on-base percentage was a league-best .518. Nommensen also stole 18 bases. Tootle, who was named a preseason All-American by numerous outlets has been great in his first two seasons at JSU. In two years with Jax State, Tootle has compiled a 16-5 overall record, including an unblemished 8-0 mark against Conference opponents a season ago. Last season he struck out 79 batters and walked only 29 in 86 innings of work.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
