Daniel Hill, OF • Jr., 6-0, 190 • Germantown, Tenn. • Murray State

In six games last week, Hill clubbed five home runs and drove in 18 RBI as Murray State compiled a 5-1 overall record. Overall he hit .577 (15-of-26) with nine runs scored and two doubles. In the series-opening victory over North Dakota State, Hill was 5-for-7 with a four runs scored, double, three home runs and eight RBI in the 20-9 Thoroughbred victory. He also had two or more RBI in four of the other five games during the week (the fifth game he had only one official plate appearance as he walked three times).

Daniel Calhoun, LHP • Jr., 6-2, 190 • Evansville, Ind. • Murray State

Calhoun earned his second-straight OVC Pitcher of the Week honors after allowing only one unearned run in eight innings of work last week. In a relief appearance against Arkansas State, Calhoun retired all three batters he faced as Murray State went on to win 11-5. On Saturday in an 11-1 victory over North Dakota State he tossed a complete-game, two-hitter to improve to 3-0 on the season with a 1.29 E.R.A. In the win over the Bison, Calhoun struck out 14, including the final nine batters of the game. For the week opponents hit only .080 against him.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (5-6, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay won three of four games last week, winning four of six games total on its most recent home stand. The Governors topped Indiana State (12-4) to start the week and then lost the opener to Iowa (15-9) before taking the final two games from the Hawkeyes (10-4, 20-9). Junior Matt Kole hit .545 (6-for-11) with seven runs scored, a double, four home runs and nine RBI to lead APSU. Returning from injury, Kole homered in his first two at-bats against Iowa, then added a round-tripper in each of the next two games. As a team the Govs hit .347 for the week, hammering nine home runs and driving in 50 runs. They were also successful on the base paths, stealing 11 bases in 12 attempts. Sophomore Ryne Harper saw his scoreless innings streak to start the season end at 15, allowing a home run in game one against Iowa. Junior lefty Jake Snodgrass made his season debut against ISU, going 6.2 innings and allowing one run on six hits while striking out four. Austin Peay will play two games at Ole Miss this week before coming back to Raymond C. Hand Park to host Milwaukee for four games this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (6-3, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois, who will play its first 20 games of the season away from home, won three of four games last week, including topping in-state rival Southern Illinois to begin the week. The Panthers then played three games at the University of Louisville's stadium, topping Milwaukee twice and losing to No. 25 Louisville in the other contest. Junior Richie Derbak hit .550 (11-for-20) for the week, scoring four runs, netting four doubles, a home run and six RBI (all of which came with two outs). His week was highlighted by a five-hit game in a 16-4 win over Milwaukee. In that game he homered, doubled three times and scored three times. He also came into the game to pitch on Saturday, earning a save after pitching an inning and two-thirds against UWM; four of the five outs he recorded came by strikeout. Derbak also pitched an inning of scoreless relief against SIU. On the mound sophomore Mike Recchia made two appearances and pitched 10.0 innings in picking up a win. Recchia tossed three scoreless innings against SIU then allowed only one run in 7.1 innings against UWM. The win over Southern Illinois during the week was the first since 1998 (team teams did not play from 1998-2005). Sophomore Josh Mueller tossed 7.1 innings of two-run ball against Milwaukee and Tyler Kehrer went six strong innings against UofL. EIU will play at Indiana State on Tuesday then head to Tampa, Fla. to play in the USF Bulls Baseball Classic. The Panthers will play host USF, Bethune-Cookman and Oklahoma.

Eastern Kentucky (3-4, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky play three games last week, topping No. 25 Louisville, losing in walk-off fashion to No. 29 Kentucky and falling to Bowling Green in its first game of a Spring Break trip to Winter Haven, Fla. Senior outfielder Matt Davis hit .462 (6-for-13) with three runs, two doubles and two RBI last week. He was 2-for-4 with two runs scored and a RBI in the win over in-state for Louisville. He was 3-for-6 in the Colonels loss at UK. Junior pitcher Jim Clancy struck out six of the first seven batters he faced in the win over the nationally-ranked Cardinals. He lasted five innings, allowing two hits, two walks and striking out five in picking up the win. EKV continues its Florida trip with five more games this week. The Colonels will play Bowling Green, Sacred Heart, Bucknell, Vermont, Connecticut and Toledo before returning to the Bluegrass State.

Jacksonville State (5-5, 0-0 OVC): After starting the season 1-4, Jacksonville State won four of its five games last week to even its record at .500 on the season. The Gamecocks won at UAB and then took three of four games from Harvard at home. Sophomore hurler Jason Zylstra allowed only one hit in seven innings while striking out seven to pick up his first win of the season. The only hit he allowed was a slow roller through the left side in the fourth inning. Harvard hit just .043 against the righty. Junior outfielder Daniel Adamson hit .368 (7-for-19) with five runs scored, a double, triple, home run, seven RBI and two stolen bases last week. He raised his batting average 66 points during the week. Junior Ben Tootle picked up his first win of the season at UAB, allowing just three hits and striking out eight. He has allowed only two earned runs in his last 34.0 innings dating back to May of last season. He now has 17 career wins and 158 career strikeouts. Jax State is going to hit the road, as the team play nine of its next 10 away from home. Including Friday's opener with Harvard, the team will have played 12 games in 13 games after it plays Troy on March 18. This week the team will be in Lakeland, Fla. to play at the RussMat Central Florida Games. JSU's opponents include Miami (Ohio), Central Michigan, Indiana, Bradley

Morehead State (4-5, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State played six games last week, including one at Marshall that was suspended and will be resumed before Wednesday's schedule home game with the Thundering Herd. The game was tied 4-4 after 12 innings when suspended due to darkness. MSU started the week with a 6-1 loss to Western Michigan in Lexington, Ky. Morehead State then returned home to play Long Island, sweeping the Blackbirds by a combined margin of 68-49. That included a 27-19 win

Last season the Eastern Illinois Panthers went undefeated in the event and topped Southeast Missouri in the finals to claim the championship.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

and a 23-16 victory. In the 27-19 victory, the team had a school-record 26 hits and came up just one run short of another school mark. Junior Michael Bottoms hit .500 (9-for-18) in that series, driving in 13 runs and compiling a .7778 slugging percentage. He also pitched in Saturday's doubleheader, picking up a win. Senior Tyler Bess pitched the final four innings of Friday's 8-6 victory, picking up a win while allowing two hits and striking out six. MSU is leading the OVC in batting, compiling a team average of .354 through nine games. Morehead will play at Indiana on Tuesday, host Marshall on Wednesday and then host Canisius for four games this weekend.

Murray State (9-3, 0-0 OVC): A favorable home schedule and some hot hitting has led the Thoroughbreds to a 9-3 start through 12 games. The team is off to its best start since the 2001 season. The team is hitting .323 (second in the league) and leads the Conference in E.R.A. (4.27). Murray State topped Freed-Hardeman and Arkansas State at home and then took three of four from North Dakota State at home over the weekend. Junior outfielder Daniel Hill was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week (and OVC Player of the Week) after hitting .577 (15-of-26) with nine runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 18 RBI. Hill was 5-for-7 with four runs, a double, three home runs and eight RBI in his team's 20-9 win over NDSU on Friday. The five hits and three home runs in a game were Murray State records. He had two or more RBI in five of six games last week. Teammate Daniel Calhoun picked up his second OVC Pitcher of the Week award in a row, pitching a seven-inning complete game against NDSU on Saturday. He struck out 14 batters, including the final nine of the game. Calhoun allowed only one unearned run and two hits in the game. He is now 3-0 on the season with a 1.29 E.R.A. For the week the 'Breds had 10 home runs and scored 66 runs. As a team the Thoroughbreds have 13 home runs after hitting only 10 all of last season. MSU will complete its 11-game home stand on Wednesday when Mississippi Valley State comes to town. This weekend Murray State will play at regional rival Saint Louis.

Southeast Missouri (7-5, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri State split six games last week, topping rival Saint Louis at a neutral site in Sauget, Ill., losing to St. Catharine and going 2-2 against Northern Iowa over the weekend. Senior 1B Matt Wagner hit .409 (9-for-22) with three home runs and eight RBI; Wagner slugged .864 for the week but did commit four errors in the field. Tony Spencer also hit .409 while Tyrell Cummings hit .370 (10-for-27) with two home runs and eight RBI. James Leigh picked up a win against UNI over the weekend and pitched three innings of scoreless relief in the win over SLU to start the week. He struck out 11 batters in 8.1 innings of work during the week. The Redhawks are back in action this coming weekend when Northern Illinois comes to town for a four-game set.

SIU Edwardsville (1-4, 0-0 OVC): SIU Edwardsville has embarked on a seven-game road trip to Florida which started with a win and a loss. The team topped Leigh 6-5 in 10 innings to pick up its first win of the season on Saturday. That game was followed by a 8-4 loss to St. Bonaventure. The team will play St. Bonaventure again on Monday and also battle Pittsburgh, Saint Joseph's, Long Island and Ohio State in Florida before the week is over. Charlie Thrasher leads the team with a .429 average while Josh Street is hitting .355 with a team-high 10 RBI.

Tennessee Tech (8-3, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech continued its early season success, winning three of four games last week against Toledo. The Golden Eagles took games by scores of 4-2, 14-7, 8-6 and then lost the series finale 11-7. Sophomore A.J. Kirby-Jones hit .471 (8-for-17) with five runs scored, four doubles, two home runs and nine RBI in the series. Six of his eight hits in the series were for extra bases as he slugged 1.059 and had 18 total bases. He hit a two-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning to tie Saturday's contest that Tech went on to win 8-6. Kirby-Jones also pitched 3.1 innings of relief during the week, striking out five batters. The loss on Sunday ended TTU's five-game winning streak overall. The Golden Eagles are back in action this week when they host Belmont for a single game and Valparaiso for a four-game set.

UT Martin (4-4, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin lost two of three games last week, falling at Southern Illinois and losing to Lambuth at home and defeating Bethel at home. Senior Miles Hartsfield hit .462 (6-for-13) with a double and two RBI last week. That included a 5-for-5 performance in the team's one-run victory over Bethel. Junior catcher Ty Nelson hit .455 last week and now has a six-game hitting streak. Already this season the Skyhawks have played four one-run games, compiling an impressive 3-1 record in those contests. UT Martin will play its next six games away from home, starting this week with two games at UAB. The team will then play three games at Georgia State in Atlanta this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Three weeks into the 2009 season Ohio Valley Conference teams have fared well against non-conference competition, compiling a 51-38 record...That includes a 3-2 record against teams from each the SEC and Big Ten and a 7-4 record against the Missouri Valley Conference...The league has wins over nationally-ranked Alabama (Southeast Missouri twice) and Louisville (Eastern Kentucky) this season...This week's set of games includes a full slate, as several teams take Spring Break trips to Florida.

Murray State's Hill Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week: Murray State junior outfielder **Daniel Hill** was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball on March 9. Hill (Germantown, Tenn.) helped the 'Breds to a 5-1 week by going 15-for-26 (.577) with two doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs and nine runs scored. He had a slugging percentage of 1.231 and an on-base percentage of .633. He started the week by going 3-for-4 with a pair of RBIs in a mid-week victory over Freed-Hardeman and followed it up the next day by going 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs against Arkansas State. Hill stepped up his game in the four-game series against North Dakota State as he led school-record 28-hit attack in the series opener by going 5-for-7 with a double, three home runs and eight RBIs in the 20-9 victory. He tied the MSU single-game record for hits and home runs in a game. In the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday, Hill did not get much to hit at the plate as he walked twice and was hit by a pitch in four plate appearances. The Bison did not fare so well in the second game as Hill was 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs. The series finale turned into a classic slugfest as the 'Breds rallied twice and survived a ninth-inning rally. Hill hit his fifth home run of the week and drove in three runs in the 13-11 victory.

Tootle Named to Brooks Wallace Award Watch List: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** has been named to the preseason Brooks Wallace Player of the Year Award Watch List as announced by the College Baseball Foundation. The Wallace Award is dedicated to the memory of former Texas Tech player and assistant coach Brooks Wallace. Wallace was a slick-fielding shortstop at Texas Tech from 1977 to 1980. A four-year starter, he was named All-Southwest Conference and All-District his senior year. He led the Red Raiders to their first-ever appearance in the Southwest Conference Tournament in 1980. The Wallace Award is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate baseball player in conjunction with the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremonies. The 2009 award banquet will be at 7 p.m., Thursday, July 2, in the United Spirit Arena on the campus of Texas Tech University.

JSU's Tootle Named to Golden Spikes Award Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Ben Tootle** has been named to the 2009 Preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List by USA Baseball, marking the organization's first step toward identifying the top player in college baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top collegiate talents and will be presented in 2009 for the 32nd time. The award is sponsored by Major League Baseball. Last season Tootle was named first-team All-OVC after leading the conference with an impressive 10-2 record with two shutouts in 2008. He finished the season with 79 strikeouts, which was the second most in the OVC, and had a 3.87 earned run average. He was named OVC Pitcher of the Week three times during the season after going a perfect 8-0 against conference members. Baseball America named Tootle as the fourth-best prospect from this summer's Cape Cod League, while ESPN's Keith Law has named the Gamecock pitching ace as the 13th best prospect in the country for the 2009 season.

Austin Peay's Tenholder Named to NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List: Austin Peay relief pitcher **Daniel Tenholder** has been named to the initial 40-player watch list for the fifth annual National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I baseball. Tenholder returns after posting a 4-1 record and an OVC-best 11 saves in 2008. He ranked 18th nationally in saves last season and is one of the nation's top seven returning relievers. Tenholder compiled a 2.72 ERA in 36.1 innings over 30 appearances, striking out 41 batters. The initial list will be updated with a mid-season release the week of April 16, including the national saves leaders. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, May 27, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee will then select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced in early June.

JSU's Tootle Named to Numerous Preseason All-American Teams: Jacksonville State junior pitcher **Ben Tootle** was named to four preseason All-American lists this year. Tootle was a first-team NCBWA selection, second-team Louisville Slugger pick and a third-team choice by Ping! and Baseball America. Eastern Illinois' **Brett Nommensen** was a third-team pick by Ping! while Southeast Missouri catcher **Jim Klocke** was a honorable mention pick by Ping!.

Jacksonville State Picked as Preseason Favorite For Second Straight Season: For the second year in a row, Jacksonville State has been picked as the preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The Gamecocks claimed the 2008 regular season championship with a 23-4 record last season but came up just short in the OVC Tournament. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as Jacksonville State, who received five first-place votes, edged Eastern Illinois, who had the other four first-place votes, by just one total point. Eastern Illinois swept through four games at the OVC Tournament last season on its way to team's first title since 1999 and a berth in the NCAA Regionals. Those two teams were followed by Austin Peay (48 points), Southeast Missouri State (42), Tennessee Tech (38), Murray State (23), Morehead State (22), Eastern Kentucky (20) and UT Martin (10).

Nommensen and Tootle Named Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year: Jacksonville State junior right-hander **Ben Tootle** was tabbed the OVC Preseason Pitcher of the Year while Eastern Illinois senior outfielder **Brett Nommensen** was picked the OVC Preseason Player of the Year in a preseason vote of league head coaches. Nommensen produced gaudy numbers last year in earning All-OVC first-team honors as well as being selected to the NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team. He hit .402 with 82 hits, 56 runs, 18 doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI. His slugging percentage was .603 while his on-base percentage was a league-best .518. Nommensen also stole 18 bases. Tootle, who was named a preseason All-American by numerous outlets has been great in his first two seasons at JSU. In two years with Jax State, Tootle has compiled a 16-5 overall record, including an unblemished 8-0 mark against Conference opponents a season ago. Last season he struck out 79 batters and walked only 29 in 86 innings of work.
