PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

ERNIE BRACAMONTE • SS, SR. • CHANDLER, AZ • SE MISSOURI

Bracamonte hit .524 (11-for-21) while driving in six runs and scoring five more as Southeast Missouri posted a 3-2 record last week. The Chandler, Ariz., native's best outing came against 19th-ranked Missouri, where he went 4-of-6 with five RBI and three runs, including a three-run homer in the bottom of the 10th that lifted the Redhawks to an 8-5 upset of the Tigers. The senior shortstop also sparkled defensively, recording eight putouts and 13 assists without an error during the five-game stretch.

Hardy and Thomas teamed up to throw back-to-back complete-game shutouts in Saturday's 6-0, 6-0 twinbill sweep of OVC opponent Tennessee Tech. Hardy, a native of Bethel Springs, Tenn., ran his streak of scoreless innings to 21 while recording his third straight victory and second consecutive complete-game shutout, giving up three hits with four strikeouts in nine innings of work in Game 1. Thomas, a product of Rio Rancho, N.M., then fanned five batters while ceding four hits through seven innings of his Game 2 victory, marking his first complete game as a Governor and first-ever shutout.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (18-12, 5-4 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a midweek contest to Middle Tennessee but recovered with a three-game OVC sweep at Tennessee Tech. The Governors are 5-4 and have moved from the Conference cellar to a third-place tie in two weeks...Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** and senior LHP **Devin Thomas** both threw complete-game shutouts at Tech as part of Saturday's twinbill. Hardy ran his streak of scoreless innings to 21 while picking up his third straight victory and second consecutive complete-game shutout. Thomas threw his first complete game as a Gov and his first career shutout...Senior **Jared Walker** sits one hit shy of reaching the 200 career hit milestone after leading the team with a .533 average, going 8-for-15...Junior **Cody Youngblood** had a hit in each of the four contests to run his hitting streak to 10 games. He also had a busy week on the basepaths, going 4-for-5 and upping his season stolen base total to 17...APSU entered the week with just eight homers but belted out five during the four-game stretch...All six of **Jacob Schroeder**'s hits went for extra bases as he accounted for four of the Govs' nine doubles and finished with a 1.000 slugging percentage...APSU travels to Middle Tennessee and Memphis before returning home to entertain Southeast Missouri in OVC play.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (8-21, 5-4 OVC): Eastern Illinois moved into a third-place tie in the OVC standings, taking two of three from host Jacksonville State. Earlier in the week, the Panthers dropped non-conference decisions to Indiana State and Northern Illinois...Sophomore 3B **Ryan Campbell** led EIU with a .444 average at the plate (8-for-18), driving in four runs and rapping out three doubles plus a homer...Sophomore P **Chris Vaculik** picked up a win and a save while pitching 6.1 scoreless innings in three appearances...The Panthers racked up 30 runs and belted four homers during the five-game stretch, batting .328 and slugging .471 as a team...EIU visits to Southern Illinois before returning home to host Saint Xavier and OVC opponent Samford.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (9-15, 3-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky has lost five straight after dropping a non-conference decision to Tennessee and going 0-3 in OVC action at Murray State...Freshman P **Shane Zegarac** fanned a career-high 10 batters while tossing his first-ever complete game in the nightcap of Saturday's doubleheader versus the 'Breds...Sophomore **Tony Wells** went 0-for-3 at the plate on Sunday to see his hit streak snapped at 16 games...Junior **Brett Bolger** has hit safely in 15 straight games and leads the league in both batting (.476) and on-base percentage (.521)...EKU continues to lead the Conference in hitting (.323), despite batting just .285 as a team last week...The Colonels complete a six-game road swing with non-conference contests at Xavier and Western Kentucky before hosting OVC opponent Jacksonville State.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (13-16, 5-4 OVC): Jacksonville State slipped into a third-place tie after dropping two of three to OVC opponent Eastern Illinois. Earlier in the week, the Gamecocks routed Alabama State (22-8) to record the sixth-most runs in school history and a season-high. The 22 runs also marked the second-best tally under head coach **Jim Case**...Senior OF **Winston Pearson** is riding a 13-game hit streak after going 8-of-14 (.571) from the plate, driving in five runs and scoring nine more...Sophomore P **Jon Clements** held EIU to three hits while tossing his second complete game of the season en route to the 7-2 victory in game two of Saturday's twinbill versus the Panthers...The EIU series marked the Gamecocks' first OVC series loss this season...Jax State plays five games on the road this week with two at South Alabama and three at OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-14, 8-0 OVC): Morehead State has won seven games in a row, two off the school record, after defeating Shawnee State and taking all three OVC outings at Tennessee-Martin. The Eagles sit undefeated atop the Conference rankings at 8-0...Sophomore C **Donald Cheney** batted .529 (9-of-17) with seven RBI and three runs for the week while posting slugging and on-base percentages of .882 and .526, respectively...Senior RHP **Adrian Duran** took a no-hitter into the eighth inning of Saturday's 8-3 win at UT Martin before surrendering three hits and three runs after a two-out error extended the frame...Senior 2B **Lance Seasor** pushed his hitting streak to 21 games...Junior DH **Paul Rhodes** returned to the lineup last week after missing six games with a hand injury, going 6-of-15 at the plate (.400) while scoring eight runs and knocking in six more...On Sunday, the Eagles had three different hitters (**Rhodes**, **Cheney** and **Kevin Bryant**) come to the plate with chances to hit for the cycle. None were successful, though, as Rhodes

lacked a double while Cheney and Bryant needed triples...Junior RHP **Dan Klausmeier** continued his solid work on the mound, going 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA in three appearances, allowing one earned run in 5.1 innings of action...The Eagles travel to Marshall before playing host to second-place Murray State in an OVC showdown.

MURRAY STATE (18-14, 7-2 OVC): Murray State remains in second place at 7-2 after sweeping OVC foe Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. Earlier in the week, the Thoroughbreds dropped a 6-2 decision to Southern Illinois...Senior 3B **Alex Stewart** led the team with a .636 effort at the plate (7-for-11) against EKU, slugging 1.091 while tallying three runs and six RBI...Junior RHP **Billy Fares** tossed his fourth complete game of the season en route to picking up the win in game two of Saturday's twinbill with EKU, striking out seven and walking none...The 'Breds outscored the Colonels 32-9 and racked up 41 hits to EKU's 24 while outhitting the league's top offense (.402 to .250)...DH **Chaz Ebert** went 7-for-11 in the EKU series with three doubles, six runs and five RBI, while C **Dustin Hennigar** went 6-for-10 with four runs and four RBI...The 'Breds pitching staff posted a 1.80 ERA in the series with 16 strikeouts to two walks over 25 innings. All three starters pitched seven innings, with **West Harris** getting the Game 3 win, allowing only two hits after the first inning, while **Craig Kraus** got the come-from-behind win in the first game...Murray State hosts Evansville and Arkansas State before heading cross-state to take on league leader Morehead State.

SAMFORD (9-20, 4-5 OVC): Samford took two of three from Southeast Missouri to improve its Conference record to 4-5. Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs dropped a 14-5 decision to 24th-ranked Mississippi State...Freshman IF **Bill Whitehead** led the team with a .429 batting average last week, including a 4-for-5, two-RBI effort in Saturday's 13-5 win versus the Redhawks...Sophomore P **Chandler Tidwell** struck out seven batters and surrendered just two earned runs through 7.0 innings to pick up Sunday's 4-2 victory over Southeast...The Bulldogs have added an April 12 home game against Auburn and will be looking for their second straight win over the Tigers this season. Samford also visits Mississippi State before traveling to Eastern Illinois for OVC play.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (12-18, 3-6 OVC): Southeast Missouri recorded back-to-back non-conference extra-inning victories over Saint Louis and then 19th-ranked Missouri before going 1-2 at Samford in OVC action. The win over Mizzou snapped the Redhawks' four-game losing streak...Senior SS **Ernie Bracamonte** had a great game against the Tigers, going 4-for-6 with five RBI and three runs, including a walk-off three-run homer in the bottom of the 10th. For the week, he batted .524 (11-of-21) with five runs and six RBI while extending his hitting streak to 12 games...Catcher **Brady Noll** hit .500 with one homer in five starts behind the plate...**Freddy Lopez** collected six RBI...Freshman P **Joey Evans** saw his consecutive scoreless innings streak snapped at 12, but won his fourth straight game in as many appearances, going 3-0 last week while holding opponents to one earned run and a .107 batting average through 8.2 innings of action. He has made 14 outings this season, including complete-game efforts in three starts, while posting a 5-3 record with a 2.62 ERA...The Redhawks make a return trip to Missouri, then head over to Austin Peay for Conference play.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (6-22, 2-6 OVC): Tennessee-Martin dropped four straight games this past week, including a non-conference game to Arkansas State and a three-game series against Morehead State...The Skyhawks committed 15 errors during the stretch, including six in Sunday's 18-11 loss to the Eagles...Junior RHP **Scott Massey** pitched two innings against Morehead State in game one of Saturday's double-header before having to come out because of tightness in his throwing arm...Junior SS **Hideaki Sato** hit .444 to lead the Skyhawks, going 8-for-18 with a double and an RBI...Skyhawk pitchers Massey, **Adam Ledlow** and **Jacob Smothers** all turned in 0.00 ERA's this past week. Ledlow pitched 4.2 innings against Morehead State, while Massey and Smothers pitched two innings each against the Eagles.

TENNESSEE TECH (6-24, 1-7 OVC): Tennessee Tech saw its losing skid stretch to nine games after the Golden Eagles dropped a midweek decision to Lipscomb and three straight to OVC foe Austin Peay...Senior 1B **Nathan Marty** hit his fifth home run of the season as part of a 3-for-4 in Sunday's narrow 10-9 loss to the Govs. He leads the team with a .324 batting average, 21 RBI and five homers...The Golden Eagles return a game at Lipscomb and visit East Tennessee State before returning home to host Tennessee-Martin in league action.
