PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

DONALD CHENEY • C, JR. • CRIDERSVILLE, OH • MOREHEAD STATE

Cheney hit safely in all four Morehead State contests last week to extend his hit streak to seven games. On Friday, the Cridersville, Ohio, native belted three home runs in game one of a twinbill sweep of UT Martin. Cheney also rapped out a double and a triple among his seven hits on the week, posting a slugging percentage of 1.267 while driving in seven runs and scoring four more. In addition, Cheney walked twice and was hit by a pitch once to finish with a .556 on-base percentage. Behind the plate, the junior catcher went errorless in 14 chances and did not have a runner attempt a stolen base.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

HENRY MABEE • RHP, JR. • VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA • MOREHEAD ST.

Mabee threw a seven-inning shutout to lead Morehead State to a 2-0 victory in game two of the UT Martin series, stretching his streak of not allowing an earned run to 19.2 innings (all in Conference play) en route to his fourth consecutive complete game. The junior righthander surrendered five hits without a walk and did not allow a runner past second base. A Canadian product who hails from Victoria, British Columbia, Mabee retired the last five batters and seven of the last eight, striking out the final two.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (20-15, 5-7 OVC): Austin Peay saw its losing streak reach seven games, dropping a midweek outing to Middle Tennessee (15-5) and a Friday twinbill to Tennessee Tech (5-3, 2-1) before snapping the skid in Saturday's series finale against the Golden Eagles (11-7)...Senior LF **Ryan Kane's** 31-game hit streak is tied for the nation's longest active streak...Kane also has reached base safely in every game during the 2006 campaign and in 43 consecutive games dating back to last season...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** (6-2, 2.74 ERA) picked up his season's second consecutive loss, allowing two earned runs in the game one loss on Friday...Junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** (2-3) has only allowed 14 runs in 57.1 innings pitched, lowering his league-leading ERA to 1.57...Freshman **Ryan Gilboy** has made the start at first base in the Govs' last five games, going 9-for-19 (.473) at the plate during that stretch...Senior OF and leadoff hitter **Cody Youngblood** leads the team in batting (.362) and on-base percentage (.472) while ranking second in slugging (.477)...The Govs end their third five-game homestand of the season with a pair of mid-week affairs versus Western Kentucky and Belmont before embarking on a season-long five-game road stretch at OVC opponent Southeast Missouri.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (18-14, 7-5 OVC): Eastern Illinois picked up a 6-1 victory over Indiana State before taking two of three from OVC foe Jacksonville State, winning games one and two (8-2, 7-1) and dropping a tough 5-4 decision in 13 innings in the series finale, the Panthers' first extra-inning game of the year...Junior 1B **Erik Huber** was 6-for-11 with runners in scoring position and 3-for-4 with the bases loaded, rapping out seven hits and driving in six runs last week to push his career-long and team season-high hit streak to 13 games...Senior RHP **Kenny Firlit** (2-1, 4.50 ERA) picked up a win in his first career OVC start, scattering four hits and allowing just one run over five innings in game two of the JSU series...Freshman **Brett Nommensen** went 5-for-5 in the JSU series opener, collecting the Panthers' first five-hit game of the year...Junior SS **Adam Varrassi** recorded his first career four-hit game in the series finale, homering in his first at-bat...Junior OF **Mark Chagnon** extended his hit streak to 11 games and tallied a .579 on-base percentage, rapping out seven hits, walking three times and getting hit by a pitch...All 14 of the Panthers' hits in game one of the JSU series were singles...EIU's first three batters in the lineup went a combined 14-for-22 in Friday's twinbill sweep...The Panthers host Aurora and Southern Illinois before traveling to OVC foe Samford.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (18-14, 7-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky posted a 2-2 mark last week, edging Miami (OH), 6-5, before winning one of three in its OVC series with Murray State...The Colonels surrendered 26 runs to the Throughbreds in a doubleheader loss on Friday, but won a 16-13 slugfest in Saturday's finale...Four of junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough's** eight hits went for extra bases, including three homers, as he registered slugging and on-base percentages of 1.200 and .632, respectively, while driving in seven runs and scoring six more...Yarbrough leads the OVC and ranks among NCAA leaders in homers (13), RBI (47) and slugging percentage (.831)...Freshman RHP **David Owens** (2-0, 2.45 ERA) earned his first save of the season, inducing a double play and a flyout after coming on in relief in the ninth inning of Saturday's Murray State series finale with a man on first and no outs...EKU makes a return visit to Miami (OH) before visiting Jacksonville State for OVC action.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (17-19, 6-6 OVC): Jacksonville State went 2-2 on the week, edging UAB (5-4) before taking one of three from Eastern Illinois in OVC action...The Gamecocks lost both ends of Friday's twinbill (8-2, 7-1) but salvaged the series with a 5-4 victory in 13 innings on Saturday...Freshman 1B **Jay Harrington** led the team with a .417 batting average for the week, belting his first career homer with a two-run shot against UAB...Sophomore reliever **Mitch Miller** (2-2, 7.23 ERA) made three appearances, picking up a win and a save while allowing four hits over 5.0 innings of work...JSU now has five players batting over .300 on the season, led by sophomore OF **Brian Piazza's** .351...Piazza is batting .429 in OVC games...Senior OF **Jason Horn** hit a game-winning homer in the top of the ninth at UAB, his first round-tripper of the season...Six players have active hitting streaks, led by junior OF **Nick Cleckler's** eight-game streak...Through 12 OVC games, the Gamecock pitching staff has recorded 90 strikeouts, while the opponents have just 53...JSU is also 20-of-22 in stolen bases in league games...The Gamecocks return home to host Alabama State and OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

MOREHEAD STATE (14-19, 5-6 OVC): Morehead State posted a 2-2 mark last week, dropping a 15-3 decision to Marshall before taking two of three from UT Martin...The Eagles swept Friday's twinbill with the Skyhawks (10-7, 2-0) but were unable to complete the trifecta with a 23-7 loss in Saturday's series finale...Junior C **Donald Cheney** drove in seven runs and scored four more while going 7-for-15 and stretching his team-leading hit streak to seven games...Cheney belted three homers in game one of the UT Martin series, hitting at least one each from the left and right side of the plate, and also had a double and a triple to finish with a 1.267 slugging percentage for the week...The Eagles continue to get sparkling pitching from their top two Conference starters, senior RHP **Shane Lucci** (5-5, 4.78 ERA) and junior RHP **Henry Mabee** (3-5, 3.44 ERA)...Lucci pitched eight and a third innings in the game

one victory over UT Martin, while Mabree tossed a seven-inning shutout for the game two win against the Skyhawks...Mabree has thrown four straight complete games while not giving up an earned run in 19.2 consecutive innings...All 12 of Morehead State's runs in Saturday's doubleheader win crossed the plate courtesy of the long-ball...Senior 2B **Paul Rhodes** has a five-game hitting streak...The Eagles take a break before traveling to OVC rival Murray State.

MURRAY STATE (10-26, 3-9 OVC): Murray State dropped a 12-1 decision to Memphis, then exploded for 26 runs in an OVC doubleheader sweep of Eastern Kentucky on Friday...The thoroughbreds were unable to make it three in a row, however, falling to the Colonels, 16-13, in Saturday's series finale...Junior 2B **Seth Hudson** went 6-for-9 at EKU with two doubles, a triple, four runs and three RBI...He finished the series with a 1.111 slugging percentage and a .700 on-base percentage...Senior LHP **Andrew Bishop** (2-5, 6.62 ERA) earned the complete-game victory in game two of Friday's twinbill at EKU, holding the league's top-scoring team to just two runs on seven hits...The 'Breds hit .456 as a team at Eastern Kentucky last weekend, tagging the Colonels' pitching staff for 39 runs while posting slugging and on-base percentages of .702 and .519, respectively...Senior OF **Brett Mullins** hit .636 at EKU with six RBI and two runs scored...Junior C **Jason Payton** hit as many home runs over the series (3) as Murray State had as a team heading into the weekend...The 'Breds finished the weekend with five dingers against a team averaging 0.39 homers allowed per 9 innings (second in the OVC)...Senior C **Brett Wilson** hit .545 for the week, scoring two runs and driving in three...Murray State's team batting average increased from .261 to .279 following the EKU series.

SAMFORD (20-16, 10-2 OVC): Samford remains atop the OVC standings after taking two of three from Southeast Missouri...The Bulldogs split Friday's twinbill, winning the opener (6-5) and losing the nightcap (7-4) before collecting an 8-6 victory in Saturday's 15-inning series finale...Junior 3B **Parker Gargis** drove in the winning run and was the winning pitcher in the game three victory...Gargis, who finished the series 6-for-15 with four RBI, four runs scored and three doubles, is batting a league-high .413 for the season...Junior LHP **Josh Ehmk** (6-2, 3.01 ERA) has picked up a win in all four of his OVC starts, recording double-digit strikeouts in three of those, including 11 K's in Friday's game one win...Samford's 10-2 start in Conference play is its best since joining the league for the 2004 season...The Bulldogs play a home-and-home series with Birmingham-Southern before hosting OVC foe Eastern Illinois.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (14-20, 5-7 OVC): Southeast Missouri posted a 2-3 record in five games last week...The Redhawks lost an 8-5 decision to Southern Illinois before recording a season-high 17 hits to earn a 9-5 road win at Missouri...Southeast closed out the week with a tough OVC series against Samford, sandwiching a 7-4 win between losses in the series opener and finale (6-5, 8-6), the latter of which was a 15-inning affair...Senior DH **Andrew Johnson** is still swinging a hot bat, registering five extra-base hits among his six hits last week, including a grand slam that capped off a six-run third inning for the Redhawks at Mizzou...Johnson has hit safely in all eight games he has started since being added to the lineup two weeks ago...Junior LHP **Asif Shah** threw 193 pitches en route to the complete-game victory at Mizzou as the Redhawks picked up their first win in Columbia since the 2002 season...Senior RHP **Anthony Maupin** made his fourth straight complete-game start in game two of Friday's doubleheader against Samford...Junior 3B **Phillip Riley** has hit safely in seven consecutive contests...Southeast hit nine homers on the week, including six in the Samford series...The Redhawks take a break before returning to OVC action at home against Austin Peay.

UT MARTIN (12-23, 5-7 OVC): UT Martin went 2-3 in five outings, dropping a 4-3 decision to Martin Methodist and breezing past Saint Louis, 12-4, before winning one of three against OVC opponent Morehead State...After losing both ends of a Friday twinbill to the Eagles (10-7, 2-0), the Skyhawks exploded for a school-record 27 hits in a 23-7 victory in Saturday's series finale...Senior C/DH **Brett Spivy** batted .571 over the five-game stretch, scoring six runs and driving in seven more...Spivy racked up 21 total bases on the week, counting six doubles and three triples among his 12 hits...Junior 3B **Douglas Nicodemus** went 9-of-18 at the plate on the week, registering three doubles...Senior RHP **Casey Estill** (1-1, 4.88 ERA) came away without a decision in the Martin Methodist contest after not allowing an earned run over 6.2 innings...The Skyhawks return to Martin for a five-game homestand, featuring meetings with Arkansas State and Lipscomb as well as OVC opponent Tennessee Tech.

TENNESSEE TECH (13-24, 6-6 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a pair of games to Georgia State (5-2, 13-8), then bounced back to win both ends of an OVC doubleheader at Austin Peay on Friday (5-3, 2-1)...The Golden Eagles were unable to complete the sweep, however, falling in the series finale, 11-7...Junior C **Steve Soper** hit .455 in the APSU series and finished the week with five hits, three runs scored, two RBI and a homer...Junior RHP **Justin Fields** (2-3, 5.08 ERA) recorded a win and a save against the Gobs, surrendering four hits and an earned run over 5.1 innings with four strikeouts and no walks...Freshman IF/DH **Stuart Meinhardt** also had a solid week at the plate, batting .400 with one run, eight hits, one double and seven RBI...The Golden Eagles are 6-6 in Conference play, matching their entire OVC win total from a year ago...Tech hosts Tennessee before opening a four-game road stretch at OVC rival UT Martin.
