## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - APRIL 18

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

**BRIAN PIAZZA • OF, FR. • MONTGOMERY, AL • JACKSONVILLE ST.**

Piazza batted .444 and extended his hitting streak to nine games as Jacksonville State posted a 3-2 record last week, including an OVC series win versus Eastern Kentucky. The freshman outfielder collected eight hits in 14 at-bats without a strikeout, launching two homers while driving in nine runs and walking twice. A native of Montgomery, Ala., Piazza slugged .778 and recorded 14 total bases.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

**CRAIG KRAUS • RHP, SR. • LOUISVILLE, KY • MURRAY STATE**

Kraus became the first OVC pitcher to beat Morehead State this season, limiting the league-leading Eagles to a .161 hitting average while striking out eight batters and walking two in nine innings of work. A native of Louisville, Ky., the senior righthander surrendered just two runs on five hits while registering his second complete-game effort of the season and upping his record to 6-1.

## AROUND THE DIAMOND...

**AUSTIN PEAY (21-14, 7-5 OVC):** Austin Peay remains tied for third at 7-5 after taking two of three from Southeast Missouri in OVC action over the weekend. The Govs also split a pair of non-conference outings at Middle Tennessee and Memphis and now sit at 21-14 overall... Senior SS **Jared Walker** recorded his 200th career hit, going 9-for-18 at the plate for the week while driving in seven runs and scoring five more. Four of his nine hits went for extra bases as he rapped out two doubles and homered twice... On Sunday, sophomore RHP **Shawn Kelley** fanned seven batters and held Southeast scoreless through five innings en route to picking up his first victory in four starts... Senior 2B **Jake Peterson** is enjoying a career-best seven-game hitting streak after leading the Govs with a .529 (9-for-17) average last week... The Govs, who had just eight home runs in their first 26 games, have belted nine in their last nine contests... Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** had his streak of 22 scoreless innings snapped when Southeast scored five runs in the first inning of Saturday's 6-4 loss, also halting Hardy's four-game win streak... APSU hosts Georgia State for a pair of midweek outings before traveling to OVC foe Tennessee-Martin this weekend.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (9-24, 6-6 OVC):** Eastern Illinois slipped into a fifth-place tie at 6-6 after going 1-2 in its OVC series with Eastern Illinois. Earlier in the week, the Panthers were shut out in a non-conference trip to Southern Illinois and now sit at 9-24 overall... Sophomore C **Joe Hernandez** hit two doubles and a home run as part of a 4-for-12 effort on the week... Sophomore RHP **Mike Budde** picked up his first win of the season on Sunday, fanning five Bulldog batters while giving up two runs off eight hits. Budde, who missed all of the 2004 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery, hasn't allowed more than four earned runs in any of his six starts thus far and has given up only seven extra-base hits in 35.2 innings of action... All six of EIU's Conference wins have been in games decided by five runs or less... Junior 2B **Blake Meyer** is out for the season after being injured in a centerfield collision with teammate **Mark Chagnon** during the Panthers' series at JSU two weeks ago. Sliding over from shortstop to handle Meyer's duties is sophomore **Adam Varrassi**, while junior **Jon Hickey** re-enters the lineup to fill in for Varrassi... Sophomore OF **Erik Huber**, one of only two Panthers to start every game thus far, is also one of the squad's most productive hitters, tying for the team lead in multi-hit (11) and multi-RBI (6) games... EIU travels to Illinois-Chicago and hosts Indiana State before heading down to Southeast Missouri for OVC action.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-19, 4-7 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky went 1-2 in OVC action over the weekend, snapping a seven-game losing skid with a 5-1 win over Jacksonville State in the series opener. The Colonels lost the next two, however, and are now in seventh place at 4-7. Midweek losses to Xavier and Western Kentucky are part of EKV's 10-19 overall record... Senior OF **Derrick Bussell** was the only Colonel to hit over .300 last week, going 8-for-15 (.533) while also drawing five walks to raise his on-base percentage to .650. He also scored four times and stole four bases... Sophomore P **McKenzie Willoughby** improved to 3-0 in OVC play, allowing just four hits over seven innings en route to Saturday's game one win... Junior **Brett Bolger** entered the week as the nation's top hitter (.436), but managed just a 5-for-19 (.263) effort at the plate while also seeing his hitting streak end at 19 games... Junior **Chris O'Dell**, who led EKV with 15 homers last year, hit his fourth round-tripper of the season in game three at JSU. Prior to Sunday, O'Dell hadn't homered since March 19, a span of 51 at-bats... EKV hosts Xavier and visits Marshall before visiting Samford for Conference play.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (16-18, 7-5 OVC):** Jacksonville State took two of three from Eastern Kentucky to remain in a third-place OVC tie at 7-5. The Gamecocks are 16-18 overall after also splitting a pair of non-conference games with South Alabama earlier in the week... Freshman OF **Brian Piazza** upped his team-leading hit streak to nine games while pacing the Gamecock offense with an 8-of-14 effort (.444) at the plate, hitting two homers and driving in nine runs... Junior P **Clark Jinks** made two appearances, drawing a start and a win against USA and tossing two innings in relief on Sunday versus EKV... Senior OF **Winston Pearson** saw his hitting streak end at 13 games, third-longest in school history... The Gamecocks are off until this weekend, when they entertain OVC foe Morehead State.

**MOREHEAD STATE (20-15, 10-1 OVC):** Morehead State retained sole possession of first place but saw its eight-game win streak come to an end, going 2-1 against OVC foe Murray State over the weekend after taking a 14-6 decision from Marshall on Wednesday... Senior 1B **Bryan Ingram** registered a 1.000 slugging percentage while going 8-of-17 (.471) at the plate with eight RBI, six runs, three doubles and two homers... Junior RHP **Shane Lucchi** gave up only three singles and an unearned run while pitching a complete game for the win in Saturday's nightcap... The Eagles' eight-game win streak fell one shy of tying the school record as they have now won 10 of their last 11 and 13 of their last 15... On Sunday, relievers **Reid Kittleson** and **Dan Klausmeier** pitched five innings of shutout baseball, allowing only two singles as Klausmeier got his third win of the season (all OVC games) without a loss... Senior CF **Kevin**

**Bryant** upped his average to .319 after hitting .429 with two doubles and a home run...Morehead State continues to pound out the doubles, topping the 100 mark as a team with five different Eagles boasting 11 or more two-baggers...**Lance Seasor's** 24-game hit streak ended on Sunday when he went 0-for-5... The Eagles (20-15 overall, 10-1 in OVC) host a two-game series with Maryland-Eastern Shore, then take off for a league set at Jacksonville State.

**MURRAY STATE (20-17, 8-4 OVC):** Murray State snapped Morehead State's eight-game win streak, taking game one of the series before dropping the final two. The Thoroughbreds retained their second-place spot in the Conference standings at 7-2 and moved to 20-17 overall. Earlier in the week, they lost a 10-inning decision to Evansville and beat Arkansas State...Sophomore LF **Austin Swain** hit .533 (8-for-15) for the week with a double, five runs, an RBI and two stolen bases. Swain has reached base safely in his last 14 games, but had his 10-game hitting streak halted in game two of the Morehead State series... Senior RHP **Craig Kraus** boasts the league's only win versus the Eagles thus far after allowing two runs on five hits while striking out eight batters and walking two for the complete-game victory in nine innings of Saturday's twinbill opener...The 'Breds led nationally-ranked Evansville, 3-2, going into the ninth inning, but the Purple Aces were able to tie the game in their half of the frame before going on to win in the 10th...**Jake Ociesia** got the win against ASU, allowing one earned run in six innings. **Michal Perconte** picked up the save in that game as 'Breds pitchers held the Indians hitless over the last 4-1/3 innings...Murray State visits Evansville on Wednesday before hosting Tennessee Tech.

**SAMFORD (11-23, 6-6 OVC):** Samford remained in sixth place after evening its Conference record at 6-6 by taking two of three from Eastern Illinois. Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs lost non-conference decisions to nationally-ranked Auburn and Mississippi State...Freshman OF **John Morgan** batted .476 (10-for-21) with four doubles and five RBI in five outings, including a 4-for-4, two-RBI effort in Saturday's twinbill opener at EIU. **Stephen Artz** allowed just one earned run over seven innings of work to earn the complete-game victory in the nightcap...The Bulldogs play a five-game homestand this week with single dates versus Alabama A&M and UAB and a three-game series with OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (13-21, 4-8 OVC):** Southeast Missouri sits in eighth place in the OVC standings at 4-8 after going 1-2 in its OVC series with Austin Peay. The Redhawks also lost a midweek outing at Missouri and are now 13-21 overall...Junior 1B/RF **Jordan Payne** reached base in all four of his plate appearances at 13th-ranked Mizzou, rapping two singles and walking twice. He finished the week hitting 6-of-15 (.400) while scoring three runs from the lead-off spot...**Eric Horstman** batted .375 last week with two RBI...**Ernie Bracamonte** saw his 15-game hitting streak snapped in the series finale at APSU...The Redhawks travel to Arkansas State on Tuesday before returning home to entertain OVC opponent Eastern Illinois.

**TENNESSEE-MARTIN (8-24, 3-8 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin finished the week with a 2-2 record that included wins over Saint Louis and Tennessee Tech...Freshman **Zach Dean** hit a two-out triple in the top of the 11th inning to drive in two runs and lead the Skyhawks to a 9-7 victory at SLU...Junior **Brett Spivy** hit a pair of key sixth-inning home runs on the week, a two-run shot at SLU that gave UT Martin a 5-4 lead and a solo dinger at Tech that proved to be the game-winner in Saturday's twinbill nightcap. He finished the week batting .312 with three runs and three RBI...All four of Spivy's home runs this season have been on the road...Junior college transfer **Zane Gresback** led the team with a .462 batting average, doubling three times and scoring four runs while also drawing five walks...The Skyhawks hit .240 as a team last week with five players hitting better than .300...Junior RHP **Scott Massey** is scheduled to have an MRI after missing his start in the rotation against Tech because of soreness in his arm...Tied for ninth in the League at 3-8 (8-24 overall), the Skyhawks kick off a 10-game homestand this week against Southern Illinois, Lipscomb and OVC foe Austin Peay.

**TENNESSEE TECH (8-27, 3-8 OVC):** Tennessee Tech lost non-conference outings to Lipscomb and East Tennessee State, but put an end to its 11-game losing streak with a 5-2 win over Tennessee-Martin in the OVC series opener. The Golden Eagles also won Sunday's contest versus the Skyhawks to claim their first series win in Conference play this season...Senior SS **Brandon Selvog's** first home run of the season was a two-run shot in the bottom of the eighth that kicked off the Golden Eagles four-run, game-winning rally in Saturday's opener versus UT Martin. Selvog finished with four RBI over the weekend...Senior RHP **Colt Ashman** recorded his first victory of the year, working eight innings and combining with **Adam Cloar** for Sunday's 8-0 shut-out victory. Ashman struck out seven batters while allowing just four hits...Tied for ninth in the league at 3-8 (8-27 overall), Tech plays host to non-conference opponent Tennessee before hitting the road for an OVC series at Murray State.
