OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - APRIL 25

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

TONY WELLS • 2B, SO. • HARRISON, OH • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Wells led Eastern Kentucky to a 5-2 effort last week, including a three-game sweep of OVC foe Samford, by hitting a team-high .417 (10-of-24) and driving in a squad-best 10 runs. Four of the sophomore second baseman's hits went for extra bases as he rapped three doubles and a home run to post a .667 slugging percentage. Wells, a native of Harrison, Ohio, also walked four times and was hit by a pitch once to tally an on-base percentage of .517.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

SHAWN KELLEY • RHP, SO. • LOUISVILLE, KY • AUSTIN PEAY

Kelley becomes the fourth different Austin Peay hurler to earn OVC Pitcher of the Week honors this season after pitching a two-hit gem en route to recording his first career complete-game shutout with a 2-0 victory in game two of a Saturday twinbill versus Tennessee-Martin. Kelley, a native of Louisville, Ky., faced just two batters over the minimum, striking out six and walking none in seven innings. The sophomore righthander retired seven straight to start the game and nine straight to close it out.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (26-14, 10-5 OVC): Austin Peay ran its winning streak to seven games, sweeping a midweek pair from Georgia State and a trio from OVC foe Tennessee-Martin to push its overall record to 26-14... Sophomore RHP **Shawn Kelley** collected his first career complete-game shutout, throwing a two-hit gem in Saturday's nightcap against the Skyhawks. He faced just two batters over the minimum and walked none while striking out six in seven innings... After going 0-3 against Morehead State to open OVC action, APSU has won four straight Conference series and now sits in second place at 10-5, a game and half back of the league-leading Eagles. The Govs have won 10 of their last 12 OVC contests... Senior C **Tommy Smith** led the team with a .538 average last week, going 7-for-13 with five RBI in four games. Senior SS **Jared Walker** had three doubles and seven RBI last week as he upped his average to .388 with an 8-for-20 effort at the plate... The Govs have rapped out a league-high 16 triples thus far to rank 17th nationally (0.43 pg)... Senior LHP **Devin Thomas** matched a career-high with nine strikeouts in Sunday's victory... The Govs have executed a league-best 44 doubles plays, tying for 18th nationally (1.14 pg)... APSU wraps up a stretch of 24 straight in-state contests this week when Western Kentucky and OVC opponent Eastern Illinois travel to Clarksville.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (9-29, 6-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois has lost five straight after going without a win last week in meetings with Illinois-Chicago, Indiana State and OVC foe Southeast Missouri. With the three losses to the Redhawks, the Panthers slipped into a tie for seventh in the Conference standings at 6-9 (9-29 overall)... Junior OF **Keiji Szalo** had a strong showing at the plate, batting .563 (9-for-16) with four runs and five RBI to push his hitting streak to a season-high seven games. He knocked two doubles and two homers for a slugging percentage of 1.063... The Panthers rapped out 24 hits, including four dingers, in Tuesday's 16-15 loss to UIC... EIU has lost eight of its last nine games... The Panthers stay in-state for a pair of midweek contests, traveling to Illinois and hosting Illinois State before visiting Austin Peay for OVC action.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (15-21, 7-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 5-2 in a flurry of games last week, dropping back-to-back extra-inning affairs to Xavier and Marshall before shutting out Kentucky State in a doubleheader and sweeping an OVC series at Samford... The Colonels outscored KSU, 30-0, in Thursday's twinbill... Sophomore 2B **Tony Wells** posted team-highs of 10 RBI and a .417 batting average for the week, going 10-for-24 with three doubles and a homer... Junior RHP **Nick Barte** threw 8.1 scoreless innings last week, including the first seven of Sunday's 14-0 win at Samford. He combined with senior LHP **Eric Anthrop**, who tossed the last two... The three-game sweep at Samford, EKU's first this season in league play, propelled the Colonels into fifth place at 7-7 (15-21 overall)... EKU's pitching staff entered the week having not yet thrown a shutout in '05, but managed to rack up three in quick succession against KSU and Samford... The Colonels welcome Georgetown College and visit Wright State before hosting OVC foe Southeast Missouri.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (18-19, 9-6 OVC): Jacksonville State remained tied for third at 9-6 in the OVC standings (18-19 overall) after taking two of three from league-leading Morehead State over the weekend... Freshman OF **Brian Piazza** hit a blistering .636 (7-for-11) with a double, two runs and two RBI in the series while extending his hitting streak to a season-high 12 games... Freshman RHP **Donovan Hand** picked up the game one win on Saturday, holding the Eagles to two runs and just one extra-base hit with seven K's and no walks in seven innings of work... The Gamecocks outscored the Eagles, 17-9, en route to picking up their first home series win of the season... JSU is the first team to take two games and a series from the Eagles in Conference play... The Gamecocks play a midweek home-and-home set with Birmingham-Southern, then travel to Tennessee Tech for OVC action.

MOREHEAD STATE (23-17, 11-3 OVC): Morehead State retained its spot atop the OVC standings (11-3), despite going 1-2 over the weekend at Jacksonville State. Earlier in the week, the Eagles swept a twinbill from Maryland-Eastern Shore and now sit at 23-17 overall... Senior 2B **Lance Seabor** hit .556 (10-for-18) for the week, scoring six times while driving in three runs, finishing with a double and two homers. After having his 24-game hitting streak stopped on April 17 against Murray State, he went 7-for-7 Wednesday against the Hawks... Junior RHP **Shane Lucci** surrendered just one run on three hits en route to a complete-game win in game two of Saturday's doubleheader at JSU... The Eagles rapped out 12 doubles last week, giving them 112 for season and putting them eight shy of the school record. They rank fourth nationally with 2.86 doubles per game... Senior OF **Travis Rima** went 9-for-18 last week, driving in five runs and scoring eight more... Freshman RHP **Matt Clark** pitched seven innings of Wednesday's game one, nine-inning victory (9-1) over UMES. He allowed five hits and one unearned run while striking out seven and walking only one... The Eagles are off for the next five days before playing host to OVC opponent Samford on Saturday and Sunday.

2005 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

MURRAY STATE (21-20, 9-6 OVC): Murray State slipped into a tie for third place at 9-6 in the OVC standings after dropping two of three to Tennessee Tech over the weekend. Earlier in the week, the Thoroughbreds lost a 10-4 decision to Evansville and now sit at 21-20 overall...Sophomore CF **Tyler Pittman** drove in nine runs while hitting .471 (8-for-17) for the week. He hit a grand slam in Sunday's 12-9 loss for his team-leading fifth homer of the season...The 'Breds came within a run of tying a 30-year-old record when they scored 14 runs in the third inning of Saturday's game one victory, a 24-7 slugfest...Senior IF/OF **Clint Griggs** went 5-for-10 against Tech with three doubles, a homer, six runs and three RBI, posting a 1.100 slugging percentage in the process...Junior RHP **Matt Scalfani** pitched well for the 'Breds last week, allowing two earned runs in six innings in three appearances...Murray State begins a five-game road swing on Tuesday at in-state rival Louisville before heading to Tennessee-Martin for OVC play over the weekend.

SAMFORD (13-26, 6-9 OVC): Samford won a pair of non-conference decisions over in-state rivals Alabama A&M and UAB before going 0-3 in OVC action against Eastern Kentucky. The Bulldogs slipped into a tie for seventh in the league standings at 6-9 (13-26 overall)...Freshman OF **John Morgan** went 9-for-23 (.391) while extending his hitting streak to eight games, rapping out two doubles with five RBI...Junior OF **Justin Worthington** ranks fourth nationally in sacrifice hits (0.35 pg)...The ECU series marked the first time the Bulldogs had been swept in Conference play since going 0-3 at Southeast Missouri a year ago...Samford travels to Auburn and hosts Georgia State before visiting Morehead State for an OVC series.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (16-22, 7-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri lost a tough 3-2 non-conference midweek decision to Arkansas State, but bounced back in fine fashion, winning all three of its games against Eastern Illinois to earn the Redhawks' first OVC series win of the season. Southeast now sits in sixth place at 7-8 (16-22 overall)...Redhawk head coach **Mark Hogan** picked up his 700th career win in game two on Saturday...Senior SS **Ernie Bracamonte** recorded multi-hit efforts in all three games over the weekend to finish with a .429 average (6-for-14)...Freshman RHP **Joey Evans** threw his fourth complete game and picked up his team-leading sixth win of the season in Saturday's opener. He had seven strikeouts in the contest and ranks second in the league with 8.1 K's per nine innings...Junior RHP **Jamie McAlister** also worked a complete game in the EIU series, making just his second start of the season and giving up only two runs in the game two win. He has made a team-high 20 appearances this year to rank second in the league...Senior IF/OF **Eric Horstman** extended his hitting streak to eight games while batting .400 with six runs and going 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts...Freshman 1B/DH **James Clayton** hit .385 with two doubles and six RBI...Southeast embarks on a four-game road trip with dates at Southern Illinois and OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (8-29, 3-11 OVC): Tennessee-Martin saw its losing streak stretch to six games with losses to Southern Illinois, Lipscomb and Austin Peay last week...The Skyhawks hit .247 as a team while the pitching staff posted an 8.16 ERA...Junior C **Brett Spivy** missed Saturday's doubleheader versus APSU because of a mild concussion he suffered in Wednesday's game against Lipscomb. Spivy was hit in the head by a pitch in the fourth inning of an 8-3 loss...After missing a scheduled start last weekend at Tennessee Tech due to soreness in his right arm, junior RHP **Scott Massey** tossed five innings in relief on Sunday...Junior 2B **Hideaki Sato** and freshman SS **Jason Moore** were the only two position players to start all five games for the Skyhawks last week...Redshirt freshman **Zach Parham** made his first starts of the year against SIU and Lipscomb, driving in a team-high four runs while batting fourth in the designated hitter's spot...The Skyhawk pitching staff recorded three pickoffs last week as Massey, **Micky Dobson** and **Jacob Smothers** nailed one baserunner each...Saturday's game two loss to APSU lasted just one hour and 24 minutes...UT Martin, 8-29 overall and 3-11 in league action, wraps up its 10-game homestand with non-conference foes Mississippi Valley State and Belmont and OVC opponent Murray State.

TENNESSEE TECH (10-29, 5-9 OVC): Tennessee Tech recorded its second straight series win in Conference play, taking two of three at Murray State. Earlier in the week, the Golden Eagles dropped a 15-4 outing versus Tennessee, and now sit at 10-29 overall (5-9 in OVC play)...Sophomore OF **Scott Dunham** pounded out five hits, including two triples, and drove in six runs in the series at Murray...Sophomore RHP **Justin Fields**, who entered Saturday's nightcap with a 6.32 ERA, held the 'Breds scoreless while picking up his first victory of the season, surrendering just three hits in seven innings of work...The ninth-place Golden Eagles travel to Appalachian State, then return home to entertain Jacksonville State in league action.
