PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

CHRIS O'DELL • DH, SR. • LEXINGTON, KY • EASTERN KENTUCKY

O'Dell rapped out seven extra-base hits, including home runs in four straight games, to help Eastern Kentucky to a 2-2 record last week. The senior designated hitter opened with a two-run shot as part of a 3-for-4 outing against Louisville, then homered three times in the Colonels' three-game series with Tennessee Tech. O'Dell, a native of Lexington, Ky., finished the week batting .529 with seven RBI and seven runs scored.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

JAMIE McALISTER • RHP, SR. • PIEDMONT, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

McAlister pitched 9.2 shutout innings en route to a 2-0 record in two appearances for Southeast Missouri last week. The senior righthander retired all four batters he faced in 1.2 innings of hitless, scoreless relief against Missouri, then held Murray State to six hits, all singles, while working the first 8.1 innings of a combined shutout in game one of an OVC doubleheader on Saturday. Over the two outings, the Piedmont, Mo., native struck out seven batters without issuing a walk.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (18-8, 4-2 OVC): Austin Peay posted a 5-0 record last week, sweeping home-and-home outings against Memphis (14-6, 11-9) and taking a three-game series from Morehead State (4-2, 4-1, 10-4)...Senior OF **Cody Youngblood** batted .476 (10-for-21) from the leadoff position, homering twice while driving in six runs and scoring eight more...Youngblood is riding a six-game hitting streak...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** (6-0, 1.56 ERA) registered a victory in relief at Memphis before tossing a complete-game win against Morehead State...Hardy now sits two wins shy of the OVC career mark...Senior **Ryan Kane** extended his hitting streak to 22 games...Senior 3B/RHP **James Ray** had two hits in each of the week's first four games before taking the mound to start Sunday's contest against Morehead State...The Govs' win in game one against Morehead State was the program's 500th victory at Raymond C. Hand Park...APSU visits Western Kentucky and hosts Vanderbilt before traveling to Samford for OVC action.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (11-12, 3-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois evened its OVC record at 3-3, taking two of three from UT Martin over the weekend...The Panthers also split a pair of non-conference outings, losing to Saint Louis (7-2) before edging Indiana State (12-11)...Junior C/DH **Jason Cobb** batted .412 for the week, posting his first career four-hit game in the ISU contest and driving in four runs in a doubleheader sweep of UT Martin...Junior RHP **Brandon Murphy** registered the first nine-inning complete game by a Panther pitcher this season, tossing a three-hit gem and fanning an EIU career-best six batters en route to the victory in the opener of Saturday's twinbill...Junior 1B **Erik Huber** rapped out eight hits and drove in six runs...Juniors **Adam Varrassi** and **Jason Cobb** and senior **Keiji Szalo** each hit their first home run of the season...Junior RHP **Drew Gierich** tossed six scoreless innings at SLU, then struck out a career-high six batters in 5.1 innings against UT Martin, but came away with no decisions despite leaving with the lead in both contests...The Panthers host Olivet Nazarene and visit Western Illinois in non-conference action before traveling to Murray State for an OVC series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-11, 3-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky outscored Tennessee Tech 29-9 while taking two of three from the Golden Eagles over the weekend...The Colonels swept Saturday's doubleheader (22-4, 5-1) before losing Sunday's finale in 10 innings (4-2)...EKU also dropped a 14-4 non-conference road decision to Louisville...Senior DH **Chris O'Dell** homered in each of the four games, finishing with six RBI and seven runs scored while going 9-for-17 (.529) at the plate...Junior LHP **Christian Friedrich** struck out a career-high 11 batters through six shutout innings en route to the game two win against Tech...Friedrich has recorded at least 10 strikeouts in three of his four starts and boasts a streak of 13 scoreless innings...EKU hits the road for a non-conference stop at Western Kentucky and a trip to OVC foe UT Martin.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (12-16, 3-3 OVC): Jacksonville State posted a 17-6 win on Sunday to salvage its OVC series with Samford after dropping games one (11-5) and two (7-3)...The Gamecocks also defeated UAB (5-1) in non-conference play...Freshman 2B **Bert Smith** extended his team-high hitting streak to nine games, going 5-for-14 (.357) at the plate with four RBI and five runs scored...Smith has gone more than three weeks without a strikeout, a span of 31 at-bats...Sophomore OF **Brian Piazza** led the team with a .444 batting average over the four-game stretch...In Sunday's win against Samford, all nine starting batters recorded a hit as Jax State set season-highs in at-bats (42), runs (17), hits (17), RBI (15), doubles (5), total bases (27) and walks (10)...The 17 runs were the second-most scored in an OVC game in the Gamecocks' three-year history in the league...**Richard Turner** (.467) heads up a quartet of JSU juniors batting over .400 in OVC contests, followed by **Garrett Bass** (.444), **Allen Rose** (.444) and **Brian Piazza** (.417)...Jax State's only action this week is a home OVC series against Southeast Missouri.

MOREHEAD STATE (9-17, 1-4 OVC): Morehead State went winless in four road contests last week, dropping a 15-4 non-conference decision to Kentucky before getting swept at Austin Peay (4-2, 4-1, 10-4)...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** batted .412 for the week, rapping out seven hits in 17 at-bats and driving in four runs...In a stretch where they will play seven of eight games on the road, the Eagles are off to an 0-4 start...Despite going 0-2 last week, freshman LHP **Tyler Lee** made a strong case for the number three starter role on the Eagles' staff, allowing just three hits in five and a third innings at APSU...Morehead State hosts West Virginia Tech in a non-conference tilt before going back out on the road for an OVC series at Tennessee Tech.

2006 OVC Baseball Notes

MURRAY STATE (7-21, 0-6 OVC): Murray State saw its losing skid stretch to 10 games after dropping a 12-inning non-conference decision to Evansville (7-4) and being held scoreless in a trio of OVC losses at Southeast Missouri (1-0, 5-0, 7-0)...Freshman SS **Justin Yount** went 3-for-5 at Evansville...Senior RHP **Kalen Gibson** was the hard-luck loser in Saturday's twinbill opener, giving up just one unearned run in the complete-game effort...Gibson has allowed four earned runs in his last three starts, all one-run losses...The Thoroughbreds' current slide is the longest in a single season and ties for the program's longest ever, matching a 10-game skid over the 1954 and 1955 seasons...Junior 2B **Seth Hudson** went 6-for-16 (.375) at the plate for the week, but saw a 10-game hitting streak fall on Sunday...Murray State rapped out a season-high 18 hits, including eight over the 9th through 12th innings, in its 12-inning loss to Evansville...That 18-hit barrage was sandwiched between a 15-hit series against Samford (5.0 hits per game) and a 16-hit weekend at Southeast (5.3 hits per game)...The 'Breds visit non-conference foe Arkansas State, then return home to host Eastern Illinois in OVC action.

SAMFORD (14-15, 5-1 OVC): Samford remained atop the OVC standings after taking two of three from Jacksonville State over the weekend...The Bulldogs swept a Saturday doubleheader (11-5, 7-3) before dropping the series finale (17-6)...Earlier in the week, Samford lost a two-game set at Middle Tennessee (6-4, 12-1)...Junior C **Luke Peavy** played in three of the five games, driving in five runs and scoring four more while going 5-for-11 (.455) at the plate...Junior RHP **Eric Lassiter** notched his second straight complete-game win in the nightcap of Saturday's twinbill with JSU, giving up three runs (one earned) while striking out three batters and walking two...The Bulldogs have played 12 of their last 13 games on the road...After a Tuesday night non-conference meeting with Auburn at a neutral site in Hoover, Ala., Samford returns home to entertain Austin Peay in OVC action.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-14, 3-3 OVC): Southeast Missouri snapped a seven-game losing streak in convincing fashion, upsetting Missouri (3-2) before shutting out Murray State (1-0, 5-0, 7-0) in OVC action...Senior C **Levi Olson** batted .500 over the four-game stretch, counting three doubles among his five hits...Senior RHP **Jamie McAlister** pitched 9.2 innings of shutout baseball without a walk in two appearances, picking up a win in relief against the Tigers before working 8.1 innings of a combined shutout of Saturday's doubleheader against Murray State...Freshman OF **Daniel Schuh's** first career home run in the bottom of the ninth against Missouri marked the second straight year the Southeast used a walk-off homer to defeat the Tigers...The Redhawks' pitching staff enters the week with a streak of 27 consecutive scoreless innings...Southeast's three-game shutout of Murray State marked the first time since 2001 the Redhawks had held opponents scoreless in three straight outings...Southeast takes a four-game win streak into this week's action, visiting Saint Louis and hosting Southern Illinois in a pair of non-conference tilts before traveling to Jacksonville State for an OVC series.

UT MARTIN (9-16, 4-2 OVC): UT Martin dropped a 7-1 non-conference decision to Southern Illinois and lost a Saturday OVC doubleheader to Eastern Illinois (6-1, 5-4) before halting the three-game slide with an 8-5 come-from-behind win over the Panthers in Sunday's series finale...The Skyhawks hit a disappointing .200 over the four-game stretch...Junior SS **Lance Renton** led the team with his .313 average, while junior 1B **Jason Hockaday** hit .286 with four RBI...The four losses dropped UT Martin's 2006 road record to 3-13...Saturday's final 5-4 tally in the nightcap brought to 12 the number of one-run decisions this season for the Skyhawks, who are 8-4 in such outings...UT Martin hosts Southern Illinois on Tuesday and plays a neutral-site contest against Memphis on Wednesday in Union City, Tenn., before welcoming Eastern Kentucky for league action.

TENNESSEE TECH (10-18, 3-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech lost a 10-9 decision to Belmont and dropped an OVC twinbill to Eastern Kentucky (22-4, 5-0) before ending the skid with a 4-2 10-inning win in the series finale on Sunday...Senior OF **Kyle Rowekamp** batted .375 over the four-game stretch, driving in four runs and scoring four more...In Sunday's win at EKU, Rowekamp's two-out, RBI-single in the ninth tied the game and forced extra innings...Junior OF **Josh Goodwin**, the Golden Eagles' leader in hitting (.336) and runs batted in (16) led the team with a .412 average at the plate for the week...Tech returns home to host non-conference foe Belmont and OVC opponent Morehead State.
