## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - APRIL 24

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

**RYAN KANE • OF, SR. • MUSKEGON, MI • AUSTIN PEAY**

**Kane** extended the nation's longest active hitting streak to 36 games with multi-hit efforts in four of five Austin Peay contests last week, finishing with a .611 batting average, 11 hits, two doubles, two triples, five RBI and seven runs scored overall. The senior outfielder registered his first four-hit effort of the season in a one-run loss to Belmont and went 5-for-11 in an OVC series win at Southeast Missouri. A native of Muskegon, Mich., Kane currently boasts the second-longest hitting streak in league history and has also reached base safely in 48 consecutive games dating back to last season.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

**BRAD DANIEL • RHP, SR. • DICKSON, TN • AUSTIN PEAY**

**Daniel** made three appearances last week, collecting both a win and a save in the series at Southeast Missouri. The senior righthander worked 1.2 innings of scoreless relief against both Belmont and Southeast (game one), picking up the save in the latter outing, then came within two outs of a complete game in Sunday's nine-inning finale versus the Redhawks. A native of Dickson, Tenn., Daniel struck out 13 batters over 11.2 innings of work.

## AROUND THE DIAMOND...

**AUSTIN PEAY (23-17, 7-8 OVC):** Austin Peay posted a 3-2 record last week, splitting a pair of non-conference games and winning 2-of-3 in its OVC series at Southeast Missouri (7-4, 4-8, 7-2)...The Govs are tied for fifth in the Conference standings...Senior OF **Ryan Kane** extended the nation's longest active hitting streak to 36 games with multi-hit efforts in four of the five contests, finishing the week with a .611 batting average, two doubles, two triples, five RBI and seven runs scored...Kane, who currently boasts the second-longest hitting streak in league history, has also reached base safely in 48 consecutive games dating back to last season...Senior RHP **Brad Daniel** (4-1, 5 saves, 2.00 ERA) made three appearances last week, collecting a save and a win in games one and three, respectively, of the series with Southeast...Daniel, who worked 8.1 innings on Sunday in just his second start of the season, struck out 13 batters on the week...Senior **Rowdy Hardy** (7-2, 2-78 ERA) recorded his 30th career victory, moving him into a tie with former Eastern Kentucky hurler Jeff Cruse for the OVC record...Hardy also became the school's all-time leader in innings pitched, pushing his career tally to 322.1 thus far...Junior OF/DH **Jacob Crass** belted his first career homer in the Govs' 6-5 loss to Belmont on Tuesday...Freshman IF/DH **Ryan Gilboy** has started the last 10 games and is batting .412 with 10 RBI during that stretch...Senior IF **Jacob Schroeder** went 4-for-4 in game two against the Redhawks and finished the series with a .667 average at the plate...The Govs visit Vanderbilt and Belmont before returning home for an OVC series with UT Martin.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (20-17, 8-7 OVC):** Eastern Illinois split a pair of non-conference tilts and dropped the first two games at Samford (13-5, 11-1) before handing the Bulldogs their first OVC home loss of 2006 with a 6-4 victory on Sunday...Junior OF **Mark Chagnon** and junior 1B **Erik Huber** each saw their career-long 14-game hitting streaks come to an end during the five-game stretch...Chagnon, who batted .625 (10-of-16) on the week and leads the OVC with a .407 average, registered his fourth four-hit outing of the season in a 6-4 win against Aurora...Huber finished the week 7-for-20 with a team-best four RBI...The Panthers' top three hitters (**Brett Nommensen**, Chagnon and Huber) were a combined 8-for-12 in the game three win at Samford...Junior C **Jason Cobb** broke out of a month-long hitting slump with a 5-for-9 series against the Bulldogs, accounting for four of the Panthers' nine doubles over the weekend...Junior reliever **Chris Vaculik** (5-6, 4.97 ERA, 4 saves) picked up his 16th career win on Sunday, moving into ninth place on the school's all-time list for victories...Junior 3B **Ryan Campbell** pushed his career hit total to 185, moving him into ninth on EIU's all-time hit list...The Panther defense turned seven double plays last week and ranks second in the league with 39 overall this season...Tied for third in the league, EIU enjoys home-field advantage for three of its final four OVC series this season...After entertaining Illinois and traveling to Illinois State, the Panthers host Southeast Missouri.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (19-17, 8-6 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky struggled to a 1-3 mark last week, with its lone win coming in game two of its OVC series at Jacksonville State (4-2, 7-4, 10-5)...EKU remains in second place in the Conference standings, holding a slim half-game lead over Eastern Illinois and JSU...After an 0-for-2 outing in the Colonels' 7-6 loss to Miami (OH), junior OF **Shawn Flora** unleashed his bat in the JSU series, registering a trio of hits in each of the three games and scoring four runs with two RBI...Flora also walked three times and was hit by a pitch once to post a .684 on-base percentage for the week...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (6-1, 2.39 ERA) did not figure in the decision in Saturday's game two win, despite pitching 6.2 frames of the seven-inning contest, allowing just four singles and an unearned run with five strikeouts and no walks...Friedrich, who as of April 15 was ranked fourth nationally in strikeout average, has been particularly solid in Conference play, surrendering just 0.93 walks to 12.67 strikeouts per nine innings versus OVC opponents...Junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough** is hitting .393 and ranks among the top five nationally with league-highs of 15 homers, 50 runs batted in and an .807 slugging percentage...The Colonels host Kentucky State and pay a visit to Marshall before returning home to entertain OVC foe Samford.

# 2006 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (20-20, 8-7 OVC):** Jacksonville State played its way to 3-1 record last week, posting a 12-1 victory over Alabama State and winning 2-of-3 in its OVC series with Eastern Kentucky (4-2, 4-7/10 inn., 10-5)...Junior OF **Garrett Bass** raised his batting average 48 points and now leads the team with a .393 average in OVC games following a 6-for-9 series against EKU...Bass is one of five Gamecocks hitting better than .300 versus Conference foes...Junior OF **Nick Cleckler** extended JSU's longest hitting streak of the season to a career-high 12 games, while freshman 2B **Bert Smith** currently has a nine-game streak going...Cleckler is batting .442 during his 12-game stretch...Sophomore **Brian Piazza** will miss the remainder of the season after undergoing surgery last Tuesday...JSU sports a 5-0 record this season in OVC series finales, batting .375 while holding opponents to just .257 and outscoring them 62-25 in those contests...Meanwhile, the Gamecock pitching staff boasts a 4.04 ERA in OVC series finales, compared to a 9.98 ERA for opposing hurlers...JSU pitchers have recorded 110 strikeouts in Conference play overall, compared to just 43 walks...Tied for third in the OVC standings, the Gamecocks make a return trip to Alabama State before heading up to Morehead State for another Conference tilt.

**MOREHEAD STATE (15-22, 6-8 OVC):** Morehead State sits in eighth place after going 1-2 in its OVC series at Murray State, bookending a 6-1 victory between losses in game one (8-5) and three (14-2)...On Saturday, junior RHP **Henry Mabee** (4-5, 3.03 ERA) scattered five hits and fanned five batters without issuing a walk en route to the Eagles' lone win, working his fifth consecutive complete game and extending to 26.2 his streak of innings pitched without giving up an earned run...In Conference play, Mabee boasts an anemic 0.53 ERA while holding opponents to a .198 batting average...Sophomore SS **Nick Nail** was 5-of-10 and drove in three runs at Murray, while junior 2B **Chris McCaslin** batted .455...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** sports a seven-game hitting streak after getting a rap in each of the three games...Junior OF **Dustin Miles** has a league-high 35 walks on the season and as of April 15 ranked third nationally in free passes...The Eagles have another break before playing host to OVC foe Jacksonville State.

**MURRAY STATE (12-28, 5-10 OVC):** After dropping a 10-0 non-conference decision to host Evansville on Wednesday, tenth-place Murray State rallied to win its second straight OVC series, taking two of three games from cross-state rival Morehead State over the weekend (8-5, 1-6, 14-2)...Freshman 3B **Tyler Owen** batted .500 with three doubles, two runs and an RBI against the visiting Eagles, including a 3-for-4 performance in the series finale...After facing the minimum three batters in the ninth inning to pick up the win in game one against Morehead, sophomore RHP **Michal Perconte** (3-3, 4.87 ERA) worked eight innings on Sunday to pick up the game three victory, allowing one earned run while fanning eight batters...Since taking over for an injured **Seth Hudson** at second base, **James Akin** is hitting .333, including an 8-for-20 effort over his last seven games...Freshman SS **Justin Yount** batted .556 with a triple, three runs and two RBI against Morehead, while junior C **Jason Payton** homered twice and drove in seven runs for a 1.111 slugging percentage...On Saturday, junior LF **Austin Swain** was hit by a pitch for the first time in his three-year career at Murray...The Thoroughbreds' bullpen was solid over the weekend, allowing no runs on three hits, striking out four and walking one in five innings of work...Prior to its OVC series at Tennessee Tech, Murray State visits Kentucky for a Wednesday doubleheader, the second game of which will be televised at 6:00 p.m. Central on Fox Sports South.

**SAMFORD (23-17, 12-3 OVC):** League-leading Samford saw its win streak stretch to four games with victories over Birmingham-Southern (4-2) and Eastern Illinois (13-5, 11-1) before dropping a 6-4 decision Sunday to the Panthers in their OVC series finale...Senior 2B **Trey Moody** went 3-for-3 in the second game of the EIU series and finished the weekend batting .545 with a home run, two doubles, four runs scored and a 1.000 slugging percentage...Junior RHP **Eric Lassiter** (4-3, 3.94 ERA) worked all seven innings of Saturday's twinbill nightcap, giving up just one run on four hits for his third complete-game effort of the season...Lassiter also worked the first two innings of Tuesday's win over BSC, finishing with seven strikeouts on the week...Senior OF **Matt Alling** is riding a season-long seven-game hitting streak, batting .407 (11-for-27) with three RBI over the stretch...Junior 3B/RHP **Parker Gargis** ranks second in the league with a .400 batting average...The Bulldogs have added a midweek game to their schedule, traveling to Kennesaw State on Wednesday before heading up to Eastern Kentucky for OVC action.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (15-22, 6-9 OVC):** Southeast Missouri slipped to ninth place in the OVC standings after going 1-2 in its Conference series with Austin Peay over the weekend (4-7, 8-4, 2-7)...Junior 2B **Omar Padilla** recorded three two-hit outings against the league's top pitching staff, pushing his total of multi-hit performances to 13 on the season...Padilla, who rapped out three doubles in the series and recorded a .571 on-base percentage while hitting from the leadoff spot, now leads the team with 13 two-baggers on the year...Senior RHP **Anthony Maupin** (5-3, 4.94 ERA) picked up his fourth victory in as many starts in Saturday's game two win, not allowing any earned runs with four strikeouts and two walks...Maupin saw his streak of consecutive complete games end at four, however, exiting the contest after 6.1 innings of work...The series loss was the third straight in Conference play for the Redhawks, who have not won the finale of an OVC series since sweeping Murray State in three games on April 1 and 2...Freshman 1B **Aaron Rave** sat out game one of Saturday's twinbill, marking the first time he had been out of the starting lineup all season...Junior 3B **Phillip Riley** and junior LF **Dustin Pritchett** had hitting streaks of nine and seven games, respectively, snapped on Sunday...Junior LHP **Asif Shah** (2-2, 5.36 ERA) recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts in the series finale...The Redhawks travel to Kansas City, Kan., on Tuesday and Wednesday to take part in the Best of the Midwest Tournament, where they will face Kansas and Missouri in tourney action before returning to OVC action with a weekend trip to Eastern Illinois.

**UT MARTIN (16-24, 7-8 OVC):** UT Martin posted an impressive 4-1 record last week, picking up non-conference wins against Arkansas State (11-5) and Lipscomb (9-8) before taking two of three from Tennessee Tech in OVC play (5-1, 5-7, 6-5/10 inn.)...Senior DH **Brett Spivy** swung a hot bat over the five-game stretch, going 10-of-19 (.526) while posting slugging and on-base percentages of 1.000 and .591, respectively...Spivy's best effort came in Saturday's twinbill against the Golden Eagles, where he went 5-for-7 with three doubles, two home runs and five RBI...The three doubles tied a school single-game record and moved Spivy into ninth place on UT Martin's all-time list (26) while the two dingers tied him at No. 6 on the Skyhawks' chart for career home runs (15)...Junior 3B **Douglas Nicodemus** pushed his hitting streak to 15 games with an 8-for-18 week at the plate, while sophomore CF **Zach Dean** went 9-of-20 and drove in seven runs over the five-game stretch...Nicodemus' 15-game hitting streak is the longest on the team and second-longest in the OVC this season...Sophomore C **Chris Rezabek** and junior SS **Lance Renton** also helped out in the RBI department, driving across seven runs each while batting .350 and .294, respectively, for the week...Currently tied for fifth in the league standings, the Skyhawks are on the road this week, visiting Mississippi Valley State before heading over to Austin Peay for a Conference series.

**TENNESSEE TECH (14-27, 7-8 OVC):** Tennessee Tech dropped a tough 6-4 non-conference decision to Tennessee, then went 1-2 in an OVC series at UT Martin with a 7-5 win in game two...Junior 3B **Brian Sprowl** hit .357 over the four-game span with three RBI, three runs and a homer...Sprowl ranks among league leaders with three home runs in Conference play, while freshman IF/DH **Stuart Meinhardt's** six doubles are also among the best in league action...Junior OF **Josh Goodwin** leads the team with 13 multi-hit performances in 2006, and is one of four Tech players with five multi-RBI outings...The Golden Eagles' 7-8 record in Conference play surpasses the team's six OVC wins a year ago and has TTU tied for fifth in the league standings...Tech visits in-state rival Middle Tennessee for a midweek non-conference tilt before returning home to entertain Murray State in league action.
