PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

CHARLIE YARBROUGH • 1B, JR. • RICHMOND, VA • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Yarbrough picks up his second consecutive OVC Player of the Week honor after batting .412 while helping guide Eastern Kentucky to a 2-2 record last week. The junior first baseman went 3-for-4 with two home runs, four RBI and four runs scored in the Colonels' 18-14 win over Bellarmine. A native of Richmond, Va., Yarbrough added two RBI in a 5-4 loss to Connecticut, then went 2-for-5 with a double and an RBI in a 13-2 win over St. Francis.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

JAMIE McALISTER • RHP, SR. • PIEDMONT, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

McAlister registered his fourth career complete game while pitching Southeast Missouri to a 5-1 victory over South Dakota State. The senior righthander went the distance, registering his fourth career complete game while surrendering just one run on five hits over nine innings. A native of Piedmont, Mo., McAlister struck out a career-high 11 batters and did not issue a single walk, throwing 82 of his 109 pitches for strikes.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (10-4, 0-0 OVC): The Govs posted a 4-1 record in non-conference action last week, sweeping two from North Florida (3-2, 3-1) and taking two of three from YSU (11-9, 4-6, 11-2)...Senior OF **Ryan Kane** extended his hitting streak to 10 games, going 8-for-16 with six runs, three RBI and two doubles...Sophomore 1B **Jake Lane** went 3-for-5 and tied school records with three homers and seven RBI in the series finale with YSU, marking the first time a player had reached both marks in the same contest...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** struck out seven batters and walked none en route to a complete-game effort in Wednesday's win at UNF...The one-two punch of Hardy and junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** has allowed a combined six walks in 50.2 innings of work this season...APSU hurlers, under new pitching coach **Ryan Edwards**, have allowed just 35 walks in the first 14 games, a 2.52 BB/9 clip...The Govs were scheduled to play a home-and home series with Indiana State this week, but Monday's game in Clarksville was rained out...After traveling to Terre Haute on Tuesday, APSU plays host to Middle Tennessee on Thursday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (3-6, 0-0 OVC): After dropping the finale of a four-game series at Kansas State (12-1) on Monday, Eastern Illinois headed down to the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge in Bradenton, Fla., where the Panthers opened tourney action with wins over IPFW (4-2) and Indiana (12-11)...Seven EIU players recorded multi-hit outings in the IU contest as the Panthers rallied back from 8-1 and 10-6 deficits while rapping out a season-high 19 hits overall...Freshman OF **Brett Nommensen** drove in a personal-best four runs with a double and his first career homer against the Hoosiers...All four of EIU's runs versus IPFW came in the fourth inning and were courtesy of the long ball, thanks to a solo shot from freshman **Bryan Blaskovitz** and a three-run dinger by senior OF **Pete Stone**...Junior 3B **Ryan Campbell** saw his career-long hitting streak end at 21 games...Junior RHP **Chris Vaculik** picked up his first win of the season, allowing one run over five-plus innings against IPFW...Sophomore RHP **Frank Simoncelli** earned his first career victory in the IU contest...EIU remains in Florida this week, taking on tournament opponents Yale, Fairfield, Bradley, Northern Iowa, Illinois-Chicago and Vermont.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-5, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 2-2 last week...The Colonels dropped a 20-3 decision to Louisville before winning an 18-14 slugfest over Bellarmine to close out a nine-game homestand with a 5-4 mark...EKU then split two games at the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge, losing to Connecticut (5-4) and taking a 13-2 decision from St. Francis in the first two days of the week-long tournament...Four of junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough's** seven hits over the four-game stretch went for extra bases as he belted two homers and rapped out two doubles as part of a 7-for-17 (.412) effort...He drove in six runs and scored four more...Freshman LHP **Chris Friedrich** fanned 10 batters and allowed just three hits over six innings to earn the victory over St. Francis...The Panthers continue action in Florida this week, taking on Bradley, Fairfield, Indiana, Northern Iowa and Cornell.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (7-8, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State lost a 6-1 road decision to Troy, then capped off the week with a three-game sweep of host High Point (10-4, 7-5, 4-1)...Senior 2B **Bert Smith** aided the team's effort with a 6-for-15 (.400) at the plate, driving in four runs and scoring four more...Smith is batting .346 over the last seven games to lead a .277 team average during that span...Junior RHP **Jon Clements** registered a season-high seven strikeouts over six innings while picking up the victory in game one of Sunday's doubleheader...After opening the season 1-7, JSU has won six of its last seven outings...Junior CF **Nick Cleckler** and freshman SS **Steven Leach** are each riding six-game hitting streaks...Sophomore RHP **Matthew Darwin** tossed the team's first complete game of the season in Sunday's series finale at HPU...Three JSU hurlers boast an ERA of 1.80 or lower, led by Clements' 1.66 ERA in 21.2 innings of work...Senior reliever **Lee Drinkard** posted two saves over the weekend...JSU visits Birmingham-Southern before returning home to host a single game against Mississippi State and a three-game series with Rider.

MOREHEAD STATE (6-7, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State split a pair of home contests, winning a 6-5 decision over Brescia in 10 innings before falling to Western Kentucky (10-5)...The final two games of the WKU series were rained out...Senior C **Donald Cheney** extended his hitting streak to eight games, going 5-for-7 (.714) with three runs and a double on the week...The Eagles used eight pitchers in both the Brescia and WKU contests...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** had the game-winning hit against Brescia, leading off the bottom of the 10th with a solo home run...The Eagles play host to a pair of three-game series this week against Youngstown State and Western Michigan.

MURRAY STATE (4-9, 0-0 OVC): Murray State split a two-game series with 19th-ranked Ole Miss, falling 9-3 in Tuesday's outing before stunning the Rebels with a 7-6 victory on Wednesday...The Racers also swept two from Akron (6-5, 15-14) to put their win streak at three games...Murray State jumped out to a 6-0 lead in the win at Ole Miss...Senior DH **Chaz Ebert** walked twice and was hit by three pitches to post an on-base percentage of .632 over the four-game stretch...He finished the week 7-for-14 at the plate with six runs scored...Junior 2B **Seth Hudson** went 5-for-8 in the Ole Miss series, while junior CF **Tyler Pittman** finished the week hitting .429 and tying for a team lead with four RBI... Junior C **Jason Payton** belted the team's first home run of the season in game one of Sunday's twinbill with Akron...Freshman 3B **Tyler Owen** also had a homer on Sunday, the first of his career...The 'Breds close out their three-game series with Akron on Monday, then play host to Memphis on Tuesday...Murray State also visits Indiana State for a three-game series over the weekend.

SAMFORD (8-8, 0-0 OVC): Samford remains at .500 after losing a 7-1 decision to Lipscomb and taking two of three from Longwood (6-3, 7-8, 13-1)...Junior 3B/DH **Parker Gargis** batted .615 while collecting five RBI and leading the Bulldogs in hits (8) and runs (5) over the four-game stretch...He was 7-for-10 with a double and five RBI in the Longwood series...Freshman RHP **David Knapp** fanned four batters and walked one while pitching 7.0 shutout innings in Sunday's 13-1 win over Longwood...After enjoining home-field advantage for the last four outings, the Bulldogs will play 12 of their next 13 dates on the road, beginning with a three-game series at Arkansas State over the weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-8, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri snapped a four-game losing streak, winning its first two meetings with South Dakota State (5-1, 6-5) before falling, 8-5, in the series finale...After recording a pinch-hit RBI double in game one of the SDSU series, junior OF/DH **Dustin Pritchett** made his first career start in left field in game two, going 2-for-3 with two doubles and a walk-off two-run triple in the bottom of the seventh to lead the Redhawks' comeback victory...All four of Pritchett's hits in the series went for extra bases for a 1.125 slugging percentage...Senior RHP **Jamie McAlister** posted his fourth career complete game, working all nine innings of Friday's 5-1 victory...He struck out a personal-best 11 batters and allowed just one run on five hits without a walk, throwing 82 of his 109 pitches for strikes...Senior C **Levi Olsen** batted .667 and drove in three runs over the weekend while junior 2B **Omar Padilla**, senior SS **Jordan Payne** and junior 3B/RHP **Phillip Riley** each recorded their first home runs of the season...The Redhawks visit Memphis for a two-game series, then return home to entertain Missouri State for a three-game set.

UT MARTIN (3-10, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin struggled to a 1-4 record last week, splitting a Tuesday doubleheader at Arkansas State (3-12, 5-4) before going 0-3 in a weekend series at Arkansas-Little Rock (2-5, 7-12, 4-5)...The win at ASU marked UT Martin's fourth one-run victory of the 2006 campaign...The Skyhawks hit .256 over the five-game stretch with three players each hitting better than the team average during that span...Junior 2B **Chad Green** hit .438 while sophomore OF **Kevin Holt** hit .417 and junior OF **Nick Luper** batted .286...The Skyhawks finished the week with five stolen bases, including senior SS **Jason Moore's** swipe of home plate in the win over ASU...Moore finished that series batting .500...Sophomore OF **Zach Dean** smacked a pair of homers and drove in five runs on the week to lead the team in RBI...The Skyhawks play single road dates at Belmont, Lipscomb and Middle Tennessee.

TENNESSEE TECH (5-11, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech went winless in four outings last week, falling to East Tennessee (9-7) before being swept by the Creighton Bluejays in a weekend series (3-17, 10-18, 5-8)...Sophomore 2B **Matt Mihoci** went 7-for-18 (.389) on the week, pushing his hitting streak to 12 games before seeing it end in the series finale against Creighton...Tech pitchers had a rough time on the hill, surrendering six home runs to Bluejay Chris Gradoville and finishing the week with a 12.34 ERA...Senior OF **Kyle Rowekamp** hit .400 over the four games while junior OF **Josh Goodwin** collected five RBI...Goodwin leads the team with 12 RBI and a .365 batting average thus far...Tech batters launched five homers on the week as sophomore 1B **Clint Alexander** belted two and Goodwin, junior C **Steve Soper** and sophomore OF **Adam Black** had one apiece...The Golden Eagles host Chicago State for a three-game series before heading over to Tennessee for a lone date.
