Rice batted .583 to lead the Samford offense in a three-game series at Arkansas State. The junior first baseman turned in his best effort on Saturday with a 4-for-5 outing at the plate, belting a home run and a double while driving in three runs. A native of Mobile, Ala., Rice finished the week with five runs scored and team-highs of seven hits, three doubles and five RBI.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

DAVID KNAPP • RHP, FR. • MARIETTA, GA • SAMFORD

Knapp struck out a career-high eight batters and walked none en route to picking up the 13-0 win Sunday against Arkansas State. The freshman righthander from Marietta, Ga., shut out the Indians over seven frames, pushing his streak of scoreless innings to 14.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (11-5, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a 5-2 road decision to Indiana State before earning an 8-4 victory against in-state rival Middle Tennessee...The Govs' home contest versus ISU was cancelled due to inclement weather...Senior OF **Brett Luther** had three hits in each game, finishing the week with a 6-for-8 effort at the plate...Senior **Ryan Kane** extended his league-high hitting streak to 12 games, going 3-for-8 over the two-game stretch...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** picked up his third consecutive victory, working 6.2 innings of the MTSU contest...Hardy now has 26 career wins, tying the school record set by former Govs standout Mike Weel (1999-02)...Senior reliever **Brad Daniel** earned the save against the Blue Raiders...APSU travels to Evansville on Tuesday before returning home to entertain Jacksonville State in the opening weekend of OVC action.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (7-8, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois closed out its stay at the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge with a 6-2 record after registering wins over Yale (14-2), Fairfield (6-0), Bradley (6-2) and Vermont (2-1) while falling to Northern Iowa (13-10) and Illinois-Chicago (6-4) last week...Junior 3B/C **Ryan Campbell** hit .409 and drove in a team-high eight runs while striking out only once in 22 at-bats...He also rapped out four doubles to move into sixth place on the school's list for career two-baggers (44)...Freshman RHP **Jake Wade** pitched 8.1 scoreless innings in two appearances, including six shutout frames against Fairfield to pick up the win in his first career start...Freshman OF **Brett Nommensen** batted .412 and pushed his hitting streak to 10 games while junior 1B/P **Erik Huber** batted .467 but saw his career-long 10-game hitting streak end in the loss to UNI...Huber recorded five straight multi-hit games to begin the spring break trip...Sophomore LHP **Mike Manns** earned his first career victory in the win over Yale...The Panthers host Blackburn College and are tentatively scheduled to visit Northern Illinois before kicking off OVC play at Tennessee Tech.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (9-8, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky wrapped up its stay at the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge with a 3-3 mark in action last week...The Colonels defeated Indiana (7-6) and swept a doubleheader from Northern Iowa (8-5, 13-9) but lost outings against Bradley (2-3), Fairfield (4-6) and Cornell (7-8)...Freshman LF **Aaron Barrows** batted .421 over the six-game stretch, rapping out two doubles among his nine hits while scoring four runs and driving in another...Junior LHP **Michael Mulholland** picked up two saves and did not allow a run in four relief appearances, striking out five batters over 7.1 innings of work...EKU hosts Georgetown College on Tuesday before jumping into Conference play on the road at Morehead State.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-11, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State lost games to Birmingham-Southern (6-1) and 6th-ranked Mississippi State (7-4) before taking two of three from Rider over the weekend, winning games one (9-6) and three (7-3) while dropping game two (12-10)...Senior 2B **Bert Smith** batted .421 and posted a .522 on-base percentage over the five-game stretch, scoring seven runs and driving in three more while going 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts...Smith was one of five Gamecocks to bat over .400 for the week...Sophomore outfielders **Brian Piazza** and **Clay Whittemore** are riding six-game hitting streaks...In the nightcap of Saturday's twinbill against Rider, senior SS **Bret Pettus** hit his first home run since May, 2004, a span of 252 at-bats...Junior OF **Nick Cleckler** batted .421 last week to raise his average from .328 to a team-high .355...JSU has recorded double-digit hits in three of the last four games...The Gamecocks entertain Birmingham-Southern and Mississippi State before opening Conference play at Austin Peay.

MOREHEAD STATE (7-12, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State struggled to a 1-5 mark last week with its lone win coming in a 16-13 slugfest against Youngstown State...The Eagles lost games one and three to the Penguins by identical 7-1 tallies, and also dropped a three-game set to Western Michigan (12-5, 13-3, 14-3)...Junior 3B **Ryan Kinder** went 12-for-24 at the plate and handled 17 fielding chances without an error over the six-game stretch...After being successful in his first 11 stolen base attempts, junior OF **Dustin Miles** was finally caught twice in Sunday's finale of the WMU series...Through 19 games in 2006, the Eagles have already matched their total of 31 stolen bases from a year ago...Morehead State visits Lipscomb and Western Kentucky before hosting Eastern Kentucky to begin the Conference portion of its schedule.

2006 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

MURRAY STATE (7-12, 0-0 OVC): Murray State posted a .500 mark in six games last week, defeating Akron (11-3) and Freed-Hardeman (7-6), losing to Memphis (13-6) and going 1-2 in a three-game series with Indiana State (1-2, 7-3, 7-14)...Six of junior CF **Tyler Pittman's** eight hits went for doubles as he finished the week with eight RBI and five runs scored...Sophomore RHP **Michael Perconte** pitched his second complete game of the season in the 7-3 win at ISU, throwing only 106 pitches and scattering eight hits while striking out two and walking none...Junior OF **Jamie Leidolf** had a team-high .400 batting average last week, going 8-for-20, while **Seth Hudson** rapped a team-best nine hits (.360)...Senior RHP **Kalen Gibson** pitched a gem at ISU on Friday, scattering four hits over the first eight innings before dropping the 2-1 decision in the ninth, striking out seven...Leadoff hitter **Brett Mullins** leads the Thoroughbreds with a .432 on-base percentage, boasting 16 walks to six strikeouts, while junior OF **Austin Swain** has a .409 on-base percentage with nine walks to four K's...The 'Breds visit Southern Illinois and host Lambuth before welcoming Samford to open OVC play.

SAMFORD (9-10, 0-0 OVC): Samford posted a 13-0 shutout of host Arkansas State to avoid being swept by the Indians after losing games one (11-3) and two (11-10), the latter of which was a 10-inning affair...Junior 1B **Garrett Rice** went 4-for-5 with a home run, double and three RBI on Saturday...He finished the series batting .583, scoring five runs and leading the team in hits (7), doubles (3) and RBI (5)...Freshman RHP **David Knapp** pushed his streak of scoreless innings to 14 after not allowing a run through seven frames en route to earning the victory on Sunday...He struck out a career-high eight batters and walked none at ASU...Samford tied season-highs in runs (13) and hits (15) en route to picking up the win...The team also pounded out 15 hits in Saturday's extra-inning contest...The Bulldogs visit Auburn and host Mercer in non-conference play before hitting the road to open OVC action at Murray State.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-10, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri was outscored 20-2 while dropping a pair of outings at Memphis (1-5, 1-15)...The Tigers' 15 runs on Saturday were the most allowed by the Redhawks' pitching staff this season...Freshman 1B **Aaron Rave** led the team with a 4-for-7 effort at the plate over the two-game stretch, while junior 2B **Omar Padilla** had a pair of singles to push his hitting streak to six games...Southeast, looking to snap a three-game slide, is scheduled to host Missouri State for a three-game series this week before visiting UT Martin to kick off Conference play.

UT MARTIN (5-13, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin edged Belmont (4-3) before losing back-to-back games to Lipscomb (4-3) and Middle Tennessee (12-11)...The Skyhawks have played in eight one-run contests this season, including four straight, posting a 5-3 mark in those games...Junior 3B **Douglas Nicodemus** went 5-for-7 and drove in six runs in two outings...**Jason Hockoday** was 6-for-12 with five runs scored on the week...Senior LHP **Micky Dobson** posted a 1-1 record last week while upping his number of appearances to a team-high seven on the season...Inclement weather has forced the cancellation of UT Martin's March 21 contest at Saint Louis...The Skyhawks open Conference play this weekend against Southeast Missouri.

TENNESSEE TECH (7-12, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech took two of three from Chicago State, dropping game one (5-7) before winning the last two (9-8, 6-5), the latter of which was a 10-inning affair...Senior OF **Kyle Rowekamp** batted .455 for the series, extending his hitting streak to nine games while rapping out five hits, driving in two runs and scoring two more...He also went 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts...Junior **Brian Sprowl** had three RBI and seven runs to accompany his .231 batting average for the week...Sophomore LHP **Jake New** and freshman RHP **Patrick Kimmons** each picked up wins, as Tech's staff had a 5.79 ERA for the series...Junior righthanders **Justin Fields** and **Matt Smith** each posted a 0.00 ERA for the week, working 6.0 and 2.2 innings, respectively...Sophomore 2B **Matt Mihoci** leads the team with a .348 batting average, while junior OF **Josh Goodwin** has collected 14 RBI...Of Tech's starting pitchers, junior **Zac Cole** (1-1) currently holds the best ERA with a 3.68...The Golden Eagles visit Tennessee and host Middle Tennessee before kicking off OVC action at home against Eastern Illinois.
