## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 21

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

**CHRIS POYNTER • 1B/DH, SR. • COLUMBIA, TN • AUSTIN PEAY**

**Poynter** batted .636 (7-for-11) to help Austin Peay post a 2-1 record last week as the Governors defeated Lipscomb and split a doubleheader with Indiana State. The senior first baseman/designated hitter rapped out a double, a home run, a triple and a single in his first four at-bats at Lipscomb, becoming the first APSU player to hit for the cycle since 1996. A native of Columbia, Tenn., Poynter finished the game 5-for-5 with one RBI and four runs scored. For the week, he slugged 1.182 while posting a team-high .667 on-base percentage.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

**JOSEPH EDENS • RHP, SO. • FAYETTEVILLE, GA • SAMFORD**

**Edens** picked up a complete-game win last week, working all nine innings of Samford's 3-2 victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader versus Butler. The sophomore lefthander struck out seven batters while walking only one and surrendering two runs for a 1.00 earned run average.

## AROUND THE DIAMOND...

**AUSTIN PEAY (10-7, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay split a twinbill with Indiana State and cruised to a 13-5 win over Lipscomb to up its record to 10-7 overall...Senior 1B/DH **Chris Poynter** hit for the Govs' first cycle since 1996 in his first four at-bats at Lipscomb and finished the game 5-for-5 at the plate. For the week, Poynter batted .636 while posting on-base and slugging percentages of .667 and 1.182, respectively...Junior transfer **Cody Youngblood** has recorded a hit in all but one of 14 games played thus far and enters the week with a nine-game hitting streak...Head coach **Gary McClure** recorded his 500th career win with the victory at Lipscomb...A cancellation of Monday's game against Martin Methodist has created a 10-game, 21-day road trip for the Govs. After playing a lone date at Belmont, APSU kicks off defense of its OVC regular-season title this weekend at Morehead State.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (1-14, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois saw its losing skid extend to eight games as the Panthers concluded their road trip through the state of Arkansas with a pair of losses at Arkansas-Little Rock and a trio of setbacks at Arkansas State...Sophomore OF **Erik Huber** rapped out six hits on the week, while **Keijo Szalo** and **Joe Hernandez** each homered...Senior P **Kyle Widegren** went 0-1 in a pair of starts on the mound, giving up just two earned runs for a 2.08 ERA through 8.2 innings of work with five strikeouts...The Panthers play host to Chicago State before opening OVC play at Tennessee-Martin.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-8, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky racked up 53 runs in a three-game sweep of Northern Illinois to stretch its win streak to four...Senior 3B **Bryan Stevenson** posted multi-hit and multi-RBI efforts in all three contests to lead the team with a .600 batting average, six RBI and eight runs. Five of those runs came in the Colonels' 19-11 win in Game 2, where Stevenson went 4-for-5...EKU hit .443 for the series, averaging 17.7 runs per game...The Colonels put up a 10-spot in the bottom of the first inning en route to their 27-6 victory in Game 1...EKU hosts in-state rival Kentucky before beginning Conference play on the road at Tennessee Tech.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (7-10, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State went 1-2 in a three-game series with Furman. The Gamecocks' Mar. 16 meeting with UAB has been rescheduled for May 10th after being postponed due to inclement weather...Sophomore SS **Jake Ball** is riding a seven-game hit streak after going 3-for-11 against the Paladins...Freshman P **Donovan Hand** (2-1) made two appearances over the weekend, including working the final three innings of Friday's game to pick up the 3-2 win, not allowing a hit or run while retiring the final nine Furman batters...The Gamecocks are on the road this week, visiting Alabama before entering into Conference action at Samford.

**MOREHEAD STATE (7-13, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State had a busy week, playing a total of eight home games during a six-day span. The Eagles took two of three from Cleveland State, then dropped three to Youngstown State and two to Lipscomb...Senior 2B **Lance Seasor** had a solid week, hitting .464 with six runs, four RBI and four doubles...Junior RHP **Reid Kittleson** started and worked the first six innings of Morehead's 12-0 Game 3 shutout of CSU, surrendering only four hits en route to the win...The Eagles' pitching staff combined for a 4.50 ERA during the eight-game stretch and sports a 4.99 ERA through 20 games, a far cry from last year's 9.00 ERA at the same point in the season...Morehead lost six of eight last week, despite outscoring its opponents by a 42-39 margin...The Eagles kick off OVC action at home against Austin Peay.

# 2005 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

**MURRAY STATE (10-10, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State slipped to .500 after going 0-4 last week, including a 5-2 setback at 16th-ranked Vanderbilt and a trio of losses at South Alabama...Sophomore OF **Austin Swain** went 5-for-10 at the plate with a run and a .545 on-base percentage...The Racers have lost six straight...The Thoroughbred pitching staff gave up just five hits while fanning eight batters at Vandy with **Jake Ociesa** taking the loss after allowing five runs (four earned) on five hits with six K's and four walks...**Seth Hudson** hit .333 at USA...Murray State visits Memphis to end a five-game road swing before opening its league slate at home versus South-east Missouri.

**SAMFORD (4-12, 0-0 OVC):** Samford won its first series of the season, taking two of three from Butler before dropping an 8-5 decision to Dayton...Freshman OF **John Morgan** went 4-for-4 in Game 3 against Butler and finished the week with a .563 batting average...Sophomore RHP **Joseph Edens** picked up the complete-game, 3-2 victory in Game 3 of the Butler series, striking out seven batters while walking just one in nine innings of work for a 1.00 ERA...The Bulldogs continue their homestand with Dayton and OVC-opening opponent Jacksonville State.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (7-11, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri fell to 7-11, dropping a two-game set at 12th-ranked Mississippi before losing two of three at home to Central Michigan...Senior 3B **Eric Horstman** went 10-for-20 at the plate, rapping out two doubles while scoring runs. He recorded multi-hit efforts in four of the five contests while extending his hitting streak to an OVC-best 11 games...Sophomore LHP **Josh Parham** posted a 1-0 record in four relief appearances, holding opponents to a .167 batting average. He currently sports a 4.1 scoreless innings streak...The Redhawks kick off Conference action on the road at Murray State.

**TENNESSEE-MARTIN (4-14, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin continues to search for a winning formula as the Skyhawks saw their losing skid extend to eight games with losses to Birmingham-Southern and Lipscomb...In Wednesday's Game 2 loss to BSC, Tennessee-Martin trailed 9-0 before **Brett Spivy** hit a grand slam to lead a seven-run rally attempt that fell short in the 9-7 loss...Hitting woes continue to plague UT Martin, who hit .182 as a team last week...Senior **Nick Bruner** was the only Skyhawk to hit better than .300, going 4-for-12 with a double and three RBI...UT Martin returns from a nine-game road stretch to host OVC opponent Eastern Illinois.

**TENNESSEE TECH (5-13, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech went 2-2 last week, dropping a twinbill on the road to Georgia State before sweeping a pair at home from Chicago State...Senior 1B **Nathan Marty** raised his batting average to .333 while rapping out six hits and driving in six runs last week, including a two-run homer in Sunday's 15-8 triumph over CSU...Marty leads the Golden Eagles with 14 RBI on 19 hits and a slugging percentage of .544...Tech visits Vanderbilt before returning home to kick off Conference play against Eastern Kentucky.

**CONFERENCE PLAY OPENS:** Two-time defending OVC regular-season champion **Austin Peay** has the target aimed directly its way as Conference play gets underway this weekend. The Govs received four first-place votes and were picked to win a third crown in a preseason poll of the league's head coaches. **Southeast Missouri** also received four first-place nods and is a second-place choice, while 2004 OVC Tournament champion **Jacksonville State** claimed the final two-first place votes and was selected third.
