PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

PARKER GARGIS • 3B, JR. • HOMEWOOD, AL • SAMFORD

Gargis led Samford with a 6-for-10 effort at the plate in the Bulldogs' three-game OVC sweep of Murray State. The junior third baseman drove in five runs while posting slugging and on-base percentages of .800 and .692, respectively, against the Thoroughbreds. For the week, the Homewood, Ala., native batted .353 with six hits, six RBI, one run scored and a triple.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

CHRISTIAN FRIEDRICH • LHP, FR. • EVANSTON, IL • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Friedrich pitched the fifth no-hitter in Eastern Kentucky history in a 1-0 shutout of OVC opponent Morehead State. The freshman righthander from Evanston, Ill., faced just two batters over the minimum, hitting one and walking the other while striking out 10 in a seven-inning, complete-game effort.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (13-8, 1-2 OVC): After kicking off the season with a 9-3 mark, Austin Peay has dropped five of its last nine...The Govs lost an opening Conference series for the second straight year, going 1-2 against Jacksonville State over the weekend...APSU also split a pair of non-conference outings, falling to Evansville (7-2) and beating Freed-Hardeman (14-8)...Senior LF **Ryan Kane** is batting .403 with 17 RBI during a league-high 17-game hitting streak...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** (4-0, 1.72 ERA) became the Govs' all-time wins leader with his complete-game victory over JSU in the series opener...Hardy is 27-9 during his three-year career at APSU and sits just three wins shy of tying the OVC's all-time record of 30 victories, set by former Eastern Kentucky hurler Jeff Cruse (1984-87)...Freshman 2B **Brandon Munsey's** first collegiate hit was a home run to left field against FHU...The Govs play a home-and-home series with Memphis before hosting Morehead State in OVC action.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (8-10, 1-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois went 1-2 in its Conference-opening series at Tennessee Tech, bookending a 4-0 shutout in game two with losses of 7-3 and 6-3 in games one and three, respectively...Hits did not come easily for the Panthers as they tallied just 12 over the three-game stretch...Sophomore RHP **Mike Manns** (2-0, 0.60 ERA) retired the side four times in seven innings en route to his first career complete-game shutout on Saturday, allowing just four hits while striking out a career-high eight batters for the win...In three starts this season, Manns has surrendered just one run...Junior OF **Dan Fox** rapped his first career triple to drive in two of the Panthers' four runs in game two...Freshman OF **Brett Nommensen** went 0-for-9 in the series to end his career-high hitting streak at 10 games...Junior reliever **Drew Gierich** (0-2, 3.67 ERA) tossed 4.1 innings of one-hit, shutout ball in the game one loss, retiring the final 12 Tech batters...EIU visits Saint Louis and Indiana State before returning home to entertain UT Martin in Conference play.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (11-9, 1-1 OVC): Eastern Kentucky edged Georgetown College (3-2) before splitting an OVC-opening doubleheader at Morehead State, losing game one (12-2) before ekeing out a 1-0 victory in the nightcap...The series at Morehead was reduced to two games on Sunday after rain forced the cancellation of Saturday's action...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (4-0, 2.00 ERA) pitched the fifth no-hitter in school history en route to the game two win against the Eagles, going the distance and striking out 10 batters in the seven-inning contest...Senior LF **Brett Bolger** had two hits and scored the winning run in the bottom of the ninth against Georgetown, then went 3-for-4 with an RBI in game one at Morehead...The Colonels travel to Louisville before returning home to welcome OVC foe Tennessee Tech.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (11-14, 2-1 OVC): Jacksonville State won its seventh consecutive OVC series, taking two of three at Austin Peay...Earlier in the week, the Gamecocks lost non-conference decisions to Birmingham-Southern (10-8) and No. 1 Mississippi State (6-1)...Junior C **Richard Turner** had five hits and led JSU with a .357 batting average over the five-game stretch, going without a strikeout in 17 plate appearances...Second baseman **Bert Smith** is one of two freshmen ranked among the league's offensive leaders, batting a team-best .356 while topping the OVC in multi-hit games (11) and overall hits (32)...Junior C **Eric Beck** has recorded six multi-RBI outings while driving in a team-best 22 runs...Junior SS **Jake Ball** raised his batting average from .169 to .206 with a 3-for-3 effort at APSU on Sunday...Sophomore **Mitch Miller** (1-1, 6.94 ERA) had six strikeouts over 5.0 innings in two relief appearances...The Gamecocks are 3-1 in one-run contests this season...JSU plays four at home this week, hosting UAB and in-state OVC rival Samford.

MOREHEAD STATE (9-13, 1-1 OVC): Morehead State posted a 10-3 win over Western Kentucky then split a rain-shortened OVC series with Eastern Kentucky, winning Sunday's twinbill opener (12-2) before losing a 1-0 pitchers' duel in the nightcap...Junior C **Donald Cheney** went 4-for-8 with one homer, three runs and three RBI on the week, posting slugging and on-base percentages of 1.000 and .636, respectively...The Eagles' pitching staff was impressive over the three-game stretch, giving up just two-extra base raps among 12 hits and five earned runs in 23 innings while limiting opponents to a .154 batting average...At WKU, freshman reliever **Mark Rhodes** (1-1, 6.10 ERA) picked up his first collegiate win after retiring nine of the 10 batters he faced with the only other player reaching base due to an error...In game one on Sunday, senior RHP **Shane Lucci** (3-4, 5.36 ERA) took a shutout deep into the seventh and final inning before surrendering two runs...In game two, junior RHP **Henry Mabree** (1-4, 5.01 ERA) allowed only two hits and an unearned run while striking out 10 batters...The Eagles do not play at home again until April 5, visiting Kentucky and OVC foe Austin Peay this week.

2006 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

MURRAY STATE (7-17, 0-3 OVC): Murray State finds itself on a six-game slide after losses to Southern Illinois (8-4), Lambuth (7-6/13 inn.) and Samford (2-1, 5-0, 4-7) last week...Junior 2B **Seth Hudson** went 6-for-12 and scored two of the team's five runs in the three-game series against Samford...Freshman RHP **Mark Harmon** (1-1, 1.59 ERA) was the tough-luck loser in the 13-inning loss to Lambuth, allowing eight hits and a lone run while working the final seven frames...Sophomore **Micah Dunn** was the only Murray State player with more than one at-bat who went without a strikeout in the Samford series...Following their March 28 outing against Evansville, the 'Breds are scheduled to play just nine more home contests for the remainder of the season, a span of 29 games...Murray State also visits Southeast Missouri for a Conference series.

SAMFORD (12-12, 3-0 OVC): Samford is off to its first 3-0 OVC start since joining the league in 2004 after sweeping Murray State over the weekend...Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs dropped non-conference decisions to Auburn (6-4) and Mercer (4-0)...This also marks the first time since 1991 that Samford has opened a conference slate 3-0...Junior 3B **Parker Gargis** went 6-for-10 and drove in six runs during the series at Murray...Junior LHP **Josh Ehmke** (3-2, 2.93 ERA) and **Eric Lassiter** (2-2, 5.25 ERA) each tossed complete-game gems in Saturday's doubleheader against the 'Breds...Ehmke gave up just one run and struck out a career-high 14 batters in the opener, while Lassiter pitched seven innings of shutout ball in the nightcap...Freshman RHP **David Knapp** (3-1, 1.48 ERA) also worked six strong innings in Sunday's finale, fanning a career-high nine batters while allowing a lone run...The Bulldogs play a two-game series at Middle Tennessee before visiting in-state OVC rival Jacksonville State.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-14, 0-3 OVC): Southeast Missouri saw its losing streak stretch to seven games after an 0-4 effort last week with losses to Missouri State (5-2) and UT Martin (3-2, 2-1, 1-0)...The Redhawks' pitching staff compiled a respectable 2.78 ERA over the four-game stretch, but was stymied by a lack of run support from the offense...Senior LHP **Derek Herbig** (1-1, 5.23 ERA) struck out eight batters and gave up only one run in two starting appearances, working three shutout innings against Missouri State and eight strong frames in the series finale at UT Martin...Junior LF/DH **Dustin Pritchett** led the team with a 5-for-10 effort at the plate...The Redhawks play a four-game homestand this week, hosting Missouri and OVC opponent Murray State.

UT MARTIN (8-13, 3-0 OVC): UT Martin swept an OVC series for the first time since 1994, taking all three in its Conference-opening set with Southeast Missouri (3-2, 2-1, 1-0), including a 10-inning affair in the series opener...All eight of the Skyhawks' victories this season have been one-run contests...Senior LF **Zane Gresback** drove in two runs and posted a 3-for-5 day at the plate in Saturday's twinbill...Junior RHP **Ryan Rockholt** (1-3, 5.19 ERA) picked up his first win of the season on Sunday, fanning a career-high 10 batters over 7.2 innings, while junior closer **Chadwick Cameron** (3-0, 2.92 ERA) did not allow a hit over the final 1.1 innings en route to his second save of 2006...Sophomore C **Chris Rezabek** threw out all three of the Redhawks' stolen base tries...Five Skyhawk pitchers combined for a 1.04 ERA in the series...Junior RHP **Jacob Smothers** (2-3) lowered his earned run average to 6.35 after allowing just one run in a seven-inning, complete-game effort in game two...The Skyhawks visit Southern Illinois and OVC foe Eastern Illinois this week.

TENNESSEE TECH (9-15, 2-1 OVC): Tennessee Tech took two of three from Eastern Illinois to kick off OVC play on a winning note, winning games one (7-3) and three (6-3) and dropping game two (4-0)...Earlier in the week, the Golden Eagles lost a pair of non-conference decisions to Tennessee (21-1) and Middle Tennessee (6-1)...Junior 3B/OF **Brian Sprowl** led the team with three RBI and a .389 batting average over the five-game stretch while junior OF **Josh Goodwin** went 6-for-17 (.353) with a double and an RPI...Junior RHP **Justin Fields** (1-1, 3.75 ERA) did not allow an earned run over seven innings of work en route to the game one win against EIU...Tech hurlers combined for a 1.44 ERA in the EIU series...Sophomore 2B **Matt Mihoci** leads the team with a .341 hitting average while Goodwin (15) and junior C **Steve Soper** (13) are the squad's top RBI threats...Junior righthanders **Matt Smith** (1-1) and **Zac Cole** sport the Golden Eagles' top earned run averages at 3.32 and 3.41, respectively...Tech hits the road for trips to Belmont and OVC opponent Eastern Kentucky.
