PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

DONALD CHENEY • C, SO. • CRIDERSVILLE, OH • MOREHEAD ST.

Cheney helped propel Morehead State to a three-game sweep of Austin Peay in the Eagles' Conference opener, going 6-for-10 with four runs scored, one double, two home runs and eight runs batted in. The sophomore catcher from Cridersville, Ohio, had a 1.000 slugging percentage and a .571 on-base percentage during the four-game stretch, recording three extra-base hits, including a pair of three-run homers, among his six raps.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

CHRIS VACULIK • P, SO. • ORLAND PARK, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

In two appearances last week, **Vaculik** went 1-0 with a 1.12 ERA. His win was a complete-game, seven-inning affair against UT Martin, where he gave up one earned run on three hits with six strikeouts. The Orland Park, Ill., native also pitched an inning of no-hit, scoreless relief in the Panthers' win over Chicago State.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (11-10, 0-3 OVC): Austin Peay edged Belmont in a midweek outing before losing all three of its OVC games at Morehead State last week, marking the first time the Governors have been swept in a Conference series since going 0-3 at Southeast Missouri during the 2002 campaign. Prior to last week, APSU had not gone winless against an OVC opponent in 19 straight series...Junior **Jacob Schroeder** led the Govs at the plate last week with a 7-for-15 (.467) performance. On the mound, junior transfer **Cory Gunter** picked up the win at Belmont. Otherwise, it was a tough week for the Govs' pitching staff, as each of the team's three starters were tagged with losses, including **Rowdy Hardy**, who dropped his third consecutive decision. In those three losses, the Govs scored just 10 runs and batted .240 while the defense committed eight errors...Seniors **Jared Walker** (183) and **Chris Hyde** (182) are nearing the 200 career hit mark...After a 20-day, 10-game road trip, APSU returns to Raymond Hand Park to open a six-game homestand with midweek contests versus Lipscomb and Memphis and a three-game series against OVC foe Samford.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-15, 2-1 OVC): Eastern Illinois broke out the bats in a 23-6 win over Chicago State, then kicked off the OVC portion of its schedule by taking two of three from Tennessee-Martin...Junior OF **Keiji Szalo** led the team with a .353 batting average for the week, rapping out four doubles and a home run while driving in seven runs and scoring four more. Against CSU, he went 3-for-6 with four RBI and two runs...Sophomore P **Chris Vaculik** picked up a complete-game victory at UT Martin, giving up just one earned run off three hits with six strikeouts through seven innings...The Panthers racked up 37 runs during the four-game stretch (9.25 rpg)...This week, EIU visits Saint Louis and hosts Millikin in non-conference action before welcoming Murray State for a three-game OVC series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (7-9, 2-1 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 2-1 in its Conference-opening series with Tennessee Tech, winning games one and three. The Colonels had their contests with Louisville and Kentucky cancelled last week due to heavy rain and have now lost six games this season to inclement weather conditions...Junior OF **Brett Bolger** continued his hot hitting by batting a team-best .545 last week. He hit safely in all three games, including a 4-for-5 effort with two runs scored in the series opener, to bring his current hit streak to seven games...Sophomore P **McKenzie Willoughby** improved to 2-1 on the season by throwing 7.0 strong innings in game one...The Colonels return home to entertain Wright State and Marshall in a pair of mid-week non-conference outings before welcoming OVC opponent Tennessee-Martin for a three-game series.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-12, 2-1 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a close 5-3 decision to Alabama before taking two of three from OVC opponent Samford...Senior OF **Winston Pearson** went 10-for-19 (.526) on the week, including a 5-for-6 effort in game one versus the Bulldogs. He is currently riding a five-game hit streak while leading the team in batting average (.364), slugging percentage (.558), RBI (15), home runs (3)...Sophomore P **Jon Clements** earned his first win of the season in game two of the Samford series. He pitched all seven innings for the complete-game victory, allowing one run on seven hits while fanning five and giving up one walk. He currently has a 3.60 ERA with a 1-2 record in seven appearances and leads the team with 25 strikeouts...**Jake Ball** extended his hitting streak to 11 games...The Gamecocks visit Vanderbilt for a mid-week outing before heading over to Southeast Missouri for a three-game OVC set.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-13, 3-0 OVC): Morehead State opened OVC play with a three-game sweep of Austin Peay...Sophomore C **Donald Cheney** launched a pair of three-run homers in the series and finished the weekend batting .600 with eight RBI and four runs scored. Cheney is among 37 catchers on the Johnny Bench Award watch list for the 2005 season...Junior reliever **Dan Klausmeier** had a hand in all three victories, picking up a win and a save while allowing three singles and no runs in 4 and 2/3 innings of work...Senior 2B **Lance Seabor** extended his hitting streak to 13 games, going .500 at the plate for the series...Junior RF **Bo Stohler** hit .571 for the week with three runs scored and a homer...The Eagle defense committed just one error in three outings...Game one starter **Adrian Duran** pitched seven scoreless innings before surrendering two runs in the eighth...Morehead State continues its homestand with a mid-week two-game series against Akron and a three-game OVC set versus Tennessee Tech.

2005 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

MURRAY STATE (13-11, 2-1 OVC): Murray State went 3-1 last week, edging Memphis (10-9) before taking a two of three from Southeast Missouri in OVC play...Three of the four contests were one-run affairs as the Thoroughbreds won games one and three against Southeast by 7-6 margins... Sophomore OF **Austin Swain** went 5-for-9 (.556) for the week, driving in two runs and scoring three more...Junior LHP **West Harris** went 2-0 in two appearances, striking out five batters and walking none while holding opponents to just .111 batting in 5.0 innings of scoreless relief...The win over Memphis snapped a six-game losing skid...The 'Breds hit .300 as a team last week, including a .282 average in the Southeast series... **Jamie Leidolf** went 5-for-10 on the week, including a two-run homer that tied game one with Southeast. Game two was called due to darkness and had to be completed on Saturday...Murray State hit four homers over the four-game stretch, nearly matching its season total of five heading into the week...**Alex Stewart** had a good series against the Redhawks, going 6-for-14 (.429)...**Clint Griggs** hit .438 (7-for-16) for the week, including a 3-for-5 outing at Memphis...The 'Breds will host Memphis on Tuesday before visiting Eastern Illinois for a three-game OVC this weekend.

SAMFORD (15, 1-2 OVC): Samford dropped a midweek decision to Dayton, then lost its first two OVC contests to in-state rival Jacksonville State before halting the four-game slide with a 5-1 victory over the Gamecocks in the series finale...Freshman OF **Bear Burnett** led Bulldogs with a 7-for-15 (.467) effort at the plate, knocking a double and a triple while driving in two runs...Junior RHP **Stephen Artz** posted an ERA of 1.12 while collecting the Bulldogs' lone win. He struck out four JSU batters and walked three in eight innings of work on Saturday...Samford takes on Auburn and UAB on Tuesday and Wednesday before traveling to Austin Peay for a trio of league games.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (8-13, 1-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri sandwiched a 15-10 win between a pair of 7-6 losses to Murray State in its Conference opener last week...Senior SS **Ernie Bracamonte** went 7-for-14 in the series, scoring five times and driving in four runs with three extra-base hits...Sophomore P/OF **Brent Lawson** was solid in two relief appearances, picking up a win and giving up no runs, hits or walks while striking out two in 2.2 innings of work...Southeast's 15 runs in game two was a season-high...**Jordan Payne** hit his team-leading fourth homer of the season in game one with an inside-the-park rap...**Frank Montiel** batted .357 with six RBI for the series, including a three-run homer in game two...**Chris Gibson** batted .417 with four RBI...**Eric Horstman** extended his team-leading hitting streak to 13 games... **Bo Jenkins** extended his hitting streak to six games, batting .545 last week with three RBI and three runs scored...The Redhawks return home to entertain Arkansas State on Tuesday before welcoming OVC foe Jacksonville State for a three-game set.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (5-16, 1-2 OVC): UT Martin snapped an eight-game losing streak with a 16-4 victory in game one of its Conference-opening series with Eastern Illinois before losing the final two to the Panthers. The Skyhawks also had a mid-week game against Saint Louis rained out...Junior hurler **Scott Massey** tossed a complete game in the opener against EIU to pick up his first win of the season, scattering eight hits and giving up one earned run while walking three batters and striking out four...In the second game of the doubleheader, pitcher **Adam Ledlow** made the start in place of **Justin Bryant**, who was scratched because of tightness in his elbow. Ledlow worked all seven innings, surrendering one earned run, six hits and a walk while fanning three batters. Bryant is expected to return this week...The Skyhawks hit .306 as a team against EIU, led by sophomore **Nick Luper's** .455 average...Freshman DH/C **Chris Rezabek** hit .364 in the series with two doubles and four RBI...The Skyhawks visit Southern Illinois on Tuesday before heading over to Eastern Kentucky for a trio of games.

TENNESSEE TECH (6-16, 1-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a 4-2 mid-week decision to Vanderbilt before taking one of three from Eastern Kentucky in its Conference-opening series...The Golden Eagles picked up their first OVC win of the year in the second game versus the Colonels, 6-2. Tech will play in-state rival, Middle Tennessee, in a home-home series during the week before continuing OVC play at Morehead State over the weekend.
