OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 6

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

CHARLIE YARBROUGH • 1B, JR. • RICHMOND, VA • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Yarbrough slugged his way to the first OVC Player of the Week honor bestowed for the 2006 campaign, belting five homers and driving in 11 runs while going 7-of-9 in a two-game sweep of Oakland. Three of the junior first baseman's dingers came in the second outing of the series, tying an Eastern Kentucky single-game record. He added another hit and two RBI in a three-game series against Akron to finish the week with a .381 batting average while posting a 1.190 slugging percentage and collecting 25 total bases. For his efforts, the Richmond, Va., native was also named one of *Collegiate Baseball's* Louisville Slugger National Players of the Week.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

CHRIS FRIEDRICH • LHP, FR. • EVANSTON, IL • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Friedrich posted a 0.00 earned run average while compiling a 2-0 record in two starts last week. The freshman lefthander struck out eight batters and walked three while hurling three innings of one-hit ball against Oakland. He followed that with a five-hit, seven-strikeout performance through five innings of work in the Colonels' lone win over Akron. A native of Evanston, Ill., Friedrich surrendered just two unearned runs for the week.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (6-3, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay enjoys a league-best 6-3 record in non-conference action after dispatching Lipscomb (16-3) and going 2-1 in a three-game series with Valparaiso last week...The Govs' offense has been firing on all cylinders thus far with a .292 team batting average and 8.2 runs per game...Sophomore 1B **Jake Lane** went 8-for-17 with three doubles, a triple, five runs and six RBI last week...He has hit safely in all nine games while boasting a team-high .432 average at the plate...Senior **Cody Youngblood** sports an early .535 on-base percentage, second-best in the OVC, while also ranking fourth with a .406 batting average...Junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** fanned a career-high 11 Lipscomb batters en route to his first win of the season...He owns a 1.42 ERA and 19 strikeouts in two appearances while senior RHP **Rowdy Hardy** has a 2.66 ERA and 16 K's to his credit...After opening the season as the team's third starter, senior **Brad Daniel** has moved to the bullpen...He has not allowed an earned run in three appearances (one start, two relief)...The Govs travel to North Florida for a two-game series before returning home for a three-game set with Youngstown State.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (1-5, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped its first three outings of a four-game series at Kansas State...Junior OF **Mark Chagnon** led the team with a .583 clip at the plate last week...He recorded the team's first four-hit outing of the season (third of his career) in Sunday's 7-5 loss to the Wildcats...Junior 3B **Ryan Campbell's** hitting streak has hit a career-high 20 games, dating back to the final month of the 2005 season...He rapped out his 39th career double in the series opener at KSU, moving him into eighth place on the school's all-time list...Junior RHP **Brandon Murphy's** six strikeouts on Sunday are the most by an EIU hurler this season...Junior 1B **Erik Huber** drove in three runs through the first three games at KSU while freshman CF **Brett Nommensen** fell a home run shy of the cycle with a 3-for-5 effort in the series opener...The Panthers wrap up their series with KSU on Monday, then return to Charleston for Wednesday's home opener against Quincy before heading down to Bradenton, Fla., for the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge, where they will open with dates against IPFW and Indiana.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (4-3, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky posted a 4-1 mark last week, sweeping a two-game series against Oakland and taking two of three from Akron...Junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough** slugged his way to *Collegiate Baseball's* Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week honors, going 7-of-9 with five home runs and 11 RBI in the Oakland series...Three of his dingers came in game two, tying a school record...Through seven games, Yarbrough is batting .414 and leads the league in homers (5), RBI (15), total bases (30) and slugging percentage (1.034)...Freshman LHP **Chris Friedrich** went 2-0 in eight innings of work over a pair of starts, fanning 15 batters while giving up six hits and two unearned runs...Head coach **Elvis Dominguez** earned his 100th career victory with a 12-2 win over Oakland...After wrapping up a nine-game homestand Tuesday against Louisville, the Colonels take off for Bradenton, Fla., and the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge, where they will open with dates against Connecticut and St. Francis.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (4-7, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State went 3-1 last week, dropping a 13-3 decision to Troy before sweeping a trio of outings from Louisiana-Monroe...Junior OF **Garrett Bass** went 6-for-12 while playing a key role in a pair of one-run victories in the ULM series...On Saturday, he scored the game-winning run (6-5) in the bottom of the ninth after leading off with a double in the team's final at-bat...On Sunday, he hit an RBI triple in the bottom of the eighth to help JSU take a 6-5 lead en route to the 7-6 victory...Bass and junior C **Richard Turner** each sport four-game hitting streaks...Sophomore RHP **Donovan Hand** registered a season-high 10 strikeouts on Friday while picking up his first victory of the 2006 campaign...Hand is 1-2 with 17 strikeouts in three appearances...Junior C **Eric Beck** and sophomore OF/C **Clay Whittemore** are the only two Gamecocks to start all 11 games thus far...Beck leads the squad with a .357 batting average while junior OF **Nick Cleckler** has driven in a team-high 11 runs...JSU visits Troy on Tuesday, then travels to High Point for a two-game series over the weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (5-6, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State defeated Georgetown College (6-4), then took the first three in a four-game series with Canisius...The Eagles' four-game win streak ended with Sunday's 11-10 loss to the Griffins...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** batted .444 (8-for-18) with nine runs and eight RBI over the five-game stretch, posting slugging and on-base percentages of .944 and .565, respectively...Junior OF **Dustin Miles** hit .375 and sported a .565 on-base percentage while batting from the leadoff spot...He scored 11 runs and was 7-for-7 in stolen base attempts while also belting his first career homer...Junior C **Donald Cheney** is riding a six-game hitting streak after batting .389 with a .778 slugging percentage last week...The Eagles stole

18 bases in 19 attempts over the five games, bringing their season total to 23-of-27...In 2005, Morehead State had a total of 31 steals in 40 attempts...The Eagles, who are nine games into a scheduled 19-game homestand, play a lone date against Brescia and a three-game series versus Western Kentucky.

MURRAY STATE (1-8, 0-0 OVC): Murray State dropped outings to Vanderbilt and Southern Illinois as part of a seven-game, season-opening losing streak before halting the slide with a 4-0 win over Arkansas-Little Rock on Saturday... The Racers finished with a 1-2 record in the three-game series against the Trojans...Junior 1B/OF **Jamie Leidolf** went 3-for-4 in Sunday's win with two doubles and two RBI...He is hitting .412 with three runs and three RBI to start the season...Sophomore RHP **Michael Perconte** tossed a complete-game, two-hitter to pick up the win against UALR...In two starts, he has a 0.69 ERA with 10 strikeouts and four walks over 13 innings...Junior C **Jason Payton** has rapped two triples this season, hitting .313 through nine games...Senior OF **Lincoln Kent** leads the team with a .417 batting average, going 5-for-12 with four runs thus far...The Thoroughbreds visit Ole Miss for a two-game series on Monday and Tuesday, then return home for a rare Sunday-Monday series with Akron.

SAMFORD (6-6, 0-0 OVC): Samford struggled to a 1-4 mark last week, winning the first of a two-game series with UAB before going on a four-game slide that included a trio of losses to South Alabama...Junior 1B **Louis Rojas** went 4-for-5 with two RBI in Tuesday's win...He finished the week batting .421 (8-for-19) with five RBI and five runs...Junior LHP **Josh Ehmke** pitched seven strong innings but was still tagged with the loss on Saturday...He struck out seven batters and allowed just two earned runs...Ten of Samford's first 12 games have come against teams from the state of Alabama with the Bulldogs owning a 5-5 mark in those games...Newcomers have played a significant role for head coach **Casey Dunn** early in the season as eight position players and nine pitchers have already made their Bulldog debuts...Three of the team's top four hitters are in their first season with Samford, including Rojas (.404) and freshman OF **John Morgan** (.356)...Rojas has an OVC-high 19 hits while Morgan is tied for third with 16...The Bulldogs play a four-game homestand this week, welcoming Lipscomb for a lone contest and Longwood for a three-game set.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-7, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri went winless in four outings last week, dropping a narrow 7-6 decision to Evansville before losing meetings with Indiana State and Southeastern Louisiana as part of the Redhawks' Little Caesars Baseball Classic...The Redhawks' final tourney game against Creighton on Sunday was cancelled due to lightning and rain...Wednesday's loss to the Purple Aces came on a suicide squeeze in the bottom of the ninth...Junior OF **Brent Lawson** hit the team's first homer of the season, launching a two-run shot in the eighth inning at Evansville...Freshman 1B/DH **Aaron Rave** leads the team with 14 hits, 10 RBI and a .400 batting average...Junior reliever **Josh Parham** sports a 2.03 ERA through six appearances, surrendering just three earned runs in 13.1 innings of work...Southeast hosts South Dakota State for a three-game series over the weekend.

UT MARTIN (3-7, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin played .500 ball last week, dropping a 9-7 contest to Memphis before winning a narrow 10-9 decision against Union and splitting a twinbill with Freed-Hardeman...Sophomore OF **Blake Turner** launched two home runs against Union, then had a key hit and an RBI in the bottom of the seventh inning of the nightcap against FHU...Junior RHP **Chadwick Cameron** earned both of the Skyhawks' wins on the mound, striking out three batters while giving up a lone hit in 4.1 innings of relief work...All three of UT Martin's wins thus far have been one-run affairs...The Skyhawks hit .319 as a team last week with five players batting .400 or better...Junior SS **Lance Renton** leads the team with a .545 average at the plate, while sophomore C **Chris Rezabek** is hitting .444 after going 8-for-18 in four outings last week...UT Martin sports a 9-for-11 effort in stolen base attempts this season...The Skyhawks kick off a nine-game road swing Tuesday with a doubleheader at Arkansas State, followed by a three-game series at Arkansas-Little Rock.

TENNESSEE TECH (5-7, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech won a close 7-6 outing at Lipscomb, then capped off the week by taking two of three from Toledo...After starting off the season 0-4, the Golden Eagles have won five of their last eight... Junior C **Steve Soper** belted three home runs while tallying six hits, four RBI and four runs over the four-game stretch...He and sophomore INF **Matt Mihoci** are each riding nine-game hitting streaks...Junior RHP **Zac Cole** earned the 3-1 win over the Rockets on Sunday, allowing just four hits and one run over seven innings on the hill...Sophomore RHP **Patrick Miller** improved to 2-0, picking up the win at Lipscomb with two innings of relief work... Junior OF **Josh Goodwin** batted .538 with seven hits, one triple and an RBI last week...He leads the team with a .375 clip and 18 hits, ranking second in the OVC in the latter...Sophomore INF **Clint Alexander** is one of two players with a league-best five doubles to date...The Golden Eagles visit East Tennessee for a lone outing before returning home to entertain Creighton in a three-game series.
