OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 7

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

CHRIS O'DELL • OF, JR. • LEXINGTON, KY • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Five games into the season, O'Dell leads Eastern Kentucky in nearly every offensive category, posting a league-high .533 batting average (8-of-15) with two home runs, six RBI and slugging and on-base percentages of .933 and .636, respectively. The junior outfielder has drawn six walks and hit safely in all five games thus far with three multi-hit efforts to date. The Lexington, Ky., native also drove in a season-high three runs in a Feb. 26 outing against Bradley.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

ROWDY HARDY • SP, JR. • BETHEL SPRINGS, TN • AUSTIN PEAY

Hardy sports a 2-1 record with a 1.14 ERA in three appearances thus far. The junior lefthander opened the season with back-to-back wins against Birmingham-Southern and UW-Milwaukee before dropping a 4-3 complete-game decision to 19th-ranked Mississippi State. He has fanned 24 batters through 23.2 innings of work thus far, registering his second career double-digit strikeout effort with 10 K's in eight shutout innings versus UWM.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (5-4, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay won its season-opener at Birmingham-Southern but dropped the next two at BSC before going on to claim a four-game sweep of its own Invitational. Last week, APSU went 1-2 at Mississippi State's tournament, including a narrow 4-3 loss to the then-No. 17 Bulldogs...Junior transfer **Cody Youngblood** sat out the Govs' opening weekend but has since become a terror on the basepaths, going 7-for-8 in stolen base attempts through six games...Junior C **Tommy Smith** is 11-for-28 (.393) with six extra-base hits to his credit...Junior OF **Brett Luther** is 13-of-29 (.448) so far, and sports an eight-game hit streak...Starter **Shawn Kelley** is 2-1 on the season, despite allowing opponents to bat .320 against him...Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** opened the '05 campaign with back-to-back wins. He recorded his second career double-digit strikeout game with 10 K's versus UW-Milwaukee and has 24 K's through 23.2 IP thus far...The Govs entertain Indiana State for a twinbill on Tuesday before heading up to Evansville for the Aces' Diamond Classic, where they are scheduled to take on host Evansville, Northern Illinois and Wright State.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (1-6, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois snapped a season-opening six-game losing streak with a 5-4 win over Olivet Nazarene in the nightcap of a March 5 doubleheader that kicked off the home portion of EIU's schedule. ONU won the opener, 8-7, after scoring six runs in the top of the seventh inning...The Panthers opened with a three-game series at Oklahoma and a two-game set at Mississippi State... Sophomore 3B **Ryan Campbell** and junior LF **Keiji Szalo** both homered in Saturday's twinbill and now have two home runs apiece...Sophomore RHP **Chris Vaculik** worked 2 2/3 innings of relief on Saturday, allowing one hit and striking out four batters...The Panthers travel to 19th-ranked Arkansas this weekend for a three-game series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (1-4, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky has struggled in the early going, with a lone 11-5 win over IPFW stacked against losses to Louisville, Bradley and IPFW...Junior OF **Chris O'Dell** leads the Colonels in almost every offensive category, posting a .533 batting average (8-of-15) with two homers, six RBI, a .933 slugging percentage and a .636 on-base percentage...O'Dell has drawn six walks in five games and has hit safely in all six contests with three multi-hit efforts to his credit...After having last weekend's series with Oakland cancelled due to inclement weather and unplayable field conditions, the Colonels will be spending their Spring Break in the Sunshine State, heading down to Bradenton for the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge. EKU will play six games on six consecutive days, with IPFW, Valparaiso, Central Michigan, Bowling Green, UMass and Georgetown on the Colonels' slate.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-7, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State posted season-highs in hits (16), runs (10) and RBI (8) in a 10-4 win over Louisiana-Monroe...In addition to a lone loss to Troy, the Gamecocks have fallen short in a trio of three-game series against ULM, Southeastern Louisiana and Marshall, winning one of the three each time out...Sophomore SS **Jake Ball** is batting a team-high .375 (15-of-40) with four RBI and a home run. He had a six-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday, going 0-for-4 against ULM...Sophomore P **Jon Clements** (0-3, 2.81 ERA) has thrown a team-high 16 innings in four appearances and tops the squad with 16 strikeouts to three walks...JSU hosts Alabama State before traveling to Middle Tennessee for a three-game set.

MOREHEAD STATE (3-7, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State dropped a three-game series at Tennessee over the weekend...**Bo Stohler** went 3-for-6 in the series, including a solo home run in Sunday's 3-2 loss...Junior RHP **Shane Lucci** went the distance on Sunday, surrendering just two earned runs in eight innings of work...The Vols outscored the Eagles, 27-7 in the series as Morehead State went up against UT's projected Southeastern Conference starting rotation, including preseason All-American Luke Hochevar in Friday's 11-0 opener...Morehead State returns home to host Brescia in a single game on Monday and Niagara in a pair of twinbills on Saturday and Sunday.

2005 OVC BASEBALL NOTES

MURRAY STATE (7-4, 0-0 OVC): Murray State saw a four-game win streak snapped on Sunday with an 18-8 loss to Wright State. The Thoroughbreds won both ends of Saturday's doubleheader, however, to take the series...Sophomore C/DH **Jason Payton** is batting .407 with two doubles, a home run and nine RBI thus far, also boasting a 1.077 on-base percentage...Senior RHP **Craig Kraus** (3-0, 0.87 ERA) picked up a complete-game win on opening day. Opponents are hitting .184 against him, and he boasts a 4.67 K/BB ratio with 14 strikeouts to just three walks...2B **Seth Hudson** is hitting .417 with seven runs scored in eight games, while 3B **Alex Stewart** and C **Dustin Hennigar** are batting .324 and .400, respectively...RHP **Billy Fares** (2-1, 2.95 ERA) has tossed two complete games already...LHP **Jon Ross Shelton** is averaging 11.25 K's per nine innings...After ending an eight-game homestand on Sunday, the 'Breds now take to the road, heading over to Arkansas-Little Rock for a two-game series and Akron for a three-game set.

SAMFORD (1-7, 0-0 OVC): Samford kicked off its 2005 campaign under the direction of new head coach **Casey Dunn** with a 5-3 win over Georgia State, but the Bulldogs have lost seven straight since then, dropping a three-game series to Troy, a two-game set to UNC Asheville and single dates with Montevallo and Alabama...Junior LF **Justin Worthington** is currently batting .458 (11-for-24) and leads the team with six runs scored. To date, he has recorded a pair of three-hit outings, versus GSU and UNCA...Sophomore RHP **Joseph Edens** (1-1) has earned the team's lone win so far, compiling a 3.32 ERA and a team-high 20 strikeouts through 19.0 innings of work...The Bulldogs are on the road this week, playing a two-game series at East Tennessee State and a three-game set at Southeastern Louisiana.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-7, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri opened the 2005 campaign against a formidable opponent, dropping three straight contests to then top-ranked Tulane before bouncing back to take two of three from Southeastern Louisiana and a single game from Saint Louis. The Redhawks now find themselves looking to snap a three-game slide after getting swept by Bradley over the weekend...Senior OF **Frank Montiel** is batting .700 with runners in scoring position and leads the team with a .368 batting average, 14 hits, six doubles 11 RBI and a .605 slugging percentage...Freshman P **Joey Evans** (1-0) has appeared in four games and tops the Redhawks' pitching staff with a 3.60 ERA and 16 strikeouts. He is averaging 9.6 strikeouts per nine innings, and opponents are hitting just .154 with runners in scoring position against him...Evans pitched a season-high 5.2 shutout innings versus Bradley...The Redhawks host South Dakota State, Southern Illinois and Freed-Hardeman in a trio of single games this week.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (4-6, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee-Martin has won four of its last six after opening the season 0-4. The Skyhawks took all three from Western Illinois over the weekend to register their first series sweep since 2003...Senior 2B **Nick Bruner** hit .643 against WIU, rapping out two doubles and driving in six runs while collecting 11 total bases. Through 10 games, he is hitting .302 with three doubles and 10 RBI...The Skyhawks won both ends of Saturday's twinbill versus WIU with seventh-inning rallies, then closed out the series by plating 13 runs in the final two frames to claim Sunday's 17-8 win...Pitchers **Adam Ledlow** and **Justin Bryant** each registered complete-game victories in Saturday's doubleheader...Freshman **Zach Dean** scored seven runs over the weekend and had a .583 slugging percentage while going 6-for-12 at the plate...The Skyhawks host Evansville for a pair, then head off to Millington, Tenn., for the USA Challenge, where they are slated to play Indiana State, Connecticut and Arkansas-Little Rock.

TENNESSEE TECH (3-6, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 2-1 in its home tournament over the weekend, winning two straight over Akron and UNC Asheville, before falling in a rematch with the Zips...Senior SS **Brandon Selvog** hit safely in all three games and is batting .343 for the season. He has 12 hits, three doubles, four RBI and six runs scored...Freshman RHP **Michael Alcorn** pitched a 3-0 shutout in his first collegiate start against UNCA, giving up five hits and just one walk...The Golden Eagles visit Georgia for a two-game series, then return home to host UAB for a three-game set.


