OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 1

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

ERIC BECK • C, JR. • ELHORN, NE • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Beck batted .714 with 11 RBI and five runs while helping Jacksonville State to a perfect 4-0 mark last week. A native of Elhorn, Neb., Beck counted a double, a triple and two home runs among his 10 hits, collecting 19 total bases to finish the week with a 1.357 slugging percentage. He also posted a .765 on-base average, earning three free passes (two walks, one hit by pitch) without any strikeouts. On the defensive front, the junior backstop was perfect in 31 chances, recording 30 putouts and an assist.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

ROWDY HARDY • LHP, SR. • BETHEL SPRINGS, TN • AUSTIN PEAY

Hardy became the OVC's all-time wins leader, picking up his 31st career victory with a 7-1 decision Saturday in game one of the Governors' league series with UT Martin. The senior lefthander limited the Skyhawks to six hits and a .176 batting average over nine innings for his fourth complete game of 2006. A native of Bethel Springs, Tenn., Hardy also fanned a season-high 10 batters to become the school's all-time career strikeouts leader with 250.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (27-18, 10-8 OVC): Austin Peay is tied for fourth in the OVC standings after sweeping its three-game series with UT Martin over the weekend...The Govs also split a pair of non-conference outings at Vanderbilt and Belmont...Senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** (8-2, 2.49 ERA) became the OVC's all-time wins leader, collecting his 31st career victory in the series opener against the Skyhawks...Hardy, who struck out a season-high 10 batters to also become the school's career strikeout leader (250), pitched all nine innings to register his fourth complete game of the season...After seeing his 36-game hitting streak come to an end with an 0-for-4 outing at Vanderbilt, senior **Ryan Kane** bounced back with a 4-for-4 effort at Belmont and a home run in the UT Martin series...Freshman 2B **Ryan Gilboy** continues to swing a hot bat, going 4-for-5 with six RBI at Belmont and rapping in a pair of game-winning runs on the week...Junior DH **Jacob Crass** led the Govs' offense with a .471 average (8-for-17) at the plate over the five-game stretch...A reshuffled pitching rotation paid off nicely for the Govs as senior RHP **Brad Daniel** (5-1, 2.25 ERA) moved into the No. 2 spot and picked up the win in Saturday's twinbill nightcap while junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** (3-4, 2.29 ERA) pitched with a lead for the first time in 24.2 innings of work en route to the win on Sunday...APSU takes the week off for final exams before heading up to Eastern Illinois...The EIU series marks the third straight weekend the Govs will have taken on an OVC foe who is tied with them in the standings.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (24-18, 10-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois pushed its win streak to five games with victories over Illinois, Illinois State and Southeast Missouri, but saw the run end with a narrow 4-3 loss to the Redhawks in Sunday's OVC series finale...The Panthers' win over the Illini was their first since 2000, while their victory at ISU was the first since 1997...Junior C **Jason Cobb** batted .421 over the five-game stretch, going 5-for-10 with runners in scoring position and collecting four of his eight RBI with outs on the board...Senior RHP **Kenny Firlit** (3-2, 4.74 ERA) did not allow an earned run while tossing his first career complete game in the middle contest of the Southeast series...Senior OF **Pete Stone** posted a four-RBI game with two doubles against Illinois while junior **Ryan Campbell** rapped out a career-high three doubles and drove in five runs at ISU...Sophomore OF **Mark Chagnon** hit his first career homer in the ISU contest, finishing the week 8-for-17 with a team-high seven runs and five RBI...Chagnon and junior 1B **Erik Huber** (6-for-15, 5 R) drew a combined 11 walks on the week, including three intentional passes...The Panthers did not have an extra-base hit in Saturday's twinbill sweep of Southeast, winning on the strength of 22 singles...Junior closer **Chris Vaculik** (5-6, 4.72 ERA) recorded his team-leading fifth save in game one on Saturday, and now sits one save shy of the school's all-time record of 15...Tied for fourth in the OVC standings, EIU continues its eight-game homestand this week, taking on Saint Louis and league opponent Austin Peay.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (21-19, 10-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky became the first team this season to take an OVC series from league-leading Samford, winning both ends of a doubleheader on Sunday...Earlier in the week, the Colonels dropped a non-conference decision to Marshall...Senior DH **Chris O'Dell** belted his 10th home run of the season to tie the game in Sunday's 7-6 victory in the nightcap...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (7.1, 2.25 ERA) struck out six and scattered five hits en route to the complete-game victory in the opening contest on Sunday...Friedrich, who did not walk a batter for the third consecutive start, is tied for the league's lowest earned run average and also boasts the OVC's best numbers in strikeouts (12.05) and walks (2.25) per nine innings, as well as opponent batting average (.214)...Junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough** has been named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association's Dick Howser Award watch list...Yarbrough is hitting .373 and leads the league in home runs (15), RBI (52), total bases (113) and slugging percentage (.753)...Twelve of senior DH **Chris O'Dell's** 18 extra-base hits have come in Conference play, giving him a league-high .815 slugging percentage against OVC opponents...The third-place Colonels entertain Marshall before heading over to Southeast Missouri for a Conference series.

2006 OVC Baseball Notes

JACKSONVILLE STATE (24-20, 11-7 OVC): Jacksonville State swept Morehead State over the weekend to move into second place in the OVC standings, two games back of league-leading Samford...The Gamecocks also cruised to a non-conference victory over Alabama State...Junior C **Eric Beck** had a monster week at the plate, batting .714 with 10 hits, 11 RBI and five runs scored...Beck is hitting .591 over the last 10 games with five extra-base hits and a 1.045 slugging percentage...Junior OF **Nick Cleckler** extended his hitting streak to a career-high and team season-long 16 games, and is batting .439 with 15 RBI and 11 walks during the stretch...Sophomore RHP **Donovan Hand** (5-4, 2.62 ERA) hurled his best game of the season in the series opener at Morehead, allowing just four hits and a walk while recording 10 strikeouts during a seven-inning start...Hand sports a 3-1 record and 2.21 ERA against Conference opponents, while junior OF **Garrett Bass** is hitting .405 in OVC games, followed by Beck (.383) and junior C **Richard Turner** (.364)...As a team, JSU batted .404 last week with 63 hits, 11 doubles, four triples, five home runs, 46 RBI and a slugging percentage of .622...The Gamecocks have won eight of their last nine contests and take a five-game win streak into this weekend's OVC action at Tennessee Tech.

MOREHEAD STATE (15-25, 6-11 OVC): Morehead State slipped to ninth place in the Conference standings after losing all three games in its OVC series with Jacksonville State over the weekend...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** led the Eagles with a 4-for-10 effort at the plate, collecting a double, a home run, two RBI and three runs scored...Rhodes leads the team with 12 homers and 32 RBI while sporting a .563 slugging percentage, ranking among the league's Top 5 in each of those categories...Junior C **Donald Cheney** is fourth in the OVC in home runs (8) and slugging (.587)...**Henry Mabee** (4-6, 3.53 ERA) saw his streak of innings without giving up an earned run end at 31.1 as the junior righthander was tagged for a two-run homer in the fifth inning of Saturday's game two loss to JSU...Mabee has worked a league-high six complete games, all in Conference play, and boasts the best ERA in OVC action at 1.76...The Eagles' non-conference game at Cincinnati marks their first venture outside league play since April 11...Morehead State also visits Samford for an OVC tilt over the weekend.

MURRAY STATE (13-32, 6-12 OVC): Murray State posted a 1-4 mark last week, dropping a midweek doubleheader to Kentucky before taking one of three from Tennessee Tech in Conference play...Senior RF **Brett Mullins** hit .455 in the Tech series, finishing with a double, a run and an RBI...Mullins, junior 2B/3B **James Akin** and junior CF **Tyler Pittman** each had five hits against the Golden Eagles...Akin homered twice on Saturday, including a grand slam, to finish the weekend with six RBI and a .917 slugging percentage...All three of Akin's career home runs have been hit at Tech's Bush Stadium...Senior RHP **Kalen Gibson** (3-6, 4.12 ERA) closed out the week with a 1.80 ERA in two appearances, working two scoreless frames against his former Wildcat teammates, then tossing eight innings en route to the game one victory at Tech...After a midweek visit to Louisville, 10th-place Murray State plays its final home series of the season in an OVC matchup with UT Martin.

SAMFORD (24-20, 13-5 OVC): League-leading Samford had a tough four-game road swing last week, dropping a non-conference decision at Kennesaw State before losing two of three at Eastern Kentucky...The series loss to the Colonels was the Bulldogs' first in six OVC matchups this season...Sophomore RF **Bear Burnett** went 4-for-9 at EKU, homering once and driving in three runs while scoring five more...Junior LHP **Josh Ehmke** (8-2, 3.16 ERA) improved to 6-0 in league contests, fanning nine batters en route to the win in the series opener at EKU...Ehmke ranks first in the Conference in strikeouts (96) and is also tied for the lead in wins (8) and starts (12)...Junior closer **Joseph Edens** has tallied a league-best eight saves in 16 appearances this season...Junior 3B **Parker Gargis** leads the team with a .392 batting average, third-best in the OVC...In addition to an OVC tilt versus Morehead State, the Bulldogs will make up a non-conference contest at Birmingham-Southern...The BSC game was originally set to be played on April 19, but was postponed due to heavy rain.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (16-26, 7-11 OVC): Southeast Missouri saw its losing streak stretch to five games with setbacks to Kansas, Missouri and Eastern Illinois before ending the skid with a one-run victory over EIU in Sunday's OVC series finale...The meetings with KU and Mizzou were part of the Best of the Midwest Tournament, played in Kansas City, Kan...Southeast is 0-7 all-time against KU...The meeting with Missouri was the Redhawks' third of the season and they finish with a 2-1 record against the Tigers...Junior RHP **Josh Parham** (1-2, 4.35 ERA) registered his first win of the season, working 5.0 hitless, scoreless innings of relief on Sunday...Parham has made 21 appearances in 2006, tying for third in the Conference...Senior **Anthony Maupin** (5-4, 4.96 ERA) worked his fifth complete game of the season Saturday in game two of the EIU series, which marked the first time since March 25 the Redhawks had lost the back end of a doubleheader...Junior 2B **Omar Padilla** ranks among league leaders with 14 doubles, 10 of which have come in OVC play...Currently tied for seventh, Southeast has not won a Conference series since sweeping Murray State a month ago...The Redhawks play a four-game homestand this week, taking on Arkansas State and OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

UT MARTIN (17-27, 7-11 OVC): UT Martin found runs hard to come by last week...After opening up a four-game road swing with a 1-0 non-conference victory at Mississippi Valley State, the Skyhawks were outscored 18-8 in a trio of OVC losses at Austin Peay...Senior LHP **Derek Link** pitched a three-hit gem and struck out six at MVSU, working all nine innings to pick up his first win of the season...Junior SS **Lance Renton** went 3-for-4 in the MVSU contest, hitting a solo home run in the eighth inning to lift the Skyhawks to victory...UT Martin batted .213 as a team last week...Senior C/DH **Brett Spivy** led the way, hitting .400 with four RBI and a .733 slugging percentage...Spivy counted two doubles and a home run among his six hits, moving him into ninth and fourth place, respectively, on the school's charts for career doubles (28) and homers (16)...Senior closer **Chadwick Cameron** (3-2, 5 saves, 3.86 ERA) is tied for fifth in the league with 20 appearances this season...Tied for seventh in the OVC, the Skyhawks play one of their remaining four home contests this week, hosting Belmont before heading back out on the road for a Conference trip to Murray State.

TENNESSEE TECH (16-29, 9-9 OVC): Tennessee Tech improved to .500 in OVC play, taking two of three from Murray State over the weekend...Earlier in the week, the Golden Eagles fell to in-state rival Middle Tennessee...Sophomore OF **Scott Dunham** belted his first collegiate home run as part of a 6-for-10 effort at the plate against Murray State...Dunham finished the series with six hits, four RBI and five runs scored...Junior **Steve Soper** also turned in a strong offensive performance, batting .400 with two doubles, two homers and nine RBI...Soper's .500 slugging percentage is tied for ninth in the OVC while his 85 total bases ranks fifth...Freshman **Stuart Meinhart** has quickly established himself as the Golden Eagles' top two-bag threat, ranking among league leaders with 11 doubles thus far...Junior **Zac Cole** (2-3, 3.86 ERA) is limiting opponents to a .231 batting average, second-lowest in the league...Sixth-place Tech has the week off before visiting Jacksonville State for an OVC matchup.
