PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

CODY YOUNGBLOOD • OF, SR. • PLAINWELL, MI • AUSTIN PEAY

Youngblood batted .647 (11-for-17) from the leadoff position while helping Austin Peay to a 3-1 record last week, including a three-game OVC series sweep of Murray State. The senior outfielder had three hits in each outing against the 'Breds, finishing the weekend with a .750 batting average, a homer, a triple and seven runs scored. For the week, the Plainwell, Mich., native drove in three runs and scored eight times while posting slugging and on-base percentages of .941 and .667, respectively.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

DAVID KNAPP • RHP, FR. • MARIETTA, GA • SAMFORD

Knapp tossed a one-hit gem to pick up his first career complete-game shutout in Samford's 5-0 victory at Tennessee Tech on Sunday. The freshman righthander struck out a career-high 11 batters and issued just three walks over nine innings in his longest outing of the season. A native of Marietta, Ga., Knapp limited Tech batters to a .036 average on the day, surrendering a lone two-out single in the sixth.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (30-22, 13-11 OVC): Austin Peay saw its losing streak reach four games with a midweek loss to Lipscomb, but the Govs put an end to the slide with a three-game sweep of league opponent Murray State, assuring the Govs of their eighth straight O'Reilly OVC Tournament appearance...APSU has reached the 30-win plateau for the third consecutive season and sixth of the last seven...Senior OF **Cody Youngblood** broke out of an 11-game hitting slump (.190) with a .647 average over the four-game stretch, including going 9-for-12 against the 'Breds...Youngblood scored eight of the team's 24 runs during the week, slugging .941 and posting a .667 on-base percentage...Junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** tossed a complete-game, two-hit performance in game two on Saturday, recording six strikeouts...Freshman **Ryan Gilboy** went 7-of-16 during the week with a home run and three RBI and now leads the Govs in batting average (.360) and RBI (45)...Senior **Matt Ledbetter** returned to action for the first time since March 28, going 3-for-10 with a team-high five RBI in the Murray State series...Ledbetter was also hit by a pitch twice in Saturday's first game, giving him 33 career HBP and tying him with Joe Lancaster (1997-00) for the school's all-time record...The fifth-place Govs host Evansville on Tuesday to close out the home portion of their 2006 schedule, then finish the regular-season with a three-game series at Eastern Kentucky.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (28-21, 14-10 OVC): Eastern Illinois clinched an OVC tournament berth, despite losing its Conference series at Eastern Kentucky, 2-1...The Panthers won an 11-4 decision in the series opener, then dropped two straight to the Colonels...Freshman CF **Brett Nommensen** batted .432 for the series, beginning with three hits and a career-high four runs in the opener...Junior 3B/C **Ryan Campbell** also went 6-for-13 for the series, while junior 1B **Erik Huber** had a team-high four RBI...Junior RHP **Mike Budde** (4-1, 4.18 ERA) pitched 4.2 strong innings of relief to pick up the game one win, limiting the league's top slugging team to just two singles while striking out five...Senior RHP **Kenny Firlit** (4-3, 4.50 ERA) enjoyed his best outing on the road this season but was the hard-luck loser in game two, allowing two runs and six hits over 4.1 innings...The Panthers pounded out 16 hits in game one as sophomore OF **Mark Chagnon** registered the first five-hit game of his career, collecting three extra-base hits while driving in three runs...Junior SS **Adam Varrassi** sat out the series finale due to the flu...Heading into last weekend, Varrassi was the only Panther to have started every game at the same position this season...Fourth-place EIU visits Bradley in its final non-conference tilt before wrapping up the regular season at home against Morehead State.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (25-22, 14-9 OVC): Eastern Kentucky climbed into third place in the league standings with a 2-1 series win over Eastern Illinois...After losing game one, the Colonels bounced back to take the final two outings...Senior LF **Brett Bolger** went 3-for-3 and scored both EKV runs in the 2-1 game two victory, finishing the series with a 7-for-12 showing at the plate (.583) and a .615 on-base percentage...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (9-1, 2.09 ERA) carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning of Saturday's twinbill nightcap before wrapping up the complete-game victory with two hits allowed...Friedrich, who fanned 10 batters for the second consecutive game, currently leads the league and ranks fourth nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (12.39)...Junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough** extended his hitting streak to six games, homering twice while finishing 4-for-11 with three RBI in the series...Yarbrough leads the league and ranks among NCAA leaders in home runs (17) and runs batted in (59)...Senior DH **Chris O'Dell** also played long ball, belting two homers and slugging 1.250 as part of a 4-for-8, three-RBI effort in the series...Already assured of a berth in the upcoming OVC tournament, the Colonels close out the regular season at home, hosting in-state rival Western Kentucky before entertaining OVC opponent Austin Peay.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (29-21, 16-8 OVC): Jacksonville State moved into second place and secured an OVC tournament berth with a three-game sweep of UT Martin...Junior OF **Nick Cleckler** batted .643 for the series, including going 6-for-6 effort in the series finale, tying JSU and OVC records for most hits in a game...Cleckler, who has tallied hits in each of his last seven at-bats, boasts the league's second-longest hit streak

of the season (currently 22 games), batting .452 with 21 RBI, five doubles, four triples and a home run during that span...Sophomore RHP **Donovan Hand** (7-4, 2.13 ERA) enjoyed his third straight scoreless outing, working the first eight frames of JSU's 7-0 game one victory on Saturday...Hand, who has not allowed a run in 23 consecutive innings, is 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA and 38 strikeouts in his last six starts...Over the last 26 games, junior 3B/SS **Jake Ball** has raised his average from .159 to .285...JSU batted .320 at UT Martin, outscoring the Skyhawks 23-3 while charting 33 hits, five doubles and four homers...Meanwhile, the Gamecock pitching staff posted a 0.69 ERA over the three games, recording 16 strikeouts to just four walks...Junior DH **Garrett Bass** is hitting a team-high .381 in league play...JSU visits Kennesaw State in its final non-conference outing of 2006 before returning home to end the regular-season against Murray State.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-32, 8-15 OVC): Morehead State moved into eighth place with 2-1 series win against Southeast Missouri...The Eagles snapped a 10-game losing streak with a twinbill sweep of the Redhawks on Saturday before losing Sunday's series finale...Earlier in the week, the Eagles dropped a non-conference decision to Marshall...Junior C **Donald Cheney** racked up 16 total bases and a slugging percentage of 1.455 over the four-game stretch, belting four homers while driving in seven runs and scoring six more...A switch-hitter, Cheney homered from both sides of the plate in Sunday's series finale against Southeast, marking the second time this season he had accomplished that feat...Junior RHP **Henry Mabee** (5-7, 3.56 ERA) picked up a save and a win Saturday's doubleheader, closing out the opener with 1.2 scoreless innings before tossing a six-hit, complete-game shutout in the nightcap...Mabee fanned nine batters and walked only three in his two appearances...Junior 3B **Ryan Kinder** rapped out six hits in 15 at-bats (.400) on the week...Six Eagle seniors (**Reid Kittleson, Dan Klausmeier, Shane Lucci, Paul Rhodes, Rob Saunders and Greg Wood**) were honored between games on Saturday... One of five squads battling for the final spot in the six-team OVC tournament field, Morehead State wraps up the regular season on the road, visiting non-conference foe Louisville and OVC opponent Eastern Illinois.

MURRAY STATE (15-37, 8-16 OVC): Murray State slipped into a tie for ninth place in the league standings after dropping all three of its OVC games to Austin Peay...The 'Breds had early 3-0 leads in games one and three but could not hang on as they saw their losing skid extend to four games...Junior C **Jason Payton** helped the Thoroughbreds with a .444 batting average (4-for-9), one homer, three RBI and three runs scored...Payton also registered three walks with no strikeouts for an on-base percentage of .583...Senior DH **Chaz Ebert** went 5-for-10 over the three-game stretch...Outside of Ebert and Payton, the rest of the Murray State offense struggled, managing just six hits in 71 at-bats (.085)...Junior 2B **Seth Hudson** and Payton extending their hit streaks to seven and four games, respectively...Sophomore RHP **Michel Perconte** (4-6, 4.24 ERA) struck out six batters and walked no one in the nightcap of Saturday's doubleheader but was tagged with the complete-game loss, giving up nine hits and only one earned run over six innings...One of five teams fighting for the final OVC tournament berth, Murray State closes out the regular season at Jacksonville State.

SAMFORD (30-22, 19-5 OVC): Samford clinched at least a share of the 2006 OVC regular-season title and the top seed for the upcoming OVC tournament with a three-game sweep of Tennessee Tech...Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs lost a non-conference outing at Georgia State...Junior 3B **Parker Gargis** went 6-for-12 at Tech over the weekend, collecting a double, a home run and four RBI while pushing his hitting streak to five games...Gargis leads the league with a .397 batting average and 16 multiple-RBI games this season...Freshman RHP **David Knapp** (6-4, 3.50 ERA) pitched a one-hit gem in Sunday's 5-0 victory, striking out a career-high 11 batters and walking only three while registering his first career complete-game shutout in a season-long nine-inning stint...Junior 1B **Garrett Rice's** current 11-game hitting streak is the longest on the team this season...The Bulldogs' No. 1 seed for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament marks the first time since 1991 they will be the top seed in a conference tournament...Samford will be looking to claim the OVC regular-season title outright when UT Martin visits this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (18-30, 9-15 OVC): Southeast Missouri finds itself in seventh place in the OVC standings after going 1-2 in its weekend series at Morehead State...After losing both ends of a Saturday doubleheader, the Redhawks salvaged the series with a 13-7 victory in Sunday's finale...Junior 2B **Omar Padilla** extended his hitting streak to six games, registering at least two hits in each contest...Padilla, who leads the team with 18 multi-hit efforts this season, went 7-for-13 with one double, one homer, two RBI and three runs...The Redhawks recorded a season-high six stolen bases in Sunday's contest, including three by senior OF **Chris Gibson**...Southeast also collected season-highs of 12 RBI and 12 walks while matching a season-best 13 runs en route to the 13-7 victory...Senior SS **Jordan Payne** is the only Redhawk to homer twice in a game this season after belting two long balls in game one...Southeast has lost the services of senior **Andrew Johnson**, who received his undergraduate degree and has accepted a full-time position with Excel...Johnson, who became the Redhawks' designated hitter after shoulder injuries ended his pitching career, was batting .309 with six home runs this season...Senior RHP **Jamie McAlister** (4-10, 4.32 ERA) has set a school record for career losses (17) and tied a school mark for single-season losses (10)...The seventh-place Redhawks, who remain in the hunt for the final OVC tournament berth, close out the regular season at home, hosting Evansville in non-conference play before entertaining Tennessee Tech.

UT MARTIN (19-32, 8-16 OVC): UT Martin slipped into a two-way tie for ninth place after losing all three of its OVC games to Jacksonville State over the weekend...Runs were hard to come by for the Skyhawks, who were outscored 23-3...Junior SS **Lance Renton** led the team with a 5-for-10 effort at the plate, while senior C/DH **Brett Spivy** had a double and a home run in the series to drive in two of the Skyhawks' three runs...Spivy has taken over sole possession of fourth place on the school's all-time home run list (17) and is also ranked sixth in career doubles (30)...Spivy, who is second on the team with 25 RBI this season, has driven in 87 runs over the course of his career, putting him three shy of breaking into the program's Top 10...The Skyhawk defense picked off three baserunners over the weekend, bringing its total to 18 on the season...One of five teams battling for the final spot in the OVC tournament field, UT Martin closes out the regular season on the road, visiting non-conference foe Mississippi State before traveling to Alabama to take on league-leading Samford.

TENNESSEE TECH (17-34, 10-14 OVC): Tennessee Tech lost all three of its league games with Samford over the weekend, dropping the Golden Eagles into sixth place...Senior OF **Kyle Rowekamp** went 5-for-10 against the Bulldogs, homering once while driving in a pair of runs and scoring two more...Sophomore **Jake New**, who boasts a current nine-game hitting streak, leads the squad with a .308 batting average, 56 hits and 13 doubles...Sophomore 2B **Matt Mihoci** is the only Golden Eagle to play in all 51 games this season...Mihoci had a team-high 12-game hitting streak earlier in the year and is now batting .286 with 25 RBI...After wrapping up the home portion of its schedule with a non-conference tilt versus Lipscomb, Tech ends the regular season with a crucial trip to Southeast Missouri, the Golden Eagles' key foe in the fight for the remaining OVC tourney berth.
