## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 16

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

**JACOB SCHROEDER • 3B, JR. • LOUISVILLE, KY • AUSTIN PEAY**

Schroeder batted .421 (8-for-19) from the number seven and eight spots last week, driving in 10 runs and scoring four more while helping Austin Peay to a 4-1 effort, including an OVC series win against Eastern Kentucky. Four of the junior third baseman's hits went for extra bases, highlighted by a trio of homers that accounted for eight of his 10 RBI. The Louisville, Ky., native ripped three-run blasts against Evansville and ECU, and a two-run shot versus Belmont.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

**BRIAN LONG • RHP, SO. • FRANKFORT, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS**

Making only his fourth start of the season, Long threw a four-hit shut-out in game one of Sunday's OVC twinbill with Morehead State. A native of Frankfort, Ill., Long struck out a career-high 10 batters and walked one while working all seven innings to pick up the 2-0 victory. The contest marked the sophomore righthander's second straight complete-game effort.

## AROUND THE DIAMOND...

**AUSTIN PEAY (35-17, 16-8 OVC):** Austin Peay moved into a tie for first place in the Conference standings at 16-8 (35-17 overall) with a 2-1 series win over Eastern Kentucky. The Govs also picked up a pair of midweek victories over Evansville and Belmont while closing out the home portion of their 2005 schedule...Junior 3B **Jacob Schroeder** batted .421 with three homers and 10 RBI for the week. Eight of the runs he drove in came courtesy of the long ball as he ripped three-run blasts against Evansville and ECU, and a two-run shot versus Belmont...Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** became the first OVC hurler to reach the 10-win plateau this season, working his sixth complete game of the year in game one of the ECU series. He is the first APSU hurler to record two 10-win seasons during a career and is believed to be just the third player in Conference history to achieve the feat...Senior 2B **Jake Peterson** extended his hit streak to 20 games before seeing it snapped in game two of the ECU series. During that stretch, he batted .466 (34-of-73) with 11 RBI and 15 runs scored, boosting his average from .289 to .363...Senior SS **Jared Walker** takes over the team's active hitting streak lead with a seven-game run, batting .379 (11-of-29) with eight RBI and eight runs over that period...After a mid-week visit to Western Kentucky, APSU visits OVC co-leader Jacksonville State for a "winner takes all" series in the final weekend of regular-season play.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (15-37, 12-12 OVC):** Eastern Illinois dropped a pair of midweek contests to IPFW and Saint Louis, but kept alive its hopes for an OVC tournament berth with a three-game sweep of then league-leader Morehead State...The Panthers are 12-12 (15-37 overall) in OVC play and tied for sixth in the standings...Junior 1B **Chad Watson** more than doubled his RBI production for the season, driving in nine runs while hitting .600 (12-for-20) for the week. He hit a two-run homer in game three of the Morehead State series, finishing with slugging and on-base percentages of 1.000 and .591, respectively...In only his fourth start of the season, sophomore RHP **Brian Long** threw a four-hit shutout on Sunday against the Eagles, striking out a career-high 10 batters while working all seven innings of game two for his second straight complete-game outing...The Panthers made the most of their extra-base hits last week, scoring 42 runs off eight homers, 14 doubles and one triple...Head coach **Jim Schmitz** has 297 career wins, two shy of the school record...The Panthers play host to Bradley on Tuesday, then close out the regular season at home against OVC foe Tennessee Tech.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (21-27, 12-11 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky lost in-state matchups with Kentucky and Western Kentucky, then dropped two OVC contests to Austin Peay before halting the six-game slide with a 16-13, 10-inning victory in the series finale. The Colonels are 12-11 in league play (21-27 overall) and find themselves holding on to the number five spot in the OVC standings...Junior DH/OF **Chris O'Dell** went 4-for-6 in Sunday's slugfest at APSU, driving in a career-high seven runs and scoring four more. Three of his four hits went for extra bases, while his two-out single in the 10th kept the Colonels alive and led to a four-run inning...Senior OF **Bryan Stevenson** extended his hitting streak to a season-long 18 games... ECU's pitching staff combined for a season-high 11 strikeouts in Sunday's win, including seven by starter **Nick Barte**...The Colonels visit Cincinnati on Tuesday before returning home to wrap up the regular season against OVC rival Morehead State.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (28-23, 16-8 OVC):** Jacksonville State split a home-and-home series with UAB, then took two of three from Murray State to pull into a two-way tie for the OVC lead at 16-8 (23-23 overall)...Seven JSU players hit .313 or better in the series, including sophomore SS **Jake Ball**, who is riding a team-high, 13-game hitting streak after going 11-for-20 (.550) and driving in six runs...Junior OF **Jason Horn** had a team-high seven RBI as part of an 8-for-16 effort at the plate, while senior 3B **Clint Carroll** rapped four doubles and hit .421...The Gamecocks close out the regular season with a four-game homestand, hosting Troy on Tuesday before squaring off against OVC co-leader Austin Peay for the regular-season title.

**MOREHEAD STATE (27-24, 14-9 OVC):** Morehead State picked up a non-conference win over Marshall on Wednesday, but tumbled from first to third place in the OVC standings at 14-9 (27-24 overall) after losing all three of its outings at Eastern Illinois...The Eagles trailed in all but four innings and held only one lead during the four-game stretch, when sophomore C **Donald Cheney** singled in the winning run in the bottom of ninth against Marshall...The win over the Thundering Herd capped off a 10-run rally staged by the Eagles after Marshall jumped out to a 9-0 lead...Senior 2B **Lance Seabor** hit .533 last week with five runs scored, two home runs, four RBI, a slugging percentage of 1.067 and an on-base percentage of .588. He is within two hits of the school's single-season record (83) and within 12 hits of the program's career mark (248). He is also only one run shy of the school career record of 163... Cheney and senior CF **Kevin Bryant** both hit .500 last week, with Cheney belting two home runs and the game-winning single versus Marshall...Junior RHP **Shane Lucci** was the tough-luck loser when EIU's Brian Long pitched the 2-0 shut-out over the Eagles in the first game of Sunday's twinbill. Lucci has not given up more than three total runs or two earned runs in a start since March 15...The Eagles close out the regular-season at OVC rival Eastern Kentucky.

# 2005 OVC Baseball Notes

**MURRAY STATE (25-27, 13-11 OVC):** Murray State remains in fourth place after taking one of three from Jacksonville State in OVC action...Junior DH **Chaz Ebert** went 6-for-10 in the series, driving in two runs and scoring twice... Junior C **Brett Wilson** finally got off his offensive skid, going 3-for-6 in two games against the Gamecocks...Junior RF **Brett Mullins** maintained his team-high on-base percentage (.541) with a .636 effort over the weekend, getting on base seven times in 11 plate appearances...Senior 1B **Clint Griggs** pushed his hitting streak to a season-high eight games with a 4-for-10 effort at the plate...Murray State wrapped up its home schedule with a 17-14 overall mark, 8-7 in Conference play...At 25-27 (13-11 in OVC action), the 'Breds have already eclipsed last year's overall win total of 17...Murray State visits Samford for the final weekend of league play, and for the second straight year, the series has tournament implications for the 'Breds.

**SAMFORD (19-34, 12-12 OVC):** Samford is in a three-way tie for sixth place at 12-12 in the OVC standings after taking two of three from UT Martin over the weekend...The Bulldogs also dropped a home-and-home series with Birmingham-Southern to move to 19-34 overall...Junior 2B **Trey Moody** batted .500 in five outings last week, including going 6-for-10 with three RBI in the UT Martin series...Junior RHP **Stephen Artz** threw a five-hit, complete-game shutout in the Bulldogs' 8-0 game two win against the Skyhawks, marking the first time this season the Samford pitching staff has held an opponent scoreless...Artz has gone the distance in six straight appearances (all seven-inning contests) and leads the league with seven complete games overall...The Bulldogs take the week off to concentrate on final exams before closing out the regular season at home with an OVC series against Murray State.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (21-28, 12-12 OVC):** Southeast Missouri staged a three-game sweep of OVC foe Tennessee Tech to move into a three-way tie for sixth place at 12-12 (21-28 overall) in the Conference standings...Senior 3B **Eric Horstman** led the Redhawks' offense with a .583 effort (7-for-12) over the weekend, scoring a team-high 11 runs and driving in nine more from the leadoff spot while slugging 1.077 and posting an on-base percentage of .706. He is currently riding a career-tying 19-game hitting streak, and has reached base safely in 41-straight games, which is believed to be the longest active run in the nation...Junior P **Jamie McAlister** made his team-high 24th appearance and only his fourth start of the season in game two at Tech. He worked five innings before action was suspended due to rain, then pitched a perfect frame when play resumed on Sunday to claim the 10-1 win, giving up one run on three hits...The Redhawks tallied season-highs with 20 runs on 21 hits in the series opener and finished the week batting .429 as a team. Southeast has scored 10 or more times in each of its last four outings, averaging 15.5 runs per game... Senior C **Brady Noll** batted .462 with five RBI, while senior 2B **Bo Jenkins** hit .455 and extended his hitting streak to 10 games...Senior 1B/DH **Freddy Lopez** homered twice in one game for the second time this season, ending the week with nine RBI and a .438 batting average...The Redhawks take a four-game win streak into final regular-season action, playing a two-game series at SMS before returning home to close out Conference play against Tennessee-Martin.

**TENNESSEE-MARTIN (12-38, 6-17 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin saw their hopes for postseason play dashed as the Skyhawks went 1-2 in an OVC series with Samford. Earlier in the week, UT Martin also lost a 7-3 decision to Memphis to fall to 12-38 overall (6-17 in the OVC)...In the series opener, senior **Nick Bruner** singled in **Zach Dean** to lift the Skyhawks to a 7-6, come-from-behind victory. The win improved UT Martin's record in one-run games to 7-5 on the season... Bruner has moved into a tie for eighth place on the school's Top 10 list for most at-bats with 188...Youth was served last week as the squad's freshmen took over at the plate. First-year players **Dean (.429)**, **Blake Turner (.357)** and **Chris Rezabek (.333)** each hit better than .300 for the week. As a team, the Skyhawks batted .252...Bruner and Dean extended their hitting streaks to nine games apiece while teaming up with Bruner to reach base successfully in all four games. ...Skipper **Bubba Cates** is two wins away from recording his 100th victory as head coach of the Skyhawks...Tennessee-Martin closes out the 2005 campaign on the road, playing a midweek doubleheader at Mississippi State before finishing off OVC action at Southeast Missouri.

**TENNESSEE TECH (12-39, 5-18 OVC):** Tennessee Tech also saw its plans for any postseason play come to a halt as the Golden Eagles were swept in OVC action for the third straight week. Earlier in the week, Tech won a 6-5 decision over East Tennessee State in non-conference play and now sits at 12-39 overall (5-18 in OVC)...Senior 1B **Nathan Marty** registered his first four-hit effort of the season in the series finale against Southeast, going 4-for-5 with two RBI... Freshman 3B **Clint Alexander** hit safely in all four contests to push his hitting streak to a season-long eight games...Tech wraps up the 2005 schedule on the road, visiting Kentucky and OVC opponent Eastern Illinois.

**2005 O'REILLY OVC TOURNAMENT:** The 2005 O'Reilly OVC Tournament will be held Wednesday, May 25 through Saturday, May 28 at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.
