OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK -MAY 2

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

BRYAN STEVENSON • OF, SR. • COVINGTON, KY • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Stevenson hit .583 (7-of-12) and posted a 1.083 slugging percentage with 13 total bases last week to lead the Colonels to a 4-0 effort, including a three-game sweep of OVC foe Southeast Missouri. The senior outfielder enjoyed multi-hit performances in three of the four contests, including a 2-for-3, five-RBI outing in the series finale versus the Redhawks. For the week, the Covington, Ky., native had a .643 on-base percentage and went 2-for-3 in stolen base attempts with six RBI and five runs scored. He also posted a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage on 11 chances in right field.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

NICK BARTE • RHP, JR. • GRANDVIEW, OH • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Barte threw his first career complete game with a four-hit outing en route to picking up the win against Southeast Missouri in game two of Sunday's OVC doubleheader, allowing just one run while matching his career-high with eight strikeouts. A native of Grandview, Ohio, Barte blanked the Redhawks for the first 4.1 innings of the game to push his scoreless innings streak to 12.2 frames. The junior righthander surrendered just one walk while limiting Southeast hitters to a .160 average.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (29-15, 12-6 OVC): Austin Peay extended its winning streak to nine games with a midweek victory over Western Kentucky and a 5-2 triumph in Saturday's OVC series opener versus Eastern Illinois, but saw the run come to an end on Sunday as the Govs split their final two games with the Panthers. ...APSU has won seven of its last eight games and is tied for second in the Conference standings at 12-6 (29-15 overall)...Senior 1B **Chris Hyde** led the Govs with a .583 batting average last week, going 7-for-12 with four RBI, including three doubles and a homer to post a 1.083 slugging percentage... Senior **Jared Walker** continues to flirt with .400, going 8-for-16 in the four games to give him a .399 average for the season...Junior RHP **Brad Daniel** went 1-1 and recorded a save in three appearances...Senior LHP **Devin Thomas** picked up Sunday's win against EIU after allowing two runs on eight hits and no walks in six innings...Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** became the fifth Govs pitcher to record 20 career wins with his eight-inning victory on Saturday...APSU finished its 36-day, 23-game tour of the Volunteer State with an 18-5 mark, and will take the next five days off to concentrate on finals before resuming OVC play at Murray State. The Govs' trip to Murray will be their first outside Tennessee since visiting Morehead State on March 25-26.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (10-33, 7-11 OVC): Eastern Illinois saw its eight-game losing skid end with a 3-2 victory over Austin Peay in the opener of Sunday's OVC twinbill, but that was the Panthers' lone win of the series as EIU lost the last two games to move to 7-11 in Conference play (10-33 overall)...Earlier in the week, the Panthers dropped meetings with in-state opponents Illinois and Illinois State...Sophomore OF **Jason Cobb** continued his consistent work at the plate, going 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI. He has now hit six homers and driven in 25 runs on the season...Tied for sixth in the OVC standings, the Panthers return home for a four-game stand at Coaches Stadium, playing a mid-week outing with Saint Xavier and a league series against Eastern Kentucky.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (19-21, 10-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky extended its win streak to nine games with a 4-0 effort last week, including a three-game sweep of OVC foe Southeast Missouri...The Colonels have won six straight in Conference play and are ranked fifth in the league standings at 10-7 (19-21 overall)...EKU also won a 4-3 midweek decision over Wright State...Senior OF **Bryan Stevenson** pushed his hitting streak to 10 games, going 7-for-12 (.583) at the plate and racking up 13 total bases while posting a 1.083 slugging percentage last week. He drove in the first five Colonel runs of Sunday's 12-11 victory in the twinbill opener, including three off his team-leading sixth home run of the season. Stevenson tops the Colonels with 21 multi-hit and 11 multi-RBI games...Junior RHP **Nick Barte** blanked the Redhawks for the first 4.1 innings of Sunday's 3-1 series finale win, extending his streak of scoreless innings to 12.2 frames before surrendering a run en route to recording his first career complete game. He gave up just four hits and one walk while matching a career-high with eight strikeouts in the contest...The Colonels take the next five days off before traveling to Eastern Illinois for an OVC showdown.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (21-20, 12-6 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a 13-7 midweek decision to Birmingham-Southern, then reeled off three straight victories to complete an OVC series sweep against Tennessee Tech. At 12-6 in league action (21-20 overall), the Gamecocks are tied for second place, a game and a half back of Conference leader Morehead State...Senior OF **Austin Stein** launched a pair of three-run homers to help the Gamecocks' cause in Sunday's 14-3 win at Tech. He finished the week with eight RBI, 13 total bases and a slugging percentage of 1.000 while going 5-for-13 (.385) at the plate...Sophomore P **Jon Clements** picked up his third win of the season in his fourth complete game, working the nightcap of Saturday's 12-2 game two victory. He fanned eight batters while giving up two runs on five hits with no walks and only two extra-base hits...JSU outscored Tech 35-7 while sweeping the Golden Eagles for the second straight year...Freshman OF **Brian Piazza** extended his hitting streak to a conference-best 16 games, tying the school record held by Stein...The Gamecocks play a five-game homestand this week, beginning with midweek outings versus Samford and Birmingham-Southern and ending with an OVC series against Tennessee-Martin. Tuesday's meeting with Samford will not count in the league standings.

MOREHEAD STATE (25-18, 13-4 OVC): Morehead State retained its spot atop the OVC standings by going 2-1 in its series with Samford over the weekend and now sports a 13-4 mark in Conference play (25-18 overall)...Sophomore C **Donald Cheney** was an iron man behind the plate, working all 25 innings of the Samford series while going 5-for-10 with his bat, scoring four times and driving in two runs with three extra-base hits...Senior RHP **Adrian Duran** allowed just one run off four hits in nine innings for the complete-game win in Game 1 on Saturday. He struck out seven batters and held the Bulldogs to a .133 average...Senior 1B **Bryan Ingram**, junior DH **Paul Rhodes** and senior

2B **Lance Seasor** are tied for the team lead in home runs with 12 dingers each...The Eagles have 117 doubles on the season, three shy of the school record. Ingram leads the team with 16 two-baggers...It was Baseball Alumni Weekend at Morehead State as the team retired its first two baseball jerseys, honoring former coaches John E. "Sonny" Allen and Steve Hamilton as well as the 1973 OVC Championship team...The Eagles visit Louisville on Wednesday and OVC foe Southeast Missouri over the weekend.

MURRAY STATE (23-22, 11-7 OVC): Murray State took two of three from Tennessee-Martin in OVC action over the weekend and now sits in fourth place at 11-7 in Conference play (23-22 overall). The Thoroughbreds also dropped a midweek decision to Louisville...Junior RF **Brett Mullins** scored the game-winning run on a ninth-inning suicide squeeze in Saturday's 4-3 victory at UT Martin. He finished the series with a .429 effort at the plate (3-for-7)...Senior LHP **Jon Ross Shelton** won his first start since Feb. 27 in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader against the Skyhawks, allowing one earned run on seven hits with five strikeouts in six-plus innings...'Breds hurlers recorded a pair of three-hit outings last week, but both came in losing efforts (6-3 at Louisville and 4-2 at UT Martin)...Junior DH **Chaz Ebert** led 'Breds batters with a 7-for-17 week at the plate (.412)...Junior RHP **Billy Fares** won the series opener at UT Martin in relief, holding the Skyhawks hitless in 2.2 innings...After visiting No. 21/25 Ole Miss, the 'Breds return home to entertain Austin Peay in OVC action...Murray State is 1-1 thus far this season in meetings with Top 25 teams.

SAMFORD (14-30, 7-11 OVC): Samford struggled to a 1-4 effort last week, dropping midweek decisions to Auburn and Georgia State and taking one of three from OVC foe Morehead State...Freshman OF **Bear Burnett** batted .313 (5-for-16) for the week, finishing off with a home run and three RBI in Sunday's 6-4 loss to the Eagles...Junior RHP **Scott Fowler** was the hard-luck loser in Wednesday's 1-0 pitcher's duel, giving a lone unearned run on an eighth-inning error. He struck out five and allowed only three hits through seven innings of work...The Bulldogs' Tuesday visit to in-state rival and fellow OVC member Jacksonville State will be a non-conference contest...Tied for sixth in the OVC, Samford also plays host to Tennessee Tech for a weekend league series.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (16-26, 7-11 OVC): Southeast Missouri finds itself tied for sixth in the OVC standings at 7-11 (16-26 overall) after going 0-3 in its Conference series at Eastern Kentucky. The Redhawks also lost a midweek decision to Southern Illinois...Senior 3B **Eric Horstman** pushed his hitting streak to 12 games and collected his team-high ninth stolen base of the season, going 7-for-16 (.438) at the plate and scoring a team-best seven runs...Junior C **Levi Olson** belted his first career homer in the SIU contest and led the team with four RBI for the week...Freshman RHP **Joey Evans** posted a 2.25 ERA and struck out five batters in eight innings of work...The Redhawks return home for four games, playing host to Evansville and OVC leader Morehead State.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (9-32, 4-13 OVC): Tennessee-Martin dropped a mid-week decision to Belmont and its first two of an OVC series with Murray State, but snapped a nine-game losing streak with Sunday's 4-2 win over the Thoroughbreds...The Skyhawks are 9-32 overall and 4-13 in Conference play...Junior SS **Jason Moore** hit .571 in the Murray State series with a double, three runs, three walks and two stolen bases...Two of the Skyhawks' losses last week were by one run each, giving them a 5-5 record this season in one-run decisions...Senior **Brett Hall** is most likely lost for the season after shattering a bone in his thumb while sliding into third base in Saturday's twinbill opener...Junior 2B **Hideaki Sato** did not play in the Murray State series because of a pulled hamstring he suffered in the Belmont game. Sato is hitting .243 and leads the team with eight stolen bases...Junior LHP **Micky Dobson** made an appearance in all three games versus the 'Breds, picking up his second save of the year in Sunday's win. Overall, he pitched two scoreless and hitless innings while surrendering a lone walk...After starter **Justin Bryant** got tagged for six first-inning runs in Sunday's doubleheader-opening loss, junior **Casey Estill** came on in relief and did not allow an earned run in 6.1 innings of action...The Skyhawks went 6-for-7 in stolen base attempts during the Murray State series. **Zach Dean** led the team with three thefts...UT Martin visits Belmont before heading down to Jacksonville State for OVC action.

TENNESSEE TECH (11-32, 5-12 OVC): Tennessee Tech slipped to 5-12 in the Conference (11-32 overall) after dropping a three-game OVC series to Jacksonville State over the weekend...Earlier in the week, Tech picked up a 9-1 road victory at Appalachian State...Senior SS **Brandon Selvig** pushed his hitting streak to six games, going 6-for-10 with two runs and two doubles in the four contests...Senior 1B **Nathan Marty** scored four times and drove in four runs on the week, giving him a team-high 34 RBI on the season. He also has a squad-best nine home runs, more than double any other Golden Eagle...Marty (.327) and Selvig (.321) are the only two Tech starters hitting better than .300...The Golden Eagles play host to Belmont before visiting OVC foe Samford.
