PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

JORDAN PAYNE • SS, SR. • BOLIVAR, MO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Payne batted .412 (7-for-17) while helping Southeast Missouri to a 3-1 record last week, including a pair of wins over Tennessee Tech that guaranteed the Redhawks the sixth and final berth in the upcoming O'Reilly OVC Tournament. The senior shortstop saved his biggest game for last, going 4-for-6 with two homers, a double, five RBI and four runs scored in Saturday's tourney-clinching win against the Golden Eagles. For the week, the Bolivar, Mo., native posted a 1.059 slugging percentage with three home runs and two doubles while collecting seven RBI and seven runs.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

BRAD DANIEL • RHP, SR. • DICKSON, TN • AUSTIN PEAY

Working on one day's notice, Austin Peay ace reliever Brad Daniel made the start and pitched a complete-game, three-hit shutout in game two against Eastern Kentucky on Friday. The senior righthander held the league's top-rated offense to a .130 batting average, including limiting the Colonels' top five hitters to a 1-for-13 combined effort. A native of Dickson, Tenn., Daniel struck out five batters and walked four en route to recording the Govs' first shutout of the 2006 campaign.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (31-25, 14-12 OVC): Austin Peay closed out the regular season with a 1-3 mark last week, dropping a non-conference meeting with Evansville (8-4) and taking one of three at Eastern Kentucky (6-12, 5-0, 4-6)...Senior RHP **Brad Daniel** (6-2, 2.09 ERA) tossed a three-hit, complete-game gem en route to picking up the win in game two at EKU, limiting the league's top-ranked offense to a .130 team average at the plate...It was the Govs' first shutout of the season and the first since Daniel blanked Jacksonville State in the championship game of last year's OVC tournament...Senior CF **Cody Youngblood** takes a nine-game hitting streak into postseason play, batting .545 during that span to give him a team-high .365 average on the season...Freshman 2B **Ryan Gilboy** is hitting .361 and leads the Govs with 49 RBI...Roster shakeups left APSU with a 24-man roster for the EKU series as senior ace **Rowdy Hardy** (9-3, 2.58 ERA) missed the series due to pending eligibility issues and three freshmen were suspended for a violation of team rules...The Govs have the No. 5 seed for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament and will face fourth-seeded Eastern Kentucky at 2:30 p.m. Central in opening-round action Wednesday...APSU went 4-11 during the regular season against the rest of the tourney field; however, four of the five series were on the road.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (31-22, 17-10 OVC): Eastern Illinois went scoreless in a mid-week loss to Bradley (8-0), but wrapped up regular-season play on a high note, sweeping its OVC series with Morehead State (8-0, 6-4, 7-2) to claim the No. 3 seed for the upcoming OVC tournament...Junior 1B **Erik Huber** had multiple hits in all three games against the Eagles, closing out the four-game stretch with an 8-for-12 effort at the plate and a .706 on-base percentage...Junior RHP **Drew Gierich** (1-2, 3.87 ERA) worked a career-high 7.1 shutout innings in the opener of the Morehead State series to earn his first victory as a Panther, snapping a streak of eight consecutive no-decisions...Gierich's outing was the longest by an EIU hurler this season...Junior **Chris Vaculik** collected his 16th and 17th career saves, closing out both ends of Saturday's doubleheader to become the Panthers' all-time saves leader...Twenty of the Panthers' 21 hits on Saturday went for singles...Freshman RHP **Jake Wade** (4-1, 3.70 ERA) picked up his first career OVC victory, working the first five innings of Sunday's contest...Sophomore righty **Alex Guttosch** (5-0, 3.80 ERA) pitched 4.2 innings of scoreless relief in the Morehead series, earning the save in the finale...The Panthers will face No. 6 Southeast Missouri at 6:30 p.m. Central in Wednesday's opening round.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (27-24, 16-10 OVC): Eastern Kentucky played .500 ball in its final week of regular-season action, losing a 14-4 outing to Western Kentucky before taking two of three in its OVC series with Austin Peay (12-6, 0-5, 6-4)...Freshman 3B **Matt Davis** went 6-for-16 with three doubles, three RBI and three runs scored on the week...Freshman RHP **Eric Hash** (5-1, 3.55 ERA) allowed just five hits and one earned run to pick up the win in the series finale with APSU...Hash recorded seven strikeouts in the contest, retiring 11 straight batters and 15 of 16 at one point...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (9-2, 1.92 ERA) recorded his third consecutive outing with double-digit strikeouts, fanning a career-high 14 batters in the game two loss...Friedrich has registered double-digit K's on seven occasions this season and ranks fourth nationally in strikeouts per nine innings, currently averaging 13.08...EKU rapped out 16 hits in the game one victory to back up senior RHP **Scott Goetz**, (3-7, 7.45 ERA), who tossed a season-high seven innings to earn the win...The No. 4 Colonels will take on fifth-seeded Austin Peay at 2:30 p.m. Central in opening-round action Wednesday at the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (32-22, 19-8 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a narrow 7-6 non-conference decision to Kennesaw State, then closed out the regular season on a three-game win streak after sweeping its OVC series with Murray State (13-5, 12-1, 7-4)...Sophomore OF **Clay Whittemore** extended his hitting streak to a career-high eight games, leading the Gamecocks with a 7-for-14 effort at the plate over the four-game stretch...He drove in five runs and scored seven more...Junior LHP **Tony Drinkard** (8-4, 2.16 ERA) came within two outs of recording a no-hitter in Friday's nightcap win against the 'Breds. He retired the first 12 batters in

the game and held Murray State to a .053 hitting average (1-of-19), but surrendered a run in the final frame to end his streak of scoreless innings end at 27.2...Junior OF **Nick Cleckler** has hit safely in a school-record 26 consecutive games, the longest active hitting streak in the OVC...The Gamecocks have registered 10 or more hits in each of their last five games and are batting above .300 as a team for the first time this season...Records are falling all around as JSU has set new school Division I marks for stolen bases (79), saves (13) and pickoffs (16) in a season...In addition, the Gamecocks are one triple shy of tying the school season record of 25...As the No. 2 seed, Jax State has an opening-round bye and will play its first game of the OVC tournament on Thursday.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-36, 8-18 OVC): Morehead State closed out the season on a five-game slide, losing a 12-2 non-conference decision to Louisville and getting swept in its final OVC series at Eastern Illinois (8-0, 6-4, 7-2)...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** finished his career with 35 home runs and 104 runs batted in after leading the Eagles in dingers (13) this season and tying with junior C **Donald Cheney** for the team lead in RBI (36)...Cheney also ended the season with 12 homers, 11 doubles and a squad-tying three triples...Rhodes and junior 2B **Chris McCaslin** were the only Eagles to play in every game this season, starting all 53 at their respective positions...In his first season at Morehead, junior 3B **Ryan Kinder** rapped out a team-best 60 hits while batting .304 to rank first among Eagle starters...Junior RHP **Henry Mabree** (5-8, 4.43 ERA) also had a solid first year at Morehead, striking out 83 batters while tying school records for shutouts (2) and complete games (9) in a season...Junior OF **Dustin Miles** was the Eagles' most patient hitter, drawing a team-high 46 walks to rank among league and national leaders...Sophomore SS **Nick Nail** also ranked among OVC and NCAA leaders with 15 sacrifice hits.

MURRAY STATE (15-40, 8-19 OVC): Murray State finished the 2006 campaign on a seven-game slide after going winless in its final OVC series at Jacksonville State (13-5, 12-1, 7-4)...The 'Breds best play this season came in the middle of their Conference slate, where they sandwiched a 6-3 series record between 1-8 marks at the start and end of league play...Junior CF **Tyler Pittman** led the team with a 5-for-11 effort in the JSU series, collecting four RBI and three runs scored...He also rapped a pair of doubles to tie the school's single-season record with 21 two-baggers...In addition, Pittman was the team leader in hits (55) and RBI (35)...Senior RF **Brett Mullins** was the only 'Bred to play in all 55 games this season...Junior C **Jason Payton** belted a team-high seven homers and boasted the squad's top slugging percentage (.490) while tying for the team lead in triples (3).

SAMFORD (32-23, 21-6 OVC): Samford captured the 2006 OVC regular-season title outright with a doubleheader sweep of UT Martin on Saturday (5-4, 2-0)...The Bulldogs were unable to complete the series sweep, however, dropping a 9-7, 13-inning decision in Saturday's finale...Samford set a school record for overall wins (32) and an OVC mark for Conference wins (21)...Sophomore OF **Bear Burnett** went 4-for-8 in the series, rapping three doubles for an .875 slugging percentage...Sophomore RHP **Doug Denson** (2-1, 3.21 ERA) pitched 5.0 innings of scoreless relief over the weekend, allowing only four hits and two walks with three strikeouts in two appearances...Junior **Josh Ehmke** (10-2, 2.92 ERA) became the first OVC pitcher to reach the 10-win mark this season, earning the victory in game two on Friday, while junior closer **Joseph Edens** (2-0, 1.69 ERA) worked the final inning to pick up his league-leading 11th save...On Saturday, **Benji Waite** hit his first career homer, a three-run shot in the bottom of the ninth that tied the game at 7-7 and forced extra innings...As the top seed for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament, Samford has an opening-round bye and will see its first action on Thursday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (21-31, 11-16 OVC): Southeast Missouri clinched the No. 6 seed for the 2006 O'Reilly OVC Tournament with a 21-10 victory in its regular-season finale against Tennessee Tech...The two teams split Friday's twinbill, setting up the winner-take-all contest on Saturday...The Redhawks also picked up a 7-6 win over non-conference foe Saint Louis earlier in the week...Senior SS **Jordan Payne** led Southeast's offense on Saturday, going 4-for-6 with two home runs, a double, five RBI and four runs scored...Payne, who also drove in the winning run against SLU, fin-

ishing the week with a 1.059 slugging percentage...Junior **Phillip Riley** (3-4, 4.14 ERA) pitched 7.1 innings of scoreless relief to pick up the game one victory on Friday, allowing just two singles while striking out eight batters...On Saturday, the Redhawks set season-highs in runs (21), hits (22), total bases (34), RBI (20), doubles (6) and hit by pitch (7)...Freshman **Andrew Graham** crossed the plate five times on Saturday...Junior 2B **Omar Padilla**, who extended his hitting streak to 10 games, has recorded multiple-hit performances in six of his last seven outings...The Redhawks hit .404 as a team over the four-game stretch...Senior RHP **Jamie McAlister** (4-11, 4.30 ERA) has the dubious distinction of being the school's single-season loss leader, also tying an OVC mark with his 11th setback of 2006...The Redhawks will take on third-seeded Eastern Illinois at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday in opening-round action.

UT MARTIN (20-35, 9-18 OVC): UT Martin closed out the 2006 season on a high note, snapping a six-game losing streak with a 9-7 victory in 13-innings over OVC regular-season champion Samford on Saturday...The win salvaged UT Martin's series with the Bulldogs following a doubleheader loss on Friday (4-5, 0-2)...Earlier in the week, the Skyhawks also lost a narrow 8-6 decision to Mississippi State...UT Martin played six extra-inning contests this season, posting a 3-3 mark...The Skyhawks were also part of 20 one-run decisions, going 12-8 in those contests...Senior C/DH **Brett Spivy** homered twice in the season finale to finish his career with 19 dingers, third-most in school history...Spivy led the Skyhawks in batting (.321), doubles (11) and slugging percentage (.577) this season while tying for the team lead in RBI (28) with junior SS **Lance Renton** and sophomore OF **Blake Turner**...Redshirt freshman **Eric Walker** (1-0, 3.70 ERA) picked up his first save of the season on Saturday...Junior reliever **Chadwick Cameron** (4-3, 3.90 ERA) set school records for appearances (25) and saves (6) in a season...Junior 1B **Jason Hockaday** ended the 2006 campaign with a four-game hitting streak...UT Martin's nine OVC victories are the most for the Skyhawks since joining the league in 1993.

TENNESSEE TECH (18-36, 11-16 OVC): Tennessee Tech saw its season come to an end as the Golden Eagles lost a must-win OVC series at Southeast Missouri...After falling 10-5 in Friday's twinbill opener, Tech rallied to take a 9-5 decision in the nightcap, setting up Saturday's critical game three, which was won by Southeast, 21-10...Junior 3B **Brian Sprowl** led the team with a 5-for-12 series at the plate, driving in three runs and scoring four more...Junior C **Steve Soper** paced the team with eight home runs and 33 RBI this season, while freshman IF **Stuart Meinhart** rapped out a squad-high 13 doubles...Sophomore **Jake New** posted the Golden Eagles' best batting average, finishing the year with a .319 clip and team-highs in doubles (15) and hits (61)...Sophomore **Matt Mihoci** was the only Golden Eagle to play in every game in '06, starting all 54 at second base.
